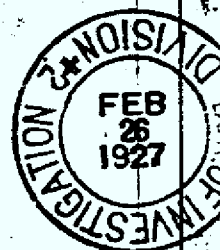

SYNOPSIS OF FACTS: Re-opened.			
E. A. Soldoni residing at 815 West Highland, Ponca City, Oklahoma, telephone 2184-J, is the only Emert Soldoni living at that place. Informant has made no conveyance of real property, or contracts in regard thereto with Homer Ramsey, son of subject John Ramsey. - PENDING -			
DETAILS: - At Ponca City, Oklahoma -			
Arriving at Ponca City, Okla., I found in the telephone directory a number of persons by the name of Soldoni. However, I finally ascertained that the only person by the name of Emert Soldoni is one E. A. Soldoni, residing at 815 West Highland.			
Upon interview, this informant stated as follows: That he had not sold any real estate recently, neither by deed of conveyance or contract of sale. The only sale of real estate made by informant was that of his former residence, which he sold about June 28, 1926 to Mr. McCracken, Tax Adjuster, of the Marland Oil Company. Informant is now renting his present residence and does not own any real estate in Ponca City, Okla.			
- At Newkirk, Oklahoma -			
DETAILS: Proceeding to Newkirk, I arranged with the County Clerk of Kay County to open the office and permit me to check up my information on the land records. I ascertained the following facts: The only conveyance made by Emert A. Soldoni is a deed in fee simple to Loraine S. McCracken, dated June 21, 1926, and recorded thereafter during the same month. This record fact would seem to corroborate statement made by informant. The consideration mentioned in this conveyance was \$12,000, subject to a mortgage (amount not mentioned), in favor of the Ponca City Building & Loan Co. I then phoned Agent in Charge McKean at Oklahoma City, explained developments, and was instructed to return. PENDING.

SYNOPSIS OF FACTS:

- Reopened Case -

Counter affidavits disputing allegations and bearing on reputations and criminal records of affiants John Ramsey, John Morris, Wm. Webster, J.O. Evans, Gene Johnson, L.F. Pock, P.J. Walker, et al, whose affidavits were attached to Defendant W.K. Hale's motion for new trial based on newly discovered evidence.

DETAILS:-

Before the Hon. John C. Pollock, presiding Judge at trial of W. K. Hale and John Ramsey for the murder of Henry Roan, motion for new trial was filed by W. K. Hale, based on alleged newly discovered evidence set out in affidavits attached to Defendant Hale's motion, as follows:-

AFFIDAVIT OF JOHN RAMSEY - in which he denies that W. K. Hale ever had guilty knowledge of events leading up to or the murder of Henry Roan, and in which he alleges a conspiracy between Roy Bunch and Ernest Burkhardt to have Roan murdered, and recites the details of alleged arrangements between Burkhardt, Bunch and Curley Johnson to kill Roan. This affidavit also tells of the actual murder of Henry Roan by Curley Johnson with pistol furnished Johnson by Burkhardt in presence of Burkhardt and Ramsey in vicinity where Roan was killed by Johnson. Ramsey alleges numerous meetings with Bunch and Burkhardt separately and collectively and the details of discussions and numerous money transactions with Ernest Burkhardt, and other considerations in lieu of Ramsey's knowledge of and assistance rendered in bringing about the murder of Roan. The affidavit names Bill Revard and Amos Tucker as being present with Ramsey and Bunch when Bunch discussed murdering Roan, and names John Morris as keeper of Burkhardt's funds and as being present when Burkhardt paid Ramsey a sum of money. It names J.O. Evans as being in

company with Ernest Burkhart and Ramsey and as seeing Burkhart with an automatic pistol. Ramsey's allegations cover other numerous details tending to substantiate his association with Burkhart, Bunch and Curley Johnson in the murder of Henry Roan and the vindication of W. K. Hale.

AFFIDAVIT OF JOHN MORRIS - alleges that Ernest Burkhart turned over to him \$950.00 for safe keeping, in latter half of January, 1923, consisting of bills of large denominations; that Morris returned \$450.00 about one week later and about two weeks later returned to Burkhart the balance of \$500.00; that sometime in the latter part of 1924 or early part of January, 1925, Morris met Burkhart and Ramsey on highway; after remarks by Ramsey of an incriminating nature against Burkhart, Morris saw Burkhart hand Ramsey a large sum of currency in bills of same denomination as money returned to Burkhart by Morris previously.

AFFIDAVIT OF WM. WEBSTER - alleges incriminating conversations between Burkhart and Curley Johnson (deceased), and between Johnson and Webster.

AFFIDAVIT OF GENE JOHNSON - alleges incriminating conversations between Burkhart and Curley Johnson (deceased), and between Curley Johnson and Gene Johnson.

AFFIDAVIT OF J. O. EVANS - alleges association of Burkhart and Ramsey prior to murder of Roan and other incriminating acts of Burkhart in support of Ramsey's allegations.

AFFIDAVIT OF L. F. POCK - alleges association of Ramsey and Burkhart and statements of Curley Johnson (deceased) incriminating Ernest Burkhart and other details in substantiation of Ramsey's allegations.

AFFIDAVIT OF JOHN MILLION - makes allegations in support of affidavit of L. F. Pock and in support of Ramsey's allegations.

AFFIDAVIT OF P. J. WALKER - makes allegations in support of affidavits of John Ramsey, and regarding conversations with Curley Johnson (deceased), incriminating Ernest Burkhart.

AFFIDAVIT OF LEE R. DOOLIN - makes allegations in support of Ramsey's affidavit, concerning payment of note which Ramsey alleged was paid with money received from Burkhart.

Counter affidavits were obtained by this Agent refuting allegations of John Ramsey and divulging the criminal records and reputations of the several above named affiants.

AFFIDAVIT OF ERNEST BURKHART, Mclester Prison, re John Ramsey - denies in detail all allegations of John Ramsey of an incriminating nature and gives a full explanation of minor details, and denies in toto the allegations of John Morris and reference in allegations of Ramsey in that respect.

AFFIDAVIT OF ROY BUNCH, at Fairfax, Oklahoma, denies allegations of John Ramsey and all other affiants in toto or in part.

AFFIDAVIT OF BILL REWARD, at Pawhuska, Oklahoma, denies allegations of John Ramsey; denies that he was ever in the presence of Roy Bunch, Amos Tucker and John Ramsey, collectively, or ever heard conversations as alleged by Ramsey.

AFFIDAVITS OF BOB PARKER and W. W. THOMASCH allege that J. O. Evans is an habitual criminal, drunkard, bootlegger, pool hall operator, friend of W.K. Hale, and employee of Hale's brother, and that Evans stated to Bob Parker, during trial of W. K. Hale and John Ramsey, that Ramsey's alibi was false and he knew facts to prove it, but would not testify for the Government. Evans bears a bad reputation in community of Fairfax, Okla.

AFFIDAVIT OF JOHN R. BURGER, Special Agent, Department of Justice, Kansas City, Missouri - alleges that Wm. Webster is a professional criminal, who has operated Osage County, Oklahoma, and Kansas with organization of criminals in transporting stolen cars in interstate commerce, and that he was convicted in Federal Court, Kansas City, in 1923, for violation of the National Motor Vehicle Theft Act, and that other cases are pending against him in the Western District of Oklahoma.

AFFIDAVIT OF ARTHUR A. GRAVES, Pawhuska, Oklahoma - alleges that Gene Johnson is an habitual criminal, bank robber and considered dangerous, and would commit perjury or any other criminal offense.

AFFIDAVITS OF C. K. TEMPLETON, ARTHUR GRAVES, A. W. COMSTOCK and DESSIE L. HAIME, Pawhuska, Oklahoma - allege that L. F. Pock is an ex-convict, now in custody in Osage County Jail, charged with numerous liquor law violations; that Pock is an unscrupulous criminal, and that he recently tried to hire a man to assassinate the Chief of Police at Shidler, Oklahoma, and burn his home. Pock recently testified in County Court at Pawhuska, Oklahoma, (certified copy of his testimony attached to file) that he was in the employment of Howard and Hamilton, attorneys for W. K. Hale, refusing to divulge nature of employment.

Copies of all counter affidavits, referred to herein, have been furnished to Special Assistant to the Attorney General Edwin Brown, Guthrie, Oklahoma, Assistant to the Attorney General O. R. Lohring, Washington, D.C., and Special Counsel for Osage Indians T. J. Leahy, Pawhuska, Oklahoma.

Originals of all affidavits were furnished to United States Attorney Roy St. Lewis, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

Defendant W. K. Hale's motion for a new trial was argued before Federal Judge J.C. Pollock at Kansas City, Missouri, February 14, 1927, and denied.

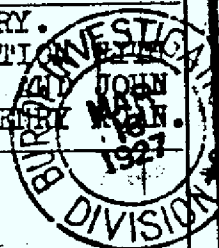

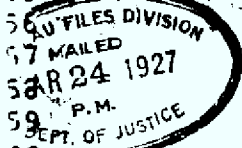

- AT MEMPHIS, TENNESSEE -

Monroe Harris, now an inmate of the Government Marine Hospital, was interviewed by this Agent and stated that one Minnie Savage rented a house from him in Pawmaka; that Charles Whitehorn and wife occupied apartments at this premises; that there was a man hanging around there by the name of Savage, a relative of Minnie Savage; that on a date (which informant is unable to establish either by day, week, month or year), which he does not remember, he met Minnie Savage and Hattie Whitehorn, wife of deceased, leaving their home going in direction of business section of city; that soon after they left he saw the man, Savage, and Charles Whitehorn come out of the house, get into a car (the kind, informant does not recall), Savage driving with Whitehorn riding on back seat; that they drove away going up the hill and in the direction of Dial Hill; that later he saw Savage at the house but never again saw Whitehorn alive.

This informant, though reputed to be honest and reliable, is of a very low mental type and has suffered a paralytic interference which has impaired his articulation to the extent that it is very difficult for him to talk and be understood. Upon being questioned in detail, it is very apparent that informant is very uncertain as to just what he did see.

- AT OKLAHOMA CITY -

Minnie Savage and Hattie Whitehorn were questioned separately in detail by this Agent and by this Agent and U. S. Attorney Roy St. Lewis, but failed to establish corroboration of Monroe Harris' allegations, or any information or leads concerning murder of Whitehorn.

Attention is respectfully called to the fact that an extensive investigation was begun shortly after the murder of Whitehorn by private detectives, employed by wife of deceased, and state and county officials of Osage County, resulting in the arrest of Minnie Savage, Earl Savage, Hattie Whitehorn, Dewey Sutton and others by County officials and their later release on account of insufficient evidence to warrant prosecution.

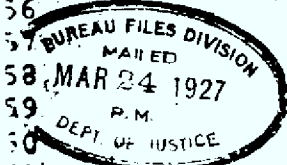

What he desired was information concerning the murders in Osage County which are now pending in the State Courts. He was especially interested in securing all available information concerning the details of the death or murder of Attorney Vaughn, whose body was found, apparently having been thrown from a moving train, while Vaughn was on his way from Oklahoma City to Pawhuska, after he had conferred with an Indian client, named Bigheart, who later died under suspicious circumstances in Oklahoma City.

I gave Mr. King the benefit of all the information collected by me during the period that I worked on the Osage murder cases.

With reference to my letter of the 26th ultimo advising that Agent F. S. Smith had been instructed to continue to assist for an additional period of not more than two weeks, T. J. Leahy, Osage Tribal Attorney and C. K. Templeton, County Attorney of Osage County, Oklahoma, in the investigation of the murder of Anna Brown, please be advised that Agent Smith completed the assignment in question on May 7th last and returned to Oklahoma City.

Agent Smith informs me that in the course of his investigation he interviewed numerous persons at Pawhuska, Fairfax, Shidler, Ralston, Oklahoma, and vicinity, in an effort to secure witnesses who could corroborate the state's evidence previously obtained and who could impeach defense witnesses suspected of having given perjured testimony at the previous trial of this matter. Agent Smith advised that he was successful in uncovering witnesses of this character and also in developing new evidence refuting the perjured testimony of the defense. Agent Smith also secured evidence to be used to rebut a concerted plan of the defense to impeach important state witnesses.

The information and facts developed by Agent Smith were submitted to Mr. Templeton and Mr. Leahy, both of whom expressed their appreciation for the services rendered by the Bureau in this connection.

This letter is to advise you of Agent Smith's return to headquarters and to, in a general way, set forth what he endeavored to do in the way of assisting the state in the investigation
