By letter dated May 17, 1941, the Dureau transmitted to the New York Field Division the Following laboratory report:

### Specimens:

KI through K10 Ten pages of the known handwriting of subject Wesley Hampton, all of the specimens are written on one side of the paper in ink, each sheet identified by the K number on the back. One envelope bearing the purported handwriting of the subject Wesley Hampton addressed to "Margaret E. Cummins, Box 1306....". First sheet of accompanying letter hearing the purported handwriting of the subject Wesley Hampton, beginning, "I rec your most welcome letter..." Second sheet of accompanying letter bearing the purported handwriting of the subject Wesley Hampton, beginning, "Possible I will drive out to..... Enclosed in envelope is a small card identified as, "Wesley Hampton Electric & Steam

Also submitted is a fingerprint card bearing the fingerprints of "Hampton Wesley".

#### Results of examination

It was concluded that the handwriting on the extortion letter designated in the Laboratory as #9-7088, Q1 through Q3, was done by WesleyOHampton, whose known specimens of handwriting are listed above as specimens KI through K14. Specimens Q1 through Q3 were transmitted to the Technical Laboratory from the Investigative Division on December 23, 1940, in connection with the case entitled "John Rogers; Mrs. Frances Perkins, (Miss Frances Perkins) Victim; Extortion", Bureau File 9-7088.

It was further concluded that Wesley Hampton, K1 through K14, did not write the extortion letter submitted in connection with the case entitled Anonymous Communication Addressed to H. Lehman, Governor, State Capital, Albany, New York and designated in the Laboratory as 62-59486, specimens Q1 and Q2. This extortion letter was forwarded to the Gureau from the New York Office under date of August 24, 1940.

It was also concluded that Wesley Hampton, Kl through Kl4, did not write the extortion letters submitted in connection with the case entitled "Unknown Subjects; Congressman Michael Joseph Kennedy - Victive Extortion" and designated in the Laboratory as 9-6706, specimens Ol av

9-581-

Q2 and specimens Q3 through Q11.

It is noted that the letter listed as specimens K11 through K13 bearing the purported known handwriting of the subject, Wedey Hampton, is much better for comparison purposes than the remainder of the specimens submitted, inasmuch as a certain amount of disguise is apparent in the dictated specimens. In this connection, if textimony is desired in this case, it is suggested that an effort be made to prove the authorship of the letter designated as K11 through K13.

In accordance with your request, specimens K11 through K14 are being returned to you herewith, photographic copies having been made for the completion of the Laboratory's files.

If testimony is desired in this case, it will be necessary to notify the Bureau in ample time to permit the preparation of charts and the arrangement of commitment.

In reference to the above report, it should be noted that the letter which was determined not to have been written by Subject was an anonymous letter addressed to Governor LEHMAN, which letter was not previously shown to have any connection with instant case. The letter which caused the designation of LEHMAN as a victim in this case was a typewritten letter, signed "John Rogers", which because of its signature and wording, containing threats to the same institutions, is believed to have been written by Subject, as are the other letters previously set out in this case.

It should be noted by the Bureau that the commitment of Subject to an insane asylum, presumably for the remainder of his life, was the direct result of the investigation conducted by the New York Field Division. No investigation was conducted by the State authorities prior to such commitment, and such disposition of the Subject supplanted the Federal prosecution which normally would have followed in this case.

The known specimens of handwriting believed to be that of JOHN P. ROGERS which were returned to the New York Field Division by the Technical Laboratory by Bureau letter dated April 12, 1941, have been returned to priginally obtained.

The letter written by Subject to his sister, obtained at the time of his arrest, which letter is referred to as Kll, Kl2, Kl3, and Kl4 in Technical Laboratory report dated May 17, 1941, is being retained in the exhibit file of this case in the New York Office.

A copy of a standing and a front and profile photograph, taken at the time of his arrest, is being forwarded to the Bureau with copies of this report for the completion of the Pureau files. with copies of this report for the completion of the case. Other copies are being placed in the New York file of the case.

A disposition sheet is being forwarded to the Bureau with this report, and a separate letter is being sent to the Bureau in regard to advising the original informants of the disposition of this case.

By reference letter dated May 10, 1941, the Bureau advised that the latent impressions previously developed had been compared with the fingerprints of HAMPTON without effecting an identification.

Under date of May 7, 1941, the Bureau furnished the following criminal record for subject:
