

Miss DISTRICH was intervisued at her suite in the Plaza by the reporting agent at which time she turned over the note in question. She advised that upon her arrival from the coast she had stayed at the St. Hegis Hotel, 5th Avenue and 55th Street, until March 6, 1948 when she moved to The Plaza. Her sejourn at the St. Regis, to which the note was cent, was publicised in the syndicated gossip columns. Miss DISTRICH advised that in addition to the threatening letter she was in receipt of two Mestern Union telegrams which might be connected with the extortion note.

These communications, ie, the original threatening letter, accompanying envelopes and the two telegrams, are described below. It is noted that they were all forwarded for appropriate examination to the PEI Laboratory by the New York Office letter of March 30, 1948.

1) Western Union telegram dated March 11, 1948 at 4:26 PM sent from West Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada, extra collect, via Hollywood, California, addressed to Miss DIETRICH, care of Famous Artists Corporation, her agents, 810 5th Avanue, New York City. It was signed and reads:

*POSSIBLY MY RECENT COMMUNICATION DID NOT REACH YOUR EARDS AND HAVE TODAY TRANSMITTED ANOTHER MORE COMPREHENSIVE BY AIR MAIL SPECIAL DELIVERY . AND MARKED COMPIDENTIAL AND BERSONAL STOP REASONABLY IMPORTANT.

2) Resters Union telegrem dated March 18, 1948, also sent from West Vancouver, British Columbia via Beverly Hills, California, addressed to Miss DIFFRICH at Hotel St. Rogis. This wire is also signed and reads:

"MY TYPERENTER IS IDLE STILLED BY TOUR PARSISTENT SILENCE STOP BEY MUST YOU LET ADOLPH SUFFER STOP HE COULD BE VERY PROUD OF YOU."

to Miss DIMTRIGH at the St. Regis Hotel and signed "Guess, Marleme, Guess". This letter was enclosed in an envelope postmarked at Vancouver, British Solumbia, Ganada at 10 PM on March 21, 1948 and restamped on the back at Mew York, New York on March 24, 1948 at 1:50 PM. It bears a Grand Centre Station flag. The address is hand printed in rough fashion in ink to Miss DIMTRICE at St. Regis Rotel, New York City, and her name is misspelled as "Miss MARLEY DRIVEIGH", contrary to the correct spelling of the victim's mane set forth in the letter itself and the wires. It is noted that the letter is suplete with femilianguage, contains a threat to Miss DIMTRICE's life and its auther makes references to earlier communications which Miss DIMTRICE advised had never actually reached her personally.

Because of the foul and caustic nature of the note, the Pareau and photographic copies are being maitained in the case file of this office.

Miss DINTRICH stated that when she received the letter on Nedmesday, March 24, 1948, she disregarded it at first as the work of a creak or a psychopath. However, after discussing it with her husband and friends, she began to think there might be senething to it because it is eleverly written. She became somewhead and determined to advise the Sureau.

The above telegrams were initially also discounted by her as probably sent by seas writer who had forwarded her a menuscript to he read. However, when she noted they also were from Venecuver, British Columbia, she thought they might have been sent by the author of the threatening letter. It is to be noted that the letter gave Miss DINTRICE up to noon on Thursday, March 25, 1948, to make her shoice either to assist the writer or die. Ho return address or place to which she was to sommunicate was set forth.

B. C., knows mobody there, and the name means mothing at all to her. She reiterated that she knows nothing about any prior correspondence referred to in the above communications although she declared letters may have been sent to her in Hollywood and not fermerded on to New York. Mothing in the letter or telegrams gives her any idea as to what the author is driving at or who he is.

It was ascertained that mail from personal friends is usually sent to her wherever she is staying as they know her whereabouts. In Hollywood, she would get personal mail at the Shoreham Apartments, Shoreham Drive. All other mail such as fan letters are usually sent to her more? addressed Marisme Districh, Bollymood or U. S. As. or at Parament Studios. The latter mail is all handled by Dressing Department, Paramount Studies, bollywood. mail, selects enything that might appeal to Riss DIETRICH or snything extraordinary and forwards it to Miss DIETRICE. To date, nothing that might pertain to the above communications has been sent on. Miss DIETRICE declared that her daily mail aspally numbers 1,000 letters. She stated that she had to examine all mail in her possession, extract all letters from Vancouver, British Columbia, and send them to her. She advised that at present her picture, "Golden Earrings", is being shown in the U. S. A. and Canada. She has never been in the latter country.

Miss DIETRICH declared that instant letter has been handled by herself; by Mr. Exice MARIA REMARQUE, the writer who lives at the Ambassador A the writer, She stated that she has been fingerprinted seveval times in expection with her hours with the U. S. Armed Forces and that she know all the feregoing have been fingerprinted in connection with their

She advised that although during her career she has received many visious letters from psychopaths and crambs this is the first that

The Laboratory was requested to examine enclosed letter for latent fingerprints using the fingerprints of the above, if such were available in the Identification Division, for elimination purposes. It was also requested that the headprinting on enclosed envelope and the typing on the threatening letter be searched through the Anonymous Better Pile for possi-

Because of the length of these communications and the rambling nature of them, they will not be set forth barein. It is noted that the letter of February II, 1948 is an incoherent note and the letter of March 10, 1948 is extrapely lengthy in which the author says he has the power to prevent the Third World Mar and requests \$100,000.00 from Miss DIETRICE to be used by him in writing a book.

By report of April 6, 1948 the FBI laboratory advised that mothing of significance was noted in the comparison with the Anonymous Letter File of the letter obtained from Miss BIETRIEM by the reporting agent and those, set forth above, which were forwarded by los Angeles to the Laboratory on March 51, 1948. By letter of April 15, 1948 the Laboratory reported that the latent fingerprint examination was negative.

On April 3, 1948 the Scattle Division advised by teletype that investigation at most Vancouver, British Columbia had revealed that the writer of the above notes to Miss DIRYRICH was one


Details of the investigation at Vancouver are set forth in 570 referenced report of Special Agent (1988) dated April 29, 1948 at Seattle, deahington.

The fasts of this case were discussed with Assistant United States Attorney ANEDED L. LAURITARD of the Southern Listrict of New York on April 2, 1948. On arms. sation of the letter received by Miss DIRTRICH on March 24, 1945, Mr. LAURITAND was of the opinion that this letter was written by a psychopath and that he should be located, if possible, and warned about sending such communications through the mails. He declared he would not reader any final opinion until he had an opportunity to read the letters obtained by the Los Angeles Office from and was advised at to the results of the inquiry at Vancouver, British Columbia.

Mr. LAURITAND declared that a review of the treaty between Canada and the United States would be necessary to determine whether this was an extraditable offense.

On April 5, 1948 the Los Augeles letters and results of the invertigation at Vancouver were furnished to Mr. LAURITANO at which time he declined prosecution because of the montal state of the subject.





Deference is made to the telegram from this office to the Division yesterday, advising that the newspaper publicity of yesterday to the effect that Miss Solleen Moore and Miss Marlans Dietrich, motion y picture stars, had received kidnaping threats many me thout foundation.


This matter was noticed in the Los Angeles Examiner yesterday morning, which carried a story on the front page, intimating that the above named stars had received kidneying threats

Acting agent in Charge Sackett contacted Miss College Moore, who stated that she had not received any letters of any kind containing any threats whatever; that during the past several weeks she did receive several anonymous telephone calls, warning her to keep a doll house, which she is building for the benefit of charity by exhibiting same which she is building for the benefit of charity by exhibiting same throughout the country, off the streets. However, according to Miss throughout the country, off the streets. However, according to Miss Moore, the unknown male person telephoning did not demand any money, nor did he threaten Miss Moore in any manner. Miss Moore is not in the least apprehensive and has for sometime amployed armed guards. Ene agreed to immediately notify this office should she receive any threats which would come within jurisdiction of this Division. This matter was explained to Miss Moore in detail.

Captain McColeb of the West Los Angeles Police Department had already contacted Miss Marlene District, who resides in Mest Los Angeles, and she informed the Captain that she did not receive any letters mattered ever of a threatening nature, nor did she receive any telephone calls, and that the newspaper publicity to the effect that she was threatened is absolutely without foundation. Miss District was furnished with the Los Angeles Division Office address and telephone number and agreed to notify this office, as well as Captain McColet in the event she receives any threatening letters or any other threats. It was also determined

Director. that Miss Districh has, for the past year, been employing five armed goards at her home so that she is constantly under protection, but this action was not due to any specific threats she received, but was morely as a precautionaly measure.

The newspaper publicity is, herefore, without any foundation and Acting Agent in Charge Sackett has determined that the same resulted when Miss Colleen Moore confidentiall, informed one of the reporters for the Los Engeles Examiner that she had received telephone calls with respect to her doll house, and that Miss Dietrich was renteing her, Miss Moore's place in Los Angeles and that she may have possibly received the same kind of telephone calls. The reporter thereupon wrote the story which appeared in the press which, of course, is without foundation. The above is being submitted for your information. Very truly yours,




