

Divisions sets forth information relative to the purchase of the residence at 1436 West 28th Street, Sunset Isle No. 1, Miami Beach, Florida, February 8, 1946, by VIRGINIA HILL, due to the fact that no one has been living there since March of 1946. This address is in an exclusive section of Miami Beach.

Reference is made to the letter from the Salt Lake City Field Division dated December 2, 1946, setting forth information relative to the ownership of the Colonial Inn and Green Acres by FRANK COSTELLO, JOE ADONIS, and MEYER LANSKY of New York City, SIEGEL of Los Angeles, and Las Vegas, which letter requested that Salt Lake City be furnished with any information concerning these places and SIEGEL's connections and contacts.

It has been the general information of the Miami Field Division for some time that these four mentioned individuals are interested in the ownership of these two gambling casinos along with There is also information that

there is a Chicago interest therein, making the so-called Big 6" group. which is said to be active on a nation-wide scale.


MEYER LANSKY also has spent considerable time during the present winter season in this area and is presently residing in the Sheldon Hotel, Hollywood, Florida.

JOE ADONIS of New York City, whose correct name is JOSEPH A. DOTO, has been reported as being in Hollywood, Florida, but this has never been definitely established thus far.


FRANK COSTELLO is likewise known to be in the Mismi Area at the present time but he generally spends a part of the winter season in this area and last winter season was at the Hollywood Beach Hotel, Hollywood, Florida.

With reference to SIEGEL, the Subject of this investigation, it is expected that if he comes to this area he will occupy the house which is in the name of VRGINIA HILL at 1435 West 28th Street, Miami Beach, Florida.



The Green Acres is located in Hallandale, Florida, Broward County, which is immediately adjacent to the City of Hollywood, Florida, and gambling operations were begun on November 1, 1946. The Colonial Inn is also located in Hallandale, Florida, being in Broward County, and about a city block from the Gulf Stream Race Track.



APNER "LONGIE" ZWILLMAN, the New Jersey racketeer, has frequented Miami and vicinity in the past but any definite connection with the group above mentioned has not been determined.







TECHNICAL SURVEILLANCES

Dear Sir:

Reference is made to your letter dated January 13, 1947, in the above-captioned matter calling my attention to the fact that in my teletype of December 24, 1946, I advised that technical surveillances were installed on LD Lines 1, 2, 3, and 4, Las Vegas Turf Club, telephone 7070, located on the second floor of the Las Vegas Club, 23 East Fremont Street at 2:00 PM on that date and that the same symbol numbers were utilized for those technical surveillances that were formerly used on similar installations in July, 1946, at which times the telephone numbers were listed as Las Vegas 2460. for LD Line 1; Las Vegas 2283 for LD Line 2; and Las Vegas 2284 for LD Line

On December 24, 1946, technical surveillances were installed on the same four LD Lines at the Las Vegas Turf Club that were previously covered by technical surveillances in July, 1946. Hence, the same symbol numbers were used in December, 1946.

In addition to the four LD Lines, the Las Vegas Turf Club, located upstairs over the Las Vegas Club, has three local lines. The local lines are numbered 2283 (which is the listed telephone number of the Las Vegas Turf Club), 2284, and 2460. The latter two numbers are unlisted. At no time were technical surveillances installed by this office on any of the three local lines numbered 2283, 2284, and 2460.

The telephone number 2442, listed for the Las Vegas Club in the Las Vegas, Nevada telephone directory, is located downstairs in the Las Vegas Club proper (the gambling casino) and has no connection with the upstairs Las Vegas Turf Club, which is a suite of rooms located on the second floor. whose business is to handle bets on horse races, and other sporting events, which bets are made by telephone and are received from all over the United States. Therefore, telephone number 2442 had no connection with any technical surveillances maintained by this office.

When the original technical surveillances were installed on the four LD Lines in the Las Vegas Turr Club im July, 1946, advised that there were no numbers for these LD Lines

and that they were merely designated as Las Vegas Turf Club lines LD 1, 2, 3, and 4.

Consequently, the only proper way to designate the LD Lines is to designate them as Las Vegas Turf Club LD Lines 1, 2, 3, and 4, Telephone number Las Vegas 7070.

The previous designation in July, 1946, of the following:

LD Line 1, Las Vegas 2460 LD Line 2, Las Vegas 2283 LD Line 3, Las Vegas 2284 LD Line 4.
