Dear Sir:

There are transmitted herewith photostatic copies of a letter dated December 5, 1940 from one John Rogers, Brooklyn, New York, received at the Department of Labor in an envelope postmarked December 5, 1940, New York City, and referred to this Bureau through the Department of Justice by Mrs. Perkins.

In view of the possible threat to the victim, it is desired that you endeavor to ascertain the identity of Rogers and thereafter discuss the matter with the appropriate U. S. Attorney relative to prosecutive action.

In view of the further threats to bomb certain unidentified buildings in New York, it is suggested that the police department in that city be apprised of the contents of Rogers' letter. Of course, arrangements should be made with the New York Police Department to obtain the results of any investigation conducted in connection with this matter.

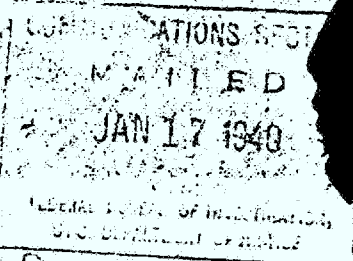
