This FRED DOOD was born 2/14/09 at Manchester, England. He arrived in the United States on 3/1/58 at the port of New York, N. Y., by means of the SS [REDACTED] from Toronto, Canada. He gave his wife's name as ELIZABETH [REDACTED], born 5/1/11 in Pennsylvania (city not given). They had one daughter LARSEN born 12/18/50, at Philadelphia, Pa. He received his certificate of naturalization no. [REDACTED] at a term of the U. S. District Court, Baltimore, Maryland. He resided at that time at 3407 Liberty Heights Ave., Baltimore, Maryland. 6x [REDACTED] advised the Sheriff's Office had apprehended a member of the NOI several weeks ago. This individual became obnoxious and unruly. In due course he was transferred from the jail to the county hospital and in turn to a mental institution. [REDACTED] said that because of this he had decided to do some research into the background of the NOI in order that he might have a better understanding of the problem. He said he directed inquiries to the Los Angeles Police Department concerning the NOI and received what background the Los Angeles Police would make available. He reviewed this material and based on the information developed from it directed his inquiry to the Identification Division for photos and Identification records.

[REDACTED] said he had no personal knowledge of either FARD or MUHAMMAD and no information as to the location of FARD.

No further action being taken with respect to the Orange County Sheriff's Office inquiry.

On 8/3/62, [REDACTED], HCUA, Los Angeles, orally advised he had received information that the Nation of Islam had been lambasted by Congressman MERDAL RIVERS (ph.). He stated that Chairman FRANCIS WALTER advised the Congressman the HCUA had conducted an investigation of the NOI and planned to hold a hearing on the organization in the near future.

[REDACTED] stated he was subsequently contacted by the Committee in Washington to assist in the preparation of a press release. [REDACTED] observed that the likelihood exists that a hearing on the NOI will take place shortly after Congress adjourns; further, that the hearing will take place in Los Angeles, California.

[REDACTED] stated he presently contemplates building the hearing around WALLACE FARAD, aka Willie D. Ford, Wally Ford, (WALLACE DODD FORD--TH), who [REDACTED] claims was an ex-convict and a caucasian. [REDACTED] stated he is currently attempting to locate FARAD.

The records of the Los Angeles Division disclose considerable investigation has been conducted by the Bureau in an effort to locate FORD, but there has been no indication of his

In connection with efforts to disrupt and curb growth of the NOI, extensive research has been conducted into various files maintained by this office. Among the files reviewed was that of WALLACE DODD FORD. In this review it was noted there was evidence indicating FORD, or ALLAH as he is known to the NOI, was last seen in September 1933 at which time he, or a person believed to be him, was arrested by the Chicago Police Department; that his former common-law wife stated she had seen him in either the summer of 1932 or 1933, at which time she said he told her he was going to return to New Zealand adding he had always been factual in keeping her advised of his whereabouts since his release from San Quentin in 1929; that on the birth of FORD's son by this woman his, FORD's, birth was listed as New Zealand. It is also noted FORD also claims to have been born on February 25, 1891 in Portland, Oregon, to ZARED and BEATRICE FORD who were born in Hawaii. Investigative efforts to verify this were negative. U

This review indicated all logical leads within the United States were covered but that leads in New Zealand were not covered. R * (Q)

Chicago, after much consideration, feels it would be appropriate and logical for the Bureau to consider covering leads as set forth in referenced Chicago letters of February 28 and April 15, 1958. It is felt that if the whereabouts of ALLAH could be inconclusively determined, the impact on ELIJAH MUHAMMAD and his followers would be tremendous and could well serve to make MUHAMMAD appear ridiculous. u

Chicago realizes the leads were, to a degree, unrealistic; however, evidence strongly indicates FORD may have returned to New Zealand and could well be still among the living, as his birth is probably 1891 and not 1879 as the NOI claims. u

ReCHlet 2/19/63 suggesting the Bureau endeavor to determine if Wallace Dodd Ford (generally known as W. F. Ford), was born in New Zealand or if he went to New Zealand when he disappeared in 1934. u

A review of Chicago letter 2/2/58 captioned "Wallace Dodd Ford, aka., IS - R01" (Bufile 100-63642, Chicago file 100-33683), indicates that one Fred Dodd and one Pearl Allen were married on 5/9/14 in Oregon. The date and place of birth of Dodd, who may be identical with Ford, are not indicated in this letter. The Bureau is not in possession of the further results of this phase of the investigation which was conducted by the Portland Office. You should furnish the Bureau with any birth data concerning this individual. Also summarize Portland's investigation in 1958 to locate the whereabouts of Dodd and Pearl Allen. u

The Bureau would also like to be advised of any action previously taken to locate Edward Donaldson, Prison Number 15003, who was arrested with Ford in 1926 (see LA letter dated 4/9/58, Chicago file 100-33683) it appears that Donaldson was a business associate of Ford and could possibly furnish pertinent information if his present whereabouts could be determined. For your information, a search by name of the Bureau identification records on 2/4-5/63 failed to locate any arrest record identifiable with Edward Donaldson. In the event Donaldson's fingerprints are available, a copy should be furnished to the Bureau. u

In addition to furnishing the above information, you should set out any logical leads which should be covered at this time. The Bureau believes that we should make certain all logical leads are covered before submitting any request to New Zealand. u

Referenced Bureau letter instructed the following investigation be conducted in an effort to locate FORD:

- 1) Furnish the Bureau with details of Portland's investigative efforts to locate background data regarding one FRED DODD who married one PEARL ALLEN in Oregon on May 19, 1914.
- 2) Attempt to locate EDWARD DONALDSON, Folsom Prison Number 15808, who was arrested with FORD in 1926 and who may have been a business associate of FORD and who may be able to furnish pertinent information regarding FORD; to furnish DONALDSON's fingerprints to the Bureau.
- 3) To set out other logical leads which should be covered.

As regards the first lead, Chicago is enclosing for the Bureau the following:

Portland letter to Chicago dated October 29, 1957, entitled "W. D. FORD, SM - NOI;"

Portland letter to Chicago dated December 31, 1957, entitled as above;

Portland letter to Chicago dated January 9, 1958, entitled as above;

Portland letter to Chicago dated March 6, 1958, entitled as above.

As is noted Portland verified the marriage of FRED DODD, a resident of Salem, Marion County, Oregon,

age about 23, and PEARL ALLEN of Multnomah County, Oregon, on May 9, 1914. Subsequent investigation, which Chicago considers to have been extensive, failed to develop any further leads as regards FRED DODD. It is believed all logical leads were conducted by Portland. U

As regards EDWARD DONALDSON, San Francisco letter to the Director dated August 27, 1957, entitled "W. D. FARD, SM - NOI" set forth data regarding the incarceration of WALLIE D. FORD at San Quentin, California, and ascertained that San Quentin records noted "This defendant had in his possession drugs which his partner, Edward Donaldson, offered to sell to police officers for \$225.00." U

Los Angeles letter to the Bureau dated April 9, 1958, entitled "WALLACE DODD FORD, Was, SM - NOI," a copy of which is in possession of San Francisco, set forth details regarding EDWARD DONALDSON and his arrests.

for EDWARD DONALDSON and forward same to Bureau. Will also conduct appropriate investigation in an attempt to locate DONALDSON for the purpose of interviewing him as regards WALLACE FORD and his present whereabouts.

SAN FRANCISCO

AT SAN FRANCISCO, CALIFORNIA. Will review records of Folsom Prison and the San Francisco Police Department and Sheriff's Office in an effort to obtain a fingerprint card of DONALDSON and forward same to the Bureau. Will also conduct appropriate investigation in an attempt to locate DONALDSON for the purpose of interviewing him as regards WALLACE FORD and his present whereabouts.

As regards other logical leads, Chicago has completely reviewed the file on WALLACE DODD FORD. It is noted that outside of the above, the only other logical lead not covered is as follows:

On October 17, 1957, Mrs. CLIFFORD EVELSIZER, 4776 Hub Street, Los Angeles, California, who stated she was WALLACE FORD's common-law wife from 1919 to 1921 or 1922 in Los Angeles, advised she last saw WALLACE FORD in 1932, at which time he was driving a 1929 Model A Ford bearing California license plates. At this time Mrs. EVELSIZER stated FORD told her he was going back to New Zealand.

In this connection the following lead is set out:

SAN FRANCISCO

AT SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA. Will review automobile registrations covering the years 1932 to 1935 in an effort to determine if WALLACE DODD FORD registered a car in California during those years. If located, logical leads should be set forth in an attempt to locate him.

For information of Los Angeles and San Francisco, information indicates FORD was last seen in Chicago in 1933, at which time he, or a person believed to be him, was arrested on a minor charge by the Chicago Police Department. This person was not fingerprinted or photographed. It is noted that on January 17, 1958, Mrs. EVELSIZER was interviewed by Bureau agents in Key West, Florida. She stated she could not be sure whether she last saw FORD in 1932 or 1933.

Upon conclusion of the above leads, Chicago will again reconsider, in light of the results, setting forth a request for having appropriate authorities and records in New Zealand contacted as regards FORD.

[REDACTED] Bureau of Health, City of Portland, 305 City Hall, Portland, Oregon, on 8/7/57, advised SA [REDACTED] that a review of birth records pertaining to the months of January through April for the years 1890, 1891 and 1892, failed to reflect any records having been filed for the birth of WALLIE D. FORD. There was no birth recorded during the above periods checked for any child of ZARED and BEATRICE FORD. [REDACTED] advised that around the time of the alleged birth in question, records were very poorly kept, that in many instances the births took place in the homes. In a great many of such instances, there was never a record made of the birth. She stated however, that in some instances where a record of the birth was later desired, there was a "delayed filing" of such birth, the records of which are maintained at the State Bureau of Vital Statistics, State Office Building, Portland.

[REDACTED] State Registrar of the State Bureau of Vital Statistics, 979 State Office Building, Portland, on 10/1/57 advised that the number of "delayed filings" constituted but a small proportion of the actual number of births. He noted that in addition to delayed filings, there are also some records of births, which by state statute, may be filed on the basis of a court order.

[REDACTED] Clerk, State Bureau of Vital Statistics, advised 10/7/57, that there is no record on file of the birth of anyone named WALLIE D. FORD. She stated that her search of records included both delayed filings and those recorded through court order. It is noted records of the State Bureau of Vital Statistics do not date back to 1891. ⁹

On 10/7/57, a check was made by SA [REDACTED] of the R. L. Polk and Company's Portland City Directories issued for the years of 1890, 1891 and 1892, on file at the Central Library, Portland Library Association, S. W. 10th and Taylor Streets. There was no record in any of the above directories of anyone named ZARED or BEATRICE FORD.

On 10/10/57, I. C. [REDACTED] ascertained from the persons listed at the agencies indicated, that there was no record on file for WALLIE D. FORD or either ZARED or BEATRICE FORD:

62 Officer [REDACTED] Records Bureau, Portland Police Department;

Detective [REDACTED] Security Detail, Portland Police Department;

Multnomah County Identification Bureau, [REDACTED] Clerk;

Retail Credit Association of Portland, Inc., [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Identification Bureau, Portland PD, on 10/10/57, advised that there is on file a fingerprint card on WALLIE FORD, Los Angeles PD #16448, reflecting his arrest on 11/17/48, for Assault with a Deadly Weapon. No Disposition is shown. [REDACTED] stated there is no other record of WALLIE FORD in the files and there likewise was no record for either ZARED or BEATRICE FORD.

[REDACTED] Special Agent, School District #1, 631 N. E. Clackamas Street, Portland, on 10/22/57, advised

that he had caused a check to be made of all school records for the City of Portland for the years 1897 to 1901, and no reference was located therein for WALLIE D. FORD. [REDACTED] pointed out that up to 1900 local laws did not require attendance of children at school until they had reached their 8th birthday.

On 10/22/57, [REDACTED] State Board of Health, Bureau of Vital Statistics, 979 State Office Building, Portland, advised that a search of marriage records for the years 1906 through 1916, failed to reflect any record of the marriage of anyone named FRED DODD.

On 10/22/57, a search of the Marriage Indices for Multnomah County, by SA [REDACTED] revealed a reference on page 224, of the Marriage Index for the Period July, 1910 - October, 1915, to the marriage of one FRED DODD to PEARL ALLEN.

Book 35, page 240 of Marriage Certificates, made available to SA [REDACTED] 10/22/57, by [REDACTED] Clerk, Marriage License Bureau, reflected that Marriage Certificate #28247, was filed May 9, 1914, for FRED DODD, Marion County, Oregon, and PEARL ALLEN of Multnomah County, Oregon, who were married by Circuit Judge, W. N. GATENS, Multnomah County. Witnesses were listed as F. D. HENNESSY and MARY E. MORENO. The certificate reflected that the application for Marriage license was issued 4/14/14. F. DODD

[REDACTED] made available Book 20, Marriage Affidavits, page 49, in which, under #28247, is set out an affidavit by "MARY E. MORENO, 313 1/2 1st", in which MARY MORENO states she knows PEARL ALLEN, 313 1/2 1st Street, that PEARL ALLEN is a resident of Multnomah County, over 18 years of age, to wit, about 18 years of age, and there is no legal impediment to the marriage of PEARL ALLEN to FRED DODD, resident of Salem, Marion County, Oregon, age about 23 years. The Affidavit was filed May 9, 1914, and contains a notation at the bottom, "Married by W. N. GATENS."

[REDACTED] advised that the above two documents are the only records which were required as of the time in question and there would be no other records relating to this marriage.

On 10/22/57 a search was made of the Divorce Indices for Multnomah County by SA [REDACTED] for the period from 1/2/14 to 12/37. No record was located of any divorce action involving FRED and PEARL ALLEN DODD.

[REDACTED], Oregon State Board of Health, Bureau of Vital Statistics, 979 State Office Building, Portland, on 10/24/57 advised that no divorce records are maintained on file by that agency prior to the year 1925. [REDACTED] advised after a search of files that there is no record of a divorce of FRED and PEARL ALLEN DODD, between the years 1925 and 1930.

On 10/24/57 [REDACTED] also made a check of birth records for the period 1903 through 1920, and advised that there is no record of the birth of a child to FRED and PEARL ALLEN DODD during that period. [REDACTED] pointed out that records of births in Portland prior to 1915 are not maintained in the State Bureau of Vital Statistics.

On 10/24/57 [REDACTED] Bureau of Vital Statistics, City Board of Health, Portland City Hall, advised that a check of the birth records for the period from 1909 to 1915, failed to reflect any record of the birth of a child to FRED DODD and PEARL ALLEN DODD.

Concerning the witnesses to the marriage certificate of FRED DODD and PEARL ALLEN, namely F. D. HENNESSY and MARY E. MORENO, the following is noted. The 1913 Portland City Directory lists FRANK D. HENNESSY, lawyer, 701 Chamber of Commerce Bldg., residence 410 - 13th Street. The 1915 Portland City Directory lists FRANK D. HENNESSY, wife, THERESA, Clerk, Circuit Court, Department 5, 410 - 10th Street. The 1956 City Directory does not list either FRANK D. HENNESSY or THERESA HENNESSY. The 1913 and 1914 Portland City Directories do not list MARY E. MORENO. However, the 1915 Portland City Directory lists "Mrs. MARY E. MORENO, 360 Front". She is not listed in the 1916 or the 1956 City Directories.

Since divorce records are not maintained by the State Bureau of Vital Statistics prior to the year 1925, and since FRED DODD listed his address as Salem, Oregon, further check is being made of divorce records at Salem, for any record of divorce proceedings between FRED DODD and PEARL ALLEN DODD.

With reference to F. D. HENNESSY, who was a witness to the marriage of FRED DODD and PEARL ALLEN, as it is noted in Portland letter to Chicago 10/29/57, the 1913 Portland City Directory lists FRANK D. HENNESSY, lawyer, 701 Chamber of Commerce Building, residence 410 - 13th Street, Portland. The 1915 and 1916 Portland City Directories list FRANK D. HENNESSY, (wife, THERESA B.) as clerk, District Court, Portland, he being shown as clerk of Department 5, Circuit Court, in 1915.

The 1920 Portland City Directory lists FRANK HENNESSY, wife, THERESA B., as an engineer, with residence same as in 1915, 410 - 13th Street. The 1950 Portland City Directory lists THERESA B. HENNESSY, widow of FRANK HENNESSY, residing at 627 N. W. 21st Avenue, Portland. Mrs. HENNESSY's name does not appear in subsequent Portland City Directories.

67c On 2/19/58, [REDACTED], Multnomah County Clerk's Office, Multnomah County Court House, advised that he has been employed in the County Clerk's office in various capacities since 1921. [REDACTED] recalled that W. N. GATENS, Circuit Judge, (who married FRED and PEARL ALLEN), died a few months after Judge GATENS was defeated for re-election to office in about 1923. [REDACTED] recalled that while GATENS was a Circuit Judge he was assigned to Department #5. [REDACTED] stated that he was unable to recall F. D. HENNESSY or FRANK D. HENNESSY as having been either a Circuit Court Clerk, or a practicing attorney. [REDACTED] pointed out it was quite likely from the facts related that HENNESSY was a Circuit Court Clerk in Department 5, in which department W. N. GATENS was Judge in 1914.

[REDACTED] further stated that it appears quite likely F. D. HENNESSY was called upon by the Judge to act as a witness to the marriage in question. [REDACTED] stated that this has been a common practice over the years. In the case at hand, he noted that MARY MORENO probably accompanied the couple being married, while HENNESSY was asked by the judge to serve as the second witness to the marriage. [REDACTED] stated that he himself has served in similar capacity under similar circumstances on a number of occasions, he having no knowledge of the persons being married other than when being introduced to them at the time of the ceremony.

From the facts outlined above there is no reason to believe that any purpose would be served in attempting to locate any acquaintances of HENNESSY to ascertain whether they have any knowledge of FRED DODD. Further effort in this direction therefore, is not being made.

It is noted there is no indication in old city directories that FRANK D. HENNESSY ever served in a law office with other attorneys. It is also noted that the 1926 Portland City Directory, lists FRANK D. HENNESSY, wife, THERESA B., as an engineer, Bureau of Water Works, Portland,

67c Reference is made to the request that long time residents in the legal field in both Portland and Salem be contacted for any information they might possess concerning DODD and/or PEARL ALLEN. This request is based upon the alleged fact that WALLIE FORD had stated his Oregon marriage was followed by a bitter separation after which he was "unable to obtain a divorce", which might indicate some other form of legal action. Any consideration given to this lead would be based upon the assumption that DODD or ALLEN had instituted action under the name of DODD, since this was the name under which they were married. As was indicated in Portland letter dated 10/29/57, a complete search was made of the Divorce Indices for Multnomah County by SA [redacted] on 10/22/57, covering the period from 1/2/14 to December, 1937. There was no record whatever of any divorce action having ever been instituted by or against a FRED DODD. It is noted records of the Bureau of Vital Statistics, Oregon State Board of Health, reflect only actual divorces granted rather than the filing of complaints for divorce. It is pointed out in Portland letter to Chicago, 12/31/57, a check made of the records of Marion County Clerk's Office, Salem, Oregon, failed to reflect any record of a divorce involving W. D. FORD, FRED DODD, PEARL ALLEN or PEARL DODD. Since there is no item of record indicating any divorce complaint was ever filed against or by FRED DODD inquiry does not appear warranted among long time residents in the legal field concerning the "bitter separation" of DODD and PEARL ALLEN, which separation would have taken place some 35 to 40 years ago.

Concerning the check of Salem City Directories and Marion County tax lists, reference to which is made in Portland letter dated 1/9/58, it is pointed out the check of records included the name FRED DODD.

It is recalled the records concerning the marriage of PEARL ALLEN to FRED DODD on 4/20/14, indicated that PEARL ALLEN of Portland, Multnomah County, Oregon, was then about eighteen years of age. It is assumed PEARL ALLEN was the maiden name of this woman although this is not specifically indicated. Examination of Portland City Directories issued during the years between 1912 and 1929, failed to reflect any woman was listed under the name of PEARL ALLEN. The directories were also checked for the years 1915 to 1929 for any record of PEARL DODD without any results. It is noted the Portland City Directories issued for the years 1952, 1953, 1954, 1955, and 1957, likewise were checked for any record of either PEARL ALLEN or PEARL DODD but no such name was listed.

It is noted as to MARY E. MORENO, one of the witnesses to the marriage of FRED DODD and PEARL ALLEN, Portland City Directories issued between 1913 and 1957, contain only one possible reference to her, same being the 1915 City Directory as indicated previously in Portland letter dated 10/29/57.

6x [REDACTED] Retail Credit Association of Portland, Inc., on 2/21/58, advised that the records of that agency contain no reference to MARY E. MORENO, [REDACTED] stated that the files of the credit agency are periodically checked and in the absence of any credit activity, files upon becoming 10 years old are destroyed.

In the absence of further logical leads, this case considered RUC.

Muslim Founder White Masquerader

Black Muslims by the thousands pay homage to Wallace Farad, their "Prophet from Mecca," in the mistaken belief that as founder of the black supremacy cult he is one of their own.

It was Farad who composed the tenets of the Black Muslim faith. He is the "holy man and divine person" who must be remembered in one or more of the Black Muslims' seven daily prayers.

Yet Wallace Farad is not a Negro. He is a white man masquerading as a Negro.

His true name is Wallace Dodd.

He was born in New Zealand Feb. 26, 1891.

His father was British—arriving in New Zealand via Australia on a sailing schooner. His mother was a Polynesian native.

MAN OF MANY ALIASES

Dodd's police "rap sheet" includes a conviction for bootlegging and a San Quentin prison term for the sale of narcotics.

To the FBI he is number 56462—and a man of many aliases. The California Bureau of Identification and Investigation lists him as Wallace Ford, number 1737924. At San Quentin, as Ford, he was number

42314. With the Michigan State Police he is Wallace Farad, number 98076.

Although the names and numbers vary, the fingerprints are

always the same, be it Los Angeles, San Quentin or Detroit, birthplace of the Black Muslim movement.

A huge doctored portrait of Dodd, alias Farad, adorns the wall behind the desk of Elijah Muhammad, present titular head of the Black Muslim cult.

"HE'S THE ONE" IS WORD

Elijah Muhammad (true name Elijah Poole, alias Gulan Bogans, 65-year-old native of Georgia), in referring to Farad as a holy man and a divine person, observes:

"He is God himself. He is the one we have been looking for for the past 2000 years to come. He is the one and his word bears witness to the fact that he is the one."

Asked if he personally knew Farad, Elijah Muhammad said that he did. He volunteered that, although Farad had gone back to Mecca, he was in constant touch with him spiritually, pending his return.

Indeed Elijah knows Farad. He first met him on a street corner in Detroit in 1931.

At that time Dodd, under the alias Ford (the names Ford and Farad came later), was a turban wearing door-to-door silk salesman.

ABANDONED FAMILY

Dodd arrived in the United States from New Zealand in 1913 and settled in Portland, Ore. He married but soon abandoned his wife and infant son.

He lingered in the Seattle area under the name of Fred Dodd for a few months before going to Los Angeles. There he opened a restaurant at 833 W. 3rd st. under the name of Wallace D. Ford.

At 28, Dodd took as his common-law wife a 25-year-old waitress employee who on Sept. 1, 1920, bore him a son, Wallace Dodd Ford.

On the son's birth certificate, Dodd listed himself as "white" and a native of New Zealand.

(In 1949 the boy's mother, aware of Dodd's identity and his role as founder of the Black Muslims, had her son's name changed legally from Wallace Dodd Ford to Wallace N...

Ford. Two years later the youth drowned while in the service of the United States Coast Guard.)

Under the alias Wallace D. Ford, Dodd was arrested for bootlegging in January, 1926. Once more he identified himself for the record as a member of the white race. He drew a brief jail sentence.

NARCOTICS RAP

On June 12, 1926, Dodd, under the alias of Ford, was sentenced to San Quentin Prison for the sale of narcotics over his restaurant counter. He drew a term of from six months to six years.

Released from San Quentin on May 27, 1929, he paused briefly in Los Angeles before walking out on his common-law wife and son. Dodd made his way to Chicago and then to Detroit to become a Bible toting itinerant peddler of silks.

Dodd posed as a Negro and prided himself as something of a Biblical authority and mathematician. He had a tremendous gift for gab and soon attracted a depression following of Negroes.

Dodd had no difficulty in convincing his followers they were descendants of the original man, that their forebears were of Islam and that they were Allah's chosen people.

A GOOD THING

Realizing he had a good thing going, Dodd began emphasizing Islam and black supremacy. Gradually he turned away from the Bible, eventually denouncing it outright through interpretations twisted to suit his purpose. He adopted the Koran as his cult's official religious text. He established a temple and conducted classes.

During this period he met Elijah Poole, whom he eventually "ordained" as minister of the Black Muslim faith under the name Elijah Muhammad, "Apostle of Allah."

By now Dodd was passing himself off as the saviour, born in the holy city of Mecca. He claimed to have arrived in America July 4, 1930.

To excite interest among his followers and gain new adherents, Dodd published a crudely printed tract, the preface of which reads:

"This book teaches the lost found nation of Islam. A thorough knowledge of our misera-

ble state of condition in a mathematical way, when we were found by our saviour, W. D. Fard."

CASH FOR SOLUTIONS

The fly leaf reads: "By Prophet W. D. Fard."

The book poses such problems as these:

"A sheep contains fourteen square feet. One-tenth of a square inch contains ten thousand hairs. How many will the fourteen square feet contain? \$15.50 for the person who works this problem. (Qualified members only.)"

Through contributions and expanding commercial endeavors, including the sale of "official" note paper, Dodd had what constituted a tidy financial income.

But the potential dangerousness and the primitive instincts of some of his colleagues became evident on Nov. 21, 1932, with an act of human sacrifice which rocked the populace of Detroit.

Cult member Robert Harris induced member John J. Smith to present himself as a human sacrifice so that he might become "the saviour of the world." Harris plunged a knife into Smith's heart as he lay prone on an improvised altar.

TWO MORE ON LIST

To their dismay, police learned that two additional members were slated as volunteer victims of sacrifice. That marked the beginning of the end for Dodd.

He was arrested by Detroit police on May 25, 1933, under the name of Wallace Don Fard, Alias W. D. Fard, Prophet W. D. Fard, W. D. Fard, Wallace Farad, Wall Farrad, Professor Ford, Farrad Mohammed and F. Mohammed Ali, Founder of the Nation of Islam.

The official report cites Dodd as being "the leader of a voodoo cult with the following of several thousand Negro men and women."

Dodd was ordered out of Detroit.

IN WHITE ROBES

According to his former common-law wife, Dodd went from there to Chicago and became a traveling suit salesman for a mail order tailor.

Working his way through the midwest, Dodd arrived in Los Angeles in the spring of 1934. He was driving a new car and

garbed in flowing white robes.

Dodd's attempt at a reconciliation with his wife failed. He remained for two weeks, visiting daily with his son, to whom he had been sending sizable sums of money from time to time.

Finally he sold his car and boarded a ship for New Zealand with the announcement he was going back to visit his relatives, including an uncle who had paid the fare for his trip

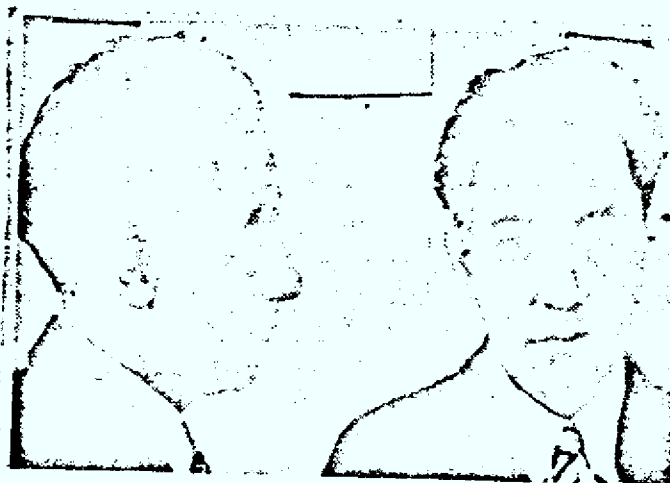
to America in 1913.

Thus the man to whom Black Muslims pray and whose Feb. 26th birthday marks the opening of each annual convention of the black supremacy cult, returned to the land of his birth—as close to Mecca as he has ever been.

Says Elijah Muhammad of "arad's prophesized return from Mecca:

"He is just waiting for his proper time to deliver speeches."

Subsequently on the same date a female by the name of RA--- SIMMONS of the "California Eagle" and ELIJAH MOHAMMED discussed a story which had appeared in the Hearst Newspapers regarding the founder of the Muslims. Their conversation is set forth verbatim as follows:

"E. It is not the picture of Mr. Farard Mohammed.

R. It is not.

E. It is not, I know the other person well, and it is not his age.

R. Not his age. How old is he?

E. It is not Farard Mohammed. He is 86 years old and he was born in the city of Mecca and he is an Arab. This is not an Arab and he speaks 16 different languages.

R. Then the whole story is false.

E. It is completely false.

R. Speaks how many languages.

E. 16 and writes 10.

R. Speaks 16 and writes 10 and you say the story is entirely false.

E. Completely false. We didn't mention of its libel when we give \$100,000 to prove them a liar. To put such a false statement in this paper they can not do it. We will give them a \$100,000 to prove it.

R. To prove it.

E. To prove this man is Mr. Farard Mohammed. Farard Mohammed is an Arab.

R. Do you have a picture of him.

E. I certainly do. I have lots of them.

R. Could I get one from Minister John.

E. Ah, I could send him one if he does not have one.

R. Think that he has one. If he has one, I could get it from him and you would release it.

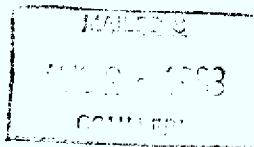

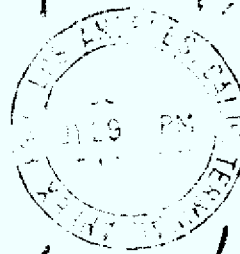

Black Muslims by the thousands pay homage to Wallace Farad, their "Prophet from Mecca," in the mistaken belief that as founder of the black supremacy cult he is one of their own.

It was Farad who composed the tenets of the Black Muslim faith. He is the "holy man and divine person" who must be remembered in one or more of the Black Muslims' seven daily prayers.

Yet Wallace Farad is, admittedly, an enterprising, racketeering fake.

He is not a Negro. He is a white man masquerading as a Negro.

His true name is Wallace Dodd.

He was born in New Zealand, on Feb. 26, 1891.

His father was British — arriving in New Zealand via Australia on a sailing schooner. His mother was a Polynesian native.

Dodd's police "rap sheet" includes a conviction for bootlegging and a San Quentin Prison term for the sale of narcotics.

To the FBI he is No. 56062 — and a man of many aliases. The California Bureau of Identification and Investigation lists him as Wallace Ford, No. 1797924. At San

Quentin, as Ford, he was No. 42314. With the Michigan State Police he is Wallace Farad, No. 98076.

alias Gulan Bogans, 65-year-old native of Georgia) in referring to Farad as a holy man and a divine person, observes:

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Indeed Elijah knows Farad. He first met him on a street corner in Detroit in 1931.

At that time Dodd, under the alias Ford (the names Fard and Farad came later), was a turban-wearing, door-to-door silk salesman.

Abandons Family

Dodd arrived in the United States from New Zealand in 1913 and settled in Portland, Ore. He married, but soon abandoned his wife and infant son.

He lingered in the Seattle area, under the name of Fred Dodd, for a few months before going to Los Angeles. There he opened a restaurant at 803 West Third St. under the name of Wallace D. Ford.

At 26, Dodd took as his common-law wife a 25-year-old waitress employe who on Sept. 1, 1920, bore him a son, Wallace Dodd Ford.

On the son's birth certificate, Dodd listed himself as "white" and a native of New Zealand.

(In 1940 the boy's mother, aware of Dodd's identity and his role as founder of the Black Muslims, had her son's name changed legally from Wallace Dodd Ford to Wallace Max Ford. Two years later the youth drowned while in the service of the U.S. Coast Guard.)

Under the alias Wallace D. Ford, Dodd was arrested for bootlegging in January, 1926. Once more he identified himself for the record as a member of the white race. He drew a brief jail sentence.

On June 12, 1926, Dodd, under the alias of Ford, was sentenced to San Quentin Prison for the sale of narcotics over his restaurant counter. He drew a term of from six months to six years.

Released from San Quentin on May 27, 1929, he passed briefly in Los Angeles before walking out on his common-law wife and son. Dodd made his way to Chicago and then to Detroit to become a Bible-toting itinerant peddler of silks.

Dodd posed as a Negro and grided himself as something of a Biblical authority and mathematician. He had a tremendous gift for gab and soon attracted a depression-following of Negroes.

Dodd had no difficulty in convincing his fol-

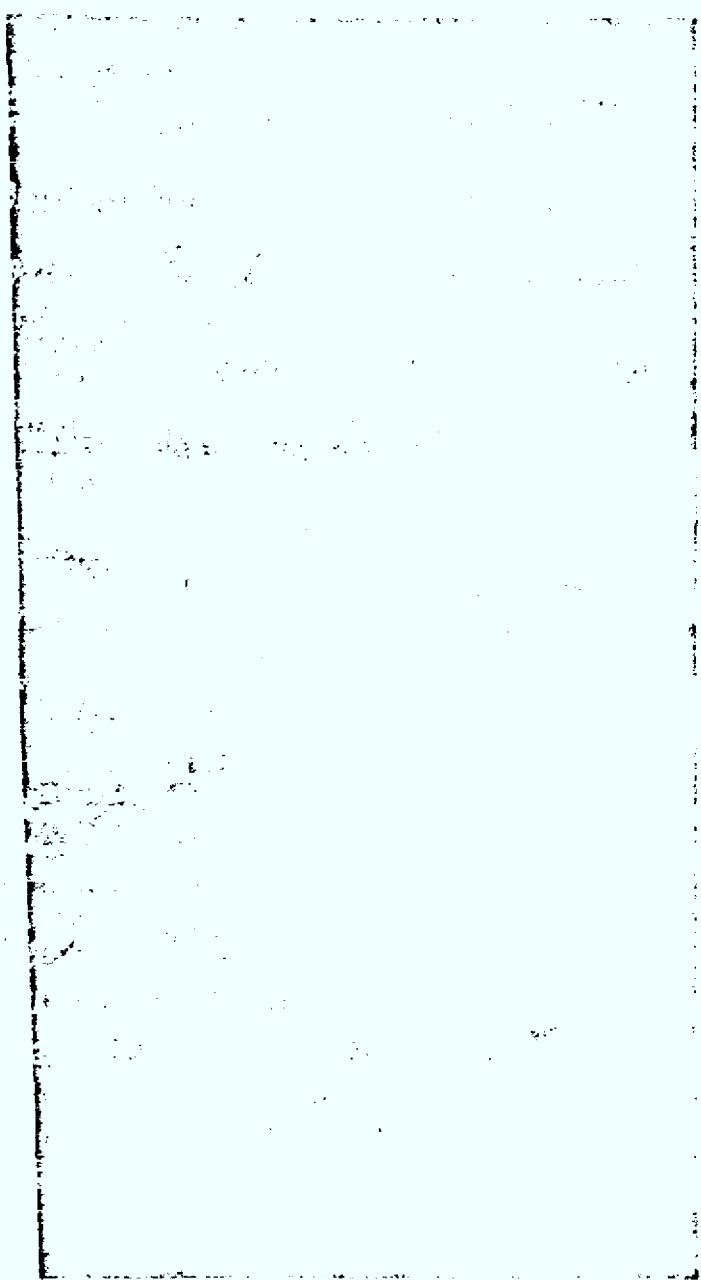
lowers they were descendants of the original man that their forebears were of Islam and that they were Allah's chosen people.

A Good Racket

Realizing he had a good thing going, Dodd began emphasizing Islam and black supremacy. Gradually he turned away from the Bible, eventually denouncing it outright through interpretations twisted to suit his purpose. He adopted the Koran as his cult's official religious text. He first held a temple and conducted classes.

During this period he met Elijah Peale, who he eventually ordained as minister of the Black Muslim faith under the name Elijah Muhammad, the "Apostle of Allah."

To excite interest among his followers and gain new adherents, Dodd published a crudely printed tract, the preface of which reads:

"This book teaches the Lost Found Nation of Islam. A thorough knowledge of our miserable state of condition in a mathematical way, when we were found by our Saviour, W. D. Fard."

The fly leaf reads: "By Prophet W. D. Fard."

The book poses such problems as these:

"A sheep contains 14 square feet. One-tenth of a square foot contains 10,000 hairs. How many will the 14 square feet contain? \$15.50 for the per-

Detroit Ousted Him For Human Sacrifice

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But the potential dangerousness and the primitive instincts of some of his followers became evident on Nov. 21, 1932, with an act of human sacrifice which rocked the populace of Detroit.

Cult member Robert Harris induced member John J. Smith to present himself as a human sacrifice so that he might become "The Saviour of the World." Harris plunged a knife into Smith's heart as he lay prone on an improvised altar.

To their dismay, police learned that two additional members were slated as volunteer victims of sacrifice. That marked the beginning of the end for Dodd.

He was arrested by Detroit police on May 2, 1933, under the name of Wallace Don Fard, alias W. D. Fard, Prophet W. D. Fard, W. D. Fard, Wallace Farad, Wali Farrad, Professor Ford, Farrar Mohammed and F. Mohammed Ali, founder of the Nation of Islam.

The official report cites Dodd as being "the leader of a Voo-Doo cult with the following of several thousand Negro men and women."

It states that Dodd admitted his teachings "were strictly a racket" and that he was "getting all the money out of it he could."

Dodd was ordered out of Detroit.

According to his former common-law wife, Dodd went from there to Chicago and became a traveling salesman for a mail order tailor.

Working his way through the Midwest, Dodd arrived in Los Angeles in the spring of 1934.

White Robes

He was driving a new car and was garbed in flowing white robes.

Dodd's attempt at a reconciliation with his wife failed. He remained for two weeks, visiting daily with his son, to whom he had been sending sizable sums of money from time to time.

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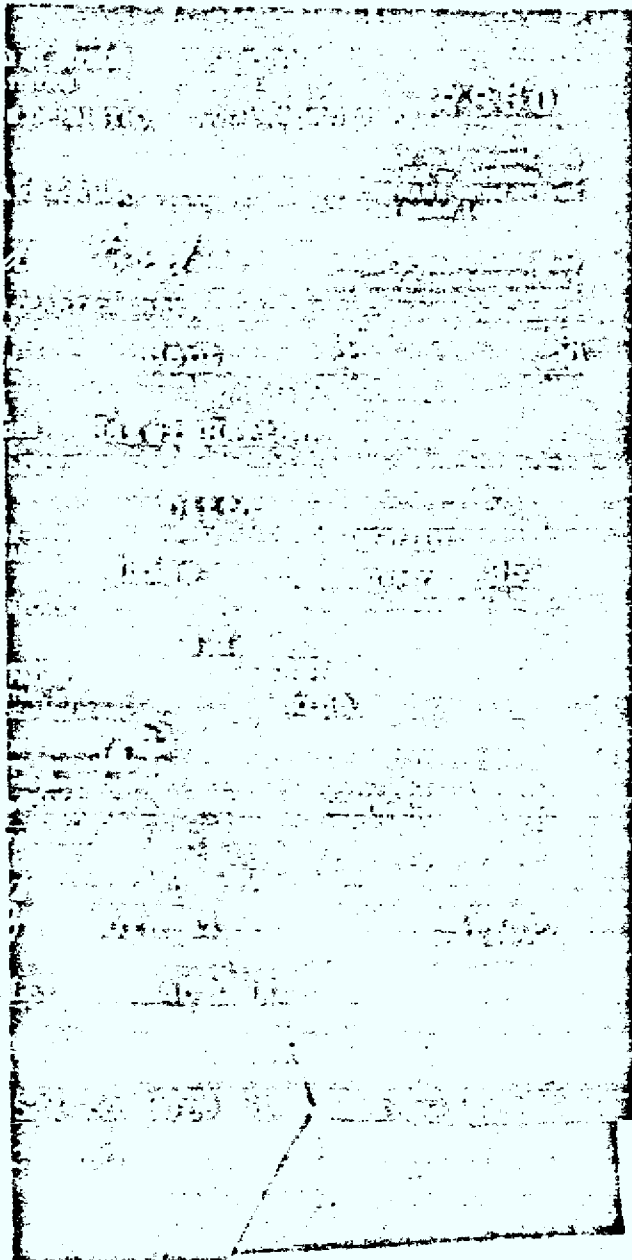

A Dope Peddler, Dodd Served Time in Quentin

Black Muslims by the thousands pay homage to Wallace Farad, their "Prophet from Mecca," in the mistaken belief that as founder of the black supremacy cult he is one of their own.

It was Farad who composed the tenets of the Black Muslim faith. He is the "holy man and divine person" who must be remembered in one or more of the Black Muslims' seven daily prayers.

Yet Wallace Farad is, admittedly, an enterprising, racketeering fake.

He is not a Negro. He is a white man masquerading as a Negro.

His true name is Wallace Dodd.

He was born in New Zealand, on Feb. 28, 1891.

His father was British — arriving in New Zealand via Australia on a sailing schooner. His mother was a Polynesian native.

Dodd's police "rap sheet" includes a conviction for bootlegging and a San Quentin Prison term for the sale of narcotics.

To the FBI he is No. 56082 — and a man of many aliases. The California Bureau of Identification and Investigation lists him as Wallace Ford, No. 1797924. At San

Quentin, as Ford, he was No. 42314. With the Michigan State Police he is Wallace Farad, No. 98076.

Although the names and numbers vary, the fingerprints are always the same, be it Los Angeles, San Quentin or Detroit, birthplace of the Black Muslim movement.

A huge doctored portrait of Dodd, alias Farad, adorns the wall behind the desk of Elijah Muhammad, present titular head of the Black Muslim cult.

Elijah Muhammad (true name Elijah Poole,

alias Gulan Bogans, 65-year-old native of Georgia) in referring to Farad as a holy man and a divine person, observes:

"He is God himself. He is the one we have been looking for for the past 2000 years to come. He is the one and his word bears witness to the fact that he is the one."

Asked if he personally knew Farad, Elijah Muhammad said that he did. He volunteered that, although Farad had gone back to Mecca, he was in constant touch with him spiritually, pending his return.

Indeed Elijah knows Farad. He first met him on a street corner in Detroit in 1931.

At that time Dodd, under the alias Ford (the names Farad and Farad came later), was a turban-wearing, door-to-door silk salesman.

Abandons Family

Dodd arrived in the United States from New Zealand in 1913 and settled in Portland, Ore. He married, but soon abandoned his wife and infant son.

He lingered in the Seattle area, under the name of Fred Dodd, for a few months before going to Los Angeles. There he opened a restaurant at 803 West Third St. under the name of Wallace D. Ford.

At 26, Dodd took as his common-law wife a 23-year-old waitress employe who on Sept. 1, 1920, bore him a son, Wallace Dodd Ford.

On the son's birth certificate, Dodd listed himself as "white" and a native of New Zealand.

In 1940 the boy's mother, aware of Dodd's identity and his role as founder of the Black Muslims, had her son's name changed legally from Wallace Dodd Ford to Wallace Max Ford. Two years later the youth drowned while in the service of the U.S. Coast Guard.

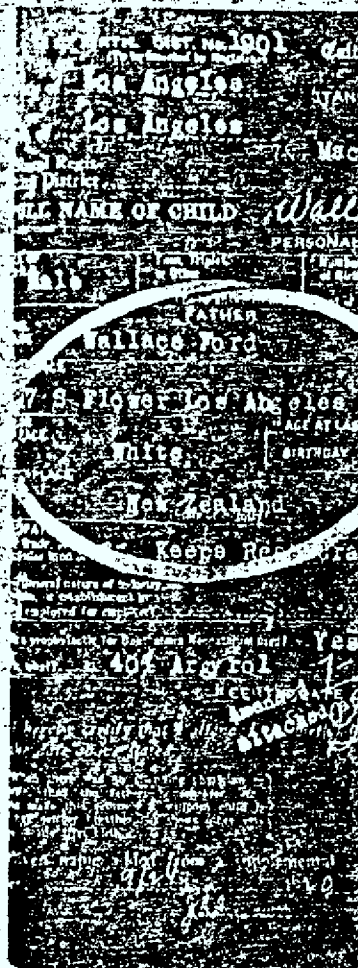
Under the alias Wallace D. Ford, Dodd was arrested for bootlegging in January, 1928. Once more he identified himself for the record as a member of the white race. He drew a brief jail sentence.

On June 12, 1928, Dodd, under the alias of Ford, was sentenced to San Quentin Prison for the sale of narcotics over his restaurant counter. He drew a term of from six months to six years.

Released from San Quentin on May 27, 1929, he paused briefly in Los Angeles before walking out on his common-law wife and son. Dodd made his way to Chicago and then to Detroit to become a Bible-toting itinerant peddler of alms.

Dodd posed as a Negro and prided himself as something of a Biblical authority and mathematician. He had a tremendous gift for gab and soon attracted a depression-following of Negroes.

Dodd had no difficulty in convincing his fol-



lowers they were descendants of the old that their forebears were of Islam and were Allah's chosen people.

A Good Racket

Realizing he had a good thing began emphasizing Islam and black. Gradually he turned away from the truthfully denouncing it outright through tions twisted to suit his purpose. He Koran as his cult's official religious text.

With reference to the article "Black Muslim Founder Imposed as a White" which appeared in the 7/24/63 issue of the Los Angeles "Herald Examiner," the Director noted: "Did we check out the names of the 'Black Muslims' or is the attached article news to you?" The article alleges that "Wallace Ford," the founder of the "Black Muslim" (Nation of Islam--NOI), is a white man masquerading as a Negro.

The information in the article is not new to us. All of the information set forth in the news story is contained in our files. We prepared two monographs, one dated June, 1963, and the other dated October, 1963, which contained information concerning the origin of the NOI and its founders. The information contained in these monographs concerning the historical origin of the NOI is in much greater detail than that set forth in the news item.

Our files indicate that the founder of the NOI was known as Wallace Ford Ford who has been known by many aliases, including Wallace Ford. His birth date has been variously listed as 1912; February 10, 1913; February 20, 1913; 1914; and 1915. His birth place has been reported as being near Portland, Oregon; Grand Rapids, Michigan; and New Zealand. We have not been able to verify his birth date or birth place nor identify his parents. W. F. Ford has not been seen or heard from since 1961.

Although the fingerprint cards received at the time of Ford's arrests show him to be white, the NOI has been successful in contributing to the mystery of Ford's origin by claiming that his father was a "Devil" (white man) while his mother was one half "original" (other than white such as Negro, Chinese or Indian). During the course of our investigation he was described as being a Negro on many occasions and on occasion as of possible Arabian descent. Although, it was not until about the time (1960) he claimed

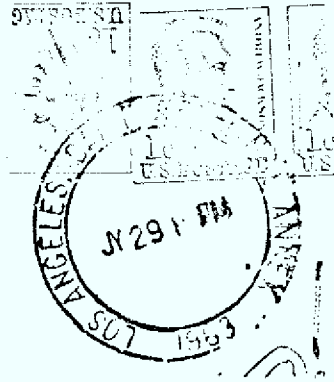

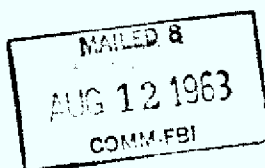

White's Black Record

'Prophet' of Muslims Afoul of Law in L.A.

Wallace Dodd, alias Wallace Farad, worshipped by thousands of Black Muslims as their divinely anointed "prophet from Mecca" possesses a lengthy Los Angeles police record as a white man who often lived outside the law.

It is as a Negro that Dodd, also known on various police blotters as Wallace Ford, is revered by members of the black supremacy cult as a holy man and divine person to be remembered in one or more of seven daily prayers.

The facts of Dodd's birth in New Zealand to a white father and Polynesian mother in 1891 were revealed exclusively in yesterday's Sunday Herald Examiner.

Microfilmed records of the Los Angeles Police Department reveal a record of law-breaking dating back to 1913, five years after he first stepped foot on American soil.

As a Caucasian, Dodd operated a cafe at 236 W. 3rd St., Los Angeles, known as Wallace's Restaurant. At this period, he used the name Willie D. Ford, recorded by the Police Department under file No. 16448F.

Less than one week after a grateful nation observed the Armistice ending World War I, two men entered Wallace's and ordered steaks. Police records show. They were R. W. Gilbrand of Santa Susana and his brother-in-law, R. A. Barker of 236 S. Flower St. The time was 2 a.m. on Nov. 17, 1918.

Dodd told the two men they each would have to post a \$2 deposit before he would put the steaks on the grill, according to the police record.

STRUCK AGAIN

An argument started, Dodd pulled a gun from beneath the counter but later put it away, came from behind the counter and swung at Gilbrand, missing him. Gilbrand backed out of the cafe and stood at the curb, where Dodd again struck at him. Gilbrand slipped and Wallace Ford, pseudonym of Dodd, struck his head on the pavement.

Bystanders summoned police. Dodd ran from the scene and later was captured at 212 S. Bunker Hill. He was described at 25 years old, 5' 6" and 133 pounds. He was booked on charges of assault with a deadly weapon and fingerprints were taken.

These were to follow Dodd wherever he went. Although he changed his name as the occasion demanded, his fingerprints remained without change, proving his true identity at all times.

Charges against Dodd in the restaurant beating eventually were dropped. Eight years passed before Dodd again ran afoul of the law in Los Angeles, this time for violation of the Wright Act—possession and sale of bootleg alcohol.

The date was Jan. 20, 1926; the scene, Wallace's Restaurant. The future patron saint of the Black Muslims committed the error of selling a pint of illegal booze to a police officer.

That scrape cost him a \$101 fine. Between the time of Dodd's arrest for bootlegging and his court appearance, he was nabbed for violation of the State Poison Act at 3rd Street and Vermont Avenue. He gave addresses of 722 W. 3rd St. and 217 S. Flower St.

At that time, arrests for the sale of narcotics came under the Poison Act. He then gave his birthplace as Oregon, later changing his story to the effect that he was of Hawaiian ancestry.

"Subject is the FARD MUHAMMAD who allegedly appeared to ELIJAH POOLE (Muhammad), the leader of the Nation of Islam in 1930. ELIJAH POOLE has been quoted as saying that FARD MUHAMMAD came directly from Allah to teach him (Elijah). ELIJAH further states that FARD has returned to Mecca.

"Information from Los Angeles City Health Dept., Bureau of Vital Statistics:

"Name of child - WALLACE DORIS FORD, born September 1, 1940 in the City and County of Los Angeles, Calif. at McDonald Sanatorium, 1521 So. Folk St., Los Angeles. Local Registrar's # 7850. Father - WALLACE FORD, 247 So. Flower St. in Los Angeles, wife, age 26, born in New England, occupation keeps restaurant. Mother - HAZEL BARTON, 247 So. Flower St., Los Angeles, wife, age 25, born in New York, occupation, none.

"On July 1, 1940, HAZEL FORD EVELSIZER petitioned to the Department of Public Health to change the name of her son, WALLACE DORIS FORD, to WALLACE MAX FORD, and also changed the occupation from none to housewife. This affidavit was also signed by CLIFFORD EVELSIZER of 4776 Hub St., Los Angeles.

"Information from Los Angeles Police Dept., Criminal Records:

"WALLY D. FORD, LA # 16448, CII # 1797904, FBI # 56062, San Quentin Prison # 42314.

"Subject was first arrested on November 17, 1918 for assault with a deadly weapon. Subject was alleged to have assaulted P. V. GILLIERAND of Santa Barbara, Calif., with a pistol and then struck him with his fists. This took place in a restaurant at 803 W. 3rd St., Los Angeles, which was owned and operated by MR. FORD.

"Note: There is a P.V. Gillierand in the Ventura County telephone directory who resides at 751 Vista Del Rincon in Ventura, Calif. Phone Number, Miller 39565. For further information, see arrest reports of subject.

At the time of his arrest subject gave his residence address as 722 W. 3rd St., Los Angeles. At this time of arrest, subject stated that his race was Hawaiian and that he was born in Portland, Oregon. Subject was convicted of this offense and sentenced to 0-5 years at San Quentin. Subject served approximately 2 years prior to his release.

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"Information from [REDACTED] (It is requested that this information remain CONFIDENTIAL)"

"The name WALLACE D. FORD and his various aliases were checked with the Michigan Police Headquarters and Identification Bureau. It was noted that he was arrested on 5/25/33 by the Detroit P.D. and charged with investigation of disorderly person. FORD at that time gave his age as 33 and his color as white. The name on the arrest report is WALLACE D. PARHAD. He gave his address as the TRAYNOR HOTEL, Detroit, Michigan. On May 26, 1933, he was discharged by the superintendent of police at the request of Lieutenant Hoffman of the detective bureau.

"Information from Los Angeles County, Files of the Superior Court:

"File #27328 and 27329

"Defendants WALLY D. FORD and EDWARD DONALDSON charged with violation of the State Poison Act (three counts). Count 1 - defendant had in his possession a preparation of morphine containing more than one quarter grain of morphine to the swardupois ounce. Count 2 - on or about the 14th of February, 1926, he had in his possession a preparation of heroine containing more than one eighth grain of heroine to the swardupois ounce. Count 3 - on or about the 14th of

"On the hearing of this act, the following facts appeared in evidence:

"A man by the name of DONALDSON (co-defendant) negotiated with a police officer (without the knowledge of the latter's official position) for the sale to him of certain narcotics. At that time, DONALDSON stated to the police officer that the narcotics which he proposed to sell, were in the possession of FORD. Thereafter, DONALDSON and FORD met the police officer for the purpose of concluding the proposed sale, at which time, after the arrangements for the sale had been fully discussed between the parties, FORD discovered that his prospective customer was a police officer who subsequently arrested both FORD and DONALDSON. ~~CONFIDENTIAL~~

"About three hours later, the police officer and two others visited a certain restaurant owned and operated by FORD. In the rear of the restaurant, a package rolled in a newspaper which contained numerous bottles and vials of narcotics, was found. Before the package was opened, FORD stated that it was 'a bundle of old laundry'. Afterward he admitted to the officers that it was the stuff that he wished to sell. ~~CONFIDENTIAL~~

"Subject was found guilty by a jury on May 14, 1926 and was sentenced to San Quentin as prescribed by law. He was received at San Quentin on June 12, 1926. The sentence was set at four years by the State Board of Prison Directors. Subject was released from custody on May 27, 1929. ~~CONFIDENTIAL~~

"Interview with MRS. HAZEL EVELSIZER, conducted on February 7, 1933 at approximately 10:00 A.M.: ~~CONFIDENTIAL~~

"MRS. EVELSIZER stated that she and FORD met in Los Angeles, Calif. in the early 1920's. She stated that they ~~CONFIDENTIAL~~

lived together for approximately 3 years but were never married. She said that he was very definitely a Caucasian. She first met him at his restaurant which was located at 803 W. 3rd St. She said that during the time they were living together she had occasion to read correspondence which was sent to him in the name of FRED DODD at 803 W. 3rd St. In this correspondence there was a mention of a marriage in Portland, Oregon and of a son which was the result of this marriage. When DODD was arrested, Mrs. EVELSIER met EARL OSBORNE and later married him in Santa Ana, California. MR. OSBORNE died six months later. Mrs. EVELSIER met CLIFFORD EVELSIER in Los Angeles in the late 1920's when they were both working for the same company. She later went with him to New York and married him on September 18, 1930 in Erie, Pennsylvania.

*Information from Portland, Oregon Police Dept., dated September 11, 1962:

*Portland Oregon Police Department was unable to locate any public records concerning WALLACE B. DODD although they were able to locate the record of marriage between FRED DODD and FRANK ALLAN on May 5, 1914. The witnesses to this marriage were J. D. HUNNESKY and MARY E. WOFENO. That department states that a thorough investigation was conducted and no further information was found on subject, his wife, births of any children or a record of any witnesses to this marriage.

*CLIFFORD O. EVELSIER and SARAH E. EVELSIER, 4776 Hub St., Los Angeles. News item - "Funeral services for MR. CLIFFORD O. EVELSIER was playground director for the City of Los Angeles Recreation and Parks Department for 14 years. He was a veteran of World War I and had resided in the city for 45 years. On 12/31/52, he received a disability pension of 75%. His death certificate shows his name as CLIFFORD OLIVER EVELKINER, deceased 2/19/61 at 4:10 A.M. from lung cancer.

"Information from Police Headquarters, Wellington, New Zealand:

"An investigation was conducted by the above source and a search was conducted for WALLACE POOD giving the above aliases. In a letter received December 28, 1962 from that Department, they state that there are very few Poods in New Zealand using the name of POOD. An inquiry was made of those families and no one of the above name or description was found. The above source could furnish no further information on the subject.

"Information from magazine article, THE AMERICAN JOURNAL OF SOCIOLOGY, Vol. XLIII, No. 6, May, 1938, pp 894-907, 'The Voodoo Cult Among Negro Migrants in Detroit' by MARY ANN DOANE MCKINCH

"Page 896, 'The Prophet (POOD, Wallace B.).' '...the prophet lived in Detroit from July 4, 1930 until June 30, 1934...' 'His very name is uncertain. He was known usually as Mr. WALLI PARRAD or MR. W. B. PARD, although he used the following names: PROFESSOR POOD, MR. PARRAD MURKIN, MR. F. MURKIN, MR. ALL. One of the few survivors who heard his first address stated that he himself said, 'My name is W. B. PARD and I come from the holy city of Mecca.'

"(Page 895), 'The Prophet and founder of the cult made his first appearance among the Negroes of Detroit as a peddler. He first came to our houses selling raincoats and then afterwards milks. This way he could get into the people's houses for every woman was eager to see the nice things the peddlers had for sale. ...we asked him to tell us about our own country. If we ask him to eat with us he would eat whatever we had on the table but after the meal he began to talk: 'Now don't eat this food. It's poison for you. The people in your own country do not eat it. Since they eat the right kind of foods they have the best of health at all time. If you would live just like the people in your home country, you would never be sick any more.'" X u

CSLA 3184-S also made available arrest reports on 8/23/63, for the three LAPD arrests recited in his above report. The report for the 11/17/68 arrest for assault states that witnesses R. A. EENKERT and GILLIBRAND went into the restaurant at 803 West 3rd Street and ordered a steak and the cook (MR. FORD) (booked as WALLIE FORD) told them they would have to put up a \$2.00 deposit before he would put the steak on. This started an argument and FORD pulled a gun on them. He finally put the gun away and came out from behind the counter and made a swing at GILLIBRAND. He dodged the blow and backed out on the sidewalk and just as he got to the curb FORD struck at him again; this time GILLIBRAND slipped off the curb and struck his head on the curb. FORD jumped astride him and grabbed him by the throat and beat his head on the street. Officers went to the restaurant to locate FORD but he had gone and they could not locate his home address. WALLIE FORD was subsequently arrested at 212 South Bunkerhill Street, Los Angeles, and released because the complaining witness would not prosecute. X u

The report of the 1/20/26 arrest shows he was arrested at 803 West 3rd Street, Los Angeles. An officer went to that address as he had received information that bootlegging was going on in a restaurant there. He told WALLIE D. FORD he wanted to buy some liquor and FORD telephoned an order of 8 pints. FORD was arrested following a sale. The identification sheet dated 1/20/26, contains the following information: X u

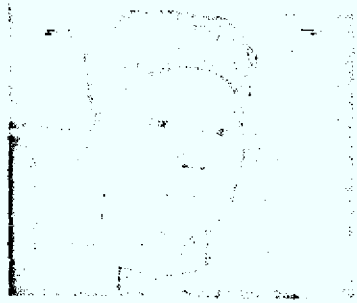

I am interested in obtaining a copy of the criminal record on one Wallace Farad, alias Wallace D. Ford and Wallie Ford, FBI #36002. This FBI number was taken from a criminal record of the Detroit Police Department #45318 of May 25, 1933, when Farad was arrested on a charge of "Inv.; Diso. Person." The record further indicated that Farad was the leader of the "Voodoo Cult" in the city of Detroit. It is my understanding that this organization later became the Nation of Islam.

An Assistant Attorney General of the State of New York, Mr. William D. Bresinhan, has tried and won several prison cases involving members of the Nation of Islam and has several additional trials coming up early in October. I have discussed mutual problems involving the Nation of Islam with him and I am endeavoring to exchange some information with him. He has asked for an authenticated copy of Farad's criminal record so that he may use it in one of his October trials. If you can provide such a document I would be glad to forward it to Mr. Bresinhan in Albany.

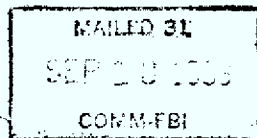

Prison and the San Francisco Police Department records for the same reason as regards DONALDSON and to also review automobile registrations to determine if FORD registered a car in California during the years 1932-1935, it being noted FORD was driving a car in California in either 1932 or 1933.

Re San Francisco letter to the Director of 6/17/63, a copy of which is being enclosed herewith for San Diego, sets forth information regarding arrests of EDWARD DONALDSON. The letter noted that the Folsom Prison file revealed DONALDSON was born and lived his entire life at San Diego, California; that he was discharged from Folsom Prison on 9/7/34. San Francisco also advised that California Motor Vehicle registrations were negative as regards FORD. The letter also enclosed fingerprint cards on DONALDSON to the Bureau.

Re Los Angeles letter to the Bureau dated 8/29/63, a copy of which is being forwarded to San Diego, also set forth arrest and background data re DONALDSON, aka EDWARD DONALSON, EDWARD MANN, EDWARD MNAH. This letter also reflects that the Los Angeles Police Department caused an investigation on FORD to be conducted in New Zealand and nothing of pertinence was gained. Set forth below is descriptive data re WALLACE DODD FORD:

He has utilized, or has been referred to, by the following names: FRED DODD, WALLACE DON FORD, WALLIE D. FORD, W. D. FARD, WALI FARRAD, WALLACE FARAD, W. D. FERAUD, WALEI FORD, F. The San Diego Office is requested to review indices, credit, criminal and other appropriate records in an effort to locate EDWARD DONALDSON, aka EDWARD DONALSON, EDWARD MANN, EDWARD MNAN. It is noted he was last heard of in September, 1934, and prior to that time had resided all his life in San Diego.

San Diego is also requested to interview DONALDSON, if located, regarding the location of WALLIE D. FORD, his co-defendant on 2/15/26 in Los Angeles, California (See page three of Los Angeles letter to Bureau dated 8/29/63). It is noted WALLIE D. FORD and his partner, EDWARD DONALDSON, were arrested in Los Angeles on 2/15/26 on charges of violation of the State Poison Act. Apparently the two men operated a cafe in Los Angeles at that time.

San Diego is further requested to search its indices regarding WALLACE DODD FORD and aliases used by him as set forth above. It is also requested appropriate credit and criminal checks be made.

This is being requested as FORD was last seen in 1932 or 1933 and DONALDSON was released from prison in September, 1934. The possibility exists DONALDSON returned to San Diego and the possibility also exists that FORD may have gone to San Diego in 1932 or 1933 or at a later date.

The Bureau's attention is directed to the fact that Chicago originally intended to set out a lead for New Zealand authorities in an effort to locate ALLAN. It is noted that referenced Los Angeles letter of 8/29/63 reflected the Los Angeles Police Department had already conducted this lead with the New Zealand authorities.

As noted above, all leads outstanding in this matter, other than the ones being set forth for San Diego, have been covered. There appears to be no need to set out further leads for the New Zealand authorities. It appears now that the only logical leads are ones to attempt to locate and interview DONALDSON. Upon the results of the San Diego investigation, Chicago will, if the results offer no logical leads, recommend no further investigative activity in this matter.

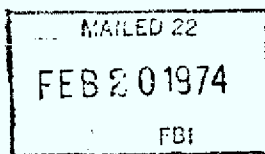

As I told you in my letter of March 14th, ^{NR (cont. 1/2/75)} I have been trying to verify the information about Wallace Ford, alias Farad, contained in the newspaper clipping you so graciously sent me (Los Angeles Herald Examiner, July 28, 1963, article by Ed Montgomery). However extensive research has failed to turn up any evidence to corroborate Mr. Montgomery's story. In fact, information provided by the U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service in Washington and in San Francisco, and by the New Zealand Registrar-General tends to disprove Mr. Montgomery's findings.

My research tends to indicate that :

- 1) Wallace B. Ford was born in Oregon in 1891.
- 2) He was a black man and a U.S. citizen.
- 3) He fathered a son on September 2, 1920.
- 4) He served three years in San Quentin State Prison from 1926 to 1929 for violation of the State Prison Act.
- 5) He died in Detroit in 1934.

As I stated in my earlier correspondence, I have no need for your files per se, and in any case, could not afford the fees involved. What I do need (and it is vital to my research) is authoritative confirmation or denial of the above points. Can you simply tell me whether my facts are accurate?

I realize of course that the Bureau has before it many matters which are more pressing and important than mine ; and I certainly am grateful for the time and effort already expended on my behalf. "His true name is Wallace Dodd.

"He was born in New Zealand, on February 26, 1891.

"His father was British - arriving in New Zealand via Australia on a sailing schooner. His mother was a Polynesian native.

"Dodd's police "rap sheet" includes a conviction for bootlegging and a San Quentin Prison term for the sale of narcotics.

"To the FBI he is No. 56062 - and a man of many aliases. The California Bureau of Identification and Investigation lists him as Wallace Ford, No. 1797924. At San Quentin, as Ford, he was No. 42314. With the Michigan State Police he is Wallace Farad, No. 98076.

"Although the names and numbers vary, the fingerprints are always the same, be it Los Angeles, San Quentin, or Detroit, birthplace of the Black Muslim movement.

"A huge doctored portrait of Dodd, alias Farad, adorns the wall behind the desk of Elijah Muhammad, present titular head of the Black Muslim cult.

"Elijah Muhammad, (true name Elijah Poole, alias Gulan Bogans, 65-year old native of Georgia) in referring to Farad as a holy man and a divine person, observes:

"He is God himself. He is the one we have been looking forth for the past 2000 years to come. He is the one and his word bears witness to the fact that he is the one."

NATION OF ISLAM

"Asked if he personally knew Farad, Elijah Muhammad said that he did. He volunteered that, although Farad had gone back to Mecca, he was in constant touch with him spiritually, pending his return.

"Indeed Elijah knows Farad. He first met him on a street corner in Detroit in 1931.

"At that time Dodd, under the alias Ford (the names Fard and Farad came later), was a turban-wearing, door-to-door silk salesman).

"Abandons Family

"Dodd arrived in the United States from New Zealand in 1913 and settled in Portland, Oregon. He married, but soon abandoned his wife and infant son.

"He lingered in the Seattle area, under the name of Fred Dodd, for a few months before going to Los Angeles. There he opened a restaurant at 803 West Third St. under the name of Wallace D. Ford.

"At 26, Dodd took as his common-law wife a 25-year-old waitress employe who on September 1, 1920, bore him a son, Wallace Dodd Ford.

"On the son's birth certificate, Dodd listed himself as "white" and a native of New Zealand.

"(In 1940 the boy's mother, aware of Dodd's identity and his role as founder of the Black Muslims, had her son's name changed legally from Wallace Dodd Ford to Wallace Max Ford. Two years later the youth drowned while in the service of the U.S. Coast Guard).

"Muslim Founder Admits:
'I'm a Fake'

"Under the alias Wallace D. Ford, Dodd was arrested for bootlegging in January, 1926. Once more he identified himself for the record as a member of the white race. He drew a brief jail sentence.

"On June 12, 1926, Dodd, under the alias of Ford, was sentenced to San Quentin Prison for the sale of narcotics over his restaurant counter. He drew a term of from six months to six years.

"Released from San Quentin on May 27, 1929, he paused briefly in Los Angeles before walking out on his common-law wife and son. Dodd made his way to Chicago and then to Detroit to become a Bible-toting itinerant peddler of silks.

"Dodd posed as a Negro and prided himself as something of a Biblical authority and mathematician. He had a tremendous gift for gab and soon attracted a depression-following of Negroes.

"Dodd had no difficulty in convincing his followers they were descendants of the original man, that their forebears were of Islam and that they were Allah's chosen people.

"A Good Racket

"Realizing he had a good thing going, Dodd began emphasizing Islam and black supremacy. Gradually he turned away from the Bible, eventually denouncing it outright through interpretations twisted to suit his

purpose. He adopted the Koran as his cult's official religion text. He established a temple and conducted classes.

"During this period he met Elijah Poole, whom he eventually ordained as minister of the Black Muslim faith under the name of Elijah Muhammad, "Apostle of Allah."

"By now Dodd was passing himself off as The Savior, born in the Holy City of Mecca. He claimed to have arrived in America on July 4, 1930.

"To excite interest among his followers and gain new adherents, Dodd published a crudely printed tract, the preface of which reads:

"This book teaches the Lost Found Nation of Islam. A thorough knowledge of our miserable state of condition in a mathematical way, when we were found by our Savior, W. D. Fard."

"The fly leaf reads: "By Prophet W. D. Fard."

"The book poses such problems as these:

"A sheep contains 14 square feet. One-tenth of a square inch contains 10,000 hairs. How many will the 14 square feet contain? \$15.50 for the person who works this problem. (Qualified Members Only).

"Through contributions and expanding commercial endeavors, including the sale of "official" note paper, Dodd had what constituted a tidy financial racket.

"Detroit Ousted Him
For Human Sacrifice

"A Sacrifice

"But the potential dangerousness and the primitive instincts of some of his followers became evident on November 21, 1932, with an act of human sacrifice which rocked the populace of Detroit.

"Cult member Robert Harris induced member John J. Smith to present himself as a human sacrifice so that he might become "The Saviour of the World" Harris plunged a knife into Smith's heart as he lay prone on an improvised altar.

"To their dismay, police learned that two additional members were slated as volunteer victims of sacrifice. That marked the beginning of the end for Dodd.

"He was arrested by Detroit police on May 25, 1933, under the name of Wallace Don Fard, alias W. D. Fard, Prophet W. D. Fard, W. D. Foard, Wallace Farad, Wali Farrad, Professor Ford, Farrad Mohammed and F. Mohammed Ali, founder of the Nation of Islam.

"The official report cites Dodd as being "the leader of a Voo-Doo cult with the following of several thousand Negro men and women."

"It states that Dodd admitted his teachings "were strictly a racket" and that he was "getting all the money out of it he could".

"Dodd was ordered out of Detroit.

"According to his former common-law wife, Dodd went from there to Chicago and became a traveling salesman for a mail order tailor.

"Working his way through the Midwest, Dodd arrived in Los Angeles in the spring of 1934.

"White Robes

"He was driving a new car and was garbed in flowing white robes.

"Dodd's attempt at a reconciliation with his wife failed. He remained for two weeks, visiting daily with his son, to whom he had been sending sizable sums of money from time to time.

"Finally he sold his car and boarded a ship for New Zealand with the announcement he was going back to visit his relatives, including an uncle who had paid the fare for his trip to America in 1913.

"Thus the revered holy man to whom Black Muslims pray and whose February 26 birthday marks the opening of each annual convention of the black supremacy cult, returned to the land of his birth - as close to Mecca as he has ever been.

"Says Elijah Muhammad of Farad's prophesied return from Mecca:

"He is just waiting for his proper time to deliver speeches."

In response to the above newspaper article, the August 16, 1953 issue of Muhammad Speaks, a newspaper published by the NOI contained the following newspaper article written by Elijah Muhammad, leader of the NOI.

"Beware of Phony Claims

"I, Elijah Muhammad, Messenger of Allah, told the Los Angeles "Herald-Examiner" Office on Monday, July 29, 1963, that my followers and I will pay the Los Angeles "Herald-Examiner" Newspaper \$100,000.00 (one hundred thousand dollars) to prove the headline charge ("Black Muslim Founder Exposed As A White") made against us; that we are following one Wallace Dodd with many aliases including the name, Fard; that he is the man that I am representing to my people as being Master Fard Muhammad (Allah in Person) who appeared among us in Detroit, Michigan, in 1931 and is the same person (Wallace Dodd).

"The Los Angeles "Herald-Examiner" also printed his prison history in San Quentin Federal Penitentiary on a charge of peddling dope, and that he admitted he was teaching us.

"If he (Dodd) was teaching for money in those panic days in Detroit, he did not get it from us. Mr. Dodd, undoubtedly, must have been teaching the white people if he received any money at all, because we did not have any.

"We did not pay Mr. Fard any money to teach us and there are many who will verify this statement who are yet alive. We could hardly pay the rent of a hall in those days.

"Sometimes they (the Believers) would give Him (Master Fard Muhammad) gifts such as topcoats, overcoats, ties, shirts, or a few packages of hankerchiefs - but money was so scarce in those days that we just did not have any. Just about everyone who believes was on the "Relief" in Detroit including myself.

"Muhammad, Followers Will Pay \$100,000 -
If Paper Can Prove Charge!

"I would like the Los Angeles "Herald-Examiner" to prove that this man (Dodd) was my teacher by bringing him to this country at our expense.

"Mr. Wallace Fard Muhammad, Whom Praises are due forever, the Finder and Life-Giver to we, the Lost Found Members of that Great Asiatic Black Nation from the Tribe of Shabazz, speaks 16 different languages. Can Mr. Wallace Dodd speak 16 different languages?

"Mr. Wallace Fard Muhammad also writes 10 of the languages He speaks fluently. His native language is Arabic (Does Mr. Dodd speak Arabic?) of which we have in His handwriting and it is the best writing or penmanship in the Arab world.

"Let Mr. Dodd prove that he was among us; prove that he gave us our names. Let Mr. Dodd prove who was his secretary and where were the identification cards printed, of which we have with us today and did he write the Arabic on them himself?

"If Mr. Dodd was The Mr. Wallace Fard Muhammad, why did not the F.B.I. arrest him for this teaching of truth? Let this paper prove these things before it headlines us as liars and worshippers of white devils.

"I would like to ask the Herald-Examiner to give us a minute closeup of this fake (Mr. Dodd) who they would like to make the public believe is our Saviour. Even the description of this man's height and weight does not correspond to Master Fard Muhammad's, (to Whom Praises are due forever) measurements. I know His height, His weight, the size of clothes and shoes.

"When Master Fard Muhammad left us, it was in 1934. Again, let Mr. Dodd prove that he and I were together and that the Lessons that I am teaching to my followers are from him, and where were they given to me and did he ever examine me on what he gave me, and where?

"There are many questions that I could ask this Mr. Dodd about, that would prove to the world that this man is a fake that the Los Angeles Herald-Examiner has published. We believe this by the reasoning of such unfounded truth.

"Let the Herald-Examiner Newspaper put us in contact with this Mr. Wallace Dodd. We will show the world that the entire statement is false; that this Mr. Wallace Dodd is not Master Fard Muhammad, To Whom Praises are due forever.

"I have warned you against allowing the devils to trick you into believing their false propaganda which they are spreading all over the world. And especially among the so-called Negroes who have been the perfect model-slaves for 400 years and yet do not have freedom, justice, and equality from the slave masters.

"And now these smart, scientific tricksters are trying to prevent them from enjoying a permanent salvation that Allah, (God) under the name of Master Fard Muhammad to Whom all Praises are due, has offered us.

"We who believe in him are a living proof of this offer that we are now being blessed with, even though we are afflicted with persecution and death.

"You have those whom the Prophets prophesied of in Washington and in Rome (the Catholics) to deceive the whole world and especially the so-called Negroes. Look in your poison book, the Bible: Revelation 12:9- 13:4, 8, 14- 14:11-20:10- and 21:8.

The Nation of Islam (NOI) is a black nationwide organization headquartered at Muhammad's Temple #2, 7351 South Stony Island Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, under the guidance of Elijah Muhammad, self-styled "Messenger of Allah," and alleged divinely appointed leader of the black race in America.
