SF 9-998 reviewed in an attempt to develoge logical suspects in this case with negative results. On April 6, 1954, the Washington Field Office advised that the contents of the instant letter had been furnished to . . of the Metropolitan Folice Department and to Captain **5** of the United States Canitol Police. At Cakland, Californias pr, United States Post Office, was interviewed in an effort to develop leads from the envelope in which the message was contained. that the figure 2 appearing in the postmark on the envelope indicated that the envelope had been processed by the No. 2 cancellation machine at the Post Office Annex, Oakland, California. He said that there were five such machines in the Post Office Aumex. Advised that the 6:30 PM time appearing on the postmark revealed that the envelope had gone through the camellation machine between 6:00 PM and 6:30 PM. Regarding the collection of stated that sixteen post office trucks make pick upe from mailboxes throughout the city of Ockland and all letters are deposited, postmarked and canceled at the Post Office Assex in Oakland. He advised that it was impossible to determine from the cancellation or postmark on the envelope in which section of the sity of Cakland the envelope had been smiled. Regarding the stamps on the envelope, he stated that the two two cent stamps appearing on the envelope were from a coil of stamps rather than a sheet of stamps. He said that this type of stamp is available in stamp machines at the main post office and stamp machines located in drug stores and other business houses throughout Oakhand. He farther advised that these coils of stamps were sold to numerous basiness houses throughout Cakland, California, where they are installed in plactic dispensers for use in business mailing. He advised that it was impossible from the nature of the stamps to ascertain from where they were obtained. advised that the cancellation containing the 24556


TE -- 298 message "California Public Schools Week, etc." was of no significance since all mail from the Oakland Post Office on March 18, 1954, would bear this cancellation notice. An examination of the content of the threatening letter revealed J. Butter that it appeared possible that the subject had written prior letters expressing his opinion of Senator McCARTHY. A review was conducted of crank letters written to the Cakland, California, "Tribune" from January 1, 195h to the present time. Wo letter that appeared similar to the instant letter in content, form and nature of typing was noted. San Francisco T-1, of known reliability, was interviewed and was unable to provide any further information of value to this investigation. 

HC CANNEY - VESTIM EXTORTION The Senator by letter dated March 24, 1954, furnished a lotter to the Dureau which he felt contained a threat against him. The Senator's letter was admowledged on March 30, 1951. He was advised that in view of the possible threat investigation would be instituted. (Photo of btter and envelope attached) The San Prancisco Division contacted the United States Attorney for an opinion and he advised that he deferred opinion regarding prosecution and requested investigation in an attempt to locate and interview the unknown subject. Considerable investigation was conducted by the San Francise Division without identifying the subject By airtel dated aril 15, 1954, the San French pivision advised investigation thus far was negative and that the U. S. Attorney at San Prancisco was recontacted and prosecution was declined. The U.S. Attorney advised that because of the political nature of the letter it indicated anyone of an unlimited number of opponents of the victim might have written the letter. Therefore, further investigation was unwarranted. The above is for your information.
