No investigation has been conducted by the FBI relative to the captioned individual. However, our records reflect the following information concerning her:

On July 30, 1958, a confidential source furnished a letter dated July 22, 1958, written by Dorothy Dandridge to an official of Loew's, Inc. which pertained to articles which had appeared in the "Laily People's World," west coast communist newspaper. The pertinent portions of the letter follow:

"Certain newspaper reports have been brought to my attention which I would like to comment on.

"I. PN 3/14/47 - One Dorothy Dandridge will appear at a party Suturday night, March 22nd at 2118 Hobart Street, Los Angeles, auspices National Negro Congress.

Negro Congress was associated with the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP), a well recognized organization. I went with my husband, Harold Micholas. I went for social reasons and because I was interested in the Negro community. I honestly can't remember who asked us to attend.

**2. PN 6/30/47 Denothy Dandridge among those who spoke at a series of rallies sponsored by the Progressive Citizens of America protesting the Taft-Hartley bill.

"I did not speak, however, I was asked to sing by a member of the program committee, whose name I can't remember. As an entertainer, I have been asked by hundreds of organizations during the past seven years to appear at benefits, the names of the individuals requesting my appearance has long since been forgotten with this event as well as numerous others such as the Catholic Youth Organization, B'Ea Brith Brotherhood Week, Red Cross, Cerebral Palsy, Heart Campaign, Pittsburgh Couries, Somens Clubs that I appeared on. I only remember this as one of over a hundred benefit appearances I have made and just another benefit.

"3. PF 9/17/47 - One Dorothy Landridge, actress, on ballot for executive board of Hollywood Arts, Sciences and Professions Council.

Professions Jouncil. I voluntarily became a member when I read that several prominent personalities in show business were active, such as Al Jarvis and Horman Forwin. I believed it would further my career and that it would help members of my race. I never held nor sought an office with this organization nor was I an active member. As I have not been participating in this nor paid any dues for many years, I have written them a letter of resignation as of this date so as to avoid there being any possibility of them considering me a member.

*4. P# 9/10/48 One Dorothy Dandridge student at Actors Lab.

"Ies, I joined the Actors! Lab because this workshop was one of the few outlets available to a young actress of my race seeking actual workshop training. Attending the Lab was in direct relationship with my theatrical ambition.

"5. P3 9/4/51 One Dorothy Fandridge, young Regro Actress, student at the Lab has commented "As an actress and student of the Lab, I am anxious to know whether Redda Hopper considers the democratic policy of the Lab, wherein students are accepted on ability, a subversive policy. If she does, she advocates a policy which is un-American and subversive and fans the flames of race hatred."

"I noticed the date of this alleged quotation is 1951. First of all, I was not a student at the Lab at this time and to

my knowledge the Lab was no longer in existence at this date. I recall one incident regarding Hedda Hopper while I was a student at the Lab. That Hedda Hopper said did affect me and I did express concern. However, the exact wording of this particular quotation is not the kind of language I use but I'm sure no one could object to my expressing concern.

nor ever have been a member of the Communist Party or Communist Party folitical Association nor have I ever made any donations to these parties. And I known that any of the above organizations would later be cited as communistic and or subversive, I would never have participated. I have at no time been active politically. My sole interests are towards having a successful career and aiding my people." (Letver among many by various individual furnished by James F. O'Neil, Director of Publications, American &

In reference to item 5 quoted above, our records reflect an article which appeared in the "Daily Forker," east coast communist newspaper dated September 22, 1948, captioned "medda dopper happed for Anti-megro Bias" which relates to the incident referred to by Hiss Dandridge. (100-294936-A)

Regarding the organizations referred to by Miss Dandridge the Rational Regro Congress has been designated by the Attorney General of the United States pursuant to Executive Order 10450. The Progressive ditizens of America was cited by the valifornia Coumittee on Un-American Activities in its 1947 and 1948 reports. An informant who has furnished reliable information in the past advised on May 15, 1956, that until January 3, 1956, the Hollywood Arts, Sciences and Professions Council (HASP) was the California Chapter of the National Council of the Arts, Sciences and Profession (NUASP) in New York City and consistently followed the programs and policies of the parent organization. On January 3, 1956, the MASP officially dissolved by action of its executive committee and vote of its meaverenip. The ECASP was cited as a "Communist front" by the Congressional Committee on Un-American Activities in its 1950 report. Actors Laboratory was cited as a "communist venture" by the California Committee on Un-American Activities in its 1947 report.

An informant who has furnished reliable information in the past reported on February 21, 1955, that an employee of the Sands Motel, has Vegas, Mevada, who was a gambler from the east coast, had advised the informant that Jack intratter, part owner of the Sands Movel and who was in charge of the Bands Topa Moom, found Mat King Fole and Borothy Mandridge together in Fole's room at the hotel. Fole was appearing as a star in the Fopa Moom at the time. The informant stated that intratter became furious with Fole for naving an "affair" with Lorothy Mandridge and threatened him. Danaridge reportealy told

Intratter to forget the whole matter as she was Cole's color, too. The informant further advised that Entratter was formerly manager and part owner of the Copacabana in New York City and has reportedly spent a great deal of time and money promoting Dandridge's career and that Entratter considered her his girl friend. (CI SU-293-C; 62-75147-44-591)

On May 10, 1955, Agents of the FBI arrested Louis Arlander Rerr at New Orleans, Louisiana, on a federal warrant charging a violation of the Interstate Transportation of Stolen Property Statut while being interviewed concerning the federal charge on which he was arrested, Kerr volunteered information that he was a homosexual. He furnished the names of 45 individuals with whom he claimed to have had homosexual relations since 1951. Kerr also stated that he had a long standing friendship with Lorothy Dandridge, Regro moute actress. However, he added that she was in no way a sex deviate. The reliability of Kerr is unknown. It is to be noted that he had previously been arrested on fraudulent check charges and had admitted receiving psychiatric treatment of an unknown nature in the past.







RALLY AT WRIGLEY FIELD, SPONSORED BY THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION FOR THE ADVANCEMENT OF COLORED PEOPLE, ET AL, LOS ANGELES May 26, 1963

All of the sources used in this document have furnished reliable information in the past.

Sources advised that the rally for freedom in support of the Birmingham, Alabama movement filled Wrigley Field to near the capacity and that approximately 30,000 persons were in attendance. The meeting lasted from about 3:00 p. m. until 5:30 p. m. and it was described as the largest rally of its sort ever to be held in Los Angeles, California. The featured speaker was Reverend Martin Luther King, President of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference, who spoke in support of the Birmingham non-violence movement. He commented on events in Birmingham and remarked that they would be helped by getting rid of segregation and discrimination in Los Angeles, California. King also stated that President Kennedy should personally escort Negro students into the University of Alabama and issue an executive order declaring that segregation is unconstitutional under the 14th Amendment.

There were numerous introductions and comments by people in the entertainment world. One of the more celebrated was Sammy Davis, Jr., who was reported to have pledged \$20,000.00, which was said to represent one week's earnings in Las Vegas, Nevada. There were also various donations from individuals, churches, unions, and other organizations, and a collection was taken from the audience. These proceeds were requested for the Birmingham demonstrators. The other celebrities who participated were actresses Dorothy Dandridge, Joanne Woodward, Rita Moreno, and Davis's wife, May Britt. The actors included Tony Franciosa, Mel Ferrer, and Miss Woodward's husband, Paul Newman. Commedian Dick Gregory also spoke at the rally.

California Governor Brown sent a message supporting the meeting which was read at the rally.
