Loading of Tanks Aboard SS Motomar Sevilla

at Brooklyn Pier; Neutrality Act

The New York Office of this Bureau has informed that an article appearing on the front page of the "Daily Worker" in New York dated March 1, 1948, carried the following headlines "Franco Ship Loading Tanks at Brooklyn Pier." This article, which was written by Art Shields, "Daily Worker" reporter, stated that Shields and others observed some Army tanks marked "U. S. Army" and "U. S. Ord." being hoisted aboard the SS Motomar Sevilla, a Spanish ship which was scheduled to depart for Balboa on Thursday, March 4, 1948. Shields declared in his article that he observed thirty tanks on the dock awaiting shipment and there were another fifty or sixty tanks on three loading barges at the aft end of the ship.



PAMPHLETS AND PUBLICATIONS

It is noted from the attached clipping of "The Worker" dated April 18, 1948, that the Communist Party is publishing an Ohio edition of "The Worker".

The Party also publishes a Michigan editon of "The Worker", a Pennsylvania edition of "The Worker", and the Chicago "Star". All of these four publications deal largely with matters of local interest. The items contained in these publications concerning national matters are more adequately covered in the editions of the "Daily Worker", "The Worker", and the "Daily People's World", all of which are reviewed and clipped at the Bureau.

In view of the coverage obtained from the last named national Communist publications, it is not believed to be necessary to review here the previously mentioned local Communist publications. These local papers, however, should be reviewed by the interested offices so that they may be informed that kept current on local Communist matters appearing in the Party's pressure.

ACTION:

There is attached for your approved suggested letters to the interested offices advising them that the above-mentioned local Communist papers are not being reviewed at the Seat of Government and that the interested offices should review those publications for their knowledge and for clinding.
