DETAILS: Abscam is a solely Bureau funded, controlled undercover operation targeted against major political corrupters in various Federal and State Government, as well as major swindlers and property thieves. During the course of the operation, Abscam has developed prosecutive Federal cases against Angelo Errichetti, Mayor of Camden, New Jersey; Kenneth McDonald, Vice-Chairman of the New Jersey Casino Control Commission; Harrison Williams, U. S. Senator, New Jersey; Senator Williams; associates Henry A. Williams, III.; Alexander Feinberg; and George Katz; and an INS investigator Al Alexandro; Michael Ozzie Myers, U. S. Congressman, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; Raymond F. Lederer, U. S. Congressman, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; Frank Thompson, Jr., U. S. Congressman, New Jersey; John M. Murphy, U. S. Congressman, Staten Island, New York; John W. Jenrette, Jr.; U. S. Congressman, South Carolina; and Joseph A. Maressa, New Jersey State Senator.

An Abscam operative, who has been in contact with William Rosenberg, a known comman, and Stanley Weiss, a Long Island accountant, who has Organized Crime ties with John Delmastro,

a known member of the Luchese family, was introduced to Gene Ciuzio, who reportedly has Organized Crime connections in Florida. Ciuzio has advised that he controls Florida Congressman Richard Kelly, 5th Congressional District, and that Kelly, for an initial payoff of \$25,000 will assure undercover Agents that he will use his congressional position to see to it that Yassir Habib receives political asylum in the United States. This meeting is scheduled for 1/8/80. This meeting will be recorded and videotaped.

Thomas Puccio, Chief, Eastern District of New Jersey, Organized Crime Strike Force, recommends that the payoffs be made to Congressman Kelly if and when he provides the proper commitments concerning utilization of his influence to obtain political asylum for the Arab principal of this project.

FBI, Miami and Tampa indices reflect the following information concerning Congressman Richard Kelly and Eugene Robert Ciuzio: Regarding Kelly, Tampa File 56-0-34, captioned, "Possible Election Law Violations, Congressman Richard Kelly - Complaint," pertains to an unsubstantiated claim by Congressman Kelly and his administrative assistant of a possible election law violation. The basis of the allegation concerned possible ballot tampering in Pasco County, Florida, during Kelly's 1978 re-election for the 5th congressional seat.

Kelly, according to the Miami Office, is listed in the 1978-1979 issue of "Who's Who in America" as being born 7/31/24 at Atlanta, Georgia, as serving as a city attorney for Zephyrhille, Florida, and Assistant U. S. Attorney, District of Florida, 1956-1959. According to this issue, Kelly served as a county judge in the 6th Circuit Court of Florida from 1960-1974.

Regarding Ciuzio, Tampa File 92-1994, captioned, "Eugene Robert Ciuzio, aka Geno, AR" revealed a New York memo to Tampa for general information dated 5/22/75, which indicated that Ciuzio was a former associate of Michael Casale (deceased), a suspected member of the Bonanno LCN family.

Undercover Agents of Abscam operation through Philadelphia Attorney Howard Criden have a meeting arranged for 1/10/80 or 1/11/80 at Washington, D. C., with U. S. Congressman John P. Murtha of Pennsylvania. Criden has assured undercover Agents that U. S. Congressman Murtha, for a payment of \$50,000, will promise to use his influence/position to obtain political asylum and/or permanent resident status for Yassir Habib, the Arab

principal of Abscam. This meeting will be recorded and videotaped. It should be noted that Criden for the past few months has been hounding Abscam operatives to meet with this Congressman for the purpose set forth above.

Thomas Puccio, Chief, Federal Strike Force, Eastern District of New York, has recommended that the \$50,000 payoff be made to U. S. Congressman Murtha, provided he makes the proper assurances concerning the political asylum scenario.

On January 7, 1980 Howard Criden met with Abscam operatives and with U.S. Congressman John P. Murtha from Johnstown, Pennsylvania. This meeting was set up in order to make a payment of \$50,000 to U.S. Congressman Murtha in exchange for his cooperation in gaining permanent resident status for the Arab principal of this operation. During this meeting Murtha pledged his support, however, indicated he would not accept the money at that time. He advised that he was aware that U.S. Congressman Murphy from New York and U.S. Congressman Thompson from New Jersey, had already accepted money and were presently working on the political asylum problem. Subsequent to this meeting Criden indicated that a share of the money to be paid to Murtha was actually to go to U.S. Congressmen Thompson, Murphy and himself. He requested that he be given his share, which would amount to \$10,000.

Thomas Puccio, Chief Federal Strike Force, Eastern District of New York has recommended that the \$10,000 payoff be made to Criden in order to insure his continued cooperation.

Williams. However, before this takes place, Yassir Habib wants to meet with Senator Williams on 1/15/80 to ask him for one favor, namely that Senator Williams give his personal assurances to Habib that Habib would be granted either political asylum and/or permanent resident status in the United States. Habib intends to offer Senator Williams \$40,000 in cash for these assurances.
