Our checks were positive with regard to approximately 100 of these individuals. Negative responses have previously been forwarded to the Department.

The Department's request in this instance does not follow the Criminal Division's standard guideline, which requires specific data regarding location, duration, etc., of the electronic surveillance in question. This inquiry is the same type which has previously been received prior to the Department's launching of a task force operation and does not require specific detail regarding the installation nor does it require the submission of logs, as have been requested in the guideline-type request.







Carmine "Lilo" Galante DATE OF REVIEW 2

Carmine Galante was released from Federal Prison, Atlanta, Georgia, on January 24, 1974. Information increasingly indicates Galante will assume command of the crime group known as the Bonnano - Evola Family, which he has long been associated with, and will possibly attempt a take over of all New York Italian crime groups. The following is background information regarding Galante:

In 1930, Galante was arrested for the murder of a New York patrolman, who was trying to protect a payroll from robbery, in Brooklyn, however, he was released for lack of evidence.

On December 24. 1930, Galante was wounded by who surprised Galante and three other men in an accempted armed robbery of a truck. Galante was captured by plercing his overcoat several times and hitting him in the thigh. Two small children were also wounded in this shooting.

For this offense he received a twelve years and six months sentence, however, he was paroled on May 1, 1939. While on parole to the New York State Parole authorities, considerable suspicion was aroused concerning the legitimacy of his activities, and efforts were madetto determine if he was violating the provisions of his parole. On the evening of January 11, 1943, Galante reported to his parole office and upon leaving, was put under surveillance. He was observed to enter a Ford sedan, the license number of which was noted by the parole officers. Since they had no vehicle available and no other transportation was immediately available, they were unable to continue their surveillance. Shortly thereafter, at approximately 9:40 p. m. that same evening, Carlo Tresca, editor of an Italian language newspaper, was murdered on Fifth Avenue, by an unidentified assailant who entered a Ford sedan in which two accomplices were believed to be waiting. The following morning, an abandoned Ford sedan was found two blocks from the scene of this murder which the police department

believed may have been the vehicle used by the escaped murderers. The license plate of this abandoned vehicle was identical to that license number noted by the parole officers from their surveillance of Galante on the previous night. Galante was taken into custody on January 13, 1943, and held in violation of parole since no evidence could be obtained to directly link Galante with this murder, and since it was not positive that the abandoned vehicle was the murderers' getaway car, Galante was not prosecuted for this murder. He was, however, returned to Sing Sing for violating the provisions of his parole in that he associated with the ex-convict. and that he drove an automobile for approximately six months, such being unauthorized under the terms of his parole. He was returned to prison to serve the remaining portion of his sentence. To date this murder has never been solved although the

At approximately 10:00 p. m., on that evening, a state trooper stopped a speeding car and the driver identified himself by means of a driver's license as Joseph Di Palermo, 246 Elizabeth Street, New York City. The driver of the vehicle, upon being unable to give the correct birth date on the driver's license was placed in the state trooper's car and brought to the Binghamton Substation, where he was identified as Carmine Galante, 274 Marcy Avenue, Brooklyn, New York. He had over \$1,800 in cash on his person, \$1,200 of which was in \$100 bills. The other two occupants of this vehicle were later determined to be Frank Garofalo and John Bonventre.

Galante was charged with speeding, being an unlicensed operator, and the unauthorized use of another's driver's license and was arraigned before the Justice of the Peace in the town of Windsor where he pled not guilty and was released on \$600 bail with the case set for October 25, 1956. Shortly after this arrest, efforts were made by Chief of Detectives Chris Gleitsmann and Sergeant Peter Policastro of the West New York, New Jersey Police Department to obtain leniency for Galante. It was alleged that an offer of \$1,000 was made if the State Police would intercede and allow Galante to be given a suspended sentence.

In January, 1958, considerable publicity appeared in the local New York newspapers concerning the probe being conducted by the New Jersey Law Enforcement Council into

the activities of racketeers. This investigation brought to light the alleged bribery attempts on behalf of Galante by the West New York, New Jersey Police Department. Police Commissioner Ernest J. Modarelli was suspended from his position by the Hudson County Board of Freeholders since it appeared that he was the link behind the efforts of Gleitsmann to intercede on Galante's behalf.

The "New York Daily News" of January 9, 1958, related that the West New York, New Jersey City Commission approved the suspension of two partolmen accused of offering a New York state trooper a \$1,000 bribe to clear Carmine Galante of the traffic violation. No action was being taken against Police Commissioner Modarelli since he appeared to be evading all public contact and comments. Later Modarelli in a public statement denied sending Gleitsmann to Binghamton on Galante's behalf.

The "New York World Telegram and Sun" dated January 11, 1958, stated that Assemblyman William F. Passannante had identified himself as one of the legislators who interceded on behalf of Galante. Passannante claimed that a "lawyer friend" asked him to find an upstate lawyer to defend Galante and that he had requested Assemblyman Daniel S. Dickenson, Jr. of Binghamton, New York, to look into the situation. Each claimed, after being made aware of Galante's prior record, that they did not desire to become involved in the case.

In the January 13, 1958 edition of the "New York World Telegram and Sun", an article appeared in connection with the report to be released by the New Jersey Law Enforcement Council concerning their investigation. This report concluded that the conduct of West New York, New Jersey Police Commissioner Ernest J. Modarelli and Detective Captain Chris Gleitsmann strongly suggested that their relationship with the criminal element may go much deeper than intercession and bribery on behalf of an ex-convict. The report described Modarelli as sedulously avoiding a council subpoena and concluded that Captain Gleitsmann did attempt to bribe a New York State trooper.

Concerning the well publicized Apalachin meeting of November 14, 1957, the January 11, 1958 edition of the "New York Daily Mirror" carried an article captioned, "12 on Lamb in Mafia Probe", which reported the activities of the New York Legislative Watchdog Committee. A portion of this article related that investigators stated that Galante was among the 60 hoodlums attending the Apalachin meeting at the home of Joseph Barbara at Apalachin, New York. He also had visited there in October, 1956, when he was arrested as a trafic violator.

In the "New York Journal American", dated January 9, 1953, an article appeared stating that a law enforcement official told the "New York Journal American" that Carmine Galante was seen in Havana two days ago. He stated that prior to that, Galante was observed in Miami Beach in the company of three well-known gangsters. This official was quoted as saying, "We have every reason to believe that Galante may be planning to move into the operations of Havana's Sans Souci gambling concession."

In the "New York Daily Mirror", dated January 11, 1958, an article appeared in connection with the investigation being conducted by the New York Legislative Watchdog Committee. It was reported that investigators had said that Galante had been reported to have left the United States for Italy, but that the Interior Ministry at Rome had said an extended check had failed to show his entry.

The "New York Herald Tribune", dated January 3, 1958, carried an article stating that Galante was believed, to have fled to Italy, where he could enlist the aid of Lucky Luciano for whom he used to run narcotics in Harlem.

The "New York Times", on January 11, 1958, reported that Galante was reported to have fled from the Apalachin meeting, possibly to Italy, but that Interior Ministry sources in Rome had said an extended check had failed to produce any evidence that he was in that country.
