KIRKMAN BEY, Assistant Cread Shiek is one BEY who also has ministerial papers from Colonel KIRKMAN BEY. Chairman of the TEPPLE is one BEY. Treasurer is Sister BEY; and Secretary is Sister BEY. It was learned that the ro are 43 active members in TEMPLE 48.

BEY related that mostings are held every Friday and Sunday evenings and are open to the public. He referred to the fact that the TEMPLE is a religious organization duly incorporated in the state of New Jersey.

Agent noted that the TEMPE room, as shown to him, had a seating capacity for about one hundred persons. At the front of the room there was a chair decorated with crepe paper of various colors. BEY said that this is the vacant chair for the Prepatupon his return. This profit is MOBEL DREW ALI who, according to the Koran, will return to the earth. This vacant chair is in the middle of the group of four or five chairs set up for the grand shiek and other officers. On one side of the table, in front of the chairs, is a red silk flag. BEY explained that his duties as Director of Industrial Activities include management of properties acquired by the organization in the State. The first floor of this building houses the restaurant referred so and behind this is the general meeting room and lounge for the roomers who are tenants of living quarters on the third and part of the second floors. Nost of the second floor is given over to the TEMPLE.

TEMPLES 48 and 10, according to BEY, are presently purchasing a farm near Moorestown, N. J.

According to BEY, the organization does not pay any money in salaries, money collected being used for the upkeep of the TEPPIE.

BEY stated that his own living was made through the restaurant.

BEY further related that the teachings of the organization are based upon the Koran. He said that they teach that the negroes are not

black but are orientals. He offered the statement that no teachings are mide to the effect that the Japanese are any closer to the negro than any other Oriental.

All members are duly registered for Selective Service and many members were alleged to be presently serving. BEY stated that their work was aimed at hattoring the conditions for the nagro generally. He exhibited his own Selective Service card which showed ho was presently abassified in 3-4. He stated he was born in and reserved an eight-crode adjustion. 

On Fonday, April 19, 1943 BEY, referred to above in this report, phoned the Tronton resident agency. He said he wanted to make a complaint concorning one to whom he had given authority to operate a

branch TEIPLE at 100 Union Street, South Trenton, provided she turned over all dues collected. This she had not done and he advised that recently he had been refused permission by her to inspect her books and told to leave the place. He wanted to know if it was possible for the F.B.I. to obtain the records of the disobedient TEMPLE to check over the receipus to report them to the national body. Unsuccessful in this, BEY stated he would try to handle his difficulties through administrative pressure because he did not desire any publicity that might result from a court action.

"In my duties as jamitor I seesplup around the various machines including the "sander" and "under nose cutter" on the SEAR assembly line—There are usually various seeps lying on the floor around these and other nearby exchines when I sweep up—It is really the duty of the operators of those machines to pick them up and not to put so much of the responsibility on us because I have lets of jobs to do said things to think about—Cocasionally case—hardened sears fall on the floor around these exchines

from nearby machines and are kicked around somewhat. Then I find any pieces on the floor I pick them up and put them on one of the nearby machines, or in trays of sears in operation at the sachines or in a box of discarded sears. Three or four weeks ago during a rushed period, on four times that I know of, I picked hardened sears off the floor which pieces probably came from the nearby grinding machine, and put these hardened pieces or sears on top of soft or unhardened pieces at the sander or under nose cutter in trays which were in process of operation. I figured that the operator of the machines would find them, though I realized that the nardened pieces would ruin the cutter if they reached it. I had so intention of slowing up production nor did I want to get even with any of the operators.

For instance, we weren't given jobs during the depression while after good times we are the first to be fired when things slack off. I resent this segregation and discrimination.

"I want the United States to win the far but only on condition that lynching and segregation are done away with and my people are given an equal status. I don't think the United States is a true democracy as long as lynching rocs on. The whole basis of the war is the discrimination between the white and colored races. The Bureaucrats in ashington should know about it. It rould be better for our people for Japan to win though I don't say Japan will win. By our people I mean the people of my race. I have arrived at these views from my own thinking, by way of further explanation I wish to add that I respect the v.S. flag but don't like the way things are gone.



According to information extracted from the Holy Koran of the Moorish Holy Temple of Science as prepared by the Noble Prophet DREW ALI, the history of the organization is as follows:

The Moors are purportedly descendants of the ancient Moabites who were the founders of the Holy City of Mecca. However, the Egyptians, who were the Hamathites and direct descendents of the Mizrians, the Arabians, who were the seed of Hagar, the Japanese and Chinese, as well as the Hindus of India, who word related to the ancient Canaanites, the Hamathites and Moabites of the Asiatic nations and countries in North, South and Central America, are all Moslems. The inhabitants of Africa are descendants of the ancient Canaanites. The migration was started by one CUSH and his families who were the first inhabitants of Africa and who came from Cana. His father, HAM, and his family followed CUSH, and it was after they had settled there that the word Ethiopia, which means the demarcation line of the Dominion of Amexem, and the first true and divine name of Africa, came into being. CUSH and his father divided Africa, between them and ruled there jointly until many years later they were joined by their brethren from Asia and the Holy Lands. The Moabites, whom it was formerly pointed out, were the forefathers of the licors, had received pormission from the Pharoahs of Egypt to settle and inhabit Northwest Africa, and these people, along with the Canaanites, the Hamthites and Amorites, joined CUSH and his father In Africa and founded the present Moroccan Empire. Their dominion and inhabitation purportedly extended from Africa across the Great Atlantic to the present North, South and Central Americas. Subsequent to this inhabitation, a great earthquake came and caused the Atlantic Ocean and, therefore, aparated ? the land of CUSH and his father from the American continents where the Moslem settlors had migrated. As a consequence, the Moors were the aborigines of the Americas. The explanation of why these people are no longer called Moors is her imicated as being that through sin and disobedience to the creeds and principles of their forefathers, the nationality of the Moors and their names were takenfrom them in 1774 and the words negro, black and colored were given to them, the true Asiatics of America.

BEY, a mumber of subject Temple #11, was contacted and interviewed relative to the principles of his Temple and, at the time of the interview, gave his understanding of the history of the Moorish Americans as. BEY stated that the Moors believed that Allah, God of ... set out above. the Universe, created a government of the world and that Allah gave his laws to Mohammed, which laws were meant for the entire human family. In order to put these laws into effect, Mohammed founded the Nation of Islam. BEY then advised that all the prophets of God brought their books on earth for the human race, and, according to the belief of the Moors, Jesus Christ, one of these prophets, brought the Bible which was the Holy Writ and contained laws for the entire human family. He stated, however, the Bible was changed through the years and changed so drastically that the Holy Writ was, in fact, done away with inasmuch as these changes were made to meet the peoples' need instead of the people's changing to meet the conditions of the Holy Writ. The Bible today no longer represents the Holy Writ because it has been so changed by generation after 1978 generation to meet their needs that the people have slipped back into the idolatry that they had lived in before the coming of the Holy Writ. As a result of this, Allah, therefore, sent another prophet of the modern age, Noble Prophet DREW ALL, who brought a new book, another Holy Writ, the Koran, upon which he was to set up new government and bring the people back from their cvil ways into a life of love truth, peace, freedom and justice. According to BEY, DREW ALI was to accomplish this task by uniting the people and bringing them back to their true religion. Islam. He stated that in ancient times, the Mosbites, descendants of MOAB, were given permission by the Pharoah of Egypt, who, he stated, was then living in America, to settle Northwest Africa, the modern Africa of today. In 👫 consequence, about 10,000 years ago, these Moabites migrated to Africa and set up a government there.

BEY further stated that America was originally the real Africa, the land of CUSH and his father, HAM, and still is. However, when the whites arrived on the shores of North America about 600 years ago, Columbus was the first man here, and when he found the negroes, who were the true Moors and dark in skin, Columbus, believing he had sailed to India, called thom Indians, BEY stated, these people were descendants of the ancient whon, in fact Moabites and were even then practicing the religion of Islam. that the colored people are called negroes today because the white man named them after the Niger River which can be found today in Africa and from which region numerous white expeditions brought the Moors to this country in slavery. He then said that the whites went to war with the Moabites, the Indians, and took the land from them and these too were captured and sold into slavery and, although they were Moors with names of their nationality, they were eventually given the names of their masters. EY then advised that, according to their belief, that is the reason why the colored people of today do not use the Loorish names, and because of the fact that the white man forced his Bible, the Holy Writ brought? to earth by the prophet Jesus, upon them, the Moors do not realize their true nationality. BEY stated that although the negroes were set free eighty years ago, it was but a shackled freedom because these men still have the white

men's names and, as yet, no one has given them back their true names; therefore, they are still subjects of the white conquerors.

During the interview, BEY remarked that if the President of the United States does not give the colored people more freedom than they presently have, he is as wrong as the others, meaning Hitler and Tojo whose names were used in connection with the questioning. BEY further stated that all individuals should be equal and that no one group should have rights in the government that are denied to others. He said that the colored people are not being treated fairly today and that the majority of negroes are not getting the same opportunities as the whites, particularly in jobs.

As far as Selective Service matters are concerned stated that the Moabites had control of the government here in America when the whites came and, inasmuch as this was their country, they are willing to protect it against all evils but are not willing to fight across the sea because they do not live there and do not get their existence there. He said that the belief of their religion is that the Moors have to go to war because they are particles this country and must protect this land even though they are not given the rights of citizens and even though this means fighting in foreign lands. He said that although the negro is not considered a citizen by the whites today, the whites will have to recognize this fact in the future. He advised that this will come about through the fact that although the Moors do not believe in enforcing their rights on government, they must live, and by living a good life, the A. whites will take an example from them and grant them the privilages which are BEY stated that until that day there will be no peace in the world, and that there will be no peace until love, truth, freedom, justice and peace are universally taught and then, and only then, when the leaders realized that these virtues are necessary will peace come to the world.

BEY, Grand Shick of subject Temple #11, was interviewed, at which time he gave a history of his Temple in Philadelphia which was verified through investigation. He stated that the Moorish Science Temple was EL, who was the organized in 1928 at 817 S. Broad Street by representative of the Noble Prophet DREW ALL, and who established the Temple on the authority of that Prophet. He stated that after the Temple was organized, he was made Grand Shick and was acting as Grand Shick in 1929 at which time the Tomple was closed because of several misunderstandings with the police, These misunderstanding, it was determined, arose over local violations, principally number selling. He stated that the Temple was reopened again in 1931 at 17th and South Streets and that subsequent to that the Temple was moved in 1932 and again in 1940 to its present location at 18th and Christian Structs. stated that there are three other Temples in Philadelphia which claim to be Moorish Holy Temples of Science and which claim #11 because #11 was the original BEY's Temple, when At. number given by the Noble Prophet DREW ALL to his, was first established in 1928. It should be noted that the Temples referred to BEY are Temples #11, #33 and #40, which are under the leadership of

was disbanded in 1929, numerous members drifted away after the trouble with the police and established their own Temples. The names of the leaders of these other Temples were familiar to BEY as being the names of those who had drifted away from his Temple. He stated, however, that Temple #11 at 18th and Christian Streets is the only one in Philadelphia which is under the leadership of the Noble Prophet DREW ALI and that all other Temples are under the leadership of C. KIRKMAN BEY.

BEY stated that EL, who has offices at This coup of Moorish Science Temples of which he is a member. He said that EL is the reincarnation of the Noble Prophet DREW ALI and that, as a consequence, they look to him for leadership.

BEY advised that his Temple has no connection with the Moorish National Home in Virginia or the Moorish Farms in New Haven and Hartford, Conn. He said that at the present time his Temple has no Moorish industrial group although at one time it did exist with EL as the leader. EL still has his original store at 1926 South Street, and there has engraved on the windows thereof "M.I.G." which stands for the Moorish Industrial Group.

stores operated by Moors in this city, they are not operated as a cooperative venture but are owned and operated by members and all profits as a result of business transactions go to the individual members only. He stated that these stores are petronized by the Moors and by people who have no connection with the Moorish Temple and stated that it would be financially impossible for these stores to continue in operation without the patronage of peoples other than Moors.

There are seven stores in all in Philadelphia which are operated by the group which consist of a fish market at 1926 South Street owned and operated by EL, which was mentioned above; a grocery store at 1919 South Street EL; a grocery store at 2006 South Street EL; a restaurant at 2004 South Street BEI; a women's dress shop at 1913 South Street a tallor shep at 1735 Webster street; and a bakery on 21st Street near South. There is another tailor shop which was originally located at 26th and Annin Streets but has recently moved to 2901 Alter Street and, from all appearances. It is preparing to go out of business. This shop is owned and operated by BEY.

BEY further advised that members of his groups are for bidden to shave. They must wear a red fez, are not permitted to indulge in intercents or tobacco, do not use powder or rouge, straighten their har or wear short dresses, do not eat meat, are not permitted to frequent taprooms or motion picture and, in general, do not amalgamate with the outside world.

Phila, 100-15442 From the above, it is apparent that the practices of the Tomples under the leadership of C. KIRKMAN BEY are not indulged in by the members of subject Temple. The information set out above has all been verified through invostigation. The books of Temple #11, as well as considerable literature concerning its operations, and personal papers were thoroughly scrutinized and nothing of an un-American nature was discovered. Their books of account were examined and it was determined that the majority of members are behind in their dues and that the amounts actually brought in barely cover the rental of the Temple premises, sick benefits and other expenses.
