

Dear Sir:

The information furnished herewith concerns an individual who is believed to be covered by the agreement between the FBI and Secret Service concerning Presidential protection, and to fall within the category or categories checked.

1. Has attempted or threatened bodily harm to any government official or employee, including foreign government officials residing in or planning an imminent visit to the U. S., because of his official status.
2. Has attempted or threatened to redress a grievance against any public official by other than legal means.
3. Because of background is potentially dangerous; or has been identified as member or participant in communist movement; or has been under active investigation as member of other group or organization inimical to U. S.
4. U. S. citizens or residents who defect from the U. S. to countries in the Soviet or Chinese Communist blocs and return.
5. Subversives, ultrarightists, racists and fascists who meet one or more of the following criteria:
 - (a) Evidence of emotional instability (including unstable residence and employment record) or irrational or suicidal behavior;
 - (b) Expressions of strong or violent anti-U. S. sentiment;
 - (c) Prior acts (including arrests or convictions) or conduct or statements indicating a propensity for violence and antipathy toward good order and government.
6. Individuals involved in illegal bombing or illegal bomb-making.

On May 13, 1970, Agent [REDACTED], Liaison Division, United States Secret Service, 1800 G Street, N.W., Washington, D.C., made available an envelope addressed to Pig Ted Kennedy, Boston, Massachusetts, with return address [REDACTED] Williminton, which was received May 6, 1970, by Senator Kennedy's Office. Contained in this envelope were nine unidentified newspaper clippings with pencil printing containing threats to the Senator. Copies of this letter and results of examinations conducted by the FBI Laboratory and Identification Division are attached.

The United States Secret Service made a check of their name files and visual files of previously submitted letters which indicated that this was another in a series from the same individual who has been submitting similar letters since 1965 to prominent individuals. All attempts to identify this individual have been negative to date. The United States Capitol Police and the Intelligence Division of the Metropolitan Police Department were advised of the receipt of this material.

On May 18, 1970, facts of this matter were presented to Assistant United States Attorney Nicholas S. Nunzio, who declined prosecution since in his opinion the case lacks prosecutive merit.

On May 19, 1970, the opinion of Assistant United States Attorney Nunzio was made known to Agent [REDACTED] Liaison Division, United States Secret Service.







Kenneth P. O'Donnell, at a press conference Wednesday, became the first of the gubernatorial candidates to announce specifically what his campaign strategy will be, both for the September primary and, if successful in that political war, the November election.

Although regarded as a liberal, progressive leader, one who gave himself the label "the anti-establishment candidate," O'Donnell has chosen a traditional theme of party versus party, Democrat against Republican, as the foundation of his strategy.



KENNETH P. O'DONNELL

O'Donnell doesn't say that the Democrats need revitalizing, only an attractive candidate that can win. He says the lack of desirable options in the past has forfeited victory to the Republicans.

And, of course he identifies himself as the only contending Democrat who can tip over Gov. Francis W. Sargent come election day.

Republican control of government doesn't work in the executive branch of a state in which the legislature is overwhelmingly Democratic, says O'Donnell. And this is not because the

legislature becomes obstructionist, he adds.

O'Donnell contends that, historically, his party, has led the way for all liberal and progressive programs, and that the Republicans have conceded their support only when forced to do so.


He considers Sargent highly vulnerable because of lack of accomplishment. He denounces him as an "Autumn liberal," indicating that the governor comes in with late support for programs only after they have been proven popular.

O'Donnell intends to "make Sargent a Republican, a Nixon Republican, a man who carries out Republican policy."

He says Sargent, in the spirit of the regime of former Gov. John A. Volpe, blames resistance from the Democratic legislature for failure to get things done. Behind the O'Donnell strategy is his conviction that the majority of Bay Staters prefer to vote Democratic; that the 40 percent of the voters who are registered Democrats represent a decisive base for a Democratic candidate of







Gen Douglas MacArthur has been appointed the Supreme Allied Commander to receive the Japanese surrender. Great Britain, Russia and China will be represented at the signing.

Mr. Truman presided over the glad tidings at 7 p. m. (EWT), shortly after he received Tokyo's formal reply to the Allied surrender terms.

Dublin's IRA provisional

BELFAST — The Irish Republican Army, (IRA) provisionals issued a brief announcement last night in Dublin that after the failure of truce negotiations with British administrator William Whitelaw, similar talks had been resumed by the IRA with former British prime minister Harold Wilson.

The statement was remarkable in that none of the IRA top brass in Ulster, who are effectively running the guerrilla campaign to unite the province with the Irish Republic, had any knowledge of the talks — in sharp contrast to the situation when Whitelaw met IRA leaders in a London house just before the truce breakdown over a week ago.

The woman who issued the statement declined to say who was in the IRA delegation that conferred five hours with Wilson at an undisclosed location in England.

Wilson will make a full report on the talks to Whitelaw, political sources said.

While the Dublin IRA was issuing its statement, a young Catholic priest, Fr. Jack Fitzsimmonds, was telling a press conference in Belfast's Andersonstown district that the British had not responded to the IRA's "little truce" in nearby Lenadoon, where the exclusion of Catholic refugee families from homes legally allocated to them led to four days of sustained gun battle last week.

Whitelaw had promised, in that situation, the British army would withdraw to its former positions by vacating apartments it had occupied

since Thursday as firing perches in the area. As a result of this occupation, 3000 people have fled their homes.

By late last night, the army had not moved from its positions.

(Reuter reported, however, that the troops had begun to withdraw from Lenadoon.)

(It was not clear whether the troops were evacuating all the Lenadoon flats and houses they had taken over, or how many of the 7000 soldiers would be moved out of the area.)

Fitzsimmonds said he hoped that the IRA ceasefire pledge in Lenadoon would continue. But while he spoke long-range sniper shots by the IRA on the edge of Lenadoon were answered by heavy army fire

S. Viets close on strongholds

SAIGON — House-to-house fighting raged yesterday in the provincial capital of Quang Tri, with South Vietnamese troops reported inching their way toward the walled Citadel still in North Vietnamese hands.

One unit was only 100 yards from the southeastern corner of the fortress and another airborne element was within a few

hundred yards of the northeastern corner, a field report said.







Gov. Sargent and Boston Mayor White locked horns yesterday over White's proposal to eliminate the need for state approval of the planned \$260 million Park Plaza urban renewal project.

The White proposal, Sargent warned the joint Committee on Local Affairs, would give the Boston Redevelopment Authority a license to grab

any piece of property in the city without having to account to higher authority.

He termed the measure a "step backward" in urban renewal.

White criticized the Sargent administration and State Dept. of Community Affairs Commr. Miles Mahoney for having vetoed the Park Plaza plan earlier. He said com-

munity groups favored the project and that it would be protected with adequate safeguards against abuses.

"Boston is no longer a crippled city," the mayor told the committee, "but it is lacking in federal funds. The company involved in the project put up a million dollar bond and there was nothing devious about the plan.

Secret Service is conducting an investigation at this time, at their Boston Office, in an effort to determine if the unknown subject is an individual that could be a potential danger to statesman protected by Secret Service. Their Boston Office has been instructed to coordinate their investigation with the Boston Office of the FBI.

It is noted that Boston has had previous cases in the past on the unknown subject in their files 9-2244 and 9-2139.

The Bureau has instructed that this matter must receive continuous investigative attention until fully resolved. They have instructed that the Bureau must receive a summary teletype by close of business 9/17/72 immediately followed by an LHM or report suitable for dissemination.

For the information of the Bureau, the Bureau file number in the past in this matter has been 9-50714 and 9-51213. Your pocket is filled with quarters. Two at a time, you feed them into a vending machine electronically hooked up to The Game's computer at headquarters in Newton. The vending machine prints the tickets as you pay for them and then pops them out to you. You examine the tickets, light up a cigar, and wait — nervously, of course.

At a few minutes after 4 word of the results of the drawing comes through

off-track horse race betting network, not to mention a system for betting on the results of professional sporting events! Don't think the lottery people aren't looking into these matters, too, because they are. But this is for the long-term future. The daily drawings, according to good authority, could become a reality by late next winter or early next spring.

Lottery officials have made no survey to determine how many tickets the daily lottery could be expected to sell and how

from the present rate of \$1.35 million to about \$950,000. The net gain in weekly revenue should thus be between \$600,000 and \$1.1 million. That amounts to between \$31.2 million and \$57.2 million a year.

Meanwhile, the lottery has already:

—Raised about \$17 million for distribution to the Commonwealth's 351 cities and towns at the end of this year, with \$2.9 million of this amount earmarked for the City of Boston.

—Distributed prize money of nearly \$18 million to some 100,000 win-

WASHINGTON (UPI) — In the face of heavy mail from Congress and the public, the Justice Department's Internal Security Division is "looking into" antiwar statements made by actress Jane Fonda in Hanoi. It wants to determine if she violated the 1940 Sedition Act.

Asst. Atty. Gen. A. William Olson, chief of the division, told UPI in an interview, "We don't have any plans to investigate her but we are looking at transcripts

US ships raid near Haiphong

SAIGON — Four American warships steamed to within 10 miles of Haiphong, North Vietnam's main port, to shell coastal fuel dumps and gun batteries, then sank two torpedo boats which chased after them, the US Command said yesterday.

The heavy cruiser Newport News, the light guided missile cruiser Providence, and the destroyers Robinson and Rowan hit the Cat Bi fuel storage depot two miles southeast of the Haiphong city limits and also hit shore batteries and a barracks about 10 miles farther south along the coast on Sunday.

Observers said only six secondary explosions resulted from the shelling by the warships, and their mission was seen as a defiant show of strength.

Radio Hanoi claimed yesterday that shore batteries at Haiphong set two US warships ablaze.

A Navy spokesman said shrapnel from shells fell on the signal bridge of the Robinson, but there were no injuries or damage. The shells landed about 30 feet from the ship.

craft carrier Midway swooped down to finish off the crippled boat as it headed for the beach, the command said.

It was the second raid of its kind during the current communist offensive and the first since US jets mined Haiphong and all other North Vietnamese ports early last May.

A US Command spokesman said the nearest the US ships came to the shore was between 9 and 10 miles. He added that the torpedo boats had not run through the minefields but had come from an island off Haiphong.

Vice Adm. J. L. Holloway 3d; the US 7th Fleet Commander, went along aboard the Newport News.

The announcement of the raid followed first official reports that a Chinese minesweeper had been detected lying at anchor in Haiphong Harbor, but the Command spokesman said he saw no connection between the two events and there was still no indica-

tion that the minesweeper had attempted to clear the mines.

In Washington, Defense Department sources said the 20-year-old wooden-built minesweeper can do nothing useful without reinforcements — "except perhaps get sunk by American aircraft."

"There is no sign that any more are on the way. Unless others arrive to help out, the vessel will be quite incapable of clearing the mines outside Haiphong," they said.

"Frankly, we do not know why it is there, but we are watching it very closely."

Secret Service is conducting an investigation at this time, at their Boston Office, in an effort to determine if the unknown subject is ^{an} individual that could be a potential danger to statesman protected by Secret Service. Their Boston Office has been instructed to coordinate their investigation with the Boston Office of the FBI.

It is noted that Boston has had previous cases in the past on the unknown subject in their files 9-2244 and 9-2139.

The Bureau has instructed that this matter must receive continuous investigative attention until fully resolved. They have instructed that the Bureau must receive a summary teletype by close of business 9/17/72 immediately followed by an LHM or report suitable for dissemination.

For the information of the Bureau, the Bureau file number in the past in this matter has been 9-50714 and 9-51213. Also the threat in this matter is veiled and consists of statements that are handprinted on newspaper clippings that indicate the unknown subject wishes KENNEDY to be killed and that he will be sooner or later. The unknown subject also makes statements about the KOPECHNE tragedy stating that the victim was responsible for her death.


