The following memorandum is submitted pursuant to Mr. Tolson' request 3-29-60 for a summary of information contained in Bureau files concerning Frank Sinatra.

The attached memorandum, captioned as above, from Mr. M. A. Jones to Mr. Nichols dated 1-23-57, reveals information contained in Bureau files concerning Sinatra and is summarized as follows:

definite was born 12-12-15 or 12-12-16 at Hoboken, New Jersey, and began his singing career in 1935. He has been married and divorced twice, the second marriage to actress Ava Gardner in 1951 ended in approximately two years.

In 1955 Sinatra was investigated by the FBI relative to possible false statements in a passport application with regard to membership in subversive organizations. Investigation developed no evidence of Communist Party (CP) or front organization membership other than 1946 membership in the Independent Citizens Committee of the Arts. Sciences and Professions, which organization was cited by the California Committee on Un-American Activities as a communist front

Information was received during the 1940's and 1950's which linked Sinatra's name as an associate of well-known hoodlums, including Joseph and Rocco Fischetti, members of the Capone gang; Willie Moretti, former underworld boss of Bergen County, New Jersey; and James Tarantine an associate of Benjamin "Bursey" Siegel. Identification Division records reveal Sinatra was arrested Rovember, 1938, and charged with seduction; this charge was later changed to adultary and dismissed after a Grand Jury returned a no true bill.

It was reported that on his last visit to California, Senator Kennedy stayed at Sinatra's home in Lalm Springs. (63-4296)

on 3-22-60 a confidential source advised Sinatra's film production company had contracted to hire Albert Maltz, a security index subject and one of the "Hollywood Ten," who was convicted of contempt of Congress, to write the film script for "The Execution of Trivate Slovik." This story concerns the only American soldier in either World War who was executed for desertion. There was considerable no spaper publicity which criticized Sinatra's contract with Maltz, and pointed out this may cause dismay to the Presidential campaign camp of Senator Kennody in view of Sinatra's announced intention to support and assist in Senator Mennody's Presidential campaign. A newspaper account also reported that Sinatra had considered begging the news of biring Maltz a secret until after the Democratic Mational Topy bution in July, for fear it might jeopardize the political hopes of Ennator Menhody. It was further speculated that Sinatra may, through Peter Lawford and Lawford's wife, have been able to get Senator Mennedy to take a financial interest in Sinatra's film producing enterprise. You Can't Buy The White House

Former President Truman is a practical and seasoned politician. Even he, however, found it difficult to stomach the ruthless political steamroller, greased by the Kennedy millions, which rolled over the Democratic convention at Los Angeles.

A confidential source advised in June, 1958, that during the first part of that year when Sinatra was appearing at the Sands Hotel in Las Vegas, Nevada, Sinatra was with Samuel M. Giancana, described as a notorious Chicago hoodlum, and accompanied him to the El Rancho Vegas, which is located in Las Vegas.

During a search of Giancana by Customs officers in Chicago, Illinois, during June, 1958, the notation "Sinatra, Office 5-4977, Home Crestview 4-2368" was found among his effects. Crestview 4-2368 is the private number for Frank Sinatra in Los Angeles, California.

Our continuing investigation into the death of Richard Anderson, former Lake Tahoe Deputy Sheriff, who shortly before his death had been involved in a fracas with Sinatra, has produced some additional information. We have determined that on the night of his death, Anderson, while driving at an excessive rate of speed and after having been drinking, failed to negotiate a curve at high speed, ran off the road and was killed. His wife, who accompanied him, has made available a statement to the local authorities which indicated that Anderson was at fault in this accident.

Not withstanding the above, our Las Vegas Division has not overlooked the possibility there was foul play in connection with the Deputy Sheriff. A specific inquiry was initiated to determine whether any hoodlums had been brought in from out of state to cause the death of Deputy Sheriff Anderson following his argument with Sinatra. To date no pertinent information reflecting upon the possibility of imported hoodlums being brought in to Nevada for this purpose has been developed.

Further indication of the control and influence of the Chical hoodlum organization in the operation of Las Vegas gambling casinos is evident in connection with the forthcoming appearance of singer Eddie Fisher as the star attraction at the reopening of the plush Villa Venic Supper Club, Wheeling, Illinois, on October 31, 1962. Also appearing at this supper club following Fisher's engagement are Sammy Davis, Frank Sinatra and Dean Martin. Wheeling is a suburb of Chicago.

Fisher, who is now appearing in New York, was to follow his New York appearance with a month's engagement at the Desert Inn in Las Vegas. The Chicago hoodlum organization of Samuel Giancana, howeve made it known that they wanted Fisher to appear at the Villa Venice on October 31, 1962. They told the Desert Inn that Fisher could split his Las Vegas engagement in order to make a week's appearance in Chicago. Later they decided they wanted Fisher for three weeks instead of one week.

The operators of the Desert Inn headed by Morris Barney Dalit felt that such an arrangement would be bad for Desert Inn business. Fisher and his manager were of the opinion that such an arrangement would have an adverse effect on Fisher's career, going from a smash New York engagement to an unknown supper club in Wheeling, Illinois. Neither Morris Barney Dalitz nor Fisher nor his manager had the courage to express their reluctance for this arrangement.

Frank Sinatra reportedly said to Eddie Fisher "look, you're going over here for 18 days, never mind about the Desert Inn, I already handled that. I take care of that. They do what I tell them." Nothing succeeds like success. Whether you like him or not, there is no getting around the fact that Frank Sinatrasinger, actor, phonograph record manufacturer, movie producer, hotel man, cetera-has made a pile of money. How does he do it? Sinatra himself would like to know, says Leo Guild, discussing it here.

- Once upon a time a Hollywood wise man said there was a sure system for discovering whether a creative person was really a genius.

If he were knee-deep in composing music, writing a book or designing a building, and a beau-tiful girl called and asked him to come right over, and he went over, he was truly a genius.

That would make Frank Sinatra truly a genius. Because he, the most conscientious, dedicated artist in the business, will drop anything if the fun is right.

MAYBE THAT'S what makes Sinatra so great a performer. The recipe: one part human, one part genius—and sprinkle on a little humbig.

Why the humbug? Recause no one could be as great as Frank makes himself out to be. The man's got more subtle swagger than Garbo's timidity.

Many a newsman has often suspected that Frank is the em-

peror without clothes walking down vine St. to the tune of "Come Fly with Me," with the

populace praising his raiment.
Without even trying we can rattle off 10 male singers or actors who have a better critical or commercial record than Frank.

Yet he is the recognized king (or emperor) of entertainment.

LET'S BRIEFLY LOOK at the record.

As a singer with Tommy Dorsey, Frank was just a singer with Tommy Dorsey. He gambled and went out on his own, and in three years was making \$1,000,000 a year.

GANGSTERS, GAMBLING, GIRLS

n the same day 5 weeks ago that his son was kidnaped from a Lake Tahoe motel for a \$240,000 ransom, singer Frank Sinatra, 48, was denounced in Las Vegas, Nev., by Edward A. Olsen, chairman of that state's Gaming Control Board.

Addressing a group of newsmen who had gathered from various sections of the nation, Olsen declared emphatically that holders of casino gambling licenses in Nevada who associate with gangsters and hoodlums, "as singer Frank Sinatra did, will wind up on the wrong side of the tables."

Olsen's reference was to Sinatra's hosting of gangster Momo (Sam) Salvatore Giancana this past summer at Chalet No. 50 of the Cal-Neva Lodge on the north shore of Lake Tahoe, not very far from where Sinatra's son was later abducted.

Sam Giancana at 53 is a small, dark, unprepossessing, baldish man with reptilian eyes and a large bankroll who runs crime in Chicago and Illinois. According to police authorities he sits high in the

connects of the Manus. of the Cosa Nostra, as it is known today. The Justice Department lists him as involved in gambling, shylocking, extortion, burglary and murder. Chicago authorities attribute to him and his gang leadership 24 bombings and 53 murders in their community in the past 4 years.

Giancana is a close friend of Phyllis McGuire of the singing McGuire sisters. They may even be secretly married. This friendship led Giancana to Sinatra's lodge this past summer. Phyllis was singing there, and her admirer wanted to catch the act.


Late one night the Mafia leader got into a fistfight outside Miss McGuire's cabin. The resultant publicity brought state agents to Cal-Neva to investigate.

In Nevada the Gaming Board has developed a "Black Book" which contains the names of 11 undesirable underworld characters. This Black Book has been distributed to casino owners such as Sinatra. They were told that if they permitted any of these 11 hoods on their premises, they risked loss of their gambling licenses.

On September 11, 1963, Edward Olsen signed a complaint against Frank Sinatra, charging that the singer associated and spoke to Giancana without asking him to leave Cal-Neva.

"Frank Sinatra has for a number of years," Olsen complained, "maintained and continued social association with said Sam Giancana, well knowing his unsavory and notorious reputation, and has openly stated that he intends to continue such association."

Sinatra was also accused of attempting to intimidate Olsen with "vile, intemperate, obscene and indecent language." A Sinatra employee, Skinny D'Amato, was accused of trying to bribe a Gaming Board worker, and Eddie King, a Sinatra confederate from Palm Springs. Calif., was accused of deliberately avoiding a subpoena.

SHOW BUSINESS

Instead of defending the complaint and exposing to the public the extent of his association with Sam Giancana and other gangsters, or the lack of such association, Sinatra tossed in the towel.

He surrendered his 50 per cent ownership in Cal-Neva and his gambling interest in the Sands, exceedingly profitable holdings conservatively estimated to be worth \$3,000,000.

It's possible that publicity concerning Sinatra's wealth as a gambling tycoon motivated the subsequent kidnaping of his son. The children of poor people are rarely abducted and held for ransom.

Following Frank Sinatra's voluntary departure from the Nevada gambling scene, PARADE was flooded by letters from its readers asking how and why such honest, decent, talented entertainers as "that darling Frank Sinatra and that cute Phyllis McGuire—how come they get connected with a gangster like Sam Giancana?"

Other letters asked the following questions:

What is the tie-up between the underworld and show business?

Is it true that the Cosa Nostra owns or controls the major night clubs in America?

Is it true that the syndicate controls the Las Vegas gambling casinos?

Does the mob run Hollywood?

Is it true that the Cosa Nostra maintains the jukebox industry in this country?

Will you tell us if the Cosa Nostra trains, develops and controls its own entertainers?

Can you explain Lana Turner and Johnny Stomponato, Wendy Barrie and Bugsy Siegel, June Lang and John Rosselli? Why do stars take up with hoodlums?

Starting with the last question, the basis for personal relationships between stars and gangsters lies frequently in the geography of birth. Many top lights in today's entertainment world—performers like Sinatra, George Raft, Vic Damone and others—were raised in the cities of New York and New Jersey side by side with other youngsters, generally first-generation Americans, who later became criminals, racketeers, notorious hoods.

inatra once told me: "Many of the kids I grew up with in Hoboken are serving time today. A few even went to the chair. I was lucky. I had folks who took an interest in me." Boys who grow up together are fiercely loyal to one another, especially if they are members of minority groups. Later in life, regardless of the directions they've taken, they don't snub one another. To expect George East to ignore Bugsy Siegel or Frank Sinatra to cut Willie Moretti cold is both unfair and unreasonable.

When Sinatra was growing up in New Jersey, Willie Moretti, a member of the Mafia and cousin of the notorious Joe Adonis, helped him considerably. For example, when Frank started singing with Tommy Dorsey's band, he quickly became its hottest attraction. Quick to recognize that fact, Dorsey signed the singer to a seven year contract at relatively little money.

"At one, point in his marriage, Sinatra was on the road with the Dorsey outfit, making do with so small a personal allowance that his wife, Nancy, sent him a pair of gloves for his birthday. When Frank tried them on, he found a dollar bill folded into each finger.

He says he realized then that he would have to earn more money. He went to Dorsey and asked to be let out of his contract. "I knew," he says, "I could make much more on my own." Dorsey was adamant and refused to release him.

ot long after,"the band leader subsequently told me, "I was visited by Willie Moretti and a couple of his boys. Willie fingered a gun and told me he was glad to hear that I was letting Frank out of our deal. I took the hint, and Frank went."

When Willie Moretti's daughter got married some time afterward, Frank Sinatra sang at her wedding.

In the summer of 1960, when I interviewed Lucky Luciano, the Mafia chief, in Naples, we discussed the possible screen stars who might play the screen version of his life. Luciano said he was partial to George Raft and Frank Sinatra, both of whom he claimed to large.

"I always liked Frank," Luciano told me. "We were in Cuba after the war. He's done real good, Frank has. Always got a chip on his shoulder, but I don't mind that. He could play me good." Reportedly the U.S. Treasury Department has a

Reportedly the U.S. Treasury Department has a copy of a Pan American Airways manifest which lists Sinatra as a passenger flying to Havana in February 1947, in the company of Rocco and Joe Fischetti, cousins of the late Al Capone. Rocco Fischetti is one of the leaders of the Chicago branch of the Cosa Nostra, taking orders from Sam Giancana.

It was at this time in Havana in 1947 that Lucky Luciano handed out "the contract" for the murder of Bugsy Siegel, the criminal founder of modern, big-time Las Vegas gambling.

Siegel financed the first major gambling casino, the Flamingo, in Las Vegas in 1946 by loans from various Mafia gangs scattered throughout the country. In the 1940s Las Vegas was declared an "open city" by the underworld. As a result many of its gambling casinos today are owned by ex-criminals, former members of the Chicago, Detroit, Galveston, Cleveland, New York, New Orleans and Portland mobs. Several of its club owners are currently under criminal indictment, and there is little doubt but what it constitutes the number-one "drop" for investment of illegal earnings by the Cosa Nostra.

In the past 15 years Las Vegas has become the show business center of the country, employing more live talent than any other city. There are a few entertainers, Bing Crosby and Sob Hope among them, who steadfastly refuse to play Las Vegas, but practically all the others are only too anxious to accept the \$20,000 a week and up the gambling center offers.

Some Las Vegas casings are partial to entertainers who like to plunge heavilg at the gaming tables. Eddie Fisher is one, Gordon MacRae used to be another, Joe E. Lewis is a third.

The casinos also employ chorus girls who not only dance after a fashion but, in many of the establishments, must "mingle" with the "live ones," the term of or men who play for high stakes. These chorus girls are paid \$150 a week, work 7 nights a week, occasionally make more in gratitities from lucky gamblers.

At this writing only two entertainers have shares in Vegas gambling casinos. Tony Martin owns 2 per cent of the Riviera, and Dean Martin (who was at one time a croupier in Steubenville, Ohio) owns 1 per cent of the Sands.

In addition to large investments in Las Vegas, the members of the Cosa Nordal war outright or in partnership night spots in New York, Illinois, Florida, New Jersey, several other states.

Joe Valachi, the Cosa Nostra songbird, testified last October before the Senate Investigating Subcommittee that Vito Genovese, the New York Maha chief now behind bars, owns the Savannah Club, Rocky Village, 181 Club and the 82 Club an Greenwich Village. He also testified that Frank Costello owns "a piece" of the Copacabana in New York.

Deputy Inspector John Shanley, a New York police expert on organized crime, is the authority for the statement that one way the Cosa Nostra "families" get into show business is via the purchase of concessions in night clubs.

"Many times," he explains, "they will buy a concession in a club, such as hat-checking. They'll put up \$10,000 and often a proprietor will open with just that much capital and hope the place goes over. Or the mob will put its juke boxes in a place and lend money to get the place started. And in both cases, if a club isn't doing well, the mob will move in and take it over just to protect its interest."

From time to time, the Cosa Nostra will discover and finance a singer or will offer to buy an interest in him should he find himself in financial straits. I was with the late Mario Lanzá when he reported that Philadelphia gangsters had offered him \$150,000 for a 10 per cent interest in his career. Lanza was hard up at the time, but after discussing the situation with his wife, I decided to call the late Mannie Sacks of RCA and ask for a \$50,000 advance on Lanza's record royalties. Sacks sent a check for that amount and saved Lanza from fulling into Mafia hands.

Another way the mob moves into show business is through crooked or inept unions. In the late 1930s members of the Capone mob sent a convicted panderer, Willie Bioff, to Hollywood to move in on the unions.

Bioff and his partner, George Browne, took over the IATSE, a union which controlled the projectionists. They then proceeded to extort \$1,000,000 from the cowardly executives of MGM, 20th Century-Fox and Warner Brothers, who agreed to pay tribute rather than have the projectionists strike and darken the theaters.

Bioff and Browne split their take with the Chicago Mañosi. Apprehended by the federal government, Bioff and Browne turned state's witness and sang. The Chicago hoods were sentenced to 10 years in the federal penitentiary in Atlanta. After serving only three years, however, they were paroled. Who paroled these hoods, and why is one of the most shocking, unexplained scandals of the Truman Administration. In 1955, Bioff was blown to pieces in Phoenix for squealing on his one-time pals.

More recently, the mob, in order to recruit exotic dancers for its clubs in the Midwest, has resorted to the importation of girls from Canada. Advertisements are placed in Canadian papers stating showgirls are wanted for night clubs and theater engagements, "no experience necessary.

Girls who answer the ads are told they will have to join AGVA, the American Guild of Variety Artists. They are then shipped off to so-called night clubs in the Midwest and forced into prostitution.

Here, for example, from the report of the McClellan Committee, is what happened to two Canadian girls who answered a "showgirl" ad in the Montreal Star.

"They were signed up for AGVA membership and signed contracts for employment at the notorious Band Box in Hurley, Wis., without any knowledge of the true character of the place. They were promised stardom in the U.S., \$100 per week and safe lodging . . .

"During their first night at the Band Box, they observed girls dancing in the nude. They were held in literal bondage by the club operator. A bodyguard stayed with them 24 hours a day . . . It was made clear to them that it was permissible for them to engage in illicit relations with customers . . .

fter an unsuccessful attempt to escape, they were shipped to Calumet City, via Chicago, to work in the Riptide Club. They were met at Chicago by Al Holzman, a procurer who sent them on to Calumet City by taxicab. Knowing they had no money, he forced one of the girls to live with him in an illicit relationship. They were threatened that if they tried to escape, they would be found by the syndicate before they got very fur.

"At the Riptide, they found conditions even worse than those at the Band Box. The club had back rooms where the girls employed in the club took men for immoral purposes. They saw girls beaten

sergraph 3 up and customers rolled and thrown into an alley. At the Riptide also, the girls were held in bondage. They were permitted to go nowhere unless escorted by one of the four bouncers. . . .

One of the most knowledgeable men in this country on the connection between the underworld and show business is Jerome Adlerman, general counsel for the Senate Permanent Subcommittee on Investigations. At one time or another Adlerman has cross-examined many of the major mobsters in the nation.

"What you must understand about hoods and gangsters and members of the Cosa Nostra or whatever you want to call that organization," Adlerman recently told me in Washington, "is that these men are not intellectuals. They don't read; they don't study; they don't have hobbies as we know them.

"Their major extracurricular interests are broads and booze. For them, the easiest path to these two hobbies is show business. By going into the night club business, which is essentially a cash business, they find themselves interviewing singers, dancers, stripteasers, actresses. Sitting up and drinking with these girls, discovering new talent-they find that most satisfying to the ego, and that's why they do it. And in a lot of cases you find that some actresses, not particularly bright, are attracted to them. Some women, and I'm sure you know a few in Hollywood, like to play with fire.

ears ago,"Adlerman explained, "the hoods used to own flower shops. Now they own night clubs and restaurants. It's a more interesting and exciting life, more pleasurable. It's led them into the juke box racket, the recording industry, many allied fields. A few years ago when we were investigating gangster activities in the labor and management fields, we had a Mr. Robert Lindeloff of Chicago on the stand. He was in the juke box operation, and he told us that he'd been called by a Mr. Joey Glimco of the Teamsters' Union and asked to play on all his machines a tune recorded by a singer named Tommy Leonetti. We got hold of Leonetti and he admitted that he was being managed by a man with underworld connections, but he wasn't aware of the fact that the underworld was pushing his records.

"I mentioned that," Adlerman continued, "to point out that the mob is not only involved in gambling, narcotics, prostitution, the illegal sale of liquor in after-hour joints, but they've now moved into the juke box and recording fields and many other avenues of show business. For example, we know Sam Giancana is the man behind the Lormar Record Co., an underworld operation in Chicago.

According to Adlerman, gangsters became interested in show business in the post-Prohibition days of the 1930s.

"They had plenty of money from bootlegging," he explained, "and they wanted to invest some of it in pleasurable enterprises. So they moved into the night club field. They bought in or declared themselves in, and thus began their acquaintanceship with entertainers. They backed Broadway shows for their girl friends. They became silent partners in backing young hopeful singers. The glamour and the glitter of show business appealed to them, and it still does."

When Nevada legalized gambling and Bugsy Siegel opened up Las Vegas to his fellow mobsters, the gangsters realized that they needed a constant flow of show biz talent to attract the public.

That's why today Las Vegas and the new gambling mecca, San Juan, Puerto Rico, book more top performers than any other two cities in the world. The big names of show business attract the players, and the players make the roulette wheels go round and round. Everything else is incidental.

In view of the long association which Frank Sinatra, the well-known entertainer, has had with prominent hoodlums and racketeers, I discussed this situation personally with SAC Elson of Las Vegas on Saturday, April II, after the conclusion of the Organized Crime and Criminal Intelligence Conference held at Los Angeles.

SAC Elson has a close personal relationship with Frank Sinatra, his attorney and close business associates as a result of Elson's handling these individuals during the kidnaping case in which Sinatra's son was the victim. As evidence of the high regard in which Elson is held by Sinatra, it is noted Elson and his wife have been invited by Sinatra to attend social affairs being given by Sinatra at his home in Palm Springs. Sinatra even offered to send his private airplane to Las Vegas and transport the Elsons to California. SAC Elson said he graciously declined these social invitations and that he had written the Director about them sometime ago. I told Elson that in the absence of contrary instructions from the Bureau it seemed most proper not to accept social invitations extended because of Elson's handling his FBI duties.

We did discuss, however, Sinatra's background, including his long and close association with several major hoodlums and racketeers. It seems obvious that Sinatra could supply extremely valuable information about these individuals and their activities. SAC Elson believes his relationship with Sinatra is so close that he might be able to induce Sinatra to cooperate with us.

There *** attached a summary of information showing Sinatra's long association with major hoodlums

ACTION TO BE TAKEN:

Frank Sinatra is currently reported to be in the Far East where he is on location making a motion picture. On his return to the United States it is believed we should have SAC Elson contact Sinatra and explore the possibilities of developing him as an informant. This could best be accomplished by having Elson go to Southern California on two or three weekends when Sinatra would not be tied up with his business affairs. We would, of course, have Sinatra believe Elson was in California on other business which would provide an appropriate cover for Elson's meeting with Sinatra and exploring the possibilities of his cooperating with us.

Elson is convinced that his relationship with Sinatra at this time is such that he could do this discreetly without any possibility of embarrassment to the Bureau. If we are to do this we should begin promptly on Sinatra's return to the United States as Elson's relationship with Sinatra will deteriorate if no contact is made and much time elapses.

If you approve SAC Elson will be advised telephonically when he next calls the Bureau to proceed along these lines.

ADDENDUM (AHB/csh) -

I don't think the leopard will change his spots, but I recommend SAC Elson try his hand at this.

I do not agree

Frank Sinatra through the years has been associated with some of the most infamous individuals of modern times. During the 1930s when he was growing up in New Jersey, he was reportedly befriended by Willie Moretti, former underworld boss of Bergen County, New Jersey, and cousin of the notorious Joe Adonis. In later years Sinatra sang at the wedding of Willie Moretti's daughter.

In the 40s Sinatra's name was linked with such well-known hoodlums as Joseph and Rocco Fischetti, members of the Capone gang, Charles'Lucky'Luciano, and James Tarantino, associate of Benjamin "Bugsey" Seigel and editor and publisher of the magazine "Hollywood Night Life."

Newspapers on February 20, 1947, reported that Frank Sinatra had been in Havana, Cuba, for four days the previous week and that "his combanion in public and private was Luciano, Luciano's bodyguard and a rich collection of gamblers and high-binders." The article indicated that Luciano and Sinatra were seen together at the racetracks, the gambling casinos and at special parties.

A September 11, 1947, column of Westbrook Pegler reported that when Frank Sinatra flew to Havana, Cuba, on February 11, 1947, he was accompanied by Joe and Rocco Fischetti.

In recent years considerable information has been reported concerning Sinatra ties with Sam Giancana. Reports of the use of Sinatra's Palm Springs home by Giancana and Phyllis McGuire and Giancana's disappointment in Sinatra's inability to get the administration to tone down its efforts in the Anti-Racketeering field constitutes the most significant information developed. On at least two occasions in past years Sinatra has been in Atlantic City taking over an entire floor of one of the major hotels for a private party which lasted several weeks and included hoodlum guests such as Giancana, the Fischettis and Joe Bonanno of Phoenix.

Until he was recently ordered to sell his interests in Las Vegas, Sinatra owned a percentage of the Sands Hotel in Las Vegas and was 100% owner of the Cal-Neva Lodge at Lake Tahoe. Informants have speculated that Sinatra was merely a front for hoodlum money invested in these gambling casinos. During the last year of operation, the Cal-Neva Lodge was managed by Paul "Skinny" D'Amato, long-time friend of Sinatra who also has a hoodlum background and has for years operated the 500 Club in Atlantic City.

When interviewed concerning his Las Vegas interests Sinatra maintained he represented only himself and that Sam Giancana was only someone he recalled meeting at an airport. Confidential sources in Las Vegas and Chicago, however, indicate a much closer association between Sinatra and Giancana. In the Fall of 1962, Sinatra, Dean Martin, Sammy Davis, Jr., and Eddie Fisher made what appeared to be a command performance at the Villa Venice Supper Club near Chicago, apparently arranged by Sinatra for Giancana. When interviewed concerning it, Sinatra claimed he had arranged for these entertainers merely as a favor to Leo Olsen, owner of the Club and that Giancana had nothing to do with it.

It was Sinatra's continued association with Giancana that led to the revocation of his Nevada gambling license in September of 1963. This was brought about principally by the discovery of Giancana's presence at the Cal-Neva Lodge even though he was listed in the Nevada Black Book as a "undesirable" in Nevada.

During August 1976, the Los Angeles Office of the FBI received information concerning a threatening communication directed to Frank Sinatra at Palm Springs, California. The envelope, which was postmarked at <a>(?) shing, New York, on July 29, 1976, contained a typewritten letter, which advised Sinatra in part that he should arrange a press conference and denounce Spiro Agnew. The unknown author of the letter stated that Sinatra's eyes would be put out by the use of African blowing tubes.

On August 9, 1976, Assistant United States Attorney (AUSA) Earl E. Boyd, Los Angeles, California, stated that the wording, as stated in the letter addressed to Sinatra, constituted a technical violation of the Extortion Statute and that Boyd would consider prosecution of the writer if identified.

By a letter dated September 16, 1976, from Helen Montrose, Secretary to Attorney for Frank Sinatra, Milton A. Rudin, 9601 Wilshire Boulevard, Suite 526, Beverly Hills, California, Montrose forwarded a letter dated August 30, 1976, from Richard H. Sheehan for Secretary and Corporate Counsel, Ceasar's World, Inc., Las Vegas, Nevada, which letter had as enclosures an envelope postmarked at Chicago, Illinois, PM 20 August 1976, addressed to "Ceasar's Palace, Strip on the, Las Vegas, Nev." and letter addressed to Frank Sinatra.

This document contains neither recommendations nor conclusions of the FBI. It is the property of the FBI and is loaned to your agency; it and its contents are not to be distributed Dutside your agency. 4-62220-1

The letter read as follows:

"Frank Sinatra:

Judge Markoviz and Korshak plus Levi and Kissinger are planning to get rid of you as they feel you know to much abourt their throwing over the U. S. government — and they are afraid you are going to talk. Be careful — this will be in your injection, food, or medicine. Good luck....."

For further information Bureau and New York, RUDIN furnished literature received by him from the Anti-Defamation League (ADL), Pacific Southwest Region, and other memos from the ADL concerning SPIRO AGNEW. In the memos and publications, the ADL states that "AGNEW has engaged in classical anti-semitism of the Nazi variety, and that because of his business affiliations with the Arabs this has led him to become a propagandist of the most evil kind." Further, the ADL in a digest dated July and August 1976 contained an article captioned "SPIRO AGNEW - The New Darling of the Hate Press."

RUDIN stated it is well known that FRANK SINATRA is a close personal friend of SPIRO AGNEW and that many letters from individuals, known and unknown, have recently been received by SINATRA which all express concern over his (SINATRA's) association and friendship with AGNEW. No letters to date, except the one postmarked 7/29/76 in Flushing, New York, contained a threat against SINATRA.

In the group of letters received by SINATRA as mentioned above, was one which is enclosed, numbers 3 and 4 listed above, also postmarked at Flushing, New York. Review of this letter reflects the writer, Queens, New York, states in part,"...However when we read that he attended your wedding and is such a good friend of yours, we all feel very badly. It will give the public the idea of guilt by association." The letter also states, "...I hope we will read that you will repudiate him, or we will have to lose faith in you FRANK."

On 8/9/76 facts in this matter were discussed with AUSA EARL E. BOYD, Los Angeles, who stated that the wording in the letter received in the envelope addressed to FRANK SINATRA postmarked 7/29/76 at shing, New York, was a technical violation of the Extortion Statute and therefore AUSA BOYD requested a logical investigation to identify the unsub, and that AUSA BOYD would consider prosecution.

No letters to date, except the one postmarked 7/29/76 in Flushing, New York, contained a threat against SINATRA.

In the group of letters received by SINATRA as mentioned above, was one which is enclosed, numbers 3 and 4 listed above, also postmarked at Flushing, New York. Review of this letter reflects the writer, Queens, New York, states in part,"...However when we read that he attended your wedding and is such a good friend of yours, we all feel very badly. It will give the public the idea of guilt by association." The letter also states, "...I hope we will read that you will repudiate him, or we will have to lose faith in you FRANK."

On 8/9/76 facts in this matter were discussed with AUSA EARL E. BOYD, Los Angeles, who stated that the wording in the letter received in the envelope addressed to FRANK SINATRA postmarked 7/29/76 at shing, New York, was a technical violation of the Extortion Statute and therefore AUSA BOYD requested a logical investigation to identify the unsub, and that AUSA BOYD would consider prosecution.

For information of Bureau and New York, SINATRA currently residing in Palm Springs, California, and according to itinerary furnished on 8/9/76, SINATRA will remain there until 8/19/76. SINATRA scheduled to be in New York City 8/21-27/76 and will be residing at the Waldorf Astoria, for performances in Saratoga, New York, and Holmdel, New Jersey.



MILTON A. RUDIN, also known as, "The Judge", attorney, 9601 Wilshire Boulevard, Beverly Hills, California, business manager for FRANK SINATRA, was contacted concerning RUDIN's previous telephonic contact with the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), Los Angeles, California, concerning a threatening letter received by SINATRA.

RUDIN furnished an envelope which was postshing, New York, on July 29. The envelope was typewritten, addressed to Mr. FRANK SINATRA, Palm Springs, California. RUDIN also furnished the letter received in the aforementioned envelope which states in part, that unless SINATRA arranges a well publicized press conference no later than August 15, 1976, in which he denounces his friendship with SPIRO AGNEW, that a chemically treated prickle will perforate one of his, SINATRA's eyes transmitted by an African Bushmen's blowing tube. RUDIN stated that the envelope and letter were received by SINATRA at Palm Springs, California, on Thursday, August 5, 1976. Upon receipt RUDIN stated SINATRA wrote on the front of the envelope, "Sarge -Important for The Judge". FUDIN further stated that the address label affixed to the front of the envelope beneath the typewritten address is a label that the Palm Springs Post Office put on the envelope when it was received at the Palm Springs Post Office. RUDIN stated that SINATRA advised him that he would not hold a press conference as advised on August 15, 1976. A copy of the envelope and letter are attached.

RUDIN then furnished one Anti-Defamation League (ADL) Digest, July/August, 1976 issue, and one ADL memorandum dated May 26, 1976. RUDIN stated ADL memorandum and digest furnished gives background concerning SPIRO AGNEW, in that they feel AGNEW's statements to the American Press and on the Today Show are "irresponsible, anti-Semitic, and are shocking and unplausible." RUDIN stated that based on AGNEW's recent statements, a number of people have written STNATRA concerning his association with AGNEW and have recommended that his association be severed. RUDIN furnished six letters that had been received by SINATRA recently concerning STNATRA's association with AGNEW. Copies of the six letters are attached.

RUDIN then furnished SINATRA's itinerary, which reflects that SINATRA will be in Vancouver on August 20 and 21, 1976, and that from August 21 through 27, 1976, SINATRA will be at the Waldorf Astoria while performing during that period at Saratoga, New York, and Holmdel, New Jersey. SINATRA is currently in Palm Springs, California, and will remain there until August 19, 1976.
