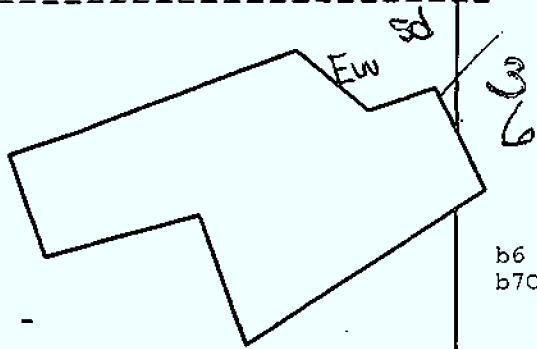

This investigation is predicated upon the receipt of a letter in the Atlanta Division on September 16, 1971. This letter was sent to the Atlanta Division of the FBI by DORA McDONALD, Secretary to Mrs. CORETTA KING.

On September 16, 1971, a letter was received by mail at the Atlanta Office of the FBI in an envelope addressed to the FBI, Atlanta, Georgia. The envelope directed to the FBI contained a letter addressed to "Mrs. Martin Luther King (Coon), Atlanta University of Jews and Niggers, Atlanta, Georgia (Jew. A.)." The envelope bears return address "Alexander Deas" and bears postmark "Pembroke, North Carolina."

The letter enclosed in the envelope begins "Coretta Coon, a b . ." and is signed "Alexander." It contains obscenities and a threat to kill the recipient of the letter.

Mrs. BERA McDONALD telephonically advised that she is Personal Secretary to Mrs. CORETTA KING, the recipient of this letter, and stated that she had opened the letter and then forwarded it to the FBI by mail in view of the threatening nature of the letter.

Mrs. DORA McDONALD was contacted telephonically and stated she wished to furnish information telephonically. She added that she is a personal secretary to Mrs. CORETTA KING and was formerly the secretary of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., deceased, former President of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference. Miss McDONALD stated that sometime around September 8 or 9, a letter was received addressed to Mrs. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., and the envelope contained a reference to Jews and Niggers. She opened this letter and noted that it contained threats and obscene language. She stated that she showed this letter to Rev. ANDREW YOUNG, an official of the Southern Leadership Conference, and YOUNG suggested that the letter be made available to the FBI.

The letter begins "Coretta Coon" and contains numerous obscene references to her and her deceased husband. The letter also stated "I'm going to slit your womb out before I kill you in Washington some 20 years from now, Coretta Coon, then I'll kill your family before your eyes." The letter also makes reference to the Ku Klux Klan and also contains the statement "You will die, Coretta Coon - because we will kill all the Goddam Jews and Niggers." Miss McDONALD stated that Mrs. KING receives numerous crank letters, including letters offering proposals of marriage. She stated that she did not even let Mrs. KING read this letter and that Mrs. KING is not aware of the identity of anyone who would write such a letter. Miss McDONALD added that neither she nor ANDREW YOUNG has any suspects.

Miss McDONALD stated that the letter was handed by her and by ANDREW YOUNG and no one else. She stated her full name is DORA EDITH McDONALD and she was born July 16, 1925 in Grasleyville, South Carolina. She worked for the United States Government in Washington, D. C., in 1944 and 1945. ANDREW YOUNG's full name is ANDREW JACKSON YOUNG and he was born March 12, 1912, in New Orleans, Louisiana. He has had several arrests in connection with racial demonstrations.

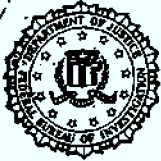

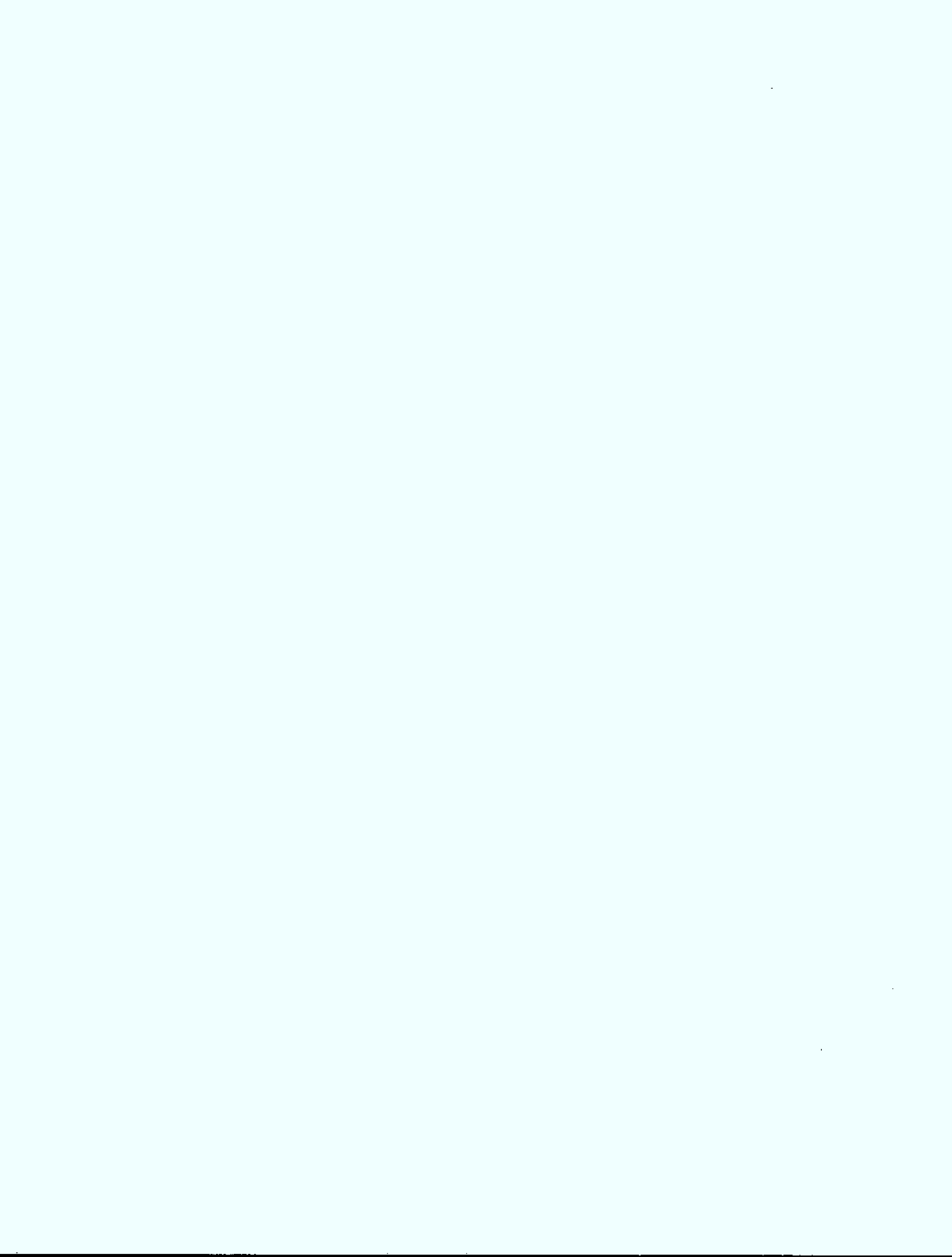

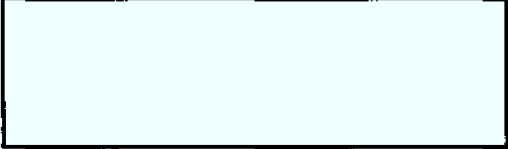

By teletype dated September 28, 1971, the FBI Identification Division advised that latent fingerprints developed on a letter submitted by the Atlanta Office of the FBI addressee to Mrs. MARTIN LUTHER KING from Pembroke, North Carolina, postmarked September 6, 1971, were identical to prints for [REDACTED].

By letter dated September 24, 1971, the FBI Laboratory advised that a definite conclusion was not reached as to whether the handwriting on a letter submitted by the Atlanta Division which was addressed to Mrs. MARTIN LUTHER KING in Atlanta, Georgia, from Pembroke, North Carolina, postmarked September 6, 1971, was prepared by [REDACTED] because of the lack of a sufficient amount of comparable handwriting of [REDACTED]. Also, a comparison could

not be made because the writing on the known writing of [redacted] is more of a broken type script than the writing on the examined document.

It was noted that the envelope containing the letter written to Mrs. MARTIN LUTHER KING was similar to envelopes previously submitted by the Charlotte Office which envelope had all observable physical features with the previously submitted envelopes in connection with an investigation being conducted by the Charlotte Office concerning a letter directed to J. EDGAR HOOVER of the FBI. Also, it was noted that sheets of paper used to prepare the handwriting on the above letter were similar with sheets of yellow paper used to prepare the handwriting in the previous submitted evidence by the Charlotte Division.

By letter dated September 30, 1971, the FBI Identification Division advised that latent fingerprints developed on the letter addressed to Mrs. MARTIN LUTHER KING at Atlanta, Georgia, postmarked Pembroke, North Carolina, have been identified as finger impressions of [redacted]

On October 26, 1971, Assistant U. S. Attorney ANTHONY M.
