

### UNKNOWN SUBJECT; THREATS AGAINST SENATOR EDWARD KENNEDY PROTECTION OF THE PRESIDENT

On September 1, 1968, Chicago, Illinois, advised that his wife and himself had heard on Channel 7 Television, Chicago Station WBKB-TV, b6 at about 11:10 p.m., September 1, 1968, what they believed b7C to be a short-wave message to the effect that the assassib7D nation of Edward Kennedy was planned. This message was described as only of a momentary nature and the exact text was not known. Melrose Park, Illinois, also advised that he had heard what he believed to be a short-wave transmission on this same television INFORMANT station with words "assassination" and "another Hitler" being spoken.

CHICAGO, JLL. On September 2, 1968, Master Controller Television Station WBKB, advised that he had just completed a monitor of their television program entitled "Three Dangerous People," which had been made available for viewing in Chicago at 11:00 p.m. on September 1, 1968. Mr. advised that at 11:18 and 35 seconds p.m. in that show technical difficulties at the television station had produced b6 brief static and an audio override of some of the sound b7C from a tape recording which was being prepared for the show entitled "Garrison's Guerrillas" for showing on September 3, 1968. ______ explained that because of this difficu _ explained that because of this difficulty the words "assassination of Hitler" were heard on the audio portion of "Three Dangerous People." Mr. advised that this undoubtedly was the technical difficulty referred to and stated that there was no mention of Senator Edward Kennedy or any interruptions or interference in this show, other than that reported above.

The foregoing was made available to Special Agent United States Secret Service, Chicago, Illinois, by Special Agent August J. Baumgartner on September 2, 1968.

This document contains neither recommendations nor conclusions of the FBI. It is the property of the FBI and is loaned to your agency; it and its contents are not to be distributed outside your agency.

No further investigation is being conducted in this matter.





It appears that this is what happened on this occasion.
