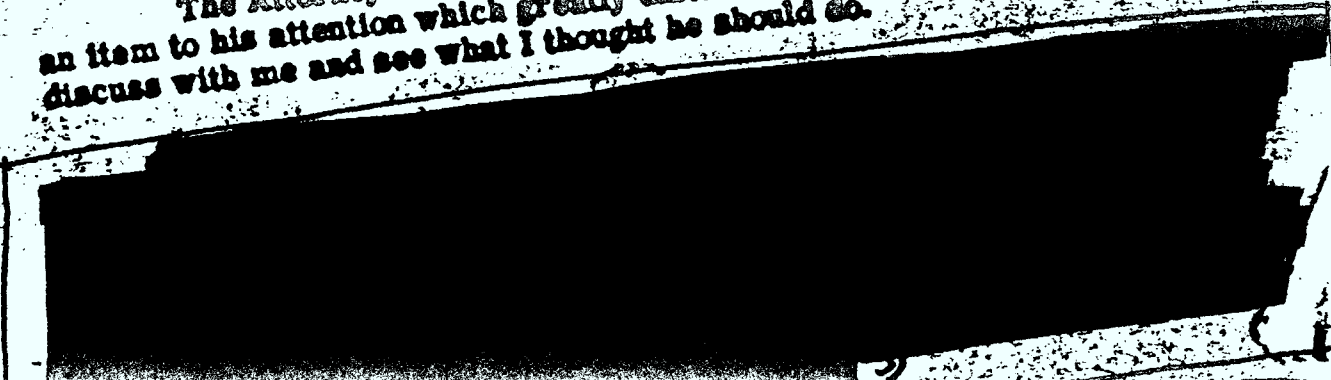

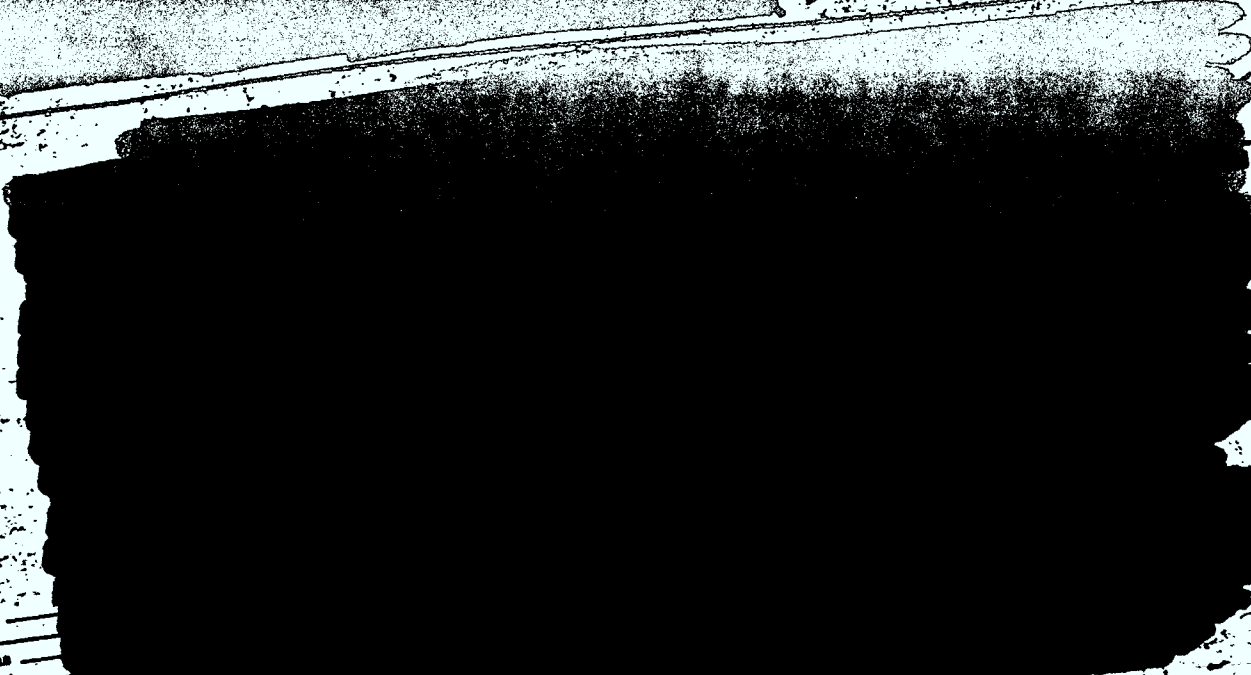

It was also mentioned to the Attorney General that an item in this morning's Washington Post stated that the pilot had said one of the jet engines exploded and in the same article the Russians claimed in examining the ejection seat mechanism it was noted the last inspection was in 1956 and it would not have worked. I stated to the ejection seat mechanism was attached some explosives that would have destroyed the plane, but the pilot did not use the seat but parachuted down. I felt such circumstances were most peculiar and especially the use of a plane which had not been inspected since 1956.

On 5-11-60 Mr. Robert Johnson, Chief of the Passport Legal Office, telephoned me and advised that on 5-11-60 Mrs. Butler of the Passport Liaison Office received a telephone call from Mr. Russell, an investigator for the House Committee on Un-American Activities (HCUA). Mr. Russell said that he would like to review the passport file on Francis G. Powers, the pilot of the downed U.S. aircraft in USSR. Mr. Russell then continued and said, "I suppose you have received quite a few requests for this file." Following this Mr. Russell said that there was a Soviet agent in Georgia named Powers.

According to Mr. Johnson, Russell did not enlarge on this latter statement, and Mrs. Butler made no inquiry.

Mr. Johnson said that they do have a file on Powers which reflects that he is a civilian employee of the U.S. Air Force. Mr. Johnson further said that HCUA would not be allowed to review the Powers file.

FRANCIS GARY POWERS

You may be interested in comments contained in a dispatch dated 5-13-60 from the U.S. Embassy in Moscow, a copy of which was received from the State Department 5-18-60.

The U.S. Embassy concluded that the plane incident was to be the subject of a mass propoganda effort directed against the U.S. inside the Soviet Union. This conclusion was based upon 1. the opening to public exhibition of the debris of the U-2 plane. This was described in the Russian press as the opening of the "second American exhibition." 2. The U.S. Embassy has received over 500 telegrams and 1,750 letters of protest from all over the USSR all of them moderate in tone. At the same time, personal contacts by U.S. Embassy officers and U.S. students in Moscow with Soviet citizens did not disclose any particular hostility toward the U.S. On the other hand, Soviet students have criticized Khrushchev's crudeness in handling the plane incident and expressed anxiety lest the incident affect the plans for the President's visit.

With regard to the "broader policy implications of the incident" the U.S. Embassy concluded that it was the Soviet intention first to put the U.S. in a difficult position and that Khrushchev's attack on the President in his 5-11-60 statements suggested that he might be trying to bring about a cancellation of the President's visit to the USSR on U.S. initiative.

Georgia Bureau of Investigation Agent advised he is in receipt of a request for advice from Chief of Police EUGENE A. ELLIS, Milledgeville, Georgia, which is the home town of Mrs. POWERS. Mrs. POWERS returned to her home immediately after the U2 incident, and because of the publicity and calls, the family had their phone disconnected. Consequently, a tremendous number of calls have come to the Milledgeville Police Department wanting information about Mrs. POWERS and requesting contact with her. Some of these calls he feels are unusual in that they seem to be in "cloak and dagger" style and it has given him some concern as to whether she is secure from possibly hostile elements and whether he is adequately affording safeguards for her.

The purpose of Mr. HUTCHINS' inquiry was how to contact a representative of CIA.

He requested this information be relayed to appropriate CIA representatives, i.e., the fact the Chief at Milledgeville expresses this concern. It is suggested the Bureau may want to send this through liaison.

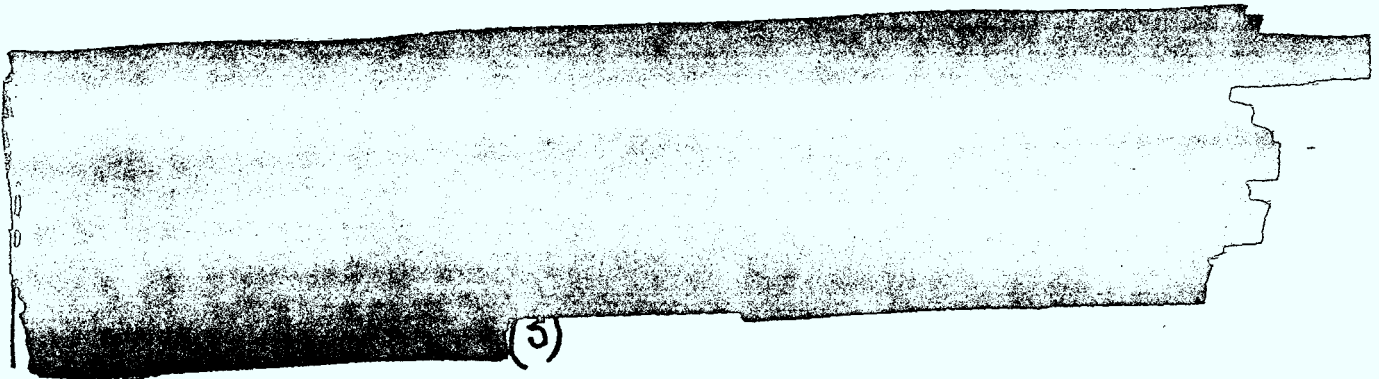

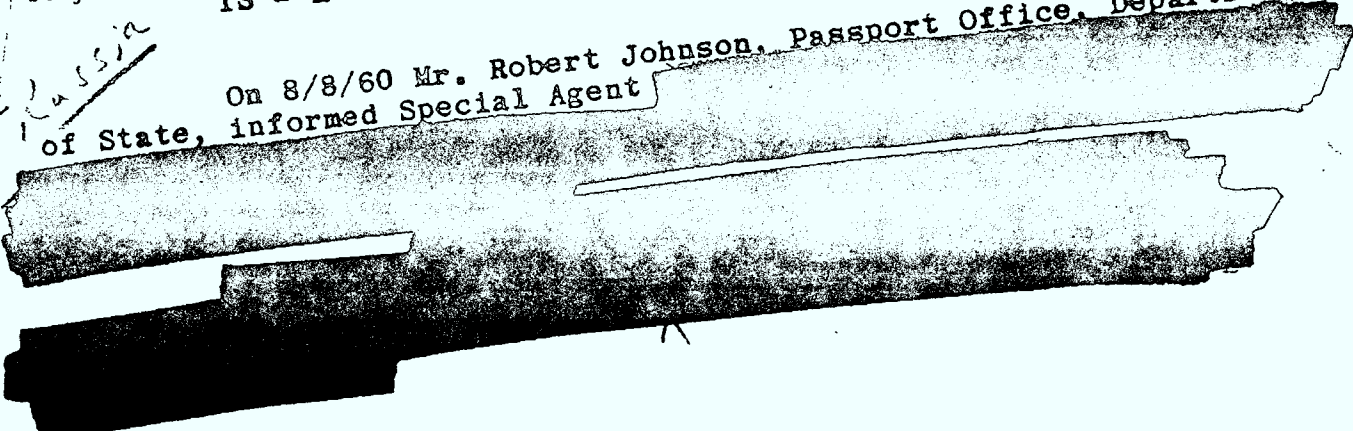
