



Zodiac: 4 years later

What happened to the killer who kept

The City in terror?

By Tim Reiterman

On the night of Oct. 11, 1969, Homicide Detective Dave Toschi was on call at home. At 10:25, the phone rang. Police operations told him a Yellow Cab driver had been shot to death near Presidio Heights.

Within minutes, police radios were describing the assailant as a black man and squad cars were converging on the area, red lights flashing. One car passed a husky white man walking into the Presidio, a few blocks from the murder

scene at Washington and Cherry streets.

A short time later, understandably rattled witnesses were able to give a coherent description of the man who pumped a single bullet into the head of cab driver Paul Stine, then mopped blood from the car seat with a piece of the driver's blue and white sport shirt, and coolly got out and walked around to the left rear door, apparently to wipe away fingerprints.

that of the man seen by officers in the squad car — a white male, 35 to 40, 5-foot-10, 180 to 200 pounds, barrel-chested, with light-colored hair, a crewcut, glasses and a blue, waist-length zippered jacket. Dozens of police searched the area, including the Julius Kahn Playground at the edge of the Presidio.

It appeared to be a routine, yet nonetheless tragic, murder-robbery that netted the thief \$10 or \$11, the sort that happens every day in

a piece of bloodstained blue and white cloth:

"This is the Zodiac speaking. I am the murderer of the taxi driver ... last night, to prove this here is a bloodstained piece of his shirt.

"I am the same man who did in the people in the North Bay Area. The SF police could have caught me if they had searched the park properly instead of holding road races with their motorcycle (sic) seeing who could make the most noise. The car drivers should have just parked their cars and sat there quietly waiting for me to come out of cover."

That night was Detective Toschi's first night on the trail of Zodiac, and his closest brush with the killer. Eight years later, he still is waiting for Zodiac to come out of cover.

It's a lonely wait, and each date of a Zodiac killing or communication rubs his frustration. Today is the fourth anniversary of Zodiac's last direct communication, a letter Toschi carries at all times to remind himself that he has failed to catch one of the most notorious and mysterious criminals in history.

"I think he is alive," the detective said in an interview. "It's almost a gut feeling. But, if he had been killed in an accident or committed suicide or been murdered, I believe someone would have gone into his room. And I think he could leave something for us to find."

It would seem uncharacteristic for an egotistical killer who taunted police with ghoulish and sometimes coded accounts of his deeds to depart this earth without a parting shot. And Zodiac has yet to explain most of the 37 murders he claims.

"We're certain he killed at least six and wounded two in the late 1960s," Toschi said. "There are many unsolved homicides, but there is no reason to attribute any to Zodiac."

The days are gone when two dozen law enforcement officers parleyed over the Zodiac menace, when newspapers implored the killer to surrender, when men matching Zodiac's description were stopped and questioned.

Now Toschi works the case alone, as he has for two years.

In eight filing cabinet drawers, he has carried on his paper chase of a nameless man who took pleasure in killing strangers on weekends for no rational reason.

He has run down and filed away 3,000 leads, many provided by fellow officers and phone calls and letters from private citizens. He has alphabetized 2,000 possible suspects, and has taken a close look at a half dozen "good suspects," none with fingerprints matching those found at Zodiac murder scenes.

As the result of wire service stories, tips have come in from all over the world, including Canada, Europe, New Zealand and Australia. The cranks have to be weeded out from persons who believe they know Zodiac and it's a time-consuming task.

He has had to contend with a self-appointed helper who called himself "The Valiant Crusader," an alcoholic named "Old Tom" who claimed to be Zodiac and jilted women who tried to finger their former spouses or boyfriends out of revenge.

Tips continue to pour in at a rate of roughly one every three days, and Toschi runs down each until satisfied that it will not lead to the long-silent killer.

"I have no idea what Zodiac looks like now," he said. "That's the problem."

Eyewitness descriptions of Zodiac can be considered shaky at best, especially since eight years have passed since the last known sighting. The witnesses at the slaying of cab driver Stine were frightened. The police officers who saw Zodiac got only a fleeting view. And the only time Zodiac killed during daylight hours—the Sept. 27, 1969,

stabbing death of a 22-year-old woman and the wounding of her male companion at Lake Berryessa Park — he wore a hood.

Police believe that Zodiac has an eye problem because he wore glasses even under his hood. There are also indications that he had some connection to the military.

He wore a military-type crew cut or short hair. His pants had pleats at a time when that cut was not fashionable. He committed several of his murders in the Vallejo area near Mare Island and one near the Presidio. And his messages showed some knowledge of cryptography.

Toschi said he leans toward the theory that Zodiac may have been connected with the Navy at one time. In addition to the fact that he wore a Navy-type windbreaker, jacket for the Stine killing, the detective notes: "Three codes were used in his messages, and some had nautical signs. One sign is used by weathermen and Navy people."

In consultation with psychologists, Toschi also has come to the conclusion that Zodiac is a high school graduate with a giant ego locked in an inconspicuous identity. "I feel he probably has a menial job and is very lonely, not around many loved ones."

Although a handwriting expert once concluded Zodiac was impotent and afraid of women, the investigator says the facts only show that he apparently enjoyed killing defenseless people. "There was no sexual activity," he said. "No molestation, no mutilation."

The key to solving the case,

Toschi said, lies in Zodiac's ego and his somewhat distinctive lettering style, not in his coded messages, one of which remains unbroken.

Zodiac seemed obsessed with publicizing his exploits. At first he communicated with smaller newspapers such as the Vallejo Times-Herald. Then he sent letters to the two large daily newspapers in San Francisco, and later sent one letter to the Los Angeles Times, the largest West Coast daily, complaining that the San Francisco papers relegate his messages to back pages.

As a result, however, his lettering has been seen by people all over California. "I hope he'll communicate with a friend or family member and slip," Toschi said. "I hope something rings a bell in someone's head and they'll pass on a letter to police.

"I'm counting on a slip of mind where he feels after nine or 10 years that he's safe and he'll write a boastful letter to a friend. Medical people and psychologists say it will come out."

Toschi believes that Zodiac has not killed since 1969, although the mystery man increased his total to 37 on Jan. 30, 1974, after nearly a three-year silence. At that time, Zodiac's ego was apparent as he panned "The Exorcist" as "bad comedy," although it caused many people to vomit.

Later in 1974, he sent two messages to the Chronicle, without disclosing his identity. One urged the newspaper to "show some concern for public sensibilities" by dropping an ad for a movie called "Badlands." The letter, signed "A Citizen," went on to say: "This kind

of murder glorification can only be deplorable at best." In a postcard signed "The Red Phantom (red with rage)," Zodiac criticized columnist Count Marco for his "superior attitude" and demanded cancellation of the column.

"He got his pleasure by telling us about the murders," Toschi said. "My guess is that he hasn't been killing. Ego is what forced him to kill and write letters, knowing the media would broadcast and print it."

If that's so, then why hasn't Zodiac killed in recent years and why has he been silent so long?

One theory is that he has been in and out of prisons, jails or mental institutions.

"I think he is in a period of remission and that some symptoms abated," Toschi said. "Perhaps during this period, he had no desire to kill."

There was a previous, though shorter, period of inactivity discovered during investigation of five Zodiac slayings from Dec. 20, 1968, to Oct. 11, 1969. Police determined that Zodiac was behind the Oct. 30, 1966, slaying of Riverside City College cheerleader Cheri Jo Bates, whose throat was slashed by a man who first sabotaged her car in the college parking lot.

A janitor inadvertently found a poem scratched in a library study

desk and later proved to be written by Zodiac:

"Sick of living unwilling to die. Cut, clean, if red! clean, blood spurting, dripping, spilling; all over her new dress. "Oh well, it was red anyway. Life draining into an uncertain death. She won't die this time. Someone'll find her. Just wait till next-time." It was signed. "r-h."

There was no mention of the name Zodiac in either the poem or confession letters sent to police, a local newspaper and the dead girl's father. Zodiac apparently tried to hide his connection to the Bates murder for some reason — possibly because the initials "r-h" might be a clue to his identity, possibly because he was a fellow student or one of her teachers, possibly because he was a military man stationed in the area, and possibly because he was a traveling businessman from the Bay Area.

Whatever the Riverside connection, Zodiac turned up in the San Francisco Bay Area and convinced police by providing details known only to the killer that he was responsible for the following homicides:

- Dec. 20, 1968, a man used a pencil flashlight taped to the barrel of a .22-caliber pistol to find and kill David Faraday and Betty Lou Jensen on a lover's lane near Vallejo.
- July 5, 1969, a man fired a 9mm pistol into a car parked less than two miles from the site of Faraday-Jensen murders, killing Darleen Ferrin, 22, and wounding Michael Mageau, 19.
- Sept. 27, 1969, a black-hooded man tied up and stabbed Bryan Hartnell, 20, 10 times, and then stabbed Hartnell's companion, Cecelia Ann Shepard, 22, 24 times at Lake Berryessa Park. The woman died, but Hartnell recovered.
- Oct. 11, 1969, a man shot and killed cab driver Paul Stine in San Francisco with a 9mm pistol.

Zodiac frequently used a 9mm pistol, yet he was clever enough never to use the same gun twice. He killed between 10 p.m. and midnight when darkness obscured his face, and he used a hood for his one daylight murder.

Although he took care to wipe his fingerprints and boasted that he took other precautions, Zodiac made mistakes. Toschi said police have enough fingerprints — from the Stine murder scene and from a Napa County telephone booth where Zodiac once called police — to make a positive identification if he is captured or surrenders.

The Stine murder was a break with Zodiac's pattern of killing women and couples. And perhaps the best explanation was Zodiac's message a month later:

"I shall no longer announce to any when I commit my murders, they shall look like routine robberies, killings of anger, & a few fake accidents, etc."

Whether or not Zodiac is carrying out his morbid promise, Toschi is waiting and working for the day when he meets the killer face to face to inform him of his legal rights. "Hopefully, that day may come," the detective said.

Expert frustrated; handwriting's not on wall for Zodiac

In his 37 years as a handwriting expert, no case has frustrated therwood Morrill as much as the codiac killer whose bizarre and poastful letters are believed to be he key to his identity.

"I'd like to find him before I lie," the 63-year-old Morrill said. If he dies, I wish he'd leave a ote saying who he was."

Since Zodiac's calculated carage in the late 1960s, Morrill has nalyzed more than 9,000 writing amples for law enforcement fficials on Zodiac's trail.

He knows Zodiac's distinctive printing better than anyone n earth, even well enough to pot it on a bank deposit slip.

And he believes, as does San rancisco Homicide Detective ave Toschi, that Zodiac's printing may give him away because may well use it every day.

"I'm sure this is his natural andprinting, and he was used to sing it a lot," Morrill said in an aterview. "It is so consistent. I on't think he uses script."

The handwriting samples poured in during the peak of Zodiac's activities. But now — though Morrill went into business for himself in December 1973 after 39 years with the state. Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation — the samples dribble in at a rate of about one a month.

In the last four years, there have been no known written communiques from Zodiac, yet the mass murderer's lettering is fresh in Morrill's mind.

"His printing is distinctive," he said. "He is an intelligent guy and we know he deliberately misspells some words because he sometimes spells them correctly.

"His punctuation and paragraphing are perfect. His tenses and syntax are perfect. His vocabulary is good.

The letter K is particularly outstanding. It's made in three distinct strokes rather than the usual two."

Still, Zodiac was careful when he wrote the bloody details of his killings, threatened to attack a school bus and diagramed a bomb that experts say would have detonated.

Using a ball point pen he wrote on various types of paper, but it generally was cheap, dimestore paper without water marks that could be traced to a manufacturer. And he never left any fingerprints on the paper or envelopes.

His one departure from this format was after the 1966 murder of a Riverside coed — a murder authorities believe Zodiac sought

to conceal for some reason. Though letters then were not signed "Zodiac," Morrill determined that typewritten letters on teletype paper were from the killer.

Investigators were unable to trace the paper to any military installations that use teletypes, yet there were some indications the killer was associated with the military.

Footprints at two of the murder scenes appeared to have been made by military-type shoes, and some witnesses said the killer wore pleated military-type pants or a military-type windbreaker jacket.

The campus killing and the possible military connection sent Morrill on the arduous task of checking handwriting samples of thousands of college students in

the Riverside area and of mi men stationed near Riversi in the Vallejo area, where se killings occurred.

1. Request an analysis of the enclosed "Zodiac" homicide letters to determine the number of authors. No identified suspect at this time.

2. These letters have been examined by Mr. Sherwood Morrill, California Department of Justice, Bureau of Criminal Identification (Questioned Documents Section) and Mr. John Shimoda, Director of Postal Crime Laboratory, Western Regional Office, San Bruno, California. Prior to his retirement in 1973 Mr. Morrill examined and authenticated all of the "Zodiac" letters, including the now disputed Riverside, California letters. On May 11, 1978 Mr. Shimoda examined, for the first time, these Riverside, California letters and formed the opinion that they were not authored by "Zodiac". We are requesting this additional examination to settle the disputed authorship due to the seriousness of the case. "Zodiac" is a mass murderer to whom we have attributed six known victims since 1966, and has subsequently reappeared by sending another letter to a local newspaper.

California State Department of Justice, Bureau of Criminal Investigation (Questioned Document Section) and Mr. John Shimoda, Director of Postal Crime Laboratory, Western Regional Office, and explained the nature of this requested examination. Neither individual expressed any reason why the examination should not be conducted.

New puzzles further muddle Zodiac case

Well-known cop removed; last letter a hoax?

Veteran homicide cop David Toschi was transferred to the pawnshop detail today following his admission he wrote phony letters praising himself to a newspaper columnist and suggestions he might have been the author of the latest communication from the Zodiac killer.

Toschi, 47, labeled as "totally absurd" the suggestion that he wrote the April 24 Zodiac letter, the authenticity of which has been challenged by at least one handwriting expert.

"I wrote no Zodiac letter," Toschi said this morning. "I don't need another letter. It only brings me tons of extra work."

A high police department official also said there was no evidence Toschi had written the Zodiac letter.

He admitted writing what he called fan letters about himself to former Chronicle serialist Armistead Maupin, now a free-lancer, who used Toschi as a hero in his fictional "Tales of the City" serial.

The "two or three" letters were written two years ago, he said, and he considered them harmless at the time.

"It was a very foolish thing to do," he said. "I am ashamed of it." (Indicate page, name of newspaper, city and state.)

The department's internal affairs division has investigated the matter but Capt. John Mahoney, head of the division, declined comment.

Gain also declined comment today, as did-officers in the intelligence division, which also was involved in the investigation. Lt. Jack Jordan, Toschi's former homicide boss, was not available for comment.

Toschi has been on the force for 25 years, the last 18 on the homicide detail. He had been assigned to the Zodiac case for the past nine years.

The announcement of his transfer was made shortly before 5 p.m. after a conference between Police Chief Charles Gain and Deputy Chief Clement DeAmicis.

The reason, Gain said, was that a departmental investigation had disclosed that Toschi, using fictitious names, had written several complimentary letters about himself and mailed them to a San Francisco writer.

The police statement did not name the writer, but he was identified through other sources as Maupin.

Gain also announced that there now is some doubt about the authenticity of the April 24 letter and that experts have disagreed on whether or not it is the real thing.

of the Zodiac case by our Zodiac investigation team, established in April 1978, has led to the conclusion that there is reason to doubt whether Zodiac in fact wrote the April 24 letter," Gain said.

The team was composed of Toschi and Inspectors James Tedesco and James Deasy.

"It was given the mission to go over every bit of the Zodiac case to examine, collate and codify, and to re-examine what had been examined before." DeAmicis said.

DeAmicis was asked if anyone had raised the possibility that the April 24 letter might have been Toschi's handiwork.

"There is absolutely nothing demonstrable that Inspector Toschi wrote any of the Zodiac letters," DeAmicis replied.

Gain said in announcing Toschi's reassignment that "I conclude that reassigning Inspector Toschi would be beneficial both to the inspector and to the San Francisco Police Department."

Regarding the letter, the chief said that "there is a conflict in the opinion of some of the questioned-document experts who examined the April letter and compared it with previous Zodiac letters. This letter will be the subject of further examination by experts."

Robert Prouty, chief of the questioned-documents section of the State Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation, said he didn't think the April letter was

genuine Zodiac.

"I examined photographs of the April letter and those of previous letters attributed to Zodiac and in my opinion the April letter was not written by the same person," Prouty said.

"Several letter characteristics in my opinion did not match the style used by Zodiac. The slant of some letters was not consistent with previous Zodiac communications.

"My first impression was that it was in the same general style as previous letters, but after closer examination my ultimate conclusion was that there were so many differences that it was not written by the same person who wrote the previous Zodiac letters."

Sherwood Morrill, who formerly held the post now filled by Prouty and who is now retired and in private practice, disagreed sharply with Prouty.

"The last letter was by the real Zodiac," Morrill declared. "There is no question in my mind. I've heard they're accusing Toschi of writing them. If Toschi wrote the last one, he's the Zodiac. He wrote them all.

"My suspicion is that somebody is after Toschi, because I worked with Toschi and Armstrong (Inspector Bill Armstrong, who also has worked on the Zodiac case) and they were always as honest with me as they could be."

Morrill said of Toschi's transfer: "It shocked me, and I'm not easily shocked after all these years.

"This last letter that turned up is definitely by the Zodiac we knew in the past," Morrill said. "I examined it. The characters and handwriting are just dead-bang the same."

Morrill said that he, John Shimoda, head of the Postal Service crime laboratory in San Bruno, and Pleasant Hill handwriting expert David DeGarmo "all agreed this last letter was real."

Morrill added, "I think Toschi's had too much publicity and some people may not like it."

He also deprecated Prouty's expertise. "He was in polygraph operations for the San Diego Police Department and had very little experience in this," Morrill said.

"He doesn't even have all the material I had. I've caught him wrong two or three times since I retired to private practice."

Morrill said that from now on he won't work on any Zodiac matters for the San Francisco department.

"Armstrong and Toschi made the first contact with me and I was doing it for them," he said. "I feel I'm absolved from doing any more. Sure, I'd like to be the guy who identifies Zodiac, but this is too much."

Maupin said this morning he received a number of letters from Toschi after he made the inspector a figure in his serial.

Although Toschi used fictitious names, Maupin said he suspected they were from the inspector. "I

noticed that the margin stops were similar, the same type in the typewriter and the D's in the signatures were much the same.":

He said he became suspicious of the last Zodiac letter in April "because I saw certain parallels" between it and Toschi's "fan" notes and "it was the only one that mentioned his (Toschi's) name . . I felt there was enough evidence there to at least warrant an investigation and the police apparently did too."

He said he and his co-author on a New West article about the matter, scheduled for publication Monday, made the complaint to police but he would not say with whom he dealt or when

Maupin denied the current controversy was part of either the New West article or his upcoming book, "Tales of the City."

"As a matter of fact, the irony about it was that because my book is coming out ... in August, I was worried people would think I had done this as publicity," he said.

"I waited two years before acting upon this because I though David Toschi is a nice guy. I'm sorry for the discomfort that this may be causing him and his family."

"The fan letters are a harmless vanity."

Maupin said he put a veiled message in his plot line in the serial to let Toschi know he was onto him but did not pursue it.







a consistent pattern or method for rearranging the letters into their proper positions during the decryption process. It is considered that a person knowledgeable enough about cryptography to be familiar with double encryption systems would not be such a novice as to use random transposition. Also, when substitution/transposition systems are employed; there are traditionally no plaintext words generated after the transposition process. In the proposed solution some straightforward plaintext words were produced. A person seeking the security afforded by a double encryption system would be unlikely to permit the presence of untransposed words.

- 2. There are no plaintext values assigned to two of the symbols comprising the siphertext message ("." and "/"). These two symbols were used a total of nine times throughout the message. While it is possible that these could have due; been used as "nulls" to theart pryptimalytic efforts, this is considered unlikely. Furthermore, two plaintext values were assigned to two of the symbols ("K" and "J"). While the same of two or sore diphertext values (variants) prepresent a single plaintext value is common (and very sound from a cryptologic standpoint) the same can not be said for multiple values being permitted for ciphertext characters because, again, the system would not had to a uniquence solution.
- The total feeling generated powerd the proposed spirition is that the solution has been forced. First the random-like transposition system

parmitted the various vowels and consonants to be forced into words, then the words were forced into being poetry in an effort to give them meaning. Just about any random selection of words could be arranged to be as "logical" as those in the proposed poetic selution. (It is noted that the initial godiac encrypted message was perfectly clear as to the meaning SODIAC desired to communicate.) When a cryptogram has been decrypted properly there is an unmistakable sense of rightness about the solution. This sense of rightness is completely absent in the proposed solution.

For information of San Francisco this analysis was conducted under Laboratory Number \$6222861 G DV. The worknotes submitted as enclosures to the referenced airtel have been designated Goldi. These are being retained in the Laboratory for future reference.

For the information of Boston, the Zodiac killings involve a series of brutal murders committed primarily in the San Francisco region beginning in 1968. The killer sent several letters to the police and press "claiming" these killings and giving details of the killings known only to the killer and investigators. Most of these letters contained cryptic symbols and codes. Unsuccessful attempts to "break" these codes and symbols have been made by numerous agencies, including the National Security Agency, and private citizens. The last authentic Zodiac letter was received in 1974 and in it, Zodiac claimed "Zodiac 37, Police 0."

Toschi is the original investigator of the SFPD assigned the Zodiac case; however, it is noted that Toschi was the author of letters to the Chronicle in 1979 which purported to be from the Zodiac. Toschi actually wrote the 1979 letters himself to get additional publicity for the case.



Each of the law enforcement agencies contacted expressed a desire that material be examined by qualified, impartial cryptographers in that there is a possibility that at least a portion of his analysis of the Zodiac codes and symbols may be accurate or of lead value. Each investigator contacted indicated they believed to be sincere, but his analysis is too complex for the resources of their respective agencies.

It is also the opinion of the interviewing Agents and Supervisor of the San Francisco Office that the material submitted by may have some merit although he appears, in some instances, to be fitting his solutions to the facts of the case as known to him.

While a definite conclusion could not be reached in this examination, some characteristics were noted which indicate that the writer of the Zodiac letters should not be eliminated as a possible suspect in the preparation of specimens Q27 and Q28.

No watermarks, indented writing or other features were found on specimens Q27 and Q28 which would be of value in determining the source of these specimens.





This is a follow-up to my letter to you of Oct. 27.

Being hipped on Zodiac, my ears pricked up last night when CBS had a story on the Green River Killer, out of Riverton, WA, Seattle suburb.

RIVERton, of course, reminds of RIVERside, CA, a Zodiac 187 site. And I learned that some five bodies were found on the banks of the Green River. There's an outside chance that this might tie in with Zodiac's preference for watery homicide sites, in accord with his horoscope or astrological "pattern".

The guy never had a strict MO, using different guns and a knife in his 187s. Even strychnine was used in one of the Santa Rosa murder series, in which Zodiac may be the responsible. And his Jack the Ripper-type message in Riverside (threat to display female organs) hints that Zodiac might also kill prostitutes, as in the Green River Killer case. In one message, he vowed to kill by "gun, knife, rope and fire".

A UPI story (obtained by computer from The Source) reported the adding of two victims' names, making a total of some 21 in the Green River case. Abernathy was said to have disappeared Sept. 5, 1982, and Bellow exactly a month later on Oct. 5. This methodical periodicity could be significant, along with the fact both vanished during the "dark of the moon," at new moon time (Zodiac's use of witchcraft, or black magic). I wish I had more dates in the case.




This all may be too esoteric for you to work with on your computers. But I hope not.

Dear Sir:

The decapitation and mutilation of a young woman, including attempted removal of her heart, in a ritual homicide near San Francisco's Golden Gate Bridge this week certainly smacks of Zodiac.

The Christmas season is significant to Zodiac. He started his Bay Area homicide series at that time in 1968. It is the winter solstice witchcraft sabbat period. Also significant is the possible linking of this 187 with the multiple stabbing homicide of another woman in the same area four years ago. I told you of the numerological significance of the number four to Zodiac.

There has been some indication that Zodiac may have observed the Druidic new moon, and the Druids reportedly practiced human sacrifice, as did the Aztecs and others.

Zodiac vowed never again to publicly claim a homicide, but that doesn't mean he wouldn't enjoy the publicity this sadistic 187 is receiving. His mentor, black magician Aleister Crowley, urged secrecy upon his disciples, which may partly explain Zodiac's abrupt change of MO. Also, his messages were helpful to authorities, as he must have realized.

For the information of Boston, referenced San Francisco airtel to the Bureau and Boston set forth details of the initial contacts between the FBI and Subsequently, San Francisco submitted a considerable amount of material provided by for analysis by the FBI Laboratory. The Laboratory could reach no definite conclusion concerning the material it has examined and has indicated regarding some of analysis that the bulk of his theory is based upon speculation and a multitude of assumptions. The Laboratory Division noted that it is possible that some of assumptions are correct, but that many, if not most, appeared to be forced with the results being used selectively. The enclosed material has not been submitted to the Laboratory Division for analysis.

The current letter makes reference to a Boston area homicide in which Joan Webster was the victim and indicates that Harvard University police may have some interest in the San Francisco area Zodiac killings and the Webster case). Accordingly, this material should be made available to both Boston and Harvard University police authorities.
