

COMMITTEE TO FREE ORLANDO BOSCH AVILA INTERNAL SECURITY-CUBA

Information was received during February, 1971, to the effect that we will be a group which had been formed for the purpose of seeking freedom for Dr. Orlando Bosch Avila.

Orlando Bosch Avila, a former medical doctor in Cuba, is the titular head of a small action group of anti-Castro exiles known as the Movimiento Insurreccional De Recuperacion Revolucionaria (MIRR).

Bosch is presently incarcerated in the Federal Penitentiary in Atlanta, Georgia. Since 1961, members of the MIRR have been involved in activities of a revolutionary nature including bombings, demonstrations and propaganda.

During interview with Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), on January 6, 1970, also known as stated he considered himself first and foremost, a Cuban patriot. He advised he was at that time a member of the MIRR, but had also anti-Castro organization which he called the Antorcha Revolucionaria Anticastrista (Anti-Castro Revolutionary Torch) (ARA).



stated at the outset, that he continues to be 100 per cent devoted to the cause of removing Fidel Castro as the leader of Cuba, and thereafter returning himself to a free Cuba. He stated that toward this end, he continues to be active in behalf of Cuban refugee affairs in the New York-New Jersey area. He advised that ARA, is not connected in any way with the MIRR. He stated that the MIRR is no longer active in the Hudson County, New Jersey area, and that most of its activity is confined to the Miami, Florida area. He continued that as a matter of fact, only two weeks ago, the ARA and two other anti-Castro Cuban refugee organizations were consolidated into one organization, which will be known as the Junta Cubana (JC). He identified the other two organizations as the Cruzada Civica. Anti-Communista and the Associacion Sindicato Independentista. continued that the JC has no leader or formal organization at the present time, and it has not held any meetings. He explained that in most cases, when Cuban refugees in the Northern New Jersey area wish to hold a rally, they generally get together with other refugees in New York City and hold their rally or meeting at the Hotel Woodstock, 43rd Street, New York City.

In connection with Dr. Bosch, stated that he has always considered him to be one of the great Cuban patriots and he has always been a close personal supporter of Dr. Bosch. He stated that during the past year he and the ARA, have been active in an effort to obtain either the freedom of, or clemency for, Dr. Bosch. He said that the majority of his activity has been trying to organize petitions for clemency for Dr. Bosch, which were to be forwarded to President Nixon; and also, he has urged all Cuban refugees, who are sympathetic with Dr. Bosch, to send telegrams to that effect to their representatives in the United States Congress. added that he understands that individuals who are seeking freedom for Dr. Bosch, made an approach during the recent past in Miami, Florida to Mr. Bebe Rebozo, who is a personal friend of President Nixon:

Cuban matters than he himself. BUTARI is a successful businessman who resides in Miami and who is also knowledgeable of anti-CASTRO operations and activities in the Miami area, according to REBOZO. (4)

REBOZO was also shown pictures (without any identifying data) but recognized none of the persons in the photographs. REBOZO stated that his number one supervisor in the Key Biscayne Bank is also very knowledgeable of friends who visit REBOZO at the bank as well as banking clients. He suggested that his number one supervisor view the photographs previously exhibited to REBOZO. He stated that this supervisor is approximately 38 years of age who has been in his employ for two years and who is considered by REBOZO to be completely reliable. REBOZO stated that he has all of his upper echelon employees. "checked out" from every angle and could state without hesitation that without any criminal history and is a good, loyal U.S. citizen. was unable to recognize any of the persons in the photographs exhibited to him.

REBOZO stated that because of his relationship with President NIXON and with other high Government officials, he discusses nothing whatsoever with any relative which would bear wn U.S. relations with Cuba. He stated that he has a brother whom he considers to be "rather naive" and volunteered that he discusses very little of anything with him. REBOZO stated that no one would learn anything whatsoever from him about U.S. - Cuban relations.

REBOZO then contacted EDGARDO BUTARI, and without revealing the FBI's interest, queried BUTARI concerning the unknown subject on the basis of the data discussed with REBOZO. BUTARI was unable to recall anyone who might be identical with the Unsub

MACHO BARKER was closely associated with MIKE SUAREZ when he ran for political office. After SUAREZ lost the election, he contacted Mayor STEVE CLARK and said he was going to expand his political operations. Although BARKER was a business associate of SUAREZ, he decided to leave SUAREZ' political organization. \ \

BARKER joined a political group of EDGAR ANTHONY BUTTARI, a wealthy Cuban who lives on Key Biscayne and is dosely associated with BEBE AKBOZO.

BUTTARI was later called to Washington by the Nixon Administration to act as a consultant on some matter.

When NIXON announced the blockade of Haiphong Harbor, BUTTARI and BARKER planned to take some action to support the Nixon Administration. BARKER called different exile groups around the United States and raised some money under the pretext it was for an operation against Cuba. The money was actually designated for pro-NIXON demonstrations to be held in Wiami and other places. was formerly a member of BRAC in Cuba.

This organization was the Bureau for the Repression of Communism and was headed by MARIANO FAGET.

GIBERGA has served in Miami as chairman or leader of foreign nationalities for the Republican Party. GIBERGA is also credited with having been responsible for a program known as "SABER," an organization which has received \$600,000 in grant from the Federal Government to help unstilled Latins to Learn English and a trade. ARMANDO LACASA and HUMBERTO QUINONES, JR., are members of a committee to disperse this money which is intended for above purpose. However, this committee has formed a survey unit which interviews applicants for aid and then questions them concerning their political views with the view to recruiting them into the Republican Party. This \$600,000 fund is kept at the Fidelity National Bank (Bird Road) of which CARLOS ARBOLEYA, Cuban exile, is the president. (This bank is owned by ROBERTO ALEJOS, honorary chairman, who placed ARBOLEYA in as president.) ALEJOS, a Guatemalan of great wealth, was involved in an attempt with Cuban exiles recruited in Miami, to overthrow the Guatemalan Government.
