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

Mrs. SOBLE stated that she believed that she heard from Mrs. IRENE WOLGA that ILYA WOLSTON was attending some sort of school while in the US Army. Mrs. WOLSA, who is the sister of ARNOLD WOLSTON, resides at 9809 64th Road, Forest Hills, NY.

Mrs. SOBLE again stated that she recalled that ILYA mentioned the names of DEMETRIUS DVOICHENKO-MARKOV, DAVID CHAYCHAVADZE and BORIS TUMARIN as friends of ILYA. She advised that she assumed, inasmuch as they were Army friends of ILYA, that they were also in school with ILYA. She stated that ILYA never told her these three individuals were in school with him. MYRA again advised she never saw the names of these individuals on a list.

Mrs. SOBLE advised she first met Mrs. WOLGA in MYC in 1942. JACK SGBLE knew Mrs. WOLGA in Lithuania. stated that Mrs. WOLGA had stated that she had not seen ILYA very frequently while he was in the Army. SOBIE was intensively interviewed on details and names of SCBLE's contacts with the Soviets in Switzerland and SCBLE denies that he can recall meeting with the Soviets on only a few occasions. SOBLE admits Soviets gave him \$5,000 in Geneva in 1950. SOBLE denies that he or MYRA ever wrote to Soviets in Switzerland or received letters from them in Paris.

Mrs. SCHIE was again questioned regarding the fraudulent passports used by the SCRIK family in getting out of Lithuania.

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

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

SOBLE now relates that he "might" have read report ALFRED and MARTHA gave him in 1948 but he does not recall exact details. SOBLE stated he was of opinion report contained information on ALP, Progressive Party and the Arts & Sciences Organizations to which the STERN's belonged.

ALEXANDER ELIAS

SOBIE related that he cannot recall any other information that ELIOS furnished Soviets except names ELIOS gave to ZUBILIN in NYC in 1942. SOBIE relates these names were of people who were connected with Canadian Government and possible approaches for Soviets. SOBIE related that photographs of ALEXANDER and HELEN KORAL were familiar to him but could not recall when or where he met them.

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Re ZLATOVSKI

SOBLE states he recalls now that JANE ZIATOVSKI told him that CHARLES FLATO was a former boyfriend of hers. SOBLE cannot recall if JANE ever told him that FLATO had furnished JANE with any information for Soviets. SOBLE expressed an attitude in interview of friendliness and expressed desire to continue to be interviewed and make full disclosure but admitted he had difficulty in talking about certain individuals. Interviews continuing.

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

MYRA SOBLE interviewed on 6/10/57. Advised she could furnish no information regarding trip taken by GEORGE ZLATOVSKI, alone, from Bad Gastein to Salsburg. Advised she had no knowledge of any attempts made by GEORGE ZLATOYSKI to get US Government job in Salzburg or elsewhere in Europe. Recalls that GEORGE mentioned the name of JOSEPH DEROYE. Believes DENOYE and GEORGE were trying to work up deal connected with television. Stated GEORGE never told her where DENOVE was employed.

MYRA SOBLE was questioned regarding JANE FOSTER ZLATOVSKI. Stated she had no additional information regarding JANE. Advised that the only report that JANE wrote for the Soviets, as far as MYRA knew, was the report on ROBERT ST. JOHN which JANE delivered to Soviets at Zurich in 1950 when accompanied by MYRA.

Stated she has furnished complete information on ESTHER RAND and believes if RAND transferred from one Jewish organization to another it would have been for higher salaries.

Stated she does not believe Dr. IRVING SOLLING was ever involved in espionage and is certain that JACK SCHLE never mentioned SOLLINS' name to the Soviets as possible recruit.

MYRA advised that ROBERT SOBLE, while employed with UNRA, never indicated a desire for a foreign assignment with UNRRA. Advised ROBERT SOFLE never not GRORGE or JAME ZLATOVSKI.

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
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DINA SCRIE studied medicine together at Kaumas, Lithmania.

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MIRA SCHLE interviewed 6/12/57, at House of Detention for Woman.

Photo of VITALI GRISCRIEVICE PAYLOW shows to MYRA. Advised photo not likeness of anyone known to her.
Stated photo definitely is not of LEONID B. PRINCY, although there is a resemblance between photo of PAVLAY and PETROY in the eyes. MYRA noted PETROY has slightly drossed eyes.
Description of PAVLAY also reflects slightly crossed eyes.
Advised person in photo has fuller mouth and fuller fore than property and that person had become being mouth. face than PETROV, and that PETROV had brown bair, much shorter than in photo of PAVLOY.

MYRA advised she did not know FLOYD CLEVELAND HILLER and never heard his name mentioned by JACK or ROBERT SCHLE. Failed to identify photo of HILLER. Mever heard of JACK SCHLE introducing ROBBET SCHLE to anyone as his "cousin."

Advised that VICTOR GIRESCHES was never used for transferring scale funds from France to the US. However, on several occasions CIESBOURG gave MYRA money and JACK SCHIE then gave the money to GIRROGRA's father in Verberie, France.

Advised LOUISE ANNUE NICES was used several times by the Status for Lengtor of Punds, Status neither extensions or times involved in explorage.


