The attention of the Bureau and the New York Office is directed to the March issue of "Political Affairs". On page 249 of that issue, an article appears entitled "Some Aspects of Party Work", by HENRY W. HENSTON, in which he says, "In a general way, we can say that the further growth of our Party depends on the building of our press, of the circulation of the Worker and Daily Worker."

The Philadelphia Office feels that this tends to show that the "Worker" and the "Daily Worker" are official organs of the Communist Party, and is being called to the attention of the Bureau and New York Office.

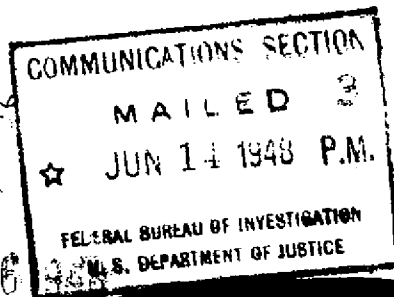

INTERNAL SECURITY

Rebulet dated 5/27/48 inquiring as to when the Bureau may expect to receive back bound volumes of the "Daily Worker" whose purchase by the New York Office, was authorized by the Bureau as a result of a telephone conversation on April 16, 1948 between ASAC A. H. Belmont and H. B. Fletcher of the Bureau.

Following a further examination of the volumes available for purchase at the New York Public Library, the New York Office advised to purchase only complete volumes for the years 1939 through 1947. The issues available between the years 1927 and 1938 were found to be incomplete and not all inconclusive and therefore their purchase seemed undesirable.

A sum of \$54.00 was paid for the volumes purchased, said payment having been made [redacted]

At the time authorization was given, ASAC Belmont indicated that this purchase was desirable because this Office had frequent occasion to refer to old issues maintained at the library which were not available in this Office.

The New York Office is under the impression that volumes are to be retained in this Office to assist in current and future investigations since the Bureau is believed to have in its possession all the issues contained in these purchased volumes. If this assumption is erroneous this Office is requested to be advised in the event the Bureau desires these volumes to be forwarded.

In response to your queries, please be advised that the volumes containing back issues of THE DAILY WORKER for the years 1939 through 1944 inclusive, were purchased for a sum of \$54.00 by [REDACTED] from [REDACTED] of the [REDACTED] Division, New York Public Library, 137 West 25th Street, New York, [REDACTED] April 21, 1948.

[REDACTED] stated that the New York Public Library had acquired the issues comprising these volumes by subscription from the publisher of THE DAILY WORKER. He said that two separate subscriptions had been entered for THE DAILY WORKER during this period and that the issues received by the Library from the publisher had later been bound into two separate sets. According to [REDACTED], the Library has retained one bound set of volumes containing THE DAILY WORKER for the years mentioned above, and since these issues have been also placed on microfilm, the Library deemed the second set surplus and for this reason permitted its sale.

[REDACTED] New York Public Library, 42nd Street and Fifth Avenue, New York City, is the person who would be in a position to testify as to the receipt of THE DAILY WORKER by the Library in the course of its official business.

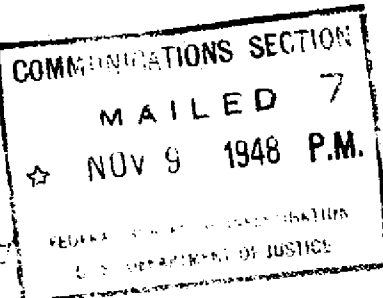

On October 7, 1948, [REDACTED] telephonically referred to the "Daily Worker" of Monday, October 4, 1948, at which time it published the ownership of the paper, which is required by postal authorities. He stated that he had noted two fake names contained in this publication of ownership, management, and circulation, namely, JOHN GATES and JOSEPH ROBERTS.

He stated that several years ago the Post Office caused the "Daily Worker" considerable trouble when they were, as a matter of policy, publishing many fake names in connection with the ownership of the paper. He suggested that possibly the Federal Bureau of Investigation could do something about causing them more trouble through the Post Office.

The Bureau is requested to advise if it desires to take any action at this time on the above suggestion.
