According to an article that appeared in the "Los Angeles Times", October 13, 1946, JAY RICHARD KENNEDY, after becoming unusually successful in property management and as an investment consultant, came to the attention of and was friendly with Government "bigwigs" and top industrialists, and he was, for example, friendly with Secretary of the Treasury MORGENTHAU and the heads of various subdivisions of the Treasury Department. According to the article, he received permission from the Treasury Department to write the script for the production, "Assigned to Treasury".



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The magazine section of the "New York Herald Tribune", issue of March 7, 1968, contains an article by JAY RICHARD KENNEDY entitled "One World Against Dope", stating that KENNEDY was author and co-producer of the production, "To the Ends of the Earth", released by Columbia Pictures, and that this picture had been made with the cooperation of the Treasury Department and was pased on Treasury Department files.
