I realize that most of the time of the bureau is probably being spent investigating the Black Panthers, and the SDS, etc. I would like to have some answers to these questions concerning another 'underrated' group which I feel are presently of the greatest danger to this and the future America. This group is known as Hell's Angels.

First of all, if you are at liberty to answer this, what investigative measures are being taken or used on this group? Why are you presently refraining from the arrest of the Angel's as accomplices to the murder of Meredith Unter, who was killed at the Rolling Stones free concert in California? Is any action being taken on the part of the Committee on Un-American activities to attempt to disband these people? Can you inform me of any psychological data or observations concerning the stability of the men who engage in such activities?

I wish to thank you for taking time out to read this letter and I would be more than appreciative if a reply is sent. again, thank you.

I received your letter of January 16th. With respect to your queries, the FBI conducts a considerable amount of investigation regarding the activities of those individuals and organizations which seek to undermine our basic freedoms and threaten the internal security of our country. The results of our inquiries are furnished to the Department of Justice which has the responsibility for determining whether prosecution is warranted in these matters. We will endeavor to make every effort to carry out our duties in the internal security field with the highest degree of thoroughness and dispatch.

Concerning the alleged murder of Meredith Hunter on December 6, 1969, at a concert in California, this is a matter within the jurisdiction of local authorities and this Bureau cannot investigate it.

Regarding your other inquiry, the House Committee on Un-American Activities is now known as the House Committee on Internal Security. I suggest you contact this Committee directly at Room 309, Cannon House Office Building, Washington, D. C. 20515.

In view of your interest, enclosed is material relating to some of our work which you may not have had the opportunity to read.

# Cops, Hells Angels And 'Reprisals'

By **Donovan Bess**

Law enforcement officials testified in Oakland yesterday that the Hells Angels are prone to take violent reprisals against persons who "snitch" on Angels who break the law.

An Oakland police officer said the fear is so great that one police informer declared he would rather go to prison for 20 years than risk the wrath of the bike-riding, leather-jacketed Angels.

The testimony was presented through Deputy District Attorney John Burke in the trial of Alan David Passaro, a Hells Angel, for the murder last December of 18-year-old Meredith Hunter.

### STAGE

The killing took place in front of a stage during a rock concert at the Altamont Speedway near Livermore — in front of a crowd estimated at 300,000 persons.

Dozens of persons probably saw young Hunter stabbed by a man wearing what appeared to be an Angels' jacket. But Burke reportedly has lined up only a few persons to testify to the murder.

One of these, a young man identified only as Paul Cox, last week told an a faltering voice of seeing Hunter stabbed in the back by a "short and very stocky man." He has not testified that the assailant is Passaro.

Yesterday Superior Court Judge William J. Hayes ordered a jury of eight men and four women out of his

Alameda County court room while police officials described the bad reputation of the Angels throughout the State.

William Bennett, who heads a special intelligence detail for the California At-

torney General, testified "We consider them to be one of the more violent outlaw motorcycle groups in the State of California."

He said information from other law enforcement agencies show that cases against Angels are not prosecuted "because witnesses have refused to testify — they were scared."

Oakland police officer James Carreker who works with narcotics offenders was asked by Burke whether the Angels directed violence toward informers.

### THREATS

"They are taking care of people who snitch on them," he replied. He said this involved "severe beatings and threats of a actually being done away with."

He testified: "One person told me he would rather go to the State Penitentiary for 20 years than be involved with Hells Angels and get caught at it."

He said the Angels have had pads from which they deal narcotics.

"Informants have related to me," said Carreker, "that they flatly refuse to do any work involving Hells Angels."

# Local Hells Angels Win Resident's Muted Praise

By PAUL L. MONTGOMERY

## But 8 Out-of-Town Members Are Held in Rape Near 3rd St. Clubhouse

There were five Hells Angels on the grimy stoop outside their clubhouse at 77 East Third Street yesterday afternoon, keeping an eye on the gleaming choppers lined up at the curb.

One was asked how things were going. "Outtasight," he replied. "Outtasight."

Downtown at the Tombs, eight out-of-town members of the motorcycle club were being held without bail for a hearing Wednesday, charged with forcible rape, sodomy and unlawful imprisonment in connection with a gang assault on a 17-year-old girl in an East Village leather-goods shop.

The police and community leaders, discussing the Wednesday evening assault, were careful to draw a distinction between the out-of-town Hells Angels and the local residents who live a communal life in the clubhouse.

"I'm not trying to paint a rosy picture," said Deputy Inspector Mario L. Gabos, commander of the Ninth Precinct. "But the group of Hells Angels that reside here have not created significant police problems for us. When they are visited by their cohorts, otherwise known as 'brothers,' from various parts of the United States, then we have problems."

"They're not saints, but they have been cooperative," said the Rev. Anthony DelBarto of Most Holy Redeemer Catholic Church, on Third Street, who has taken an interest in the motorcycle club.

"They try to make a minimum of noise when they rev up at night, and I've had people tell me they'd rather walk down Third Street than other streets around here—at least they know they won't be mugged."

Inspector Gabos said there had been no street robberies this year on Third Street between First and Second Avenues, where the Angels clubhouse is. He said that was a "fairly unusual" statistic for his hippie prelect, where the crime rate is high.

The inspector said that Sand Alexander, the president of the local club, had been "very cooperative" in the pre-

According to the police, a large group of the Angels went to the leather shop of Eugene Pritzert at 99 East Fourth Street. Mr. Pritzert often does work for the club. While there, the group saw Mr. Pritzert's 17-year-old girlfriend, who had been sleeping in a loft attached to the store.

The girl said later that she had been beaten and raped for six hours by members of the gang while others held Mr. Pritzert captive. The store owner eventually escaped and summoned the police, who made the eight arrests.

Inspector Gabos said the incident was the only serious one recently involving Hells Angels. He said many complaints stemmed not from actual crimes but from the intimidating appearance of the Angels, who favor wild hair, boots and motorcycle clothes.

"They do have a terrifying appearance," the inspector said. "But like Roosevelt said, There is nothing to fear but fear itself."

precinct's active community relations program. Mr. Alexander, he said, informed him when there was likely to be trouble, such as an "invasion" by the fival Pagan club of Long Island.

Mrs. Nettie DiMauro, a member of the Ninth Precinct Community Council, said she had found the local Angels "very community-minded" at local meetings. "I guess this is the way they want to live," she said. "They're very, very intelligent people."

Wednesday's trouble apparently began with the arrival here of dozens of out-of-town Hells Angels for the funeral of Jeffrey (Groover) Coffey, a member of the local club. The 22-year-old youth was one of five people killed last Saturday in a gang fight at the Motorcycle Custom and Trade Show in Cleveland.

UKIAH, CALIF. (UPI) -- FOUR MEMBERS OF THE HELL'S ANGELS MOTORCYCLE CLUB HAVE BEEN ARRESTED IN CONNECTION WITH THE SLAYING OF THREE PERSONS WHOSE BODIES WERE FOUND IN AN ABANDONED WELL.

POLICE SAID THERE WAS A POSSIBILITY OF MORE ARRESTS.

AFTER TWO DAYS OF DIGGING ON A REMOTE 153-ACRE RANCH IN NORTHERN CALIFORNIA, MENDOCINO COUNTY SHERIFF RENO BARTOLOMIE SUSPENDED SEARCH FOR MORE BODIES WEDNESDAY. *victim CALIF. December 18, 1942*

BARTOLOMIE IDENTIFIED THE TWO MEN FOUND SHOT TO DEATH IN THE RANCH WELL AS THOMAS SHEPHERD SHULL, 24, AND CHARLES BAKER, 30, BOTH REPORTED MISSING IN SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY. THEY HAD BEEN DEAD FOR MORE THAN A YEAR, HE SAID. *December 8, 1942 victim*

THE SHERIFF SAID THE OTHER VICTIM WAS "A YOUNG WOMAN" WHO HAD NOT BEEN IDENTIFIED. SHE DIED OF AN APPARENT DRUG OVERDOSE.

# 2 Persons Slain in Virgin Islands Robbery

ST. CROIX. Two men were shot to death and a third seriously wounded during a robbery at a Virgin Islands restaurant, police reported yesterday.

The incident follows by two months a similar robbery-slaying which resulted in the deaths of eight persons at the Fountain Valley Golf Club on St. Croix, one of the U.S. Virgin Islands. Authorities said four masked men entered the Braconero restaurant Tuesday night, demanded money and then gunned down the three customers.

The slain were Fritz Pau-Roke, 28, manager of ground services at Alexander Hamilton Airport, and Hans Onken, an employee of Hess Oil Co.'s refinery on St. Croix, police said.

The third victim, John Fowler, 31, also a Hess employee, was listed in serious condition with a facial and shot wound.

## Fatal Ambush

NEW YORK—One youth was killed and another injured in an apparent ambush, spawned by street gang disputes in the lobby of a Chinatown movie theater, authorities reported yesterday.

Police said Wuk Chung Tan, 16, and Phillip Pan, 17, were hit by gunfire as they stepped into the lobby of the Pagoda Theater late Tuesday from a stairway landing from a balcony.

Tan was killed by three bullets in the back and Pan suffered wounds in the back and right arm, police said.

A police spokesman said they are looking for three members of the Black Angels, one of a number of youth gangs involved in rivalries that have resulted in three killings this year and 60 assaults during 1971.

## Police Kill Man


NEW YORK, N.Y.—Police shot and killed a 22-year-old New York man and wounded his brother yesterday after responding to a report of a shooting in Manhattan at a second floor flat. One patrolman was slightly wounded.

Deputy Police Chief Kenneth Mechior said Jose Martinez Mendez was pronounced dead at Martland Medical Center with multiple bullet wounds.

His brother, Felipe, 22, was listed in poor condition with two bullet wounds sustained in the gun battle with police at the apartment.

Police responded to a report of a family argument involving Jose Mendez and his wife, Gloria, 22.

Mechior said that when the patrolmen arrived at the scene they found the couple engaged in a heated argument. While attempting to control the situation they became involved in a scuffle with Jose and seven other men, including Felipe, who rushed the pair when the officers intervened.

### Lansky, Bail

MIAMI — Meyer Lansky, reputedly a former financial underworld genius, was under court orders yesterday to stay in southern Florida after being arrested here Tuesday.

Lansky, 41, was arrested at Miami airport after being refused entry to Brazil, Argentina, Paraguay, Peru, and Panama. Niac bonds later he was freed on \$25,000 bail.

Charges are pending against Lansky in Las Vegas and New York for alleged involvement in racketeering and interstate racketeering.

During a court appearance yesterday, his lawyer, E. De Witt Brown, asking for a reduction of bail, said Lansky "is not the kind of person who would fly in the face of the law — he has no place here."

### Bombing Blast

ALBANY, N.Y., Nov. 9.—A bomb exploded early yesterday in the campus of the State University of Buffalo. There were no injuries and moderate vandalism.

A second, unactivated, device was found a short time later.

The bomb exploded only a few minutes after a call was made to the officers of the campus newspaper, the Spectator. A radio voice said the bomb would explode in a short time, but the caller did not give a location on campus.

The bomb was reportedly activated through the exit door of Sherman Hall, causing "minimal damage" to the building, a campus spokesman said. Police said the exploded device was "a time-delayed bomb."

### School Eviction

NEW ORLEANS, La.— Gov. Edwin Edwards has set a 1 p.m. deadline today for militant students to give up Southern University in New Orleans or be evicted by "whatever means necessary."

He issued the ultimatum yesterday in Baton Rouge, and at the same time created a 23-member special committee to talk with students about their complaints regarding the university.

### Corona Trial

FAIRFIELD, Calif.—A sheriff's deputy testified yesterday he found a post hole digger with "some hair on the digging portion" in the garage of mass murder defendant Juan V. Corona.

"It was the most damaging evidence produced to date by the prosecution against the man accused of slaying 25 migrant workers whose bodies were found buried along the Feather river.

### 'Angel' Berserk

UKIAH, Calif.—Hell's Angel lieutenant George Wethern "went off his rocker," jabbing pencils into his eyes and choking his wife in their Mendocino County jail cell, the county sheriff said yesterday.

Wethern, 32, rolled holes in the inside corner of both eyes and in the skin above the eyeballs in his effort to blind himself but suffered no permanent damage to his eyesight, said Sheriff Reno Bartolome. His wife Helen, 29, was not hurt.

Wethern owns a 153-acre ranch near Ukiah where three bodies were unearthed last week by authorities who described it as "Hell's Angels' burying ground." Four Angels were arrested in the slaying.

In January, 1979, a task force was created at the direction of the United States Attorney for the Northern District of California at San Francisco, for the purpose of investigating the Hill's Angels Motorcycle Club (HAMC) as an association and fact within the meaning of the Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organization (RICO) statute, Title 18, Section 1962, United States Code (USC). The task force consisted of personnel from the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms (ATF). On June 13, 1979, an indictment was returned by the Federal Grand Jury (FGJ) at San Francisco charging 32 members and associates of the HAMC with conspiracy to violate the RICO statute. The indictment principally dealt with the manufacture and distribution of narcotics, namely methamphetamine, and other acts of racketeering, to include murder and the investment of illicit money in a legitimate business enterprise. On June 13, 1979, joint agency arrest teams consisting of federal and local law enforcement personnel served search and arrest warrants at the last known residences of the indicted defendants. 





On July 2, 1980, the trial involving 18 Hells Angels and associates ended with a hung jury on all defendants on the substantive Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organizations (RICO) charges with the exception of Manuel Frank Rubio. United States District Court Judge Samuel Conti declared a mistrial and a new trial will be scheduled for late summer or early autumn, 1980. Manuel Frank Rubio was found guilty on one count, violation of Title 18, Section 1962(d), United States Code (RICO) as it related to the investment of illicit funds in a business known as San Rafael Auto Body and Repair Shop.

Additionally, Ronald Harrison Elledge, John Thomas Palomar, Alan David Passaro, Donald Duane Smith and Bert Samuel Stefanson were found guilty on counts relating to illegal possession of firearms.

Seven of the ten original fugitives in this matter have been apprehended. Those fugitives still outstanding include Marvin William Gilbert, Kenneth Alison Maxwell and Frederick Clifford McKnight.

In June, 1979, 32 members and associates of the HANC were indicted by the Federal Grand Jury at San Francisco for violation of Title 18, U.S. Code, Section 1962. In that same month, an anonymous caller claiming to be a member of the Hells Angels, advised that law enforcement personnel involved in the case, and also the judge who set the high bail, were on the Hells Angels "hit list".

In July, 1979, James Witt, a member of the Hells Angels, and one of the individuals indicted by the Federal Grand Jury in June, 1979, appeared before U.S. District Court Judge Samuel Conti for a bail reduction hearing. During the course of that

hearing, Judge Court raised the bail that had been set on James King from \$250,000 to \$500,000.

The trial pertaining to those arrested began in December, 1974. During the course of the trial, six of the ten fugitives were apprehended without incident. The trial concluded on July 30, 1980, with the majority of those charged being hung jury. The leader of the HMC gang, Ralph "Ricky" Lewis, was also found not guilty on one count. During the course of the trial, there were no displays of threatening behavior or any disturbance in and around the courthouse. The trial pertaining to those subjects arrested subsequent to the start of the first trial will begin in September, 1980. Two of the four remaining fugitives was arrested on July 12, 1980, in the State Line Mountains.

At the present time, the FBI is not conducting an active investigation of the HMC as such in view of restrictions placed upon investigations of groups or individuals unless criminal violations of Federal law have been committed or are contemplated. In summary, this organization has displayed extremely violent tendencies in past years toward the public in general and toward law enforcement officers and witnesses who have testified against members of the club. The FBI is in possession of no specific information at this time as to
