Reference is made to Bureau memorandum dated June 19, 1963, covering the results of an interview of [REDACTED] which was disseminated to Central Intelligence Agency (CIA). OSI, telephonically contacted week-end Supervisor J. D. Donohue at 5:30 P.M. 6-23-63 and advised that Inspector [redacted] OSI, in connection with a briefing for General Carroll on 6-24-63 requested a name search on Harry Alan Towers and Maria Novotny. Towers and Novotny were arrested by the New York City Police Department in March, 1961, and Towers was charged with maintaining a disorderly house while Novotny was charged with soliciting for prostitution. The New York Journal - American in two sensational articles is attempting to link the Towers case with Christine Keeler. *(b7c)*

After checking with Supervisor W. D. Stewart, [redacted] was furnished the facts of the Towers arrest and arraignment for violation of the White Slave Traffic Act and his subsequent jumping of bond by fleeing to Europe. [redacted] was advised that Towers was last known to be in Czechoslovakia and Novotny in England.

At 6:50 P.M. [redacted] OSI, called back and said they were particularly interested in the references in the Journal - American articles to the possible connection of the Towers case to United Nations personnel. After checking with Mr. Branigan and you, OSI was advised at 7:30 P.M. that we had nothing to back up the newspaper account.

DATE: APR 8 1987 We talked with Legal Attache Bates 6/21/63 via Defense telephone facilities. He was instructed, pursuant to the Director's wishes, that he is not to leave his post without the specific approval of the Director and he was informed that the seriousness of the matters now being handled by his office requires his presence in London until further notice. Bates stated that he recognizes this and had cancelled his trip to the Scandinavian countries, sending an assistant instead. (S)(u)

Bates acknowledged the instructions given earlier to Assistant Legat Minnich with respect to the forthcoming visit to London of Deputy Assistant Secretary of State William C. Burdett. He asked what information he should furnish in the event Burdett asked him for data concerning the case. We told him he could furnish Burdett any material which had been disseminated here at the Bureau. Bates asked that we keep him promptly informed concerning the dissemination we make and pointed out that it is most important for him to know about this so he will not be caught short in dealing with his contacts in London, both American and British. (S)(u)

Regarding Secretary McNamara's call to the Director's office, I reached the Secretary about 2 p.m. and advised him that I was acting for the Director in this matter.

He said he was concerned about the matter and would like me to come over to his office at 4:45 p.m. today to discuss it, along with Director McCone of Central Intelligence Agency. I mentioned to him that we had interviewed [REDACTED] in NY and that we were interviewing the [REDACTED], and if he preferred I could go over the matter with Lt. Gen. Carroll, who had also called us today regarding this matter. Secretary McNamara said he would appreciate it if I would come over with any information we had on the case and I told him I would be glad to come.

Yesterday we disseminated the results of [REDACTED] and I will furnish McNamara with a copy of the memorandum showing this interview, and also give him a copy of a memorandum we sent to the AG a few days ago showing information furnished by our Legat, which includes information from the Air Force that two US Airmen in England were involved with Keeler. I will be alert to see that this case is not dumped off on the FBI, pointing out that we are not operational abroad, and have no jurisdiction, and the activities of these airmen are the responsibility of the Defense Department.

I also talked with Lt. Gen. Carroll, who advised that there were three Air Force men involved, the two we were aware of and another named Hamilton, and all three of them are being flown back to the States from England today for interrogation by the military.

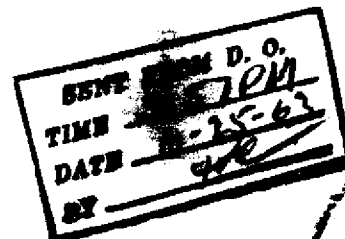

On June 20, 1963, Colonel David I. Walsh, Office of Special Investigations (OSI) Headquarters, advised Liaison Agent O'Connor that OSI has ascertained three airmen have been closely associated with Christine Keeler. The three were identified as [redacted] and [redacted] and had been assigned to communications work with the Air Force (AF) at South Ryslip AF Base, England. Colonel Walsh indicated the three Negroes had met Keeler in low-class night clubs, generally frequented by non-Caucasian elements in London. Colonel Walsh indicated the trio at the instructions of the Inspector General, AF, are being flown from England today for interrogation and to insure that the thrill-seeking English press does not get their story before the AF does. The three airmen will be housed at Bolling AF Base and the investigation is designed to determine whether Keeler had attempted to "pump" them for intelligence data which they might have in connection with their AF assignments. Colonel Walsh indicated he would keep Liaison advised of the results of the interrogations.

As a matter of interest, Colonel Walsh also advised investigation to date indicates a member of the AF, as yet unidentified, sired Keeler's baby born in early 1959 who subsequently died two weeks after birth.



[REDACTED] was interviewed on June 25, 1963, concerning her knowledge of John Profumo, former British War Minister, Dr. Stephen Ward, British Osteopath, and others whose names appear associated, social or otherwise, with John Profumo or Dr. Stephen Ward.

[REDACTED] first became acquainted with Dr. Stephen Ward during 1949, while she was residing at London, England. She described Dr. Ward at this time as having a reputation for going with attractive women; a Bohemian-type individual, who lived simply, according to his income, which, according to [REDACTED] was derived from his medical practice; occasional paintings, sketchings, and creations for magazine covers. (b7D)

Dr. Ward, during 1949, resided, and had offices at Portman Square, London, England.

Dr. Ward mixed freely among British social gatherings in London. He had a pleasing personality, and was knowledgeable of the then-current gossip. In general, his presence among British social circles was in great demand.

Lord Astor, described by [REDACTED] as an old acquaintance, was extremely fond of Dr. Ward, both for his social company and medical ability. She said that Lord Astor had been acquainted with Dr. Ward since before 1949.

Among British social circles, according to [REDACTED] Dr. Ward was considered to be a remarkable person. Medically, he was considered to be excellent and, in this regard, it was common gossip among the British social circle that Dr. Ward was lax in requesting payments for medical services rendered among those able to pay. He also gave his time and ability free to numerous patients unable to afford his services.

During approximately May, 1962, [REDACTED] and her husband visited London, England. While there, they contacted Dr. Ward and had dinner at his home. Dr. Ward was then residing at a mews, exact address unknown, located near his office, 38 Devonshire Street, London, England.

[REDACTED] recalled that Dr. Ward's residence was sparsely furnished and that both she and her husband were of the opinion that Dr. Ward wasn't doing too well financially. During the conversation, Dr. Ward remarked that he was "unable to afford a new suit". [REDACTED] said that she and her husband suggested to him that he come to the United States where his art ability would be in great demand. Dr. Ward did not comment to their suggestion.

Following dinner, Dr. Ward remarked that he "was going around with a Russian diplomat, a naval attache, taking him to various social functions and introducing him to his friends". [REDACTED] questioned Dr. Ward's actions; however, Dr. Ward said he "had told British Intelligence and they said it was all right". The matter concerning the Russian was not further discussed.

[REDACTED] commented that she was "shocked" upon learning that Dr. Ward had been accused of being a procurer and pimp, as well as possibly being involved in espionage activities on behalf of the Soviet Government.

She said that it was common knowledge among British social circles that Dr. Ward "liked pretty girls"; however, she was of the opinion that he would have "kept them for himself".

[REDACTED] noted that in her conversations with Dr. Ward concerning political matters, he would always seem to be opposed to the then-current trend of British political thinking. She said that she would not describe him as one adhering to the Communist line; however, would describe his thinking as being "somewhat Leftish".

At 8 a.m., 6/23/63, Legal Attache Charles Bates, London, telephonically furnished the following information to Special Agent William F. Shubatt.

The Sunday edition of "News of the World," a London newspaper, which was described by Bates as a scandal sheet, carries a front-page story to the effect that the American FBI is making inquiries into revelations arising from the Profumo matter. It was indicated that at Washington's request MI-5 had furnished information about activities in England of an international blackmailing organization which was known as "the syndicate," and that American investigators had flown to England from Washington to interview several people. According to Bates, it is his belief that the mention of investigators arriving in England probably refers to certain Air Force personnel who arrived in London to conduct inquiry regarding Air Force personnel involved in captioned matter.

Bates indicated that the "Sunday Express," also a London newspaper, carried an article regarding prostitution and call girls in the United Nations and in other high places. Bates indicated he has reviewed all Sunday newspapers and the above two articles are the only stories of any consequence. He stated that he has received press inquiries and has indicated he had no comment. He advised that newspaper reporters are eagerly attempting to gain information and reportedly have attempted to surveil officers of Scotland Yard.

Bates indicated that it is his opinion the newspapers are attempting to piece together various bits of information in order to write stories regarding this matter; however, he believes that, from the papers he reviewed today, an attempt is being made to play this matter down.

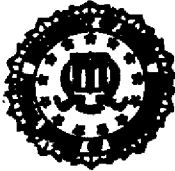



The following is information concerning Maria Novotny whose name has been mentioned in captioned matter as an associate of Dr. Stephen Ward.

Harry Alan Towers, subject and fugitive in White Slave Traffic Act investigation, was a television producer born 10/19/20 in London. He induced Maria Novotny, a 19-year-old model, television actress and also a British subject, to come to the U. S. on 12/14/60 and work as a model and television actress. Upon her arrival, Towers immediately engaged her into lucrative prostitution work. They were arrested on 3/3/61 by the New York City Police Department on prostitution charges. Towers was placed under \$10,000 bail but prior to his court appearance scheduled for 5/9/61, he fled to England where, as a British citizen, he could not be extradited. He is currently a Bureau fugitive stemming from White Slave Traffic Act charges from his original arrest on 3/3/61.

and among other information said a dinner party attended by approximately twenty guests, including Dr. Ward, was held and everyone appeared in formal dress. When the dinner was about to be served, a waiter serving the dinner appeared in complete undress except for a black hood which he wore over his head with slits for his eyes. The waiter's appearance eventually caused the dinner to culminate in a perverted sex orgy on the part of all guests. This waiter was a high-ranking cabinet minister. His identity is presently unknown.

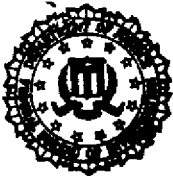

He could not recall the address or the identity of the person
who gave the party.

[REDACTED] knew Marilyn Rice-Davies as Mandy. In a
period of three weeks, he took her out six times, always to
dinner. She never visited him at his hotel, which was the
Mayfair Hotel, London. He claimed that he did not visit
her in any apartment or hotel. On five occasions he picked
Mandy up at the apartment of Stephen Ward, where Mandy was
residing. On one such occasions, he met Dr. Ward. On the
other occasion when he picked up Mandy was at the apartment
of Christine Keeler. According to [REDACTED] Mandy was living
with another girl in Ward's apartment. (b7D)

[REDACTED] only met Ward on one occasion and the conver-
sation that he had with him was brief; however, [REDACTED] said
that Ward had a good practice in osteopathy, was financially
well off, a man of prominence with a good clientele, and he
felt that the allegations that had been made against Dr. Ward by
the British authorities were completely unfounded and baseless.
[REDACTED] further stated that in his opinion Dr. Ward's position
was such that he would never have been associated with
prostitutes or party girls.

██████████ advised that on the one occasion that he did meet Christine Keeler that he found her to be a very charming, young lady, who appeared to have a good background.

According to ██████████ Mandy Rice-Davies was only 18 years of age when he met her; however, she conversed like a woman of 30 years of age. He found her cultured, refined, and a pleasure to be with. It was his opinion that Mandy Rice-Davies could never have engaged in prostitution.

██████████ does not know and has never met John Profumo. He claimed that he never met any of the associates, friends, or acquaintances of Mandy Rice-Davies, of Christine Keeler, or of Dr. Stephen Ward. He recalled that in November, 1962, Mandy had been going with a well-to-do Britisher who was a real estate man, and who died in November, 1962.

██████████ recalled that Mandy Rice-Davies told him that she had made a visit to the United States with a girl friend, name not indicated, in the early part of 1962, and that she and her girl friend stayed in New York City for about a week or ten days. Mandy indicated that she had tried to obtain a modeling job in New York and, being unable to do so, had returned to London. (b7D)

██████████ has not had any contact with Mandy Rice-Davies since November, 1962, except for a cable which he received from her in January, 1963, in which she indicated that she was planning to come to the United States. He never answered the cablegram.

In conclusion, ██████████ stated that on the six instances that he was with Mandy Rice-Davies that they always were alone in restaurants, and that he never accompanied her to any parties and he does not know the name of any individuals, either in this country or abroad, who are acquainted in any way with Mandy Rice-Davies, Christine Keeler, or John Profumo.

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
