These photographs were found by INS investigators at the time of his arrest on June 21, 1957, and were signed "MORRIS" and "SHIRLEY." GOLDFUS stated that SHIRLEY and MORRIS were people he met in Central Park, New York City, about 1949 and with whom he associated for about four months. He said he was in their company about twelve times during that period. He said when the weather was good, they usually met in Central Park, and when bad, they met in one of the museums in New York City. He went on to say that on occasions, he would have lunch or dinner with MORRIS and SHIRLEY in a New York City restaurant which he did not identify.

GOLDFUS advised that MORRIS and SHIRLEY are a married couple whose last name he could not recall and that he believed that they live in Manhattan. He stated that MORRIS was employed as a salesman, but he did not recall the place of employment. He is not sure, but he believed that SHIRLEY was unemployed.

He stated he has not seen them since 1949. He believed they lived in Manhattan, but does not know their address. He stated that their conversations concerned literature and art. He stated that the probable reason he retained the photographs of SHIRLEY and MORRIS was because they were the only photographs given to him by anyone in the United States.

He stated the reference to "Joann's murders" was reference to the fact that he likes to read detective stories, and the reference to a trip to Frisco resulted from his having told them he planned a trip to San Francisco in 1949.

The "Guide to Subversive Organizations and Publications," revised and published as of January 2, 1957, prepared and released by the Committee on Un-American Activities, United States House of Representatives, Washington, D.C., contains the following concerning the American Labor Party:

- "1. 'For years, the Communists have put forth the greatest efforts to capture the entire American Labor Party throughout New York State. They succeeded in capturing the Manhattan and Brooklyn sections of the American Labor Party but outside of New York City they have been unable to win control.' (Special Committee on Un-American Activities, House Report 1311 on the CIO Political Action Committee, March 29, 1944, p. 78.)
- "2. 'Communist dissimulation extends into the field of political parties forming political front organizations such as the * * * American Labor Party. The Communists are thus enabled to present their candidates for elective office under other than a straight Communist label.'

 (Internal Security Subcommittee of the Senate Judiciary Committee, Handbook for Americans, S. Doc. 117, April 23, 1956, p. 91.)"

On October 7, 1956, Peter Hawley, New York State Chairman, American Labor Party, publicly announced the American Labor Party State Committee unanimously approved a resolution dissolving the organization and ordering the liquidation of its assets.
