CARMINE GALANTE's hours were very irregular. He arrived home usually 5:00 a.m. and left in the early evening. He had a black Cadillac and ANN drove a light blue Cadillac, although they had a number of cars while they resided there. She further advised their older daughter, MARY, had a broken leg and was out of school beginning around Christmas, 1957.
