



At seme of the meetings there are speakers who have in general confined themselves to reading from the Keran and rendering culogies regarding the greatness of the organization.

The predominant activities of this branch during the last quarter were centered on the 17th annual national convention which was held from September 15, 1944 to September 20, 1944 at the Headquarters, 1032 Orleans Street, Approximately 250 members of the organisation convened during this period, and it is well to note that the delegates were very well spread from the various parts of the country.

A summery of the convention would indicate that most of the time was spent in settlement of personal disputes, sulegy of membership in the organization, and some indictments against treatment afforded negroes by the white mem. However, no inflammatory statements were made by any of the participating delegates or leaders during the entire convention.

It also might be well to add that the general impression assend to be that this servention was in a large measure a money-making scheme for the leader, Colonel CHARLES HIRKAN DAY. In substantiation of this fact it is well to note that the convention fees paid by each delegate were extremely high and that exerbitant prices were charged for the meals which were served the delegates at the convention hall.

The Size Certage Grove Chicago, Illinois

The leader of this branch is RL, who claims that his erganisation is levely affiliated with the KIRLLAS BAY branch described in the aferegoing paragraph. However, it is evident that EL is rather jealous of KIRLLAS BAY due to the fact that many of the members are leaving this branch and openly affiliating with the KIRLLAS BAY group. As a result thereof this particular branch has at the present time practically seased to exist. Li holds meetings on Friday and Sunday aftermoons if enough members can be gathered tegether to warrant the opening of the meeting. There are no temple branches affiliated with this particular organization.

The El Branch 8229 South Indiana Street Chicago, Illinois

The head of this particular branch is EL, who claims to be one of the legical successors to the Prophet NOBEL DRIM ALY, and states that any of the other so-called successors are claiming this honor fraudulently. At the present time IL cantinues to be a very sick man, and personal contact with him is not allowed by anyone.

The efficience of this branch are the file of this group of officers carry on whatever activities are engaged in by this particular branch.

Also of interest is the fact that STRICKLARD FL and CREBY EL back in the year 1942 made a trip to kississippl with the purpose in mind of establishing

an auxiliary temple. It has been reported that during this trip to Mississippi each of them expressed pre-Japanese sympathies in attempting to erganise this branch, and as a result were indicted for the violation of the State Sedition laws of Mississippi. Upon indictment STRICHIAED and SHELSY EL fled from Mississippi before they were apprehended, and there is presently extending process against them on this charge in the State of Mississippi. It is well to note in this connection, however, that this indictment in the State of Mississippi is purely runor and there is no evidence to substantiate the accusation.

Hembers of this group vigorously deny that they have any Japanese affiliations or any feeling of desiring to comperate with the Japanese in the war against the United States. They claim that they are good Americans, and are merely trying to live up to the five principles of leve, truth, freedom, peace, and justice for which the organisation stands.

This group at the present time has me branch temples located in any other section of the United States, and due to the serious illness of EL the meetings whenever held are very irregular and find few members in attendance.

The El Branch 8700 South Westworth Avenue Chicago, Illinois

of this group is IL, who resides at This group holds regular meetings on Friday and Sunday evenings at the meeting hall and slaims a total membership of EL is apparently attempting approximately fifty. From all appearances to cooperate in every way with the laws of the government. to shave. Therefore most of them have long flowing boards. Also all of the male numbers wear red feses, and the female numbers adorn themselves with long red robes and gaudy headgear. It is a rule of this organisation that no number is permitted to appear in public without being fully attired in the prescribed manner.

Information has also been received that the numbers of this group maintain a policy racket among themselves, and on several occasions there have been runors to the effect that the numbers are very pro-Japanese in their attitude. Sowever, investigation has failed to substantiate that such is the fact.

The numbers of this group have no definite time in which to hold a meeting, but in most instances they meet whenever they so desire.

There are several branches throughout the country which at the present time are affiliated with this group. They are located at 4003 West 18th Street, Pine Bluff, Arkansas; 18th and Christian, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; 511 Burrough, Pittsburgh, Fennsylvania; 1406 Laurans, Maltimore, Maryland; 1059 Roberts, Augusta, Georgia; 628 Kuigh Avenue, Canden, New Jersey; 250 Court, Howark, New Jersey; 255 Syesmore, Canden, New Jersey; Glassbore, New Jersey; Jersey City, New Jersey; 6 Washington Street, Montclair, New Jersey.



### THE PELLORERIP OF EPCONCILIATION

Assording to a new statement which has been amounted by the efficers of the FBE the mins and purposes of this group are as follows:

- (2) To work towards the end of abolishing war and festering good will among all nations, races, and classes.
- (5) To build a social order which will suffer no individual or group to be exploited for the profit or pleasure of another, and which will assure to all the means of realising the best possibilities of life.
- (4) To advocate such ways of dealing with offenders against society as shall transform the wrongdoor rather than inflict retributive punishment.
- (b) To endeavor to show reverence for personality—in the home, in the education of children, in association with those of other classes, antionalities, and races.
- (b) To avoid bitterness and contention, and to maintain the spirit of self-giving love while engaged in the struggle to achieve these purposes.

The Chicago Chapter of the Pellewship of Reconciliation appears to be presently bending all efforts and laying stress along the following lines:

- (1) Give aid to conscientious objectors who are presently incorrected in prison as well as help to those conscientious objectors located in Civilian Public Service Camps.
- (2) Strong opposition to any form of peace time permanent conscription.
- (5) Advocation of Pacifiam.
- (4) Work towards the end of regial equality.

The mational headquarters of the FOR are located at 2929 Broadway, New York City. It is here that the organization's publications are printed and prepared and the larger pertion of its policies formulated. The FOR has a mational ecuncil ecunosed of approximately fifty members, each of whom is elected for a two-year period, and it is this council that exercises the predominant control of the practices on the part of members of the FOR. The organization claims to have approximately 15,000 members in Durope and 10,000 members in the United States.

Parkaps the most eignificant activity on the part of the PGE Suring the last quarter was the economicated effort put forth by various members on the Midwestern Conference which was held in Chicago from September 29, 1964 to October 1, 1966. The headquarters of this conference were the First Church of the Brothron, 2000 Best Congress Street, and the adjoining Sethany Piblical Seminary, 2004 Best Von Buren Street.

As was to be expected, many of the national functionaries of the PCK were present at this Hidwestern Convention and delivered appeares to those assembled as well as took an active part in leading group discussions.

Average attendance at each of the sessions of the Midwestern Conference was approximately fifty people.

The organisation in its concentration on Pacificm has established regular coll groups throughout the Chicago area which hold weakly meetings and have as their main topic of discussion - Pacifica. Further the arganization has projected its recial equality program through helding regular conferences, the media of literature, and by close association with megroes and other recial groups interested in improving the status of these ruces in this country.



Detroit, Michigan, which is in the Megro area of Detroit, advised that on July 13, 1948, a colored woman, whose name she does not know, came to her store to make a purchase. This colored woman, who professes to be a preacher in the Christian faith, carried on a conversation in which she stated the Arabs in the current Arab-Jewish war were first going to fight the Jews and then the Reds, and then they were going to fight the United States for the purpose of eventual domination of the world by the Asiatic peoples. The Negress dropped the hint that she was interested in Mohammedanism and stated that after 1952 that faith would be preached in the United States.

According to the informant, the Negross was quite belligerent and stated that after 1952 the Negroes would take over the United States Government and would run this Government to the exclusion of the white people.

The informant also asserted that from time to time Negroes coming to her store had made statements to the effect that all Negroes are united and that someday they would regain their liberty from the white people. They have also stated in substance that in two or three years there would be a Holy War and after that the whites would no longer dominate the world.

According to the informant, some of the colored people were presently adding "Bey" and "Ali" to their names in keeping with their interest in the Asiatic world and Mohammedanism. The informant could give no specific examples of this. The informant requested that her name be kept confidential.

Inseruch as information furnished this office regarding the group of people who use the name of "Bey" and "Ali" reflects activity of the loorish Science Temple of America, an additional copy of this letter is being sent for incorporation in that file.

This is from the son of Allah himself.

Every Moorish American citizen must carry an identification certificate.

Every one of our people in America must carry that at all times and present that at the registration booth as proof of their identity.

All of our citizens must wear their Fez and Turban or they cannot vote in the general election because we want everybody to recognise our people by their wearing apparel.

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

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

The Nation of Islam is an all-black nationwide organization headquartered at Muhammad's Temple 2, 7351 South Stony Island Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, under the guidance of Elijah Muhammad, self-styled "Messenger of Allah" and only divinely appointed leader of the black race in the United States. Its purpose is separation of the black man from the "devil" (white race) through establishment of a black nation. Followers are instructed to obey the laws of the land if they do not conflict with NOI laws and not to carry weapons but are to defend NOI officials, their property, women and themselves if attacked at all costs and are to take weapons away from their attackers and use same on the attacker.

The Moorish Science Temple of Islam (MSTA) was founded in 1913 in Newark, New Jersey, by Noble Drew Ali who was born in North Carolina in 1886. Ali is Allah's Prophet. Followers of MSTA believe they are Moorish-Americans because they are descendants of Vorrocens and born in America. The purpose of MSTA is the upliftment of faller humanity. They religion of MSTA is Islamism. The MSTA flag is red with a five pointed green star in the center.

Followers of MSTA, Inc., believe in reincarnation. They believe that Buddha, Mohammed, Jesus, etc., were all Prophets of Allah and that Noble Drew Ali was the last Prophet. Noble Drew Ali "passed" in Chicago on July 20, 1929. Eighteen days later Ali was reincarnated into a member by the name of John Giobon El who "nassed" in Chicago in 1935.

Articles of The Divine Constitution and By-Laws of MSTA provides 'This organization of the MSTA is not to cause any confusion or to overthrew the laws and constitution of the said government, but to obey hereby." This is read at every meeting and followers are to abide thereby.

The MSTA believes only in peace and members are forbidden to carry weapons.

MSTA, Inc., about three months ago, started publishing a paper titled "The Moorish Crescent". It is published twice a month by members in Williamstown, New Jersey.

The MSTA, Inc., has had no problems with the followers of Elijah Muhammad.

There is a split-off of MSTA, Inc., going by the name of MSTA at 957 East 75th Street, Chicago. This group does not accept the fact that Noble Drew Ali was reincarnated into John Gibbon El. The MSTA, Inc., and the MSTA cooperate with each other. The MSTA is not known to permit followers to carry weapons and teaches followers to obey the lawfor the land.

There is another small group operating under the name MSTA in the 1200 block on North Orleans, Chicago. This group split off from MSTA, Inc., again because it did not accept the reincarnation of Noble Drew Ali. This group follows the basic precepts and laws of MSTA, Inc. They are not known to allow members to carry weapons and follow the laws of the land.

El continued he has heard of the Moorish Divine and National Movement in North America, Inc. (MDNM) and has tried to make contact with leadons thereof at 4233 South Calumet, but to no avail. The MDNM is not affiliated with, or a split-off from the MSTA, Inc.

The MSTA, Inc. split with MSTA as followers of MSTA, Inc. believe in a reincarnated Noble Drew Ali whereas followers of MSTA do not.

MSTA is headquartered at 957 East 75th Street, Chicago. The Bey who lives in Baltimore, Maryland. The MSTA has Temples in the following cities:

The MSTA in Chicago has 40 to 50 followers.

There was another MSTA group located in the 1000 or 1200 block on North Orleans in Chicago. It broke with the ESTA in the 1930s, but followed the teachings of Noble Drew Ali and was peaceful in nature. The break was caused by a despute over leadership. The group is not united with the ESTA at present. It is believed the followers of this group are now meeting in homes of members if they meet at all.

MOORISH SCIENCE TEMPLE OF AMERICA (MSTA) EM

On 7/6/73, CURTIS J. EL and four brother muslims and also members of the Moorish Science Temple of America, Inc., (MSTA) filed a civil suit action in the U.S. District Court, Philadelphia, Pa., under civil action #73-1519. These five stated in the suit that they represented MSTA and that the suit, which was against the U.S. of America, the President of the United States, the State of Pennsylvania, the Governor of Pennsylvania and the Philadelphia County District Attorney, alleged that MSTA was their victim and as such MSTA suffered numerous grievances, infirmaties and violations as a result of being in this country. The suit asked for \$43,000,000 reparations and other things.

Because of the Chicago FBI Office's liaison with of the suit MSTA there, of MSTA advise filed in Philadelphia as outlined above, docket number and party names to the suit. This liaison resulted in the MSTA in Chicago setting up an interview BEY who is by the Philadelphia FBI Office of of Philadelphia MSTA.

BEY subsequently advised that the suit nor the plaintiffs represent nor are they backed by MSTA. tried to get the plaintiffs to retract the suit without success.

The results of these interviews were furnished the USA's Office. Philadelphia, immediately.

advised that such matters involving minority groups are very sensitive matters which require special handling. From this point on special agents maintained a close contact with the USA's Office in order to receive and handle all investigative requests immediately. Six different meetings were had with the USA at which time information was furnished and discussions were had.

On 8/22/73, the AUSA requested that the plaintiffs be identified and their arrest records obtained. On 9/5/73, all information from the Philadelphia FBI files, arrest records and the full identification of the plaintiffs was furnished to the AUSA.

On 9/7/73, the AUSA, armed with the information furnished him as mentioned, filed a motion for dismissal of of the suit. In just about three week period from the time it was learned that the suit had been filed, the USA's Office was able to use the information furnished him by the FBI to file his motion of dismissal.

On 10/3/73, the U.S. District Court granted the USA's motion. A mere less than three months lapsed from the date the suit was filed, to the date it was successfully defended, with no loss to the Federal Government. The AUSA looked on the matter as a complete victory and expressed his great appreciation for the investigation done by the FBI which enable him to bring about a successful defense.

In view of all of the above, a tremendous savings was brought about by the team work among the Chicago and Philadelphia FBI Offices and the AUSA. The expeditious handling of the matter, before the minority matter may have been played up by the news media and giving rise to the origination of other similar suits, resulted in a savings of \$43,000,000. There is also an unknown amount of similar suits that might have been filed had the subject suit not have been so resolved.

Philadelphia is claiming a savings of \$21,500,000 and requests that Chicago be credited with the same amount.

- 3. FRCP 12 (B) 1. Court has no jurisdiction of the subject metter of this action.

4. FRCP 12(B) 2. Court has no jurisdiction over the Federal defendants of complaint.

5. PRCP 12(B) 6. Plaintiffs failed to state claim upon which relief can be claimed.

The following are the court's reasons for dismissal of the suit:

- l. Petitionera complaint fails to set a claim upon which relief can be granted.
- 2. Haines vs. Kerner, 404 U.S. 519, 5/20-21 (1972), such grants will be dismissed if it appears that plaintiff would be entitled to no relief under any set of facts which could be provided in support of his claim.

- 3. Plaintiffs' complaint does not allege that respondents have violated their first amendment, Right of Religious Liberty. It avers only that respondents have in some way kept members of the black race in ignorance of their true religious and cultural heritage. Such an allegation does not state a claim upon which relief can be granted.
- 4. Plaintiffs' complaint is replete with vague conclusionary statements. Indeed, reference to the "religious creed and principles of their forefathers," and to their national flag, are not allegations at all, but proclamations of religious identity. Moreover, there is no nexus between the allegations of the complainant and named respondents or between the relief sought and the alleged constitutional deprivations. Furthermore, we note that a command to the Government to financially support plaintiffs' religious organization would violate the first amendment.

AUSA ALAN M. LIEBERMAN, EDPA, was unavailable to determine specifically what assistance the information provided by the Bureau was in preparing the motion for dismissal. We noted, however, that when this information first came to the attention of the Philadelphia Office in an airtel from the Chicago Office, agents immediately discussed the matter with AUSA SULLIVAN CISTONE, who had the case assigned to him, however, had done nothing on it. CISTONE advised that the FBI could assist him by identifying the person involved in the suit and checking any criminal records that they may have. By the FBI contacting the U.S. Attorney's Office, the matter was handled more promptly.

Enclosed for the Bureau is a copy of a Letterhead Memorandum which was supplied to the USA's Office setting forth interview with the complete of the Moorish Science Temple of America, who provides information regarding the background of the complainant, which information would not have been otherwise available to the USA's Office.

Philadelphia feels definitely that the information provided assisted the U.S. Attorney in establishing that the suit was not a proper suit against the Government.

According to El, the MSTA, Inc. is headquartered at 3810 South Wabash, Chicago, and in-corporated in the State of Illinois. MSTA, Inc. has no foreign affiliations. It has an overall membership of 3-5,000 people with about 300 followers in Chicago. A branch is located in Fhiladelphia, Pa. The WSTA was founded in 1913 in Newark, N.J., by Noble Drew Ali, who was born in North Carolina in 1886, Allah's prophet. Followers of the MSTA believe they are Moorish-Americans because they are descendants of Morrocans and born in America. Followers of MCTA, Inc., believe in reincarnation. They believe that Buddah, Muhammed, Jesus, et cetera are all prophets of Allah and that Noble Drew All was the last prophet. Noble Drew Ali (passed) in Chicago on July 30, 1929. Eighteen days later he was reincarnated into a member by the name of John Gibbon El who passed in Chicago in 1935. Articles of the Divine Constitution and bylaws of MSTA provides "This organization of the MSTA is not to cause any confusion or to overthrow the laws and constitution of the said government, but to abide thereby.\* This document contains neither ALL INFORMATION ( MITAINED \ recommendations nor conclusionsief.
