WILLIAM ROBERT PLUMIEE, 9411 North 16th Place, telephone number 944-0965, was advised of the identities of the interviewing Agents and that the interview pertained to his association and knowledge of JOHN ROSELLI. PLUMIEE furnished the following information:

He stated that he first had contact with ROSELLI in 1956 at West Palm Beach, Florida. He stated that at the time he (PLUMLEE) was working for Riddle Airlines as a mechanic and he was also using Regina Airlines equipment to fly arms and ammunition to FIDEL CASTRO for the revolution in Cuba against BATISTA. On some of these missions he used the pseudonym WILLIAM H. PIERSON. His involvement in the pro-Castro effort associated him with persons involved in "Operation M-26-7," and underground pro-Castro movement supported by the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA), which persons included one JOE WESTBROOK (who organized guerrilla support in Mexico); WILLIAM WESTAND, L. B. Smith Aircraft Corporation; WILLIAM H. CARR (phonetic) (CIA - Havana, Cuba); General DARCEY, Chief of U. S. Delegation on Cuban-American Defense Board; (First Name Unknown) CABRESIE (phonetic); JOHN V. MANTINO (active in organized crime in Miami, Florida); FRUCTUSO RODRIGUEZ (pro-Castro movement), and JOHN ROSKILI (organized crime and pro-Castro movement). In October, 1956, after the signing of an agreement for pro-Castro guerrilla support from Mexico, an agreement initially negotiated by JOE WESTBROOK, he flew ROSELLI from West Palm Beach, Fhorida, to Marathon Key, Florida. He said that at the time of the flight, he was under the impression that ROSHLLI was from Detroit or Chicago.

He stated that in 1958, he learned that WILLIAM H. CARR, the CIA Agent in Havana, sent SAM GIOVANNI (not sure if this man is identical to SAM GIANCANA) or JOHN ROSELLI to the Isles of Pine Prison with \$100,000.00 to bargain for the release of one BANQUIN, a political figure in Cuba, who had a close association with American business. He also advised that associated with ROSELLI during this time period was an individual known to him (PLUMLEE) as "RIP," who he believes is identical to WILLIAM ROBERTSON, a CIA contact with the Cuban

underground, and a person known as FRESQUEZ, initially in CASTRO's cabinet and later to become anti-Castro. He said he equated "RIP" with ROBERTSON based on information he had obtained from former FBI Agent WILLIAM TURNER.

He advised that he later had contact with ROSELLI during the anti-Castro period and in 1961 he ran into ROSELLI while ROSELLI was involved in the Happy Valley Nicaragua Camp, Nicaragua. He said that this was a training camp for the Bay of Pigs invasion force. During this time, ROSELLI associated with MARTO CARDONA, president of the Guban Revolutionary Force. He noted that the interest of ROSELLI and his associates at that time was to join all anti-Castro forces into an effective invasion force.

He continued his contract type flying into 1963, flying in Utah, Arizona, California and New Mexico, as well as Florida. All of these flights were connected with operations in Miami. In March, 1963, he flew into Tampa, Florida, where he met ROSELLI at a large motel (name unrecalled) across the street from the spring training camp of the New York Yankees or the Los Angles Dodgers. He stated that by now he was under the impression that ROSELLI was employed by the State Department. He flew ROSELLI and JOHN V. MARTINO from Tampa to Riviera Beach, Florida. During this time period, he learned that one Ambassador POLLY (phonetic) (possibly Ambassador to Peru) was trying to arrange a raid to remove missile technicians from Cuba. He was under the impression that POLLY was organizing the raid through ROSELLI, MARFINO and CARDONA. PLUMLEE participated in this raid in the spring of 1963. After the raid he flew ROSELLI to Bimini Island where he was to meet with POLLY, MARTINO and others. He stated that he learned that three weeks before this meeting. POLLY met at Bimini with BEBE KEBOZO and RICHARD NAXON.

Subsequent to the above raid, he was instructed to pick up \$15,000.00 at Miami, which was to be used for the purchase of guns from the New Orleans, Louisiana area. He stated that the individual from whom he got the money was an American and he met him at the L. B. Smith Aircraft Corporation. He said that he never knew the individual's name and never saw him again. His instructions were to deliver the money to ROSELLI. He stated that he traveled to West Palm Beach,

PERSONAL

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I hesitate to write you in this manner but I feel the information contained herein is condifential in a sense and significant because the principals involved are close to the President. It is submitted for your information as I feel there is no action we in the Eureau would be obliged to take.

Briefly, the enclosed memoranda relate a summons by Mr. Bebe Rebozo to me asking that I meet him at his bank to view one hundred thousand-dollars to determine whether any examination could be made to show that the money was in his possession for a number of years. As indicated, my reply was in the negative just from a cursory examination of the money which was crisp and new and alleged to have been kept in a safe deposit box for several years. Mr. Rebozo explained the source of the money and that he intended to return it but wanted to avoid any potential embarrassment to the President and himself since the money was never funneled into the campaign by Mr. Rebozo.

At the time of this incident, Mr. Rebozo asked me to keep my visit confidential. Since I saw no area of interest for the FBI in the facts as related, I merely recited the occurrence in memorandum form to my secretary for future reference in case any inquiry were ever made. I told Mr. Rebozo I felt I had to do this and he said "Fine;" that he had all the faith in the world in my secretary and me keeping the information confidential. It should be noted this information had been previously alluded to in Jack-Anderson's column some months earlier.

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The second enclosure reflects a visit by Internal Revenue Agents to me inquiring as to what transpired at Mr. Rebozo's bank that day. They were polite, indicated that Mr. Rebozo had been straightforward and honest with them about this hundred thousand dollars, had told them of my presence in the bank and my cursory examination of the money as outlined above. It should be noted at this juncture that Bebe Rebozo called me long distance from Washington to advise me that he had been interviewed by the IRS concerning this money and he had told the interviewing agents of my presence there. indicated to him they were going to visit me. Mr. Rebozo also stated he understood when I told him I was going to be perfectly candid with the Internal Revenue officers as to the purpose of my visit and of his, Rebozo's, request of the FBI regarding the analysis of the money.

The above represents the sum total of the point of this letter. I know Bebe Rebozo personally and feel that his call to me was motivated for the reasons he stated. I cannot imagine any ulterior motive as of this writing and if his intention was to use me or the FBI, I believe it was to establish the fact he had \$100,000 in a safety deposit box and I saw what purported to be this amount. Until I was called upon by the IRS, I did not feel this incident was particularly significant. Now, however, since potential exists it might make the papers at some future time, I felt you should know about the facts of this matter. I would like you to know I told Mr. Rebozo, in view of the intersession of the IRS, I felt constrained to advise my superiors of the above.

Upon reflection, I can think of no one or any particular area within the Seat of Government who would have an interest besides yourself. I therefore am using this method of furnishing the information to you for whatever purpose you see fit. I did not commit myself or the FBI to any restrictions relative to this information to Mr. Rebozo, but did feel it should be treated more circumspectly in view of all the investigations, Senate inquiries, etc., that are presently pending.

This is to record that I received two Special Agents of the Internal Revenue Service this morning in my office at 8:45. They properly identified themselves with their credentials and the man in charge of the investigation, Mr. BARRETT, indicated he wanted to see me about a very sensitive investigation.

He then explained that his inquiry dealt with Mr. BEBE REBOZO, who is the subject of an audit by the Internal Revenue Service He stated when interviewing Mr. REBOZO about the whereabouts of \$100,000 received from HOWARD HUGHES through RICHARD DANNER, he was told the money had been returned to Mr. DANNER. Mr. REBOZO also indicated that prior to returning the money he copied all the serial numbers and that I was present on the date the money was to be counted.

I explained to Agent BARRETT the purpose of my visit; that was to respond to Mr. REBOZO's request as to whether the money could be examined in any way to determine how old it was through chemical analysis. I explained to Agent BARRETT in detail the information set forth in my memroandum dated June 18, 1973.

BARRETT was most appreciative of my cooperation and stated it was identical to what Mr. REBOZO told him about my visit and the reason therefor. BARRETT stated this was extremely sensitive. He was concerned that this information should not be leaked to the press and asked if I had told anybody about the story Mr. REBOZO related to me. I replied I

did not tell anyone except my secretary because I felt there was no jurisdiction within the FBI's interest and once it was determined we could not be of assistance, there was no further need for it to be discussed. Mr. BARRETT explained he was sure since IRS was conducting other investigations and had some other IRS agents who might know about this, it may get out to the newspapers in the fall. He pointed out that JACK ANDERSON, columnist, had mentioned this money in one of his articles several weeks ago.

It should be noted for information purposes that Mr. Rebozo had contacted me telephonically on July 16, 1973, and indicated Mr. BARRETT had interviewed him and that he, Mr. REBOZO, gave my name to Mr. BARRETT, and he expected BARRETT would call upon me for an interview. Mr. REBOZO stated he felt there was no need for me to treat this in strictest confidence any longer since the IRS was making further inquiry and that I should feel free to discuss it with them in detail.

Approximately three menths ago, two partners in a local company, EMOCH "ICHERTY" WALKER and CLAURE THEMPSER, made formal application to the General Services Assimistration (GSA) for use of the second parties of the "Male", a language concrete pier within the premises of the U. S. Keval Station, Key West. for the purpose of unloading cargo shipscarriving in this part. The application had been made on the assumption that the "Male", tegether with other Haval docking facilities in the Key West area, would be vacated by the Havy sometime within the foreseeable ficture and would, consequently, be available to civilian bidders. Some time after the application had been sent in, however, GSA informed WALKER that the "Mole" was unavailable for civilian use.

Subsequent to GEA's reply, WALKER discovered, in reviewing records and talking to friends, that enother dvilian party, in which "HERE" REBOZO allegedly held a substantial interest, had also applied to either GEA or the Many Command for use of the entire nole area as a yacht beain and yacht derage area. Heither WALKER nor whether or not that particular application received preferential consideration by GEA or the Many, but inasmuch as WALKER is actively involved in local Democratic Party activities, mannetted that this may possibly be the case.

On Movember 12, 1973, ROBERT BAGSEST, Senior Resident Agent, Maval Investigative Service (NIS), U. S. Raval Station, Key West, Florida, advised that the Executive Officer of this station had previously made an offhand comment to the effect that RESCHO's name had, in fact, come up in mome type of application for two of a part of the Maral Station facilities; however, no elaboration saw made on this comment. Backets moted that from what he had been able to ascertain; the Naval Command has no immediate plans to dispose of the mole or other local docking facilities, eventhough these facilities are not currently being utilized, and a gradual long range phase out of the station is in fact, anticipated. If and when a decision is made to do so, he said, it would be established policy to first offer use of those facilities to other government agencies including the City of May West, which has long had an active interest is taking possession of the dock area, before any commercial or private interests, could be considered. He added that disposal of any current federal property would be effected through the auspices of the General Services Administration.
