New York, appropriate local authorities covering his present
location should also be advised. When Wilkins is located, he
should be interviewed to determine if he has any suspects in
this matter or knows who might use the initials "K.P."

From a review of information submitted to date, it appears that the post card containing this threat was mailed in the Chicago area. If this is true, Chicago should make inquiry with local authorities to determine if they have any knowledge of any person who might use the summer of the containing this containing the containi

Any logical investigation should be conducted by Chicago and upon receipt of Laboratory examinations requested, Chicago will submit two copies of a closing report. Designate one copy for W. S. Attorney, Chicago. Do not consult W. S. Attorney in this matter as Department reserves the right to make all prosecutive decisions in cases of this type. Interview of Wilkins should be included in Chicago closing report. All phases of this matter should be expedited and Bureau kept advised of all pertisent developments.

THREAT TO LIFE OF BOY VILKINS NATIONAL ASSOCIATION FOR THE ADVANCEMENT OF COLORED PROPLE JULY 16, 1963
RACIAL MATTERS

On July 16, 1963, Mr. Granville Reed, Program Assistant, National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP), 431 South Dearborn Street, Chicago, Illinois, advised the Chicago Division, Federal Bureau of Investigation that he was in receipt on this date of a postal card addressed to the NAACP, 431 South Dearborn, Chicago, Illinois. Mr. Reed stated the card arriving in the morning mail is believed to have been mailed at Chicago, Illinois although the postmark is not thoroughly legible.

On the reverse of the post card is the following message:

#### "ATTENTION;

## All N.A.A.C.P. members!

If your head, Roy Wilkens wants to live beyond Sat. 7/20 he had better leave the country.

I worn you I make no empty threats! K. P."

Reed advised that Roy Wilkins is currently in charge of the NAACP and maintains his residence and office in New York City. He stated that on July 16, 1963, he had been in telephonic contact with Wilkins' office at New York but had determined that Wilkins was not present in the office. Reed stated that he was unable to ascertain Wilkins' whereabouts as of the time of that call.

On July 16, 1963, details concerning this matter were furnished to Human Relations Section, Chicago Police Department.

On 7/16/63 GRANVILLE REED, Program Assistant, Chicago Branch, NAACP, 431 South Dearborn Street, Chicago, Illinois, telephonically advised that the NAACP had received a postcard threatening the life of ROY WILKENS.

REED was interviewed on 7/16/63 and made available a pre-stamped postcard. The post mark on this postcard is cut off, however, it appears to have been post marked 7/15/63. The card is handwritten and is addressed to the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, 431 South Dearborn, Chicago, Illinois. The card reads as follows: "ATTENTION! All N.A.A.C.P. Members! If your head, Roy Wilkens, wants to live beyond Sat. 7/20 he had better leave the country. I warn you I make no empty threats! K. P."





He stated that he also recalls that a number of months ago his office received a crank telephone call but does not recall the contents of this call.

MOY WILKINS, Executive Secretary of the Mational Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP), was interviewed at his office, 20 West 40th Street,

that a postcard had been received at the office of the NAACP at Chicago, Illinois, which threatened his life. He had in his possession a facsimile of this postal card which had been sent to him by his Chicago office.

He said he had no suspects and did not know who might use the initials K.P.

He was informed that protection could not be afforded him by the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). He was told that the nature and contents of the threat had been brought to the attention of the New York City Police Department and that if he desired protection, he should contact that department. He had not contacted the New York City Police Department as of the time of the interview.

Mr. WILKINS said he did not inform his wife of the receipt of the threat as he did not want to unduly alarm her. He said his wife is employed on the staff of the Commissioner of Welfare, City of New York. She is director of Community Relations and is employed in the offices of New York City Department of Welfare, 250 Church Street, on the 14th floor. The telephone number is DI 4-8700, extension 615.

Mr. WILKINS pointed out he had attended a convention of the NAACP in Chicago, and he had left Chicago on July 7, 1963, traveling to Charleston, South Carolina. He had stayed in Charleston, South Carolina, a short time and then traveled by train to New York, arriving at noon, July 8, 1963.




