Dear Sir:

The Allies should strike at Japan while she is scared to "death".

The Allies are running around the jungle wherever the Japanese are leaving them. If you strike at Japan direct you will see entirely different result. Japan is the nucleus of this jungle warfare, and if you destroy the nucleus, the remainder of the territory in her hands will fall into our power.

We are awed too much by the indomitable courage of the Japs. The Japs are decidedly lacking in intelligence, and whatever warfare that will be conducted over there will be conducted by German brains. The capture of Japan is an easy task. Of course you will have to watch out for submarine mines (there should be an electric mine detector perfected by now). You could sweep these mines off in advance of the fleet by static electricity, i.e., positive and negative attraction, this causes an arc that would jar them enough to set them off.

You will have to be well prepared for any aerial attacks on the fleet. It would have to be constantly prepared to combat German supervised submarine warfare.

You could make China a military and supply base.

If none of these suggestions are good, or worse you can discard them for the waste basket.

It is imperative that you conquer Japan before you attempt Germany. There is going to be some hard fighting around Germany.

This letter contains instructions to the effect that Miss LAMOUR should proceed to Oakland, California, and contact one [REDACTED], apparently an airplane manufacturer representative, and further instructing that Miss LAMOUR should charter a plane from him. Miss LAMOUR was then given instructions to proceed to [REDACTED] and meet the writer of this letter.

Although this letter contains no threats or any statements which would constitute a violation of the Extortion Act, it is felt that this information should be forwarded to the Bureau in order that some investigation might be conducted by the Miami Field Division in order to determine if the writer of this letter is of sound mind and also to prevent any letters of this nature being written in the future to Miss LAMOUR.

The letter is being sent as an enclosure to the Miami Field Division.

Reference is made to Bureau letter dated November 26, 1943 which requested that the original letter forwarded to the Miami Field Division by the Los Angeles Field Division in the above captioned matter be forwarded to the Bureau. The original letter as received from the Los Angeles office is being forwarded herewith.

Per the Bureau's information on September 9, 1943, [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] had written two letters, one to the President of Brazil dated September 8, 1943 and one to the President of Argentina dated September 8, 1943 and that he only placed 30 cents in stamps on these letters whereas they required 70 cents in stamps. He stated that the letters had no return address on the outside and they were signed prior to placing them in the dead letter file.

[REDACTED] advised that subject in one of the letters called the President and Secretary of State HILL, Jews and stated that they were fluent in with the English but that he, the subject, really ran the United States. Subject spoke of having some valuable pearls in Tahiti and wanted to split with the President of Argentina if he could send a ship to Panama Bay to get him so that he could get to Tahiti to get the pearls.

In his letter to the President of Brazil the subject requested the following: to send him some brand auto and coffee, and in the letter he also stated that he wanted to request that the President give him

the following: to advise him on how the soldiers in the U.S. Army and Navy and Air Force and how soon should he be able to get a ship to Tahiti and when the ships would be available to him.

The above-listed evidence, specimen # through (3), was searched through the Miami Letter File, but nothing of significance was noted. A representative photographic copy of this material will be added to this file for future reference.

Specimens # through 53 were chemically treated for the development of latent prints, but none of value was developed.

Specimen # 54 was found to contain a white patch measuring 6.400 by 3.600 by .000 inches. This patch has an reflectivity value of 0.90. It appears to be a piece of paper or cloth.

It has been ascertained through a strictly confidential source that under date of July 7, 1944, [REDACTED] addressed a letter to "His Excellency, The French Ambassador, in care of French Embassy, Washington, D. C.," postmarked Redwood, California. In this letter, [REDACTED] stated that he had already named France an affiliate of the "New Empire," and that VLR associates in Constantinople would give the French Ambassador full information on the outlines of the "New Empire." Further on in this letter [REDACTED] asked the French to do him the favor of consulting [REDACTED] on all military matters concerning the allied cause, stating that the United States War Department could be consulted as to [REDACTED]. He requested that "in all fairness to you, the Allies are now using [REDACTED] strategy, etc. [REDACTED] spoke of the administration of [REDACTED] from time of historical time and of French policy needs.

[REDACTED] also stated in his letter that he was trying to [REDACTED] out of FRANCE because [REDACTED] and his cabinet from office, and that [REDACTED] intended to go about this in a legal manner, that is, by protection.

Upon the end of this letter, he stated that he did not know anything to do with the protection and inviolability of the Jews in Germany, although he could easily have mentioned or been placed in a position to do so. He stated that he was a "pacifist."

The letter [REDACTED] is believed to be the work of an unbalanced fanatic. However, upon a close view of the letter and the envelope is found to be addressed and delivered to the San Francisco Field Division, and two names are listed on the envelope to the person, with the request that the two being delivered to the San Francisco Field Division, with signature of Director, San Francisco Field Division, and the name of [REDACTED] on file in San Francisco Field Division (see file).



On Page [REDACTED] says: "I was born [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] as an explosion occurred which a Welsh general made [REDACTED] when he says he is a direct descendant of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was confirmed to Cagney should "call" [REDACTED] nothing".

Persons are asked to see the F.B.I.). The letter itself begins: "GOD BLESS YOU, JAMES GAGNON AND I WILL LET YOU KNOW WHAT'S GOING ON IN THE WORLD. I DON'T WANT YOU TO GET HURT. YOU DON'T HAVE A BRANCH OF MEIN KAMPF TO DO. SORRY, YOUR FRIEND" [REDACTED]

The letter then continues "ADOLPH HITLER IS THE LEADERSHIP OF THE EAST COAST. THE MESSAGE FROM PRISON. TELL THE P.D.L. THAT ADOLPH HITLER IS THE LEADERSHIP. THE SECOND PAGE IS ATTACHED."

"SIR, HITLER. Give me 100,000,000 for 'Christ Jesus' (3). How wasn't Hitler in 1945? You know a 'hot nurse' a long time?"
