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

Confidential Informant advised that he had been working with members of the cult of Moorish Science Temple of America, also known as Koorish Americans, for some time and had heard about that organization in South Bend as early as 1936. His impression was that according to his information they had been dorment from time to time stops then. He stated that their faith is founded on parts of the Koran which are translated into English; that they have meetings every Friday night which are presided over by an Assistant Grand Sheik.

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said they are all of a very peor lew-class negro, most of whom were at one time employed on the W. P. A. He estimated the number of followers of this feith in South Bend at between seventy-five and one hundred. He stated they claimed to have descended from the Israelites who were lost in Afica in the middle ages. They have their own merriage ceremony which is performed after the regular state license is obtained; that they are apparently polygamists as indicated from their moral conduct, but he did not know of anything in their religion which advocated polygamy.

The informant advised that he had heard rumors that this organization was in some respect inspired by Japanese, but he had no definite information along this line except that he did know they claimed sympathy and racial affiliation with all the darker races, preferring to be called "Olives" rather than negroes, belinving that the term "negro" was a term invented by the white Americans to promote inferitority. W

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These files indicate that the leader of the sect is JESSE RICHARD-SON, Bey, Assistent Grand Sheik, He is a laborer fermerly employed by the W. P. A. and is living with who holds the position of Divine Minister, and, therefore, is entitled to conduct the merriage ceremony. Home conditions there are very bad. He was interviewed on one occasion, and stated that he had started the temple at South Bend with the help of the Grand Shei's from Chicago; that he came to South Bend in 1931 from Detroit; that he was born in North Carolina in

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1885 and moved to Arkeness when he was two years old; that he joined the cult in Detroit in 1927.

The marriage ceremony occupies about thirty minutes, which is followed by an all day celebration. According to the statements of members, the church does believe in monogamy.

There was evidence that the same organization exists in Gary. Indians and that information had been developed there with respect to their beliefs indicating that they claim to be of Moroccan descent; that they are forbid even to eat pork unless no other reat is available; that they pray at sunrise or seven times a day, all prayers said facing the East; that on important occasions they were Arabic costumes and ferzes; and that they are incorporated under the Illinois law, their national headquarters being at 930 Fudson avenue Chicago, Illinois.



These individuals, however, were released by the United States Attorney at Topeka, Kansas, upon order of the Attorney General since they were over forty-five years of age.

By letter of October 28, 1942, the Bureau was advised with respect to the dismissal of these complaints as follows:

Reference is made to report of Special Agent of this effice dated July 28, 1942 in each of the above captioned cases. It will be noted from a review of Agent report that these Subjects, members of the Moorish Science Temple of America, were arrested on a Commissioner's Warrant at Kansas City, Kansas on July 24, 1942 for failure to register for Selective Services

Under date of August 24, 1942's letter was received from the Honorable GEORGE H. WEST, United States Attorney, Topeka, Kansas, advising that he had been instructed by Mr. NENDELL BERGE, Assistant United States Attorney General to immediately register each of the above captioned Subjects and effect their release from Federal custedy since they came within the fourth registration, registrants from fertyfive to sixtyfive, and should be dealt with in accordance with Departmental Circular 3421, supplement #6, dated May 5, 1942.

Upon receipt of this letter from Mr. WEST, he was advised under date of August 26, 1942 that all of these Subjects had been contacted on June 16, 1942 at which time it was found they failed to register and they were at that time admonished to register for Selective Service with their local Board.

On June 18, 1942 a letter was directed to Bujedier Coneral N. R. Melkan, Director of Selective Service at Topeka, Kanens advising him of the fact these Subjects had not registered and calling his attention to the fact that some of these would fall within the provisions of the fourth registration.

Under date of June 20, 1942, the following communication was received from Brigadier General M. R. McIEAN:

"Enis is in reply to the letter of Jens 18, 1942, from Mr. Dwight Brantley, Special Agent is Charge of your Office, to the State Director of Selective Service with reference to the "Moorish Science Temple of America."

Local Boards Nos. 2 and A of Wyandotte County, Kansas City, Kansas are being requested to lay the required groundwork for prosecution of the parties

residing within their respective beard areas, who appear to be nonregistrant delinquents.

After receipt of the letter from the State Director of Selective Service this office waited thirty days, after which a check was made with Local Boards 2 and 4 of Wyandotte County, Kansas City, Kansas to ascertain if any of the members of this religious cult had submitted themselves for registration and upon being informed that none of them had, the facts in this case were again discussed with the office of the United States Attorney, with Assistant LESTER LUTHER, who authorised the filing of complaints with the United States Countseloner at Kansas City, Kansas in order that they might be taken into custody, for the violation of the Selective Service Act of 1940,

On October 2, 1942 United States Atterney WEST again contacted this office and advised that he had received further instructions from the Atterney General to immediately register these Subjects and release them. Mr. WEST stated that he had ordered Deputy United States Marshall to register Subjects in accordance with the instructions of the Attorney General and release them but that when the instructions of the Attorney General and release them but that when the information and stated that it was against their religious convictions to register. Mr. WEST requested the cooperation of this office in this matter and stated that he would appreciate it if a Special Agent could proceed to the Wyandotte County Jail and witness the refusal of these Subjects to register for Selective Service when requested to de so by

Special Agents of this affice proceeded to the Wyandotte County Jeil on October 2, 1942 at which time he interviewed each of these Subjects in the presence of Deputy United States Marshall and advised them that if they would submit to registration for Selective Service at that time their release would be authorized by the Attermay General of the United States.

Each of the above Subjects was asked individually if he would register and each replied that he could not as it was against his religious.

BET was questioned as to whether or not he had a son who was registered for Selective Service and stated that if he did, it was against his wishes.

Special agent has advised me that these Subjects appear to be as Welligerent toward the Service Service and Training Act of 1940 as they did at the time when they were originally interviewed by him in June of 1942

On October 22, 1942 United States Atterney WEST again advised he had received an additional communication from the Attorney General dated October 20, 1942 Sirecting that the above named Subjects be registered by the United States Marshal and released immediately. Mr. WEST stated that he directed Duited States Marshal for the State of Kaness to comply with the orders of the Attorney General but that when an attempt was made to register these Subjects on October 24 they refused to furnish any information which would enable the Marshal to register them and when their registration cards were completed from the information available from the jail's records that each refused to take their Selective Service Certificates with them at the time of their release from the Myandotte County Jail in Kansas City, Kansas

ENT is the leader of this cult of negroes in Esnaes City, Kansas, and at the time of the arrest of the sale numbers of this cult, no information was obtained reflecting that the BKI counseled them to evade the provisions of the Selective Service Law.

This case was discussed with United States Attorney GRORGE N. WEST, Topoka, Kansas, who stated that at the recent sitting of the Federal Grand Jury inquiry was made concerning Japanese infiltration among selected groups and that the EET as well as members of this negro cult were questioned by him, particularly concerning their beliefs toward the Selective Service law. Wr. WEST stated that the EET denied that she had commelled these cult members to evade the law, stating that it was merely their religion. The various cult members who were arrested were also questioned and all of them stated that their refusel to comply with the Selective Service law was their swa personal conviction based upon religious belief and that their refusel to comply with the Selective Service law was their swa personal conviction based upon religious belief and that their secons at the prosecution against the EET could not be maintained.

In view of the fact there apparently is no activity in the Moorish Science Temple of America at Kansas City, Kansas, at the present time of a subversive nature this case is being placed in a closed status by the Kansas City Field Divisions

The Chicago Field Division has been advised to disregard the lead set forth in reference report of Special Agent Kenses City, Kansas

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It is to be commented that the investigation of this case did not disclose that the Moorish Science Temple of America, located at Kansas City, Kansas, was promoted by or influence by any Japanese representative,



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

"Upper left hand corner three quarter moon with a star in the upper center with the word Islam under it. In the center upper of the card are two hands clapsed with the word Unity over them. In the upper right hand corner is a black circle with the figure 7 in it and the word Allah under it.

"The first line reads age 45, 1942. Under this are the words .....

"Beneath this the card reads as follows:

"This is your nationality and identification card for the Moorish Science Temple of America, and Birthrights for the Moorish Americans, etc. We honor all the Divine Prophets, Jesus, Mohammed, Buddha and Confucius. May the blessings of the God of our Father Allah, be upon you that carry this card. I do hereby declare that you are a Moslem under the Divine Laws of the Holy Koran of Mecca. Love, Truth, Peace, Freedom and Justice. 'I AM A CITIZEN of the U.S.A.

"NOBLE DREW ALI, The Prophet, 1104 Sedgwick St. Chicago, Illinois.

"There is also a blue, round pin made of culluloid with a three quarter gold moon and a star in the upper right hand corner of the moon. Above the moon in red letters are the initials M. A. Under the moon in red letters is the word Allah.

Informant stated that at Christmas Time the Negro members of this organization did not celebrate by Christmas trees or Christmas wreaths as it is not the Moslem's Christmas. He further stated that ELAL had told him that there is a Moorish Home being built in West Virginia for the old people and for the children and that there was going to be a convention of the MORISH SCIENCE TELPIE in Chicago. Illinois, from September 16 to September 20, 1942. He further advised that told him that he expected to be interned by the white man as were the Jews in Germany.

Notes taken from the Informent are being retained in the Detroit file.

Informant further edvised the writer that merris and then deserted him and her four children for lives in North Detroit and has a brother who is a NPA band leader. He stated thet promised would take her to Japan, but on arriving at New York she found that he had a wife there end elso a wife in Japan and that the two were colored women and did not know about one another. He stated that grandnother is buying s home on Greely in Detroit and that he would get this address later. He stated that there is another moeting place under another name at St. Antoins end Canfield in Detroit and that the fee to join is \$1 and the dues are 50¢ a month. He said that this organization esked for \$5 donetions each month for the Moorish Home where they claim all of them will be intermed because "they won't fight." He further stated that there is a movement called the Development of Our Own which means the same as the Moslam organization.

He stated that these people do not dress as the people in the church of the MOORISH SCIENCE TEMPLE, but that he was of the opinion that it was connected with the MOORISH SCIENCE TEMPLE OF AMERICA. He advised that the temple at 9316 Oakland Avenue

Informant advised that the teachings of this organization are that the white man brought the Negro from Africa years ago although the teachers stated that the Negro was not a Negro but an Asiatic and that the white man enslaved him and gave him his surname and that the Negro, or Asiatic's, real surname was BEY or EL or some other Arabic name. He stated that the authorities in the temple apparently make up these names, but they impress on the Negroes that they know from supernatural powers what the Negro's correct surname was from his forbears in Asia. The Negro, the Informant advised, keeps his surname and adds the name of BEY or EL to the surname although sometimes the Moslems use other Arabic names. He stated that the Koran is the Bible that the Negroes use and that the favorite preaching is that the Japanese will take over America and will not touch members of the MOORISH SCIENCE TEMPLE OF AMERICA. He stated that the speakers claim that at the right time the Japanese will have a supply ship near to America where all the Negroes who are members of the MOORISH SCIENCE TEXPLE OF AMERICA can get arms to rise up against the white people and also that the Japanese would know the Negroes by their Asiatic names and would not harm them.



ACT 3.- Love, Truth, Peace, Freedom and Justice must be proclaimed and practised by all members of the Moorish Science Temple of America. No member is to put in danger, or accuse falsely, his brother or sister on any occasion at all that may harm his brother or sister, because Allah is Love.

ACT 4.-All members must preserve these Holy and Divine laws, and all members must obey the laws of the government, because by being a Moorish American, you are a part and partial of the government, and must live the life accordingly.





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
Subsequently was interviewed and advised that he was not acquainted with any of the members of St. Hary's Church and had never, at any time, attended meetings in this church. That he frankly was not a religious man and very rarely, if ever, went to church, and then only at the urging of his wife. He stated that his present address was Shepherdsville. 





HELSON BEY, claims over 1,000,000 members in national organization. Several \$100 money orders received by this colony each month from C. KIRNAM BEY, Chicago, Supreme Grand Advisor and Moderator, and numerous smaller money orders received from other temples. This colony publishes a monthly magazine "Moorish Voice", about five hundred mimeographed copies being mailed to various temples. Copies of Constitution, Rules and Regulations and "Moorish Voice" obtained. These negroes have excellent reputation in neighborhood, are registered for Selective Service, and there is no indication of subversive activities

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DSTAILS:

# AT LETISCHURG, VIRGILIA:

This investigation is predicated upon information furnished to be special agent

that he had read an article in the newspaper about an organization of negroes in the United States called "koslems" which were inspired by the Japanese and whose ultimate purpose was the overthrow of the white race. That there was an organization of negroes located near Trince George, Virginia, who called themselves "Loslems", all the men wearing red turbans. He said that the colony had been there for about three or four years, at first consisting of log cabins chinked with mud and later of houses made from concrete blocks. He estimated that there were about fifty members of the colony, whose leader is named NELSON DEY. These negroes were very polite and courteous and appeared to be well behaved, although they were in a strategic place to commit serious damage if they did have un-American sympathies

### AT ULICE GEORGE, VIRGINIA:

Sheriff of Prince George Gounty, was interviewed by Reporting Agent and stated that he was acquainted with the colony of negroes referred to but said they called themselves "Moorish Americans" rather than Moslems, claiming to worship Allah. He advised that they settled in the vicinity several years ago, coming there from various parts of the country, and that they had never caused him any trouble. According to they seemed to have an unlimited supply of money, as he recalled that at a Sheriff's sale they had bought out nearly everything that was offered for sale, and the one who paid for it did so in cash from a huge ward of greenback. He said they had cleared out a good part of the land, grew their own crops, and supported their own buildings, and had bought at least one large truck. A

that they had apparently made no attempt to agitate in any way and did not seem to associate at all with other necroes. That only one local negro had joined the colony.

that the fact that they had taken such a man into their colony made him wonder as to what their purposes might be. W

been established there seemed to be an epidemic of stealing in that part of the county, and he had gone out to the colony to talk with NELSON BEY about it. He said that BEY was quite cooperative and told him that any time he wanted to search any of the buildings in the colony he was perfectly at liberty to do so, and need not obtain any search warrant. Was not able to obtain any evidence that these negroes had stolen anything. He said so far as he knew they were law abiding citizens who had no desire to overthrow the white race and who had no contacts with any Japanese.

Draft Board #1, Prince George County, advised that she had a number of registrations from the negroes who comprised the Moorish-American Colony and so far as she knew they had all registered. She advised that FRED/NFLSOM DEY, the leader of the colony, had registered April 27, 1942, and the following description was obtained from his registration card:

Prince George, Virginia, claimed to be a conscientious objector, and the following information was obtained from his Conscientious Objector Form: U

"The principles of my religion are love, truth, peace, freedom, and justice". He received his training "from the Loorish Science Temple of America, Inc." He relies for religious guidance on Brother C. KIRKMAN HEY, 11047 Sedgwick Street, Chicago, Illinois, who is head of the organization. "At present, I am sacrificing my time and labor solely to the cause of my religion". The creed of his sect in regard to war was stated thusly: "The Holy Koran says, 'When a man harms in thought or word or deed another man, he does a wrong to Allah' My race is knownish-American." He said his occupation consisted in farming on about twenty-five acres of land, the number who work on this land being six. He gave the names of F. MELSON BEY and C. KIRKMAN BEY as references. W

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who resides near the colony, informed that the negroes had a very good reputation in the vicinity, and never causes any trouble. advised that recently he had picked up the negro that there were namely seventy-five in the colony, and that they were expecting more to come in from all over the country, in anticipation of which they were erecting some more buildings. w bod

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Informant that she had become acquainted with a number of the members of this colony, all of whom impressed her as being very courteous, of good character, and good citizens. She said they had numerous visitors all over the country.

In this connection he said that he had to examine the title to the property on which the Moorish Science Temple Colony was situated. that one BEY also, and she had apparently deeded the property to the Moorish Science Temple of America, Inc., but it was the opinion of White, Temple, Hamilton, & Wyche, law firm, that the title to the property was no good. furnished correspondence showing that the Moorish Temple of Science was incorporated under the "Not for Profit Act" of the State of Illinois on November 29, 1926, and filed a certificate May 21, 1928, changing the name to the Moorish Science Temple of: America; that it was also incorporated in the State of New York with principal offices at 44 Jefferson Avenue, Brooklyn, New York, and that it attempted to domesticate in the State of Virginia but was refused permission on the ground that the Constitution of Virginia prohibits the incorporation of a church or religious denomination which is incorporated under the laws of some other State. W

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Judge FRANK BINFORD, Circuit Court of Prince George County and Chairman of the Local Draft Board, informed that the colony seemed to be composed of well-behaved negroes and he did not recall having trouble with any of them other than one exception. He advised that one negro who had been placed on probation in Cleveland, Ohio, had come down to join this colony, being placed under Judge BINFORD's supervision.

Judge binrORD solid he required the leader, NELSON BEY, to make periodic reports on this individual and that finally NELSON HEY informed the Judge that this individual had been violating his probation and accordingly the Judge instructed NELSON BEY to place him in the County Jail so that be could be removed to Cleveland. Judge BINFORD said that before turning the negro over to the sheriff, NELSON BEY removed the negroe's red fezz and gave him an old cap to wear. Judge BINFORD said such an instance as this led him to believe that they were a law-abiding group of negroes who had no intention of stirring up racial trouble.

Special Agent and the writer proceeded to the national home of the Moorish Science Temple, which can be reached in the following manner: proceed east from Prince George on Highway #6 for about six miles; at Cummings Store, turn right on a dirt road and proceed about 13 miles, where the colony will be seen on the left.

NELSON BUY was advised that

the organization. F. NELSON BEY then furnished willingly the following information about the Moorish Science Temple of America, Inc. w

It originated in Newark, New Jersey, in 1913, its founder being NOBLE DREW ALL who was born in North Carolina in 1886 and is now deceased. The local colony was established in 1939 as the Nitional Home of the organization, most of the members coming from Chicago, Detroit, Philadelphia, Toledo, New York City, and Lauisville, Kentucky.

The local colony consists of about fifty members, and BEY claimed more than a million members for the national organization. He said there are four temples in New York City and Chicago, three in Philadelphia, some in Detroit and Chattanooga and various other cities. M

BET stated that anyone can join the organization upon paying 25¢ for a membership card, 25¢ for an emblem, and 50¢ monthly dues. No member of the organization is permitted to marry unless his spouse also joins. Their Holy Beak is the Koran, and it is the aim of the organization to set an example of leve and peace in the neighborhood. Though believing in peace, the organization instructs its men not to refuse to serve in the Army if drafted

the organization have been inducted into the U.S. Army, though none from the local colony. He informed that all members of the organization are native born citizens of the United States, though they claimed to belong to the Moerish-American race. He said that the Forefathers of the present negrees in this country were all descended from two names in Africa, the HEIS and the ELS, and they can tell by a secret sign which tribe a particular negre

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
