Employed by War Manpower Commission, Chicago, Ill. Terminated by reason of resignation. Relatives, education, addresses, and prior employments set forth. Appointee member CAP noted.

DETAILS: AT ST. LOUIS, MISSOURI

A review on August 2, 1965, of the military service records on file at the Military Personnel Records Center, St. Louis, Missouri, indicated JOHN WILLIAM CHANCELLOR, Serial Number 46 043 408, was inducted into the United States Army on November 6, 1945, and entered on active duty on the same date at Chicago, Illinois. He was honorably discharged on June 3, 1945, as a Private at Camp Lee, Virginia, to enlist in the regular Army.

He enlisted in the United States Army on June 4, 1945, and entered on active duty on the same date at Camp Lee, Virginia. He was honorably discharged on July 3, 1947, as a Technician Fifth Grade at Carlisle Barracks, Pennsylvania, by reason of expiration of term of service.

His military occupations were shown as artist and

Army Information Specialist and civilian occupations as free lance artist and writer.

He had no foreign service.

He was awarded the World War II Victory Medal.

His character and efficiency ratings ranged from unknown to excellent and there is no record of courts-martial or absence without official leave.

Service records indicated he had entered college after his junior year of high school and at time of induction had completed four quarters of credit in college. No details concerning this education were shown.

His date and place of birth were shown as July 14, 1927, Chicago, Illinois.

A discrepancy is noted in the date of entry into the service.

Personnel, this center, advised they were unable to locate any record of Naval service for CHANCELLOR.

On August 2, 1965, a review by IC [REDACTED] of the personnel records on file at Federal Records Center disclosed JOHN WILLIAM CHANCELLOR was employed on July 14, 1943, as an assistant messenger with the War Department, Ordnance Department at Large, Chicago Ordnance District at Chicago, Illinois. This employment was terminated on September 16, 1943, as an assistant messenger by reason of resignation, "to complete high school education." b7c

He was employed on July 10, 1944, as a clerk with the War Department, Ordnance Department at Large, Chicago Ordnance District, at Chicago, Illinois. This employment was terminated on December 5, 1944, as a clerk by reason of resignation, "to resume schooling at Chicago University Day School." It was noted that the last actual working day of this period of employment was listed as November 25, 1944.

The records showed he was employed on March 12, 1945, as a clerk with the War Manpower Commission, U. S. Employment Service for Illinois, Region 6, Area Number 2, Office Number 6, at Chicago, Illinois. This employment was terminated on April 20, 1945, as a clerk by reason of resignation, details shown only as "enlisting in Navy."

Appointee's relatives were identified in the records as follows:

ESTILL MARION CHANCELLOR, father, 1018 North LaSalle, Chicago, Illinois (July, 1943);

MARY BARRETT CHANCELLOR, mother, 1300 North State Street, Chicago, Illinois (July, 1943).

The records also contained a "Certificate of Baptism" dated April 11, 1942, indicating appointee was baptized on August 21, 1947, as JOHN WILLIAM CHANCELLOR, son of JOHN CHANCELLOR and MARIE BARRETT. A discrepancy is noted inasmuch as appointee's father is variously shown as ESTILL MARION CHANCELLOR and JOHN CHANCELLOR.

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The following investigation at the White House Press Office was conducted by SA [REDACTED]

On August 2, 1965, [REDACTED] advised that she has known JOHN CHANCELLOR, the appointee, on a professional basis only for approximately six months in connection with CHANCELLOR's duties with this office. She described CHANCELLOR as a very personable dedicated individual on whom she has heard nothing unfavorable or derogatory concerning his character, associates, reputation or loyalty. She stated that he conducts himself in a very gentlemanly manner and that to her knowledge based upon his statements concerning his family he is very much a family man. [REDACTED] highly recommended the appointee for a position of trust and confidence.

On August 3, 1965, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] advised that she has known JOHN CHANCELLOR, the appointee, for approximately six months since the time he was assigned to the White House by NBC. 


