

This letter is written through righteous indignation for members of a court I firmly believe will destroy our democratic way of life by doing away with all principles that have been the foundation of our culture,

I love this country, and while building my empire I devoted millions in time and money to insure a greater america for our future generations. At this point I am completely disillusioned by the rulings of the Supreme Court that have contributed most to the deteriation of our american way of life. You have devoted more time to the protection of criminals than law abiding taxpayers. The Courts may force the most learned attorney to take time out and represent the most worthless criminal. You have encouraged the more haneous crimes by abolishing capital punishment.

What is more cruel and unusual than the punishment now imposed on the Hearst family? If these Canibals are apprehended, the law enforcement officials can not inquire as to their names or identity until they have first provided them with computent counsel at the expense of the taxpayer they have offended.

The Hearst case is the last straw. I can stand no more! I have never broken the law, but I promise you here and now that if the Hearst girl is killed, or even molested, I shall make the necessary contacts, and pay interested, six million dollars to have six of your members killed. That may shock this country back to reason and logic. Probably those that follow will spend less time protecting and encouraging criminals



On March 12, 1974, the Washington Field Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation furnished a xerox copy of a letter obtained from U. S. Secret Service in Washington, D.C. This letter was addressed to the Chief Justice, United Supreme Court, Washington, D.C. and was postmarked Selmer, Tennessee, February 20, p.m., 1974, 38375. The letter was marked personal."

The latter is typewritten and is set out as follows:

"February 17, 1974

"The Chief Justice United States Supreme Court Supreme Court Building Washington, D.C.

"Mr. Chief Justice:

"This letter is written through righteous indignation for members of a court I firmly believe will destroy our democratic way of life by doing away with all principles that have been the foundation of our culture.

"I love this country, and while building my empire I devoted millions in time and money to insure a greater america for our future generations. At this point I am completely disillusioned by the rulings of the Supreme Court that have contributed most be the deteriation of our american way of life. You have devoted more time to the protection of criminals than law abiding taxpayers. The Courts may force the most learned attorney to take time out and represent the most worthless criminal. You have encouraged the more haneous crimes by abolishing capital punishment.

"What is more cruel and unusual than the punishment now imposed on the Hearst family? If these Canibals are apprehended, the law enforcement officials can not inquire as to their names or identity until they have first provided them with computent counsel at the expense of the taxpayer they have offended.

"Do not be misled by this type. I have not typed in 50 years. This is typed on a machine over 1000 miles from my office, and will be mailed here. There will be no prints, but believe you me, I mean what I say.

"You know my first, middle & last name."

It should be noted that the letter is completely typewritten with the exception of the numbers 20510 written after Washington, D.C. on the envelope.

On March 19, 1974, the facts of this matter were discussed with U. S. Attorney THOMAS F. TURLEY, JR., Memphis, Tennessee. Mr. TURLEY advised that this matter should be investigated. He advised that if the unknown subject is identified and is a resident of the Western District of Tennessee, he will consider prosecution.

On March 22, 1974, SA was recontacted and advised that to date no suspects have been developed by his agency.

On March 19, 1974 and March 20, 1974, the following employees of the U.S. Post Office in Selmer, Tennessee were interviewed. All advised that they could not recall seeing any letter postmarked in Selmer, Tennessee addressed to the Chief Justice of the United Supreme Court, Washington, D.C.:

He advised that the zip code written on the envelope does not appear to be the writing of any of his employees. He further advised that the zip code number 20510 is for the U.S. Senate in Washington, D.C. and not the U.S. Supreme Court.
