

From 07/13/2007 - 07/15/2007, FBI San Antonio, Austin Resident Agency Central Texas Joint Terrorism Task Force (CTXJTTF) coordinated with the United States Secret Service (USSS) to conduct several measures in order to provide a safe venue for the Lady Bird Johnson funeral attendees and the public. CTXJTTF Task Force members conducted coordination with Federal, State, and local agencies. This event generated national, international, and very high domestic public interest in the funeral services and the various dignitaries that attended the event.

On 07/12/2007, SA and SABT coordinated Bio-Watch assets for daily sampling via the Texas Department of State Health Service (DSHS). In addition, DSHS contacted all communicable Disease Nurses located within hospital and medical center to be vigilant regarding suspicious injuries (radiation/chemical burns, etc). The 6th Civil Support Team (CST) was requested to conducted radiological assessment of all Austin venue locations.

Supporting Motorcades

The current President and several former First Families may attend a private reception at the LBJ Library. They are not expected to attend any of the services in Austin.

• Former First Families will require a marked lead and follow with one uniformed officer in each. It is possible that some First Families will combine their motorcades into a common body routed to the same destination. These dignitaries will likely arrive via private transport to an FBO at ABIA on the morning of Day Two or Three and then depart to ABIA at the conclusion of the reception.

Hearse & Minor Cortege Motorcade

The hearse and cortege requires various movements which should involve Austin Police Motor Units if available, based on time of day, notification advance, and prior assignment:

- From the point of death (or arrival into Austin Metro) to Weed Corley Fish South Congress
- Weed Corley Fish South Congress to Weed Corley Fish North Lamar
- Weed Corley Fish North Lamar to Wildflower Center
- Wildflower Center to LBJ Library


Austin/Travis County EMS will provide one ambulance for the cortege and one ambulance for the Ranch House. The cortege ambulance will depart with the motors after a short break at the State pool (on Ranch Road One). The Ranch Ambulance will stage on the gravel drive adjacent to the residence (closest to the tool shed) beginning at approximately 9:00am on Day Four and depart at the conclusion of the funeral service.

Fleet operations will include one or two fuel vehicles (which will be pre-staged at the State pool on Ranch Road One) and a motorcycle trailer which will follow the cortege at a discreet distance.

APD Aviation shall over fly the route with either a fixed-wing or rotary aircraft.

LBJ Ranch Site Control

The Special Events Supervisor and two motor officers will depart for Ranch Road One by 7:00am to work in conjunction with Gillespie County and DPS to secure Coronet Street & Ranch Road One for the procession and the pool area for motor use.

The motorcade will be lined up for exit and a final briefing will be offered. The package consists of an unmarked APD Lead, hearse, and sixteen to seventeen family sedans. No motor unit may participate in the motorcade who has not participated in APD sponsored escort training. Those motor units showing up who have not been to training may post on the route, but may not join the procession.

Operations

Several agencies will provide marked support cars and motorcycles. The family currently expects approximately sixteen vehicles in the procession in addition to the escort vehicles. The motorcade will depart onto Red River Street Southbound to 11th Street, turn Westbound on 11th to Congress Avenue, and then turn Southbound on Congress Avenue. As the motorcade precedes Southbound down Congress Avenue from the Capitol large crowds lining both sides and extending into a lane of the street are possible. The motorcade will proceed down the centerline to Cesar Chavez and turn Westbound to Mopac/Loop 1. Turning Southbound on Mopac the procession will operate from the center lane to the US Highway 290 exit, at which point we will precede Westbound on Hwy 290. Approximately 35 miles west after joining US Hwy 281 the motorcade will make a sharp left in Johnson City back onto Hwy 290 from Hwy 281. From the time the procession turns onto Hwy 281 we expect crowds to grow. When the motorcade makes the left into Johnson City, expect there to be minimal travel room consisting of a single lane. In Johnson City we will turn left onto Avenue F, right on Ladybird Lane, drive past LBJ's boyhood home, right on Avenue H, and then return to Hwy 290. Approximately 15 miles past Johnson City the motorcade will enter Stonewall Texas and then immediately turn right onto Coronet Street (crossing Ranch Road 1 and into the ranch). The Roadway at the LBJ Ranch is narrow and parking/maneuvering room is extremely limited. Only the APD EPU Vehicle will enter from RR1, with all other APD support vehicles continuing on to the LBJ Pool & Tennis Courts parking lot (posted by an APD Officer) to the immediate right. APD Motor Units may acquire fuel at this location from a COA Mobil Fuel Vehicle. Restrooms will be available. The Johnson family will provide a boxed lunch to everyone present. After a short delay the Motorcade Escort will return to the city in one group. The Motorcade Escort will exit W/B (left) on RR1 approximately ½ mile past the pool & tennis courts and turn left onto Hwy 290.

Congress Avenue

If available, Officers should be utilized to assist with crowd control on Congress Avenue between 11th Street and the Congress Bridge. Intersection control should be off-set one block in each direction. Although there are no plans to use either the Honor Guard or the Pipes and Drums unit (all honors are handled through Military Guard), Congress Avenue provides an ideal placement along the processional route for any agency's Honor Guard.

Speeds, Times, and Traffic Control

The family desires the cortege to move at the speed limit whenever possible. Approximate travel times are:

- Departure 9:00am
 - From Sawyer Ranch Road to 281, 20 minutes at speed limit
 - From 281 to 290 split, 8 minutes at speed limit
 - From 290 split 12 minutes at speed limit

EVENT SUMMARY

Lady Bird Johnson was born December 12, 1912. She will lie in repose for approximately 22 hours in The Great Hall (4th Floor) of the LBJ Library. Several thousand members of the general public are expected to attend the viewing. At the conclusion of the repose there will be a public service in the Riverbend Church (4214 Capital of Texas Highway North, Austin, Texas; Ph. No. 327-3540). Lady Bird will be buried in the Johnson Family Cemetery on the LBJ Ranch.

Schedule

The *Final Tribute* schedule assumes a **four-day program**. The start date will be four days prior to the desired end date. Therefore, this does not assume that Mrs. Johnson will be interred four days from her death. Events such as UT home football games, Graduation, and national holidays could delay the start of Day One. Once the official clock starts, it will continue for four consecutive days. It is possible that approximately seven to eight days could pass between the actual notification of death and the service at the Johnson Ranch.

Day Zero - Day One:

- Notification of Lady Bird Johnson's death.
- The Thomson Conference Center parking lot (lot 40) should be immediately closed. A commissioned officer should be posted at the entrance 24 hours a day until approximately 9:00 a.m. on Day Four when the ceremonial cortege departs LBJ Library for the Johnson Family Cemetery. The lot will be reserved for law enforcement, EMS and AFD equipment and vehicles participating in the Final Tribute.

- The <u>LBJ Wildflower Center will only close the morning of the LBJ Family Service on Day Two</u>. [Condolence books will be available for signing by the Public during normal business hours.]
- LBJ Guards will be posted at the entrance (3rd Floor Lobby) to provide information and inform visitors to the library during normal business hours that it is closed.
- Media will begin to arrive at LBJ Library for live shots and initially media satellite trucks will be allowed to park in lot 39.) Media credentialing will be in Sid Richardson Hall, rooms 3.101 and/or 3.101. Media parking is in lot 37. (The lot is to be reserved by P&T.)
- Lot 38 will be reserved for LBJ Family, LBJ Library Staff and ADA parking.
- Only the LBJ Library construction project will be stopped.
- APD and other law enforcement agencies will handle police escorts.

Day Two:

- A private ceremony will be held at the Wildflower Center (WFC) for the LBJ Family and Wildflower Center staff from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.
- Media is expected to arrive at 4:00 a.m. at the LBJ Wildflower Center.
- The Media pool sets up equipment to cover service from 6:30 a.m. to 8:15 a.m.
- 6:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. (Departure of Ceremonial Cortege). One UTPD supervisor and four officers will provide security at the site. Two officers will be stationed at the entrance to the WFC parking lot. One officer with a marked police unit will be stationed on La Crosse just east of Snapdragon Drive to allow only authorized persons past that point. One officer will patrol the grounds of the WFC and provide a uniform presence.
- USSS, WFC staff and volunteers will arrive at approximately 7:00 a.m.
- The ceremonial cortege (police escort and hearse) will arrive at approximately 9:45 a.m.
- The private services will start at approximately 10:00 a.m. and end at 11:00 a.m.
- The ceremonial cortege will leave at approximately 12:00 p.m. enroute to the LBJ Library. APD will provide the police escort.

One officer and LBJ guards will stationed inside the LBJ Library to help monitor the line leading to the Great Hall. One officer will be stationed on the LBJ Plaza to monitor the crowd. Two officers will be stationed in lots 38 and 39 to monitor the area. The officers will work approximately four to eight hour shifts during the duration of the viewing. At any point (late evening and over night) if the crowd diminishes in numbers, the on-site supervisor may release officers at his/her discretion.



- One uniformed UTPD officer will be stationed at the LBJ Library with USSS until the casket is taken to the LBJ Family Cemetery on Day Four. (4:00 pm. 9:00 a.m. of Day Four)

- APD and other law enforcement will handle the police escort.


