The title of this report is being marked "changed" to show all the aliases of the subject. These aliases were obtained from a review of the Chicago Office files, the records of the Chicago Crime Commission, and the United States Senate investigative file regarding the subject.

PERSONAL HISTORY AND BACKGROUND

Birth Data

According to the records of the Bureau of Vital Statistics, Cook County, Chicago, Illinois, as checked by Investigative Clerk on October 1, 1958, the birth of the subject was recorded as follows:

JOSEPH AIUPPA, male, legitimate, born December 1, 1907, Birth Certificate No. 23511, which was filed on February 16, 1943. His father's name was shown as SAM AIUPPA, age 23, laborer, born in Fanary, Italy. His mother's name was shown as ROSE GRECO, age 21, also born in Fanary, Italy. The address was give as 2110 Main Street, Melrose Park, Illinois.

There was a notation indicating that this was a first child of this marriage. No physiciants name was given, and the affadavit, which was filed on February 16, 1943, was signed by ANTHONY P. AIUPPA, brother of JOSEPH, 910 North 22nd Avenue, Melrose Park, Illinois.

Marital Status

The records of the Eureau of Vital Statistics, Cook County. Chicago, Illinois, as checked by Investigative Clerk on October 2, 1958, revealed the following:

Marriage Certificate No. 1325243, filed on September 26, 1931, indicated that JOSEPH AIUPPA and Miss ANGELINE ZITO were married in Melrose Park, Illinois, on October 31, 1931, by Reverend BENJAMIN FRANCH, Catholic Priest, 1101 23rd Avenue, Melrose Park, Illinois. On an affidavit completed regarding the above, JOSEPH AIUPPA gave his address as 910.22nd Avenue, Melrose Park, Illinois, and his date of birth as December 1, 1907. It was also noted that it was his first marriage.

The affidavit also indicated that Miss ANGELINE ZITO resided at 139 23rd Street, Melrose Park, Illinois, and gave her date of birth as May 26, 1910. It was also noted that this was Miss ZITO's first marriage.

Employments

It is noted that this subject was one of the individuals investigated by the Senate Committee (Mc Cellan Committee) regarding the criminal infiltration of labor organizations.

Information from an investigation in Chicago, Illinois, was made available to SA on October 1, 1958.

During the above investigation, Senate Investigators checked the subject's prison file at the Federal Penitentiary Terre Haute, Indiana. These records indicated that the subject left school in 1918, and started working for a Mr. as a gardener.

In 1922, he was employed by the Alming Greenhouse, Hillside, Illinois. In 1925, he became a driver for the Midwest Cartage Company, Chicago, Illinois. In 1930, he purchased the Turf Lounge, located at 4831 West Cermak Road and Cicerc, Illinois. He still owns and operates this establishment. Further in 1930, he also became a partner in the Taylor Company, Cicero, Illinois, which company manufactures gambling equipment.

According to the subject's Selective Service records, checked in March of 1945 by Special Agents of the Chicago Division, the subject, when he registered with Local Draft Board No. 3, 2244 South Laramie, on October 16, 1940, indicated his occupation as the previously mentioned Taylor Company, and the Turf Lounge.

According to the previously mentioned Senate Investigation records, and the subject still owns the Turf Lounge and is an owner of the Taylor Company.

According to the previously mentioned United States Senate Investation, investigators visited the home of Mrs. ROSALIE AIUPPA, mother of the subject, on July 7, 1958, located at 910 22nd Avenue, Melrose Park, Illinois. She was asked the whereabouts of her son, JOEY; at which time she said, "he's home isn't he?". She then professed to understand little or no English, although she had shown no difficulty before. She was then served a subpoena to appear before the same Senate Committee.

Later this same day, the same investigators proceeded to the residence of the subject, and contacted an individual who identified himself as who is He was sitting in a black Thunderbird Ford, bearing 1958 Illinois License No. The investigators noted another car, described as a light green Ford, bearing 1958 Illinois License No. which was parked beside the home.

Regarding the above mentioned Thunderbird, it is noted that this automobile is registered to Illinois.

Regarding subject's current residence, it is noted that this home is located in an exclusive residential area called Yorkshire Woods. This area is made up of homes costing approximately \$\psi_0,000\$ and up. Due to the current Illinois Toll Road construction, there is only entrance or exit to Yorkshire Woods, and it is temporary, until the toll road is completed.

Physical Condition

At the time the subject completed his Selective Service questionnaire on October 16, 1940, he gave his doctors, names as Doctor

Doctor stated that the subject is supposed to visit him about once every three months, but it is usually once every six months. He stated that the subject is due for an examination, but will not be in for a while, as AIUPPA's wife advised the Doctor last week, (October 20, 1958), that the subject was going to the Dakotas hunting pheasents.

Doctor stated that the subject, in 1941, had a malignant masal growth, but this was removed and subsequent treatment has completely eleminated the malignancy or trace thereof; however, the subject must and has periodically subjected himself to a doctor's care and examination.

The subject was admitted to Presbyterian Hospital in 1957, for exploratory abdominal surgery, at which time a non-malignant mass was removed from the abdominal area.

According to Doctor records, the subject listed his residence as 4848 West 25th Street, Riverside, Illinois, and his business address as 2242 South Cicero, in 1953. The only telephone number in his records is TE 2-9440.

According to the Chicago Office files, Oak Park, Illinois, Police Department record? No. 2981, show that the Berwyn Police Department on June 17, 1935, arrested AIUPPA as a suspect in an assualt to murder, but Maywood, Illinois, and that this case was dismissed. The records further reflected that the subject has no Chicago Police Department number, nor does he have an arrest record at the Cicero, Illinois, Police Department.

It is noted that the subject's attorney at the time he refused to testify before the Kefauver Senate Committee in 1951, was GEORGE CALLAGHAN.

According to the Chicago Crime Commission records, Chicago, Illinois, in a "Chicago Tribune" newspaper clipping of December 30, 1933, JOSEPH AUIPPA, alias JOEY O'BRIEN, is listed as an official of Local No. 782, of the Teamsters Union of Maywood, Illinois, and was one of 35 co-conspiritors, named in an indictment charging 17 persons with racketeering. A mistrial against the 17 persons was declared on November 22, 1934, and on a second trial there was a finding of not guilty on May 10, 1935.

In a "Chicago Tribune" newspaper clipping of June 24, 1945, it was shown that JOSEPH AIUPPA, age 36, Cidero, Illinois, MICHEAL DE ROSE, and SAM CAPLAN were booked as keepers of a gambling house at 4820 Cermak Road, Cicero, Illinois, wefter a raid, by the Cook County Highway Police. The charge was dismissed.

In a "Chicago American" newspaper clipping of December 24, 1954, it was indicated that the sheriff's office had arrested AIUPPA, LARRY RASSANO, and RUTH SINGER, in connection with a dice game at the Frolics, 4813 Cermak Road, Cicero, Illinois.

AIUPPA at that time claimed that he was the manager of the Frolics.

On July 14, 1958, when the subject accepted a subpoena to appear before the Mc Ciellan Committee, he was accompanied by his attorney, MAURICE J. WALSH, 105 West Adams Street, Chicago, Illinois.

The "Chicago Sun" in the issue of January 26, 1947, contained an article entitled "Capone's Pals Still in Rackets".

The article reflects that more than a score of AL CAPONE's old associates of the Roaring 20's are still active. In Chicago, most of them are connected in one capacity or another with the still functioning crime outfit CAPONE built up on a foundation of booting beer.

Their activities have changed. No longer do they have lucrative incomes from illicit liquor and brothels. Most of them are now connected with gambling and other assorted rackets.

Among CAPONE's associates still active around town is JOEY AIUPPA, who now rules the Cicero rackets for the outfit.

According to information received from the Chicago Police Department in 1954, TONY ACCARDO, a notorious hoodlum, on July 5, 1954, entertained at a barbecue party at his home. 915 Frankling Street, River Forest, Illinois. Among the many hoodlums in attendance was JOEY AIUPPA, who was driwing a Cadillac bearing Illinois license 711 711, and his address was shown as 1836 South 55th Avenue, Cicero, Illinois.

a well known Chicago hoodlum, visited several bars in Cicero, Illinois, and was in contact with JOEY O'BRIEN, the boss of Cicero.

It is noted that now resides in Indianapolis.

On May 30, 1955, LOUIS CAMPAGNA, a notorious CAPONE hoodlum, died of a heart attack while fishing off the coast of Florida on a yacht owned by Attorney who has in the past represented many of the Chicago hoodlums. His wake was held in the mortuary at 2921 South Harlem Avenue, Berwyn, Illinois. According to the "Chicago Tribune" of November 13, 1956, TONY ACCARDO's annual party on the 4th of July was held this year and was attended by many of the same underworld leaders who have been ACCARDO's guests in previous years. Among those present were CLAUDE MADDOX, JOEY ALUPPA and an armed robbery ex-convict who has been arrested as an employee of ALUPPA's gambling joints in Cicero, Illinois.

According to the Chicago Crime Commission, a list of license numbers observed on the cars at the wedding of CLAUDE MADDOX's daughter on January 22, 1955, at Riverside, Illinois, reflected a license traced to JOSEPH AIUPPA, 139 23rd Avenue, Melrose Park, Illinois, for a Cadillac. The article stated BRRIN is actually JOEY AIUPPA, who likes to be known as JOEY O'BRIEN, and that AIUPPA operates handbooks at 4835, 4811, and 4818 Cermak Road, Cicero, Illinois The article stated further that AIUPPA's big spot is the 4811 Club at 4811 Cermak Road with the others being used as "sneak spots" when the heat is on.

Union Activity

It is noted that in a previously mentioned "Chicago Tribune" article of December 30, 1933, JOEY AIUPPA, alias JOEY O'BRIEN, was listed as an official of Local 782 of the Teamsters Union of Maywood, Illinois. He was shown as one of 35 co-conspirators named in an indictment charging 17 persons with racketeering. This indictment against 17 persons was discussed on July 22, 1934, and on a second trial there was a finding of not guilty on May 10, 1935.

PJD PT Employees Union in the Chicago area is controlled by the hoodlum element and that the union's international president is a Mr. BLAKELY, who is controlled by JOHN LARDINO; alias-JOHN NARDICO, a murderer, and that LARDINO is controlled by JOHNNY-MOORE; alias CLAUDE MADDOX; originally from St. Louis, Missouri. added that MADDOX's boss is MOONEY-GIANCANNA, who has the support of the triggerman JOEY ATUPPA.
