

## Importer Saved in \$50,000 Fire at Siegel Home

Millionaire Importer Juan Romero, 46, was carried to safety from a second-story window by firemen yesterday as flames swept through his palatial home at 810 N Linden Drive, Beverly Hills.

The 16-room mansion, scene of the still-unsolved gangland slay ing of Benjamin (Bugsy) Siegel on June 20, 1947, was severely damaged. Estimates of the loss exceeded \$50,000.

Romero was treated at Bever ly Hills Receiving Hospital where his condition was report ed not serious. Firemen A. Y. Velarde and B. L. Hicklin broke through an upper window to rescue the importer.







I had lunch while I was in New York with William Bradford Huie, the new editor of the New American Mercury Which will be on the magazine stands next month, and as we sat sipping our soup at the exclusive Colony Restaurant I was trying to match up the Huie who was sitting across from me with the Huie I had heard about in connection with Benjamin (Bugsy) Siegel.



In my book, "Headline Happy," I talked about a houseboy who left Siegel's mansion in Holmby Hills shortly before a raid by the U.S. Customs men, but I didn't give the name of the departed employee because I didn't know it could be told.

Huie said it could be told and as a matter of fact he is writ-

ing an article himself for his new magazine which he'll call "My Christmas With Bugsy Siegel," in which he'll reveal how he got a job as a butler with the famous underworld figure and worked at the job for three weeks.

Huie is the kind of reporter who'll do odd and daring thing to get stories, so it didn't surprise his wife, too much, when she received a letter from a Los Angeles employment agency con to her at her home in Alabama saying that she had been given as a reference by a man who claimed to have once worked for her as a butler.

She knew at once it was pappy out pulling off a stant, as she played her end of the game.

Hule became interested in Siegel one day while driving through Holmby Hills. He was passing the new home Benny had built, so he decided to pretend he was selling magazines are rang the back-door hell.

She invited him in and gave him a sandwich. She told him the servants had all just been fired by Mrs. Siegel and that they were going to hire a new crew.

This gave Huie an idea for a plan which he promptly put into action. He went to the employment agency where Mrs. Siegel hired her servants and represented himself as a fancy butler just in from the South.

This all happened at the time Siegel was out on the high seas with the Countess Di Frasso on the famous Metha Nelson trip to the Cocos Islands. Huie got the job.

You'll have to read his own story about how he played Santa Claus for the Siegel children and waited on Mrs. Siegel's parents and other relatives from New York. It's a fabulous yarn.

"I didn't find out much about Bugsy," he told me, "hecquise the guy was seldom home. It was just as well he wasn't perhaps." I was a little nervous when he was around."

had also compared the cartridge cases in the SIEGKL Murder with test specimens fired from the carbine located in the apartment in Chicago in 1949. He did not make a formal request for such a check but he said he merely assumed that such would have been done if the Bureau had tested both specimens from the SIEGRL killing and the gun found in the partment.

Subsequent to the interview the writer reviewed the handling of the cartridge cases involved in the SIECEL killing as described in file 62-2837, and found references to this matter in Serials 826, 829, 844 and 891, 892. The substance of the review reflects that there were nine cartridge cases found at the scene of the SIEGEL Murder . These eartridge cases were found on the ground outside of the window through which the shots were fired at SIECEL. These cartridge cases were appearently in the possession of investigating officer from the Beverly Hills Police Department. Subsequently, three of these catalogs cases were furnished to Agents of this office by who was then Chief Investigator for the Los py. who was then Chief Investigator for the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office, for the purpose of having the FBI Laboratory conduct examination of the cartridge This office requested the Bureau on August 27, 1947 to hold these cartridge cases pending subsequent instructions and it was suggested that the New York, Chicago, Detroit, Mismi, Salt Lake Gity, Phoenix, and San Francisco Offices be alerted by the Bureau to recover earbines of any kind for the purpose of a comparison axamination with the cartridge cases found at the SIBORL Murder scene. The Burees made an exemination as reflected in their letter of October 2, 1947, Seriel 844, in which they stated that the marks were not adequate for somparison purposes and requested that the six additional cartridge eases found at the scene of the murder be obtained by this office and forwarded to the Laboratory for comparison purposes. The additional six certridge eases work obtained and forwarded to the Laboratory.



It is the writer's recollection, although there is nothing in the file to substantiate the recollection, that in connection with the cartridge cases involved in the SIEGEL Murder, they were not being properly retained by the local investigating agencies, so that they could be utilized accurately as evidence in a trial. It may be that due to this laxness of local agencies the additional cartridge cases were not obtained or forwarded to the Bureau for examination because of subsequent difficulties which might arise.

A letter is being directed to the FBI Laboratory escerning this metter inquiring whether such an examination would now be feasible and for the purpose of calling to the Bureau's attention the fact that they probably have examined test specimens from the carbine found in appartment and may not have examined the cartridge cases in that instance with those found at the SIEGEL murder.

Investigation in the UFAP-MURBER CASE AGAINST developed that he was a subject in a Bureau case at Chicago entitled
Fugitive, FFIS, Illegal Possession of Covernment Property, in 1949

In searching his apartment they found a loaded 50 caliber carbine, SN 586459, which was turned over to the Chicago FBI office. Federal complaint against was dismissed at Chicago on 4-1-50. There was no identification at that time as being identical with Thus there was no reason to have test specimen fired from the carbine. was a suspect in the SIEGEL murder, which took place in 1947.

As stated in prior memos of the writer, through conversation with it was learned that he thought the FBI laboratory had checked the gun goundin apartment in Chicago against the cartridge cases found at the scene of the SIEGEL murder. The writer did not think that was correct and the ensuing correspondence with the FBI laboratory and Chicago took place.

On 10-24-51 the writer talked to and told him that the FBI Laboratory has never tested the carbine found apartment in Chicago. He said he thought he had learned recently that his prior impression was incorrect and that some such test has now been made. He phoned and asked him if the carbine above mentioned had been checked out on the Siegel case. It told him that fired test specimen from the carbine, which specimens had been checked by some ballistics laboratory and they were not similar to those found at the Siegel murder scene. He told that he considers the Siegel murder solved through the recent murders of TONY BRANCATO and TONY TROMBINO in Los Angeles.

No further action need be taken on the carbine at Chicago.

### 'Beverly Hills Is My Beat'

## Chief Recalls Last Moments of Bugsy Siegel

Today in his biography Chief Anderson tells the inside thory of the gangland killing of Bugsy Siegel, in a Beverly Hills mansion. He calls it "a perfectly staged execution" with every prap and every actor in place at the proper aplitaceoud.

### By Clinton Anderson

Chief, Beverly Hills Police Department

#### Chapter IX

Siegel away from Hollywood and into new ventures which eventually led to his death. He decided to build the biggest and best gambling casino in the United States, financing it with crime syndicate money put up by his eastern pals, and to expand his "bootleg" racing wire service to take over the business in the western part of the country.

He launched construction of his big casino when materials were scarce and costs soaring. He had originally planned a \$2 million investment, but found the place costing \$6 million, and running in the red. He put the squeeze on his other activities for funds, particularly the racing wire service.

After the gangland murder in 1946 of James M. Ragen, general manager in Chicago of the Trans-America News Service in which Siegel had a controlling interest, he became western representative of the wire and attempted to force the bookles to take his service at a premium.

### Siegel's Hoodium Friends Unhappy

As Siegel went deeper into debt, word got around that his crime syndicate pals were unhappy.

Six months before his killing I called him to police headquarters and reminded him pointedly that I did not want him causing any unpleasant happenings in Bevrly Hills His answer was that there was no need to worry because he was spending most of his time in Las Vegas.

while I was in New York a few months later on police business. I picked up the information that Siegel had been in the city for a meeting with the men who controlled the syndicate money, and had left in haste. His hotel was reportedly is million in the red, and Siegel had told friends he had to raise \$1,500,000 in 30 days to pull it out of the hote.

His number was up, I did not know it at the time but Beverly Hills had already been chosen as the spot for his execution.

Three months before the killing his fed haired girl friend, Virginia Hill, had rented a handsome 18-room home on N. Linden dr., which was owned by Juan Romero, former manager of Millolph Valentino. Bugsy had a gold key to the front door, kept some of his clothes and a 38 calleer automatic in the house on his one or two day business wips

The foursome drove to Ocean Fark for a trout dinner and returned home at 18:16 p. m. and Siegel and Smiley went into the fiving room and sat able by side on the davenport to read early editions at the Los Angèles morning newspapers.

At 10:45 p. m. a series of shots crashed through the fiving room window. Smiley dived to the floor unharmed, but Siegel did not move. He had been killed almost instantly by two bullets which struck him in the head. Two other bullets had lodged in his body. He lay back on the davenport, his hands resting in his lap, with a newspaper between his grotesquely sprawled legs.

### **Execution Perfectly Staged**

Nine shells were found in the driveway of the house mext door. The killer had rested his high-caliber rifle in a latticed pergola a dozen feet from where Siegel and Smiley sat.

On the day Siegel was killed I was in New York City picking up a criminal who was involved in a \$150,000 jewel robbery of a society matron. Only a few hours before the murder my prisoner staunchly maintained his innocence, using Siegel as his alibi. He swore that Bugay had seen him at the Flamingo in Las Vegas on the day the Beverly Hills holdup was committed.

Bugsy Siegel's killing was a perfectly staged gangland execution, with all the details worked out in advance.

Somebody knew that Siegel would be in Beverly Hills on this one day, and that he would be at Virginia Hills home, and when. Somehow the heavy draperies over the hilling-room window had been left open to give the killer a view of the room.

The shooting was timed to occur when a police patrol probably would not be near. It had to be done quickly because police cars were in the vicinity every 30 minutes. The gunman at the window was hidden from the street by shrubbery, and the getaway car cruised the area until the appointed time, since a parked car might have drawn suspicion.

### Siegei Case Never 'Cracked' 🔊

We spent many man-hours investigating the Siegel case and were convinced that he was killed by his own associates, but there was never sufficient evidence to pinpoint the identity of the assassins in court. I felt it was significant that Moe Sedway, a man with a police record, walked into the Flamingo to take over the operation for

the syndicate one hour after Stegel's death, 300 miles away.

I picked up Sedway for questioning and released him with word that I wanted to see him on the following day. However, he was suddenly removed to a Hollywood hospital for treatment for a heart condition.

I found him there next day lying in bed behind a door marked "No Admittance—Oxygen!" I stepped in and talked briefly to Sedway, and left with word that I would return in the morning.

But when morning came I discovered that the sick man had been put on a train and whisked off to Las Vegas, where he stayed until his death a short time later. I have always felt that Moe Sedway had the information I wanted, but he wouldn't talk.

About this time several newspaper articles mentioned that I was investigating Las Vegas angles in the Siegel killing, a fact which annoyed the then chief of police of the Nevada city. He announced in a newscast that if he caught me in his city with a gun he would lock me up in fail, but his threat did not hinder our investigation.

Later, the new operators of the Flamingo had a bitter battle, and one of them left the city in haste, under threat of death. I interrogated this man on his arrival in Beverly Hills, but he was reluctant to talk, fearing gangland retaliation.

e When I attempted to obtain more details on the fight in Las Vegas, I found that the district attorney there was also the attorney for one of the combatants, a rather unusual situation.

Siegel was killed because he would not comply with the wishes of his associates who had invested millions in the Flamingo. My investigation tied him in with mobs in other cities and with international narcotics operators. I came across the trail of half a dozen other murders which were traceable to gangster and gambling connections.
