Informants advise the farm is not self sufficient and that most of the men work in outside industry. Little activity reported there. One male member is registered for Selective Service at Putnam, Conn. and his description is set forth herein. No reported subversive acts either at Hartford or Woodstock, Conn. 100 acres and the second tract consists of 67 acres making a total acreage of 167 acres. This deed is recorded in Volume 47, Page 118 of the Woodstock, Conn. land records. The Revenue Stamps on the deed indicate that between \$6500.00 and \$7000 was the cost paid for the farm. On this same day, to wit, 2/11/41, a mortgage was executed in favor of HELEN CLARKE in the amount of \$6750.00. This mortgage was duly executed for the Moorish Science Temple by LELIA REEDY BEY, vice-president of the Moorish Science Temple. The mortgage principal was payable semi-annually in \$180.00 installments and the mortgage remains unreleased of record. The mortgage itself is recorded in the Woodstock, Conn. land records, Volume 47, Page 119.

The Woodstock tax assessment records show the farm to be assessed for taxation purposes as follows:-

The farm is located approximately two and one-half miles from the township of Woodstock, Conn. and the mailing address is R.F.D. #2 out of Putnam, Conn.

[REDACTED] that besides the above individuals who stay at the farm there are also others, including a man known as [REDACTED] EL and his wife, and a [REDACTED] BEY. There are also numerous children, both grown and infant. [REDACTED] that at the time legal transaction for the farm was closed that a large prepossessing Negro man, wearing large diamond rings and tie pin and rather flashily dressed, appeared at the clerk's office in company with [REDACTED] BEY, and [REDACTED] upon being asked if the man's name was [REDACTED] EL, said that she thought that it probably was.

b7c [REDACTED] that there was little activity on the farm as far as she knew and little farming. The farm at the present time, she stated, had a few small family garden plots but that they did not tend them well and were not raising anything on a large scale that she knew of. She said that according to information gathered by her most of the male members of the organization did not work at farming but worked away in industry in various towns comparatively nearby.

[REDACTED] that originally, i.e., back in 1941, the Moorish Science Temple farm leaders wanted to be tax exempted on the ground that it was a religious organization but that the assessors on the tax board had refused this claim because there was no evidence of any kind to support the contention that the farm and its buildings were used for religious purposes or as a church.

However, no appeal was filed from this decision and the persons residing on the farm have caused no trouble of any kind in or around Woodstock to her knowledge and also she knew of no activity on their part which could be deemed subversive in any respect.

[REDACTED] of the Woodstock Conn. Ration Board was interviewed concerning the activities of the various Moorish Science Temple farm residents and she stated that [REDACTED] BEY was the so-called head priest and on one occasion he had applied for extra gas in order to drive from the farm to Hartford, Conn. to attend meetings. [REDACTED] that the ration board refused this request because it was quite obvious that the applicants were Negroes and not Moors. On one occasion COUNTRYMAN showed her a very elaborate certificate which stated that he was

the head priest or sheik of the Moorish Science Temple there. [REDACTED] that she knew of no activity on the part of the Negro residents of this town which might be deemed subversive or un-American. She did state that [REDACTED] BEY did not work on the farm but worked in [REDACTED] Conn. for the [REDACTED]

Following the above interviews the reporting agent drove to the vicinity of the farm in question and observed first hand that the farm was being allowed to become run down and was not being fully cultivated. There were a few family gardens but these were in want of attention. The premises appeared unkempt and dirty and approximately five or six adult colored men and women were observed in and about the house and out buildings and also there were several small colored children playing in the yard. The farm itself is off of the main highway on a dirt road but access to it is easily obtained.

At Putnam, Conn.

b7c [REDACTED] of Local Board [REDACTED] Putnam, Conn. was contacted. A check of the Selective Service files of this board showed that there were only some 25 or 26 male Negroes registered with the board all together. All of these names were checked and only one known member of the Moorish Science Temple was registered there.

[REDACTED] BEY registered for Selective Service on [REDACTED] and received Order [REDACTED] At the time of his registration [REDACTED] gave as the person knowing his address as [REDACTED] BEY, [REDACTED] The registrant's classification is One AH. His employment was given as buyer of scrap iron for the [REDACTED] He also stated that he resided on the Moorish American State Farm or the Old Peoples Home for Colored People at Woodstock, Conn. He reported his wife's name as [REDACTED] and further stated they were married in [REDACTED]

b7c [redacted] of Local Board 2, Pittsburgh, Pa. advised that the records of that local board reflect that [redacted] BEY whose true name is [redacted] had been discharged from the United States Army on [redacted] 1944. His Army Serial No. was [redacted] BEY gave his address at the Local Board as [redacted] and [redacted] Pittsburgh.

He advised the local board on July 21, 1944, that he was not employed at that time, and that he did not desire that the local board or its reemployment committee should attempt to obtain work for him.

The records of the local board reflected that he had left the U.S. Army Service from the station hospital at Camp Patrick Henry, Virginia, with an honorable discharge reflecting that he was of good character. At the time of his discharge he made no claim for a pension. The records further reflected that he was discharged for "psychosis, unclassified, hysterical and grandiose paranoid features."

b2 → [redacted] advised that W. WILLIAMS BEY had adhered strictly to the doctrine of the subject organization while he was in the United States Army stationed at Camp Planche, New Orleans, La. He had refused to use his legal name, insisting upon using his Moslem name on all occasions. He refused to be known as a negro claiming that he was a Moor. He further refused to shave, cut his hair, or eat meat, thus necessitating the preparation of individual meals for him or of being allowed special permission to eat in the Camp diner.

The above meeting was attended by [redacted] Bridgeport, Conn. [redacted] and his report of that meeting includes the following quotations:-

" Following is a list of the speakers on the program.

[redacted] Bey [redacted] of the Bridgeport Moorish Temple Chairman (name unknown). This man is from New Haven, Conn. [redacted] Bey. [redacted] of the Moorish Temple in New Haven, Conn. [redacted] of the Church [redacted] Grand Sheikh [redacted] El. [redacted] of the New York and New England Area of the Moorish Movement.

From 4:00 to 5:00 P.M., religious services were conducted by [redacted] of the church and after the services were over, he spoke a few words of welcome to the gathering. [redacted] Bey., then introduced the chairman of the meeting (name unknown) and after a few introductory remarks by the chairman, he introduced [redacted]

b7c [REDACTED] spoke on the value of racial up-lift and stressed the good that the Grand Sheik was doing in bringing such knowledge of the Moorish teachings to them and that they no longer have to think of themselves as being people unrespected by other races because they have no flag. He pointed out that they no longer had to consider themselves as Colored Americans or Negro Americans, but rather as Moorish Americans because according to dictionary, the word 'Colored' means dye, tinted, painted, or dipped, and the word 'Negro' was a slave word, which had no meaning. He also expressed the economic value, inasmuch as the status of the people will change after the war. He pointed out that it would be best for the Moorish Americans to prepare themselves for the change now and expressed his gratefulness for the new mythical teachings of the Grand Sheik. He deplored conditions of the people, who have not been aroused by this emergency (meaning that Colored people should take advantage of present world conditions).

b7c The next speaker was Grand Sheik [REDACTED] El. His opening remarks were in honor of Allah and the people of Islaum. He then described the Moorish movement as the one which teaches the people not to hate. He indicated that he has been educated in Africa. He explained that there was no such people as Negroes or Colored people but rather that they should be known as Moorish Americans, regardless from what part of the globe they originated from. He went on to state that most people are under the impression that the Negro never had a flag and that this was a slave teaching handed down to them because in reality the Moorish flag, which he displayed, (a flag with a light green background with a large red star in the center) was the oldest known flag to civilization and that the African people are the founders or the mother of all civilization. He explained that the Moorish movement was entirely patriotic.

Turner went on to state that he was named after Frederick Douglas, the great Negro liberator, who told Abraham Lincoln; 'If you do not let these people go, there would rise from among them their own leaders, who will free them.' Turner went on to explain that the Negro people in America are still slaves according to the Dred-Scott decision, because they are still being lynched in America. He explained that the Negro is being discriminated against in the Armed Forces. "

- He referred to George Washington, the Father of this Country, as a pale face, whom he could not love, because he owned 350 slaves and had 14 illegitimate children by women held in slavery.

[redacted] mentioned that he has been questioned by Mr. J. Edgar Hoover, of the F.B.I. in Washington, D.C., in 1940, and that he was asked by Mr. Hoover if he was Pro-Nazi, Pro-Facist, or pro-American, and he claims that his answer to Mr. Hoover was that his people (Moorish) were just simply provoked. [redacted] also stated that he has written authority from Congress, which stipulates that no Moorish movement would be discriminated against. [redacted] also intimated that he has spoken to President Roosevelt as a representative of the people (all Colored people).

The speaker criticized the N.A.A.C.P.

Women of the Moorish movement wear a green turban while attending the meeting and the men wear a red turban. The Grand Sheik, however, wears a green turban.

Forty people were in the audience, two persons expressed their desire, after the meeting, to join the Moorish Movement. ■

[redacted] reported as the oldest Negro in this vicinity, is said to know every Negro in this county by his first name. Approximately three years ago, [redacted] BEY approached him with the idea of joining the instant organization but upon the refusal of BEY to explain the complete background and aims of the organization [redacted] was not interested.

He did state that he and BEY became involved in a serious argument due to the mysteries of the organization and since that time he has been on unfriendly terms with the leader of this organization.

[redacted] went on to add that the members were entirely composed of the immediate family of [redacted] BEY and that the other Negroes in this vicinity after the bombing of Pearl Harbor, showed very little interest, in fact, they made fun of the organization and its members.

[redacted] that the organization members, prior to the bombing of Pearl Harbor, had made any pro-Japanese statements but since December 7, 1941 he had not discussed the Japanese nor could they be drawn into conversation regarding their attitudes concerning the Japanese since that date.

This informant added that he personally is of the opinion that the local chapter members are entirely too ignorant to be regarded in any manner as a danger to the security of this country.

[redacted] that he owns the property occupied by [redacted] BEY, the son of [redacted] BEY and has rented to him for several years.

According to this informant, in the early part of June, 1944, the local chapter was host to a tri-state representation of this organization, at which time a meeting was held from Friday through Monday and was attended by an excess of 100 persons. Inasmuch as he is the owner of the property and his home adjoins it, on Sunday afternoon he went over to the meeting, fearing that heavy drinking might have been taking place and fighting which would result in deterioration of the property.

[redacted] that the meeting was in orderly progress when he got there but that most of them were either pitching horseshoes, playing pool or sitting around having a good time.

This informant did not notice any flags, decorations or anything that would indicate the activity or thought of the members but did add that the truck used by this organization for transportation of its members and on the day of his visit the flag of the Moorish Science Temple draped along its side.

[redacted] that he questioned [redacted] concerning this flag and was advised that it was the flag of the organization.

[redacted] is of the opinion that the organization has made no growth since the bombing of Pearl Harbor inasmuch as the membership is composed only of the immediate family of [redacted] and that other Negroes look down on them and scoff at their antics and beliefs.

[redacted] reports personal knowledge of the members of the instant organization and knows personally the leader [redacted] according to [redacted] is now taking over the leadership of the father and is the dominant figure in the convention held here in June of this year. This informant feels that [redacted] is the smartest one in the family inasmuch as he has traveled considerably about the country and has taken on a little more polish than the other members. He stated that at one time [redacted] was the leader of this organization in Indianapolis but had returned here approximately one year ago and is now working fulltime on the farm.

[redacted] that one of the sons of [redacted] by the name of [redacted] was discharged from military service during the past year and is working around home. He feels this is a medical discharge but claims there is nothing from an outside appearance to substantiate his belief.

[redacted] that during the past summer, one of the children of this family died and that the organization put on a large funeral, at which time the members were all dressed up in the regular cottony used for ceremonial purposes and that members of the Indianapolis chapter were in evidence at the funeral.

This informant claims that the other Negroes in this area laugh at the members and that in his opinion they cannot be regarded as dangerous due to their lack of serious attitudes and behavior.

The Criminal Division of the Department, after reviewing these reports, recently corresponded with the Bureau and advised that the facts developed to date did not warrant prosecution under the Sedition Statutes and that further investigation of this case was not warranted at the present time. It was requested, however, that the Bureau make available to the Criminal Division any additional information that might come to the Bureau's attention, indicating further activities of a questionable nature by the individuals connected with this organization.

In view of this expression of opinion, it is desired that the investigation in this matter be discontinued by your office and the offices receiving copies of this letter. Your office and the auxiliary offices should, however, remain alert for any indication that the individuals associated with the "Moorish Science Temple of America, Inc.", are continuing to engage in activities that may come within the purview of the Sedition Statutes. Upon receipt of information in this connection the Bureau should be appropriately advised in order that the information secured may be made available to the Criminal Division in accordance with its request.

It will be noted that the address of 1406 Laurens Street is a grocery store operated by instant Moorish Science Temple according to a colored employee in the store, and she stated that [REDACTED] BEY, [REDACTED] was the manager of instant store and that he was downtown at that time, and would not be available until the late evening. She was questioned concerning who maintained the records of instant organization inasmuch as it was desired by the writer and instant police officers to determine if the above mentioned Selective Service violator was a member of that organization, it being known that she was not given the name of this individual. She informed that if the writer and the police officers would return later in the afternoon that [REDACTED] BEY who has custody of instant records could furnish such information. It was thought that this possibly was a good manner in which to obtain the list of the members of this organization by talking to instant [REDACTED] BEY, leading him to believe that it is possible that [REDACTED] EL is a member of that organization and that it is desired to secure a list of his members in order to check them to make certain that instant [REDACTED] EL is not a member of his organization.

It was noted at the time the writer and the above officers went into this store that there were approximately four colored women in this store all wearing purple fezzes which is characteristic of instant organization. The woman to whom the writer talked, stated that her name was [REDACTED] BEY. She advised that her organization is known as the Moorish Science Temple of America, and that the leader of their organization is NOBLE PRINCE FALU, the prophet and that theirs is the organization temple in Baltimore.

The writer and the above two officers while patrolling in this vicinity noticed an individual loading trash on a truck who was wearing a red fez and who had a long beard and these officers knew this individual as a member of instant organization. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] BEY, while being questioned by instant officers regarding the above mentioned Selective Service violator [REDACTED] EL, advised that he knows of no such individual and that the person who would have custody of the records of instant organization is [REDACTED] EL [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] who is the "Grand Sheik." [REDACTED] BEY advised the above officers that his true name is [REDACTED] BEY and not [REDACTED] and when questioned concerning instant organization, he stated that he is a "Moor" and is not a "negro." He stated, however, that he was born [REDACTED]

b7c [REDACTED] He informed that the head of the Moorish Science Temple of America is NOBLE DREW ALI, the Prophet, and that the Moorish Movement stands for "love, trust, peace, freedom and justice."

[REDACTED] BEY stated that Temple [REDACTED] has meetings from 7:30 until 10:30 PM each Monday, Wednesday and Friday of each week and that [REDACTED] EL generally presides at each of these meetings. No further effort was made to question this individual at this time. However, a lead is being set forth to recontact him again under pretext to secure additional information regarding this organization.

A check of the records of Local Board #21, Baltimore, reflects that [REDACTED] BEY is a registrant of this board, residing at [REDACTED] and was born [REDACTED]. It reflected [REDACTED] BEY was the person who would always know his address, who being of [REDACTED] It reflected his employer as the Federal Housing Project [REDACTED] Maryland. It described him as follows:
