





The CPA hearing went on from approximately 1:50 PM until 8:25 PM, with occasional breaks of a few minutes, at which time the foregoing individuals were noted moving about the mezzanine floor. at 8:25 PM, the meeting was adjourned and SIEGEL. left the hotel in one cab, followed by in another. As these cabs were leaving the hotel emerged and took a third cab to the St. Francis Hotel where he proceeded to Room 401 alone. SIEGEL and the others proceeded to Mills Field, South San Francisco, where they met for a short time in the Grill Room. While awaiting the plane was overheard talking to SIEGEL to the following effect: "The trouble with is he never does anything -- when he doesn't write it down he can't remember it, and he never writes anything down." Meanwhile, city officials admitted that the reported influx of eastern gangsters to the West Coast is no myth. Eastern gang interests have definitely had their sye on Vallejo as a place to operate. Vallejo officials are aware of the situation and are prepared to meet the problem if and when it arises.

Siegel, gambler and gangster, over-extended himself in his attempts to control a dope ring, state law enforcement officers; say, and for that reason, died an linglorious death in the home of another girl friend, Virginia Hill, in Beverly Hills.


