After having been advised of the identity of the interviewing Agent and of the nature of the interview, provided the following information:

charge of the investigation conducted on a religious sect in Waco, Texas known as the "Branch Davidian, Seventh Day Adventist:" An individual by the name of VERNON HOWELL, also known as DAVID KORESH, is the leader of the organization. Allegations had been made in the past by several ex-members that HOWELL was planning a mass murder/suicide event. Allegations were also made towards HOWELL in that he was holding several members of the sect under conditions which may constitute violations of Federal law pertaining to involuntary servitude and slavery.

The CPS was brought into the religious sect due to allegations from ex-members of child neglect and abuse as well as two other investigators and involved in the investigation. Interviews were concurrent the several members of the organization; children as well as adults, and also HOWELL himself. Those members interviewed indicated to the CPS that all individuals on the premises were staying with the religious sect on their own accord.

Through observation and interview on both announced and unannounced visits, the Department of Human Services (DHS), CPS had no indication that any children or adults were being held against their will by HOWELL.



called to say good-bye.

Leaders of the religious group called the rumor "hogwash" and said it was created by a former member trying to smear the group's name.

Schneider said he didn't think the rumor had any affect on Saturday's event. "No, not at all," he said. "No one has to even bothered with that."

This ISS matter from Texas apparently came to the FBI'S attention through the Congressman Fred Upton's office (MI), Congressman Upton received material suggesting that members of a religious group at a commune near Waco, Texas, were planning a mass suicide and practiced involuntary servitude and slavery, did not receive the material which originally made these allegations.

The local Child Protective Services unit of the Texas.

Department of Public Health investigated the commune and its treatment of children. The FBI has submitted its report. The CPS report summarizes CPS interviews with residents of the commune (approximately 10 adults) and with children

(approximately 10 children). These reports show no evidence of any involuntary servitude by any child or adult. There is no evidence of any extensive work by the children, nor of any child abuse. No actions were taken by CPS to remove any children from the commune. The commune's leader said that there was a person in Michigan who was spreading rumors about the group.

This investigation has shown no evidence of ISS. There are no additional areas of potentially fruitful investigation which are apparent. I recommend that this matter be closed. The PSI report indicates that the U.S. Attorney's office has declined prosecution.

According to the letter, plans for self-destruction or sacrifices were to take place during Passover. A review of this letter would indicate that the time frame of the alleged acts of self-destruction would have been between the date letter was written (March 17, 1992) and Easter 1992.

Appropriate personnel have been notified in McLennan County, (Waco) Texas in the event that subject attempted such plans. These agencies include the McLennan County Sheriff's Department, Texas Department of Health and Human Services, Texas Department of Public Safety and the Texas Rangers Service. As of February 23, 1993, the Office of the U.S. Attorney, Western District of Texas, Waco Branch was also contacted where Assistant United States Attorney JOHN PHINIZY was briefed regarding the facts developed in this case.

To date, no information has been developed to verify the accuracy of the allegations. Law enforcement authorities with possible violations regarding this matter have been re-notified and appropriate contact will be maintained to ensure monitoring of this matter for possible federal violations.
