During the season just ended Saratoga wasn't "wide open" to gambling as in previous years and as a result there appeared to be a decrease in the number of confidence men, jewel thiefs, burglars and hold-up men who gathered there formerly.

A. ORGANIZED GANGS

There are no criminal organizations presently active in Saratoga Springs, New York, or the nearby Northern New York resort area, that can be regarded as a gang or a mob.

(1) National Criminal Syndicate, Aka, Eastern Criminal Syndicate

No information was learned indicating that any members of the so-called National Syndicate of FRANK COSTELLO, JOE ADONIS, MYER LANSKY, ET AL, visited Saratoga Springs during the past season.

Concerning this alleged organization Confidential Informant T-1, of questionable reliability, advised that there is a control in the Syndicate beyond that of FRANK COSTELLO, and the others. He stated that they are dominated by the Italian underworld, which he claimed is the strongest faction in the country at the present time. The informant said that The Mafia (Unione Sicilione) is an organization of Italians who are the real power and stated that their headquarters is Tampa, Florida.

- (1) Since the project is an intelligence survey and not an investigation looking toward prosecution, evidence and testimony as to conditions set forth will not be required.
- (2) This report synopsizes the material located for the most part in numerous files of the Chicago Field Office. In these files of course the sources are indicated. Individual files have been opened on practically all the fifty-five hoodlums believed to be the most outstanding, who are listed in Seption II, Part IX. Where material has been taken from books or publications the source is indicated by footnotes.

FISCHETTI was born March 24, 1901 in Brooklyn, New York; is married and has one child; resides at 3100 Sheridan Road, Chicago, and 6475 Allison Road, Miami Beach, Florida. Records at Selective Service Board 144, Chicago, reflect he registered February 14, 1942, assigned Order No. 1147, Serial No. 1526. He is classified 1AH due to his being over 35 years of age. In addition to carries \$3,000 life insurance policy with Minneapolis Mutual.

In July 1943 FISCHETTI was reported to be the owner of the Libera Loan Company, 26 East Adams Street, with affiliated with a fence for jewelry. FISCHETTI has stated his occupation as that of a speculator in Jewelry consignments and that of jewelry salesman. Credit reports reflect that FISCHETTI paid 435,000 cash for their Miami Beach home.



B. CRIMINAL ACTIVITIES:

"Scarface" AL CAPONE, and has been an active member of the Mob since it took over the leadership of the Chicago underworld. FISCHETTI brothers, CHARLES, ROCCO notorious AL CAPONE and CHARLES FISCHETTI was with FRANK CAPONE in the are cousins of the Cicero election riot when FRANK was killed. They have continued their activities up to the present time, being mainly concerned with gambling in the North Chicago area. ROCCO FISCHETTI was known to have been involved in the old Vernon Country Club prior to its closing. His principal spot now seems to be Ralph's Place located near Golf and Waukegan Roads, where extensive gambling is presently taking place. Later information received from the Chicago Crime Commission indicates that this spot is considered so good that the gembling equipment from the Hill Top Club has been moved there and several roulette whoels have been installed for the convenience of the patrons. This same source has advised that during February, 1949 ROCCO FISCHETTI remarked at Ralph's Place that "they" (the Syndicate) were in the market to purchase any Protestant cemetaries they could get their hands on and that they had managed to buy a cometary at Boston, Hassachusetts, during July, 1948. This information has not been verified and no purchases in the Chicago area are known. However, it is interesting to note that Protestant cemetaries ordinarily possess crematories.

It has also been reported that "BUGS" SEIGEL, just prior to his death, "shook down" his associates for 300,000 by threatening to tell what he knew about their operations. The remittance was supposed to have been made through the FISCHETTIS. "BUGS" then demanded more and was killed shortly

ROCCO FISCHETTI is reported to have a girl friend named former singer at the Chez Paree and other Chicago night spots, whom he has used as a contact and for introduction purposes to people he wishes to meet. is reported by the Chicago Crime Commission to be very close to girl friend of "BUGS" SEIGEL, and during the past few months visited her in California. ROCCO FISCHETTI was reported to have sent phonograph recording equipment purchased at Hudson Ross, Chicago, to her at
