The main advantage would be keeping the pertinent information and photo graph available, to aid investigation and evaluation if the name should arise. No estimate of monetary savings can be made; the savings would be in investigative time and communi cations costs. OBSERVATIONS: Intelligence Division believes this idea should not be adopted. It would involve the retention of a considerable amount of material by all of our field offices merely on the outside possibility that a given or Extremist subject migh visit their territory and that the FD-432 form might later prove of value. This Division believed this possibility is very remote and the extra paper work and expense involved adopting this proposal would not be warranted. From past experience, the Madrid Office does not feel that our operational capacity abroad requires the continued use of the albums presently in our possession. The infrequent use of these albums is not commensurate with the time required for keeping them up-to-date. In addition, these albums occupy considerable space in our limited number of file cabinets, this being particularly true of the Extremist Photograph Album, which consists of six volumes approximately two inches thick each.
