## RONCZAK RESIGNS FROM COMMITTEE ON DEFENSE HERE

## Health Commissioner's Withdrawal Strips Group of All City Officials

Health Commissioner Fronczak, following the example set by other city department heads, today resigned from the Niagara Frontier Defense Committee and thus stripped the organization of all its city-administration membership.

Dr. Fronczak made known his decision to leave the organization in the following statement:

"Due to the hectic conditions in these chaotic times, I am severing my connection with a number of non-official organizations, including the Niagara Frontier Defense Committee.

Caught in the middle of a citywide controversy because of its consideration of a resolution advocating an immediate declaration of war against Germany, the Niagara Frontier Defense Committee today delayed preparation of a substitute resolution until public reaction has shown what its policies should be.

#### McClellyn Resigns

Chairman Chauncey J. Hamlin, who sponsored the pro-war resolution, is convinced that public discussion of the question was "tend-ing to clarify the situation."

Meanwhile, following action by Mayor Holling, Fire Commissioner Castimore and Public Works Commissioner Louis A. Harding, Police Commissioner McClellan announced his resignation from the committee. However, Chairman Hamlin said his organization would continue as an unofficial body.

"We are no longer responsible for the defense of Buffalo," Mr. Hamlin explained. "The official defense council, appointed by Mayor Holling, now has charge of that. It will be our duty to see that the defense council operates and actually does something."

The latest attack on the committee for its consideration of the Hamlin resolution came from C. S. Farrar, 29 Oakland pl.

"Untimely, Unthoughtful"

"You have subversively and openly committed yourself to the promotion of American intervention into foreign wars," Mr. Farrar wrote Mr. Hamlin.

"As an individual supporting such a contention, I submit to the legality of your premises But inas-much as you support such a con-tention within the role of your public duties, I am movel to condemn your utterances."

Mr. Farrar continued that the statement was "both untimely and unthoughtful."

"Will history justify your con-tentions?" he asked. "Or are you being led along by some tinkling and shadowy illusion that you are the almighty seer and omniscient dictator of men's minds?"

Mr. Farrar said he made his statement to Mr. Hamlin "entirely on my own and not at the instigation of anyone or any organiza-

#### Warned of Appeasement

Chairman Hamlin announced that he had replied to protests from the Women's Christian Temperance Union by sending them copies of a sermon by the Rt. Rev. Henry Wise Hobson, Episcopal bishop of Southern Ohio.

Bishop Hobson warned the United States to "shun the road to appeasement and to realize that man cannot exist half slave and

half free.'

A similar letter was sent to Mrs. George W. Thorn of the Eric County W. C. T. U., who had framed the organization's original letter to Mr. Hamlin.

Mr. Hamlin said he had received letters from persons willing to fill vacancies resulting from with-

drawas from his group.

He also has received some additional cash contributions toward the organization's support since the controversy arose. The money is turned over to the treasurer, Marc W. Comstock, for office and other incidental expenses.

the author, advised that she had had some dealing with the subject regarding the transfer of Rueckwanderer marks for her from German banks to this country during the past year. Mrs. REBACK stated that she had received many thousand Rueckwanderer Marks on different occasions this year, but that she could not recall the exact figures. She said that these marks were paid to her from an account in one of the serman banks in which they had been deposited as a result of reyalties paid to her account for her books "Dynasty of Death" and "The Earth is the Lords". She stated that these books of hers had been best sellers in Germany, as well as elsewhere in the world, including the United States, and that she would advise the writer the amounts she had received from Germany for the sale of these books.

Mrs. REBACK stated further that the subject had handled, these transactions for Schoellkopf, Hutton and Pomercy, but that her relations with the subject were none too cordial as her husband was Jowish, and that she was known to the subject as being against the present regime in Germany. She advised Agent that the German Government had been very friendly to her and that German newspapers had placed her books as showing many of the frailties of Democratic Governments. She said that at one time she had been offered a German decoration by the German Consul in New York City, but that she had declined this decoration. She stated that she had difficulty in making a recenttransfer of some 10,000 Rueckwanderer Marks from Germany, and that she had finally called and advised him that she would be glad to have him relay information to the German Government that this sum could be paid to the German Red Cross for the sole purpose of relieving human suffering in Germany. She said that the subject has been especially cordial and friendly toward her since she gave him this authority.

Mrs. REBACK further advised that several New York columnists hadmentioned her name under the question "What American writer has been the only American writer to receive money from Germany for the sale of her books in Germany during recent months?" Mrs. REBACK left at the Buffalo Field Office a copy of a translation of a review of her books, which review was printed in the Voelkischer Beobachter, Muenchen (The National Observer, Munich). Mrs. REBACK stated that she resented any implications that she was friendly toward the German Government, but felt that she might be able to help the United States, and particularly

the Federal Bureau of Investigation, to a greater extent if she remained on somewhat friendly terms with the subject in the instant case.

Mrs. REBACK further stated that she had negotiated with subject. For a long period of time regarding the transfer of funds from Germany, and that finally the subject had suggested that she contact the German Consul General in New York City and see what could be done regarding the transfer of money deposited to her account in Germany. Upon this recommendation of subject, she had gone to visit the Consul General in New York City, and stayed at the Commodore Hotel. The said that this was during fugust 1940, and that on this occasion she had been interviewed by the German Consul General, and at the time she was in his office she had seen him in conversation with Colonel CHARLES A. LINDBLAGH and Senator BURTON WHEELER; that she had told the New York newspapers about this but that they had declined to give it any publicity for fear of a law suit and told her it was merely her word against theirs and they felt this was insufficient protection for them were they to print this story.


the exact amounts in German Rueckwanderer Marks and American money which she had received from Germany. Subsequent to this, she stated she had called the subject on the telephone and requested this information, and that he had been very disturbed and apparently irritated by her request and had talked very gruffly and sharply with her and had asked her why she wanted this information, whereupon she had told him she wanted the information for purposes of making out her income tax before she went to California. The subject had stated that he did not know whether he could give her this information and that she should try to find out through her own accounts what payments have been made to her, but that if she desired, he would check his records and give her this information. She advised that she would immediately advise the Buffalo Field Office upon receipt of this further information.

Mrs. NEBACK stated that at one time, German bankers had suggested that they purchase a home for her in Germany with the money deposited in her account, and that she come to Germany with her family and live in a beautiful bungalow. She had declined this information because she did not trust the German Government, and said that one of the reasons for her distrust of the German Government was that she felt

she had been locked in the German Consul General's office when she had gone to New York City in August 1940. She stated that on that occasion, the German Consul had left the room and did not return for some time and that she had tried to leave his office but found the lower locked; that after she had created some disturbance, the door was opened and she was permitted to leave, although the German Consul General had told her at the time that the door was not locked and had tracked her as though she was ill.

Mrs. REBACK further stated that the subject had told that that he could not advise her to whom the Rueckwanderer Marks had then sold in this country, but that the first lot of Marks received for her account were purchased for 7½ per Mark and the second lot had been purchased in the United States for 5½ per Mark, and that the transactions had been handled by Hardy and Company of New York City. She said she had had dealings with a man named NUELLER, who she advised was also employed by Schoellkopf, Hutton and Pomercy but who was not the least bit friendly toward the German Government. She was not quite sure of this man's first name, but thought it was FELIX.
