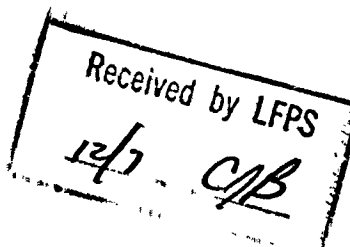

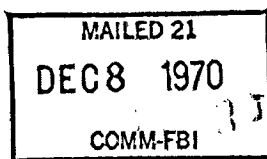

I just received a letter from Captain [redacted] of the U. S. Supreme Court Police which enclosed a Xerox copy of a letter forwarded to the Chief Justice of the United States and postmarked November 23, 1970, at Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. The letter which is signed "A Sticker For Holy Justice," bears a return address of North American Insurance Institute, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, states that the author is going to bomb Supreme Court when all nine Justices are in session unless new laws banning "pornographic junk" are passed. The author of this letter complains of permissive nudity in movies, stage plays and books. A Xerox copy of the letter is attached. A name check of the anonymous letter file in the FBI Laboratory failed to reflect any previous correspondence. Captain Coble's letter is attached.

Capitol PD, Intelligence Division, Metropolitan PD, and U. S. Secret Service, all Washington, D. C., made cognizant of the threatening letters. Inquiry, Pittsburgh PD, Allegheny County Detective Bureau, and Federal Agencies, all Pittsburgh, Pa., negative. Attempts to identify North American Insurance Institute, Pittsburgh, Pa., and "Police Association of South Hills-Mt. Lebanon, Pa.," negative. Contact with members of borough and township police associations failed to establish information concerning unsub. Examination of all letters by FBI Lab, Washington, D. C., determined letters written by same person. No latent prints of value developed.

DETAILS:

Investigation in this matter was predicated upon receipt of handwritten letters directed to the U.S. Supreme Court, the Chief Justice of the U. S. Supreme Court, and Director J. EDGAR HOOVER of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Washington, D. C.

The following undated letter was directed to the Chief Justice of the U. S. Supreme Court, Washington, D. C., in an envelope postmarked Pittsburgh, Pa., November 23, 1970, and bearing the return address, "North American Insurance Institute, Pittsburgh, Pa.?"

"Dear Chief Justice of the United States Supreme Court

"I'm going to throw a bomb on the Supreme Court of the United States of America, and destroy it, because it's no good and evil, I'll throw it while you nine Justices are in session, its occupants are no good either

"I ain't telling you when, what day, or, hour just then when you are in session, just beware and be on the alert for this action. Unless you pass new laws banning all this pornographic junk which you are allowing now in this good old country of the U.S.A.

"The United States Supreme Court of 1970 allows more permissive nudity in movies, stage plays and books than any other United States Supreme Court in the history of the U.S.A. It never was like this before, men showing their sexual organs (penis) real clear to the movie or stage audiences, also the female showing her sexual organs. Also men playing with the women's breasts, also licking them, also having orgies with them.

"The end of the world is surely coming, on account of your Court's decisions.

"You turned away the good things, prayers in school, protection of the police, you are sticking with the criminals, which you are yourself.

"These kind of dirty movies were shown down underground for stag parties, but not in decent public movie houses where good people go. You've got a lot of S.O.B. crust to allow this junk to be shown to clean audiences. The lowly animals of this world have more brains than the nine Justices of the Supreme Court of 1970. On December 7, 1970, this matter was discussed with Assistant U. S. Attorney [redacted] at Pittsburgh, Pa., by SA [redacted] of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, who advised contents of the letters involved would constitute a Federal violation of the Extortion Statute and that he would consider prosecution if the writer could be identified.

A check of the 1969 and 1970 Pittsburgh, Pa., Telephone Directories and the 1969 Pittsburgh City Directory failed to disclose an institute by the name of North American Insurance Institute.

Assistant Superintendent for the U. S. Post Office at Pittsburgh, Pa., advised that the envelopes containing the letters involved were received at the main post office at 7th Avenue and Grant Streets, Pittsburgh, Pa., as the numbers 4B and 3B appearing in the cancellation indicate the envelope was run through the automatic cancelling machines located at the main office. It was his opinion that the envelopes could have been mailed anywhere in the City of Pittsburgh, and thereafter transported to the main post office.

It was also determined that no Post Office Box was retained by an institute known as the North American Insurance Institute and that the Polk Directory also failed to disclose an institute under this name.

Inquiry at the latter association disclosed that the North American Insurance Institute was not a member of this organization, and that the Pittsburgh Insurance Directory published by the National Underwriters Association failed to disclose such an organization.

Chief of Police GEORGE GESSINGER of the Mt. Lebanon, Pa., Police Department advised that to the best of his knowledge, there was no "Police Association of South Hills-Mt. Lebanon, Pa." He stated that there was the Borough and Township Police Association for South Hills, Pa., and that subsequent contact with the Directors and known members of this association determined that the association had not received any correspondence similar to the letters involved.

Chief GESSINGER stated that his department had received several complaints and pieces of correspondence concerning one [redacted] who presently resides at [redacted] [redacted] Pittsburgh, Pa., 15234. Chief GESSINGER made available his file concerning [redacted] and it was determined handwriting of [redacted] was available, however, the correspondence therein did not appear to contain any information of a similar nature contained in the threatening letters to the Supreme Court and Director HOOVER. Chief GESSINGER made available a small 3 x 5 piece of paper containing the known handwriting of [redacted]

Mr. WILLIAM JOSEPH BAUMGARTNER, 63 Vassar Avenue, West View, Pa., was interviewed in the vicinity of his residence and prior to the interview he was advised of the nature of the investigation and of the identities of the interviewing Agents. He was thereafter advised of his rights both orally and by use of the form entitled, "Interrogation; Advice of Rights," which he read, stated that he understood, and subsequently executed. He voluntarily furnished the following information:

He had attended the play "Hair," the Saturday before last Saturday, which was February 6, 1971, and he had not particularly liked the play as he felt that it was somewhat obnoxious. He had attended the play with his wife at the Nixon Theater in downtown Pittsburgh, Pa., and paid approximately \$5.00 for the performance. He stated that he did not write a threatening letter to the Manager of the Nixon Theater and had no knowledge of anyone that was responsible for the writing of this letter.

He stated that he had no objection to furnishing samples of his handwriting to the interviewing Agents on a voluntary basis after he was advised of the use of the use of the handwriting samples and that he had a constitutional right to refuse to furnish same. At this point, six pages of BAUMGARTNER's handwriting were obtained.

BAUMGARTNER then consented to furnish his fingerprints to the interviewing Agents after he was advised of the intended use of the fingerprints and his constitutional right to refuse to furnish same.

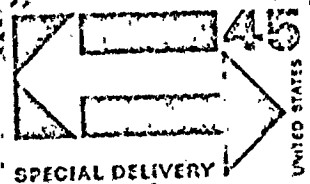

During the course of this investigation, February, March, and April, 1971, contact has been maintained on a regular basis with the U. S. postal inspectors at Pittsburgh, Pa., the U. S. Secret Service, the Pittsburgh, Pa., Police Department, the Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms Division, the McKeesport, Pa., Police Department, the Homestead, Pa., Police Department, as well as numerous other police departments in Allegheny County. During these contacts the various letters attributable to the unknown subject were exhibited in an effort to determine whether any of these departments or their personnel received or observed any such writing or printing. Personnel of these agencies all advised that their files were negative concerning letter communications and were unable to furnish possible suspects as to the letter writer.

[redacted] North Versailles, Pennsylvania, telephone number [redacted] was interviewed at his home and prior to the interview, he was advised of the nature of the investigation and of the identity of the interviewing Agents. He was thereafter advised of his rights orally and also by use of a form entitled "Interrogation; Advice of Rights," which he read, stated that he understood, and executed. He voluntarily furnished the following information:

He was presently [redacted] years old and a member of the National Socialist White Peoples Party and a firm and dedicated believer of their ideology. He stated that he was aware of the recent arrest of [redacted] in Akron, Ohio, and [redacted] plot to bomb Holy Rosary Church in the Brushton section of Pittsburgh, Pa., and stated that [redacted] was not considered a member of the National Socialist White Peoples Party, inasmuch as he had been expelled from the Party. [redacted] was in a separate faction and one of the only followers of [redacted] in the Pittsburgh area was a [redacted] pq.

He stated that he was unaware of the fact that threatening letters had been sent to the Manager of the Nixon Theatre in Pittsburgh, Pa., concerning the play "Hair" and emphatically denied any knowledge of these letters. He stated that the National Socialist White Peoples Party in the Pittsburgh area had no particular feelings about the play "Hair" and in fact one of the members, named [redacted] had attended the play with his girlfriend, name unknown. [redacted] had gone to the play the Saturday after Christmas with a girlfriend and according to [redacted] he had enjoyed the play very much and had also bought a record of the score of the play. He, himself, had not attended the play. [redacted] was a white male, age [redacted] who presently resided at [redacted] Allison Park, Pa., and was a [redacted] His telephone number was [redacted] He highly doubted whether [redacted] would write any letters concerning the Nixon Theatre and would undoubtedly not send any letters to Mr. J. EDGAR HOOVER of the FBI, or the United States Supreme Court.

He stated that his personal philosophy coincided with that of the National Socialist White Peoples Party and that was that the United States of America was the last bastion of white power. He did not believe in violence, but believed in change through peaceful means, such as the ballot box. He believed that the National Socialist White Peoples Party was the only real defense against the Communists all over the world.

He further advised that the reason that the National Socialist White Peoples Party had singled out the Jews as a group, which they wanted to separate from the rest of the white race, was because the Jews identified with subversive activities. He stated that 85 percent of the Communist Party was Jewish and that Jews considered themselves separate racially and ethically. His organization considered any individual of the Caucasian race that was not Jewish to be Aryan. He stated that his Party also wanted a separation of the Negro race from the American community, because the Black peoples had never developed culturally in any part of the world and their background showed that they had never developed a refined culture by themselves. He felt that Blacks were inferior to whites and did not want them mixing with whites. His organization did not care if the Jews and Negroes mixed, but they did not want Jews and Negroes mixing with the rest of the white race. As long as a person was not Black and not a Jew, they were considered brothers of the National Socialist White Peoples Party.

He further advised that in his opinion, the National news media was corrupt and the reason why it was corrupt was because it was controlled by the Jews. He stated that the Jews have control over all of the newspapers in the nation and that they control the other segments of the News media that they did not own by refusing to advertise. He cited an instance when the Anti-Defamation League wrote a letter to the Scribner's Publishing Company in reference to a book called "Conquest of a Continent," by MADISON GRANT, which was an anti-Jewish book and the Anti-Defamation League told Scribner's not to publish this book under threats because it was anti-Jewish. He did not elaborate on the threats set forth by the Anti-Defamation League.

[redacted] was interviewed at Apt. 4, McKeen Rocks, Pa., and, prior to the interview, he was advised of the nature of the investigation and the identities of the interviewing agents. He was subsequently advised of his rights by use of a form "Interrogation; Advice of Rights," which he stated that he understood but did not wish to sign. He voluntarily furnished the following information:

He knew [redacted] from Akron, Ohio, and had known [redacted] for a year or less. He met [redacted] through the National Socialist White Peoples Party and had assisted [redacted] in the operation of [redacted] book store in Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio, which is a suburb of Akron. The book store was one that sold National Socialist-type literature. [redacted] had gotten into some legal trouble for selling guns to minors at that time and had the charges finally dropped.

He stated that [redacted] was the type of individual who had no personal friends, but [redacted] might have confided in him. He stated that he would rather not give the names of other associates of [redacted] who were involved in the National Socialist White Peoples Party. [redacted] had not mentioned to him a plot to bomb the Holy Rosary Church in Pittsburgh, Pa., and he was very surprised when [redacted] was arrested for the plot. [redacted] had never discussed any planned bombings with him concerning that church or any other establishment.

He stated that he was last in Akron, Ohio, seven or eight weeks ago and he saw [redacted] then. He traveled to Akron to see [redacted] mainly because they traded reading material back and forth, and this literature, of course, was National Socialist-type literature. He formerly went each week when the book store was open, but the book store closed around October, 1970. He had only been in Akron, Ohio, two or three times since the book store closed.

He stated that he did not wish to comment on whether [redacted] were known to him.

He did not know of any plans of both [] as [] to bomb any buildings in Akron, Ohio, or anyone else.

He stated he had no knowledge of the bombing of the Stanley Theater in Pittsburgh or of any threatening letter sent to the manager of the Nixon Theater in Pittsburgh concerning the play "Hair." He had no knowledge of the attempted bombing of the residence of [] in Akron and knew only of [] as the head of the Akron "Beacon-Journal."

He had never purchased any explosives or explosive devices and denied ever receiving devices through the mails from anyone, stating he wouldn't want to do anything illegal. He had military training but no demolition training. He had no knowledge of building an explosive device beyond that which the ordinary citizen would possess.

He advised that he had never been a member of the National Socialist White Peoples Party and was only an active supporter. He stated that the party was all split up in the Pittsburgh area. [] had been a member of the party but was no longer one. He believed and agreed with the basic philosophy of the National Socialist White Peoples Party and formerly received all of their publications but received none now.

He refused to comment on whether he knew [] or not and refused to talk about any individuals associated with the National Socialist White Peoples Party in the Pittsburgh, Pa., area.

During the course of the interview, a weapon was observed in his room, and he advised that the weapon was a 6.5 caliber Italian carcano, bolt-action carbine, and he advised that he did, in fact, own some other weapons, which included pistols, but refused to comment on whether he owned any illegal weapons, again stating that he would not want to do anything illegal.
