

Be Dumped by Bobby K.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Attorney General Bobby Kennedy la preparing to dump FBI director J, Edgar Hoover, according to a high-level source in the Justice Department.

Neither the President nor Bobby are Hoover rooters and the group of young administrators around them also opposes J.

Edgar and is urging that he be dumped.

The durable Hoover, who has been on the Washington seene since the days of Calvin Coolidge, will be offered the chairman-

ship of a new nationwide advisory Committee on Youth Delinquency which the President will form.

Hoover, though nearing 70, remains active and in good health and still works Saturdays in addition to his regular fiveday schedule. An executive order, however, would be needed to enable him to work after his 70th birthday on January 1, 1965. Some of his subordinates have been allowed to work by this order, but it's doubtful that Hoover will get one.

Hoover, who was brought here originally to clear up the mess resulting from the Teapot Dome scandal in the early 1920s, has not been in the spotlight very much in

recent years. Most likely to succeed Hoover is George F. Schwarzwalder, currently assistant chief of the Internal Division of the Budget

Bureau. The Kennedys hope that the new job and responsibility given to Hoover will offset any possible public uproar over the shuffle. The offer to J. Edgar to head the Committee on Youth Delinquency will be put in the form of a draft. * * *

Winterrowd said that Walter Winchell had just called the New York Office and was all excited about his column which appeared in today's "New York Journal American" (a copy of the column is attached). It is noted that the first paragraph quotes from a Wisconsin editorial as follows:

"J. Edgar Hoover's needle is stuck. The FBI director can't get it out of the groove of associating two of his pet stereotypes with the menace of internal communism -- believers in civil rights are 'bleeding hearts' and defenders of the rights of the accused are coddling criminals."

Mr. Winchell said that the "Journal American" had made a terrible mistake, that this column when originally was prepared, the above quote was predicated by the statement that "The writers needle is stuck. One reason a newspaperman enjoys the right to criticize the FBI is that the FBI has protected the bill of rights from being overthrown by Reds and other criminals."

Mr. Winchell has contacted the "Journal American" and they are koing to change it in later editions but he wanted the Director to know that it was a terrible mistake.

Though you think our methods are "insidious", we feel that they are far more humane then the slow deaths inflicted on the masses by your fat capitalist murderers.

We shall build a new world from the shell of the old, Miss Kraus and you will be here to see it, I assure you. However, if you should happen to be feeling poorly in the future, don't be afraid to contact us, we can recommend you to some very fine Doctors.


Please don't call me Mr. Winchell. Everybody calls me either Walter or "That-son-of-a-bitchl" etc.

BACKGROUND:

By letter of 3-30-64 to the Director, Walter Winchell stated he was in San Diego several nights ago where he was invited to make a speech by a group of "commie fighters" which included Karl Prussion. Winchell claims the group was unfamiliar with Crestline, California. Winchell informed them that he had mentioned this place many times when he was broadcasting Sunday nights on the radio when he described Crestline as a hotbed of Reds. Winchell would like for the Director to send him what he said on Crestline, updating the material, so that he can use it for the edification of his "commie fighters."

INFORMATION IN BUFILES:

Karl Prussion traveled extensively on the west coast speaking about his former association with the Byreau and has become very controversial particularly for his extreme right-wing statements.

Walter Winchell's broadcast of 12-28-52 contained the following statement "San Francisco Call-Bulletin, West coast commies are now running a school at a camp near Crestline, California, under strict security regulations. Why is that?" (62-31615-748, page)

In his broadcast of 1-4-53, Winchell stated "I did not mean Creston (California) I meant what I said Crestline. The fact that you say, Mr. Editor of the 'Courier' Crestline, California, that there is no school for Reds near Crestline, California shows that your neighbors do not really know what is going on near Crestline. The Government, however, does." (62-31615-757 page 4) (Winchell forwarded telegram he received from Crestline Courier newspaper challenging him to furnish information to support his charge about a communist school in Crestline. Telegram does not contain a date, but was received at the Bureau 1-14-53. Dec. 10

In his broadcast of 4-29-58, Winchell stated: "Editor, San Francisco Call Bulletin." Mr. Editor - About three years ago you may recall I tried over the air to warn the people of Crestline, California, that a training school for communists was operating in that community. The Crestline newspapers, however, devoted one entire issue to calling Walter Winchell names instead of trying to check the story. One year later a man by the Enclosures (3) - 5-6-6-7

A Los Angeles Communist Party informant advised that the CP had a school at the camp from 12-5 through 12-7-52 which was attended by the Springers, Walter Waldo Smith,

Springer appeared before the House Committee on Un-American Activities at Los Angeles on 3-25-53 and invoked the Fifth Amendment when questioned about this Communist Party school.

"The Los Angeles Times" of 3-6-53 deals with Springer's testimony before the HCUA in California and also refers to the information available to the Committee the CP school was held during the week of 12-5 to 12-7-52 at Camp Tenaya which was under the operation of Joe Springer. This newspaper clipping contains considerable information regarding Springer and other background information regarding the CP school at Camp Tenaya.

Bufiles contain no additional references to Crestline or Camp Tenaya.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. That Walter Winchell be provided with a copy of his remarks regarding Crestline, California, as recorded in his broadcasts of 12-28-52, 1-4-53 and 4-29-56. This is the second part of a special series on a mysterious man with the initials E,S, Mr. Guy Richards, an experienced correspondent for the New York Journal-American, writes that Mr. E. S. turned out to be a lifelong State Department career man, and when it was finally revealed that he had been a Soviet spy for 18 years, he was found serving in one of the top spots of our American Embassy in Narsaw, Poland. After both the FBI and CIA had interrogated him extensively, and investigated his entire background, it was determined beyond a shadow of a doubt that he had definitely been serving the Communists; and, instead of trials and prosecutions, the State Department placed a tight lid on the case that was designed to keep it from public exposure, and then, to compound the treachery within a treachery, the vital information was kept from the passport division so that Mr. E. S. could skip the country with his mistress, who had also worked with him in our Embassy in " Poland.

Guy Richards told me that he spent a great deal of time assembling the jig-saw pieces of this case, so let me pass along to you the information he received from one of our high government officials in Washington.

This phase of the E. 3, spy case began in 1958 when the Russian and Polish secret police exerted heavy pressure to ransark the American Embassy for information. "That's when Polish girls were turned loose on the ten marines," explained the Washington official to Mr. Richards, and it was during this subversive invasion that "four male members of the (American) embassy staff were compromised by KGB temptresses— a diplomat's wife was seduced by a handsome KGB male agent, and — Irwin N. Scarback fell from grace under the spell of Urszula Maria Discher the girl with the intriguing voice." It was shout that time that Lt. Col. Goleniewski a high official of the Soviet Secret Police of entered the scene. Through a third party, he contacted the Cla in Warsew and said that he wanted to defect. 





Winchell had apparently not heard about the recent article in "Life" magazine and was informed of its contents by Mr. Lynum. While in the SAC's Office, Winchell called his secretary and dictated a letter to the Director requesting some historical data about the FBI so he could write a rebuttal-type article or a series of articles about the outstanding work the FBI has done under Mr. Hoover's leadership. Winchell also indicated he was to sign a new television contract which would be of a documentary nature and would include some FBI histo Mr. Winchell's letter of May 26th has been received. He mentioned his conversation with Mr. Lynum about the "Life" story and wants to do a column on the FBI or perhaps a series. Consequently, he would like some material sent to him as soon as possible about FBI accomplishments. This material is to include data on service martyrs, kidnapings and other crimes such as espionage in which the FBI participated. STATISTICAL ACCOMPLISHMENTS

The FBI established a number of records in 1963 as its achievements far surpassed several previous highs.

Fines, savings and recoveries increased to more than 210 million dollars, a figure far exceeding the amount of funds spent to operate the FBI during 1963.

This record amounted to a return to the Government of \$1.37 for every dollar in the FBI's appropriation for the year.

Some 12,000 FBI fugitives were apprehended in 1963, compared with 11,690 in 1962. And more than 12,900 convictions in FBI cases were achieved as compared with 12,813 in the previous year.

Other noteworthy achievements were the location of 19,500 stolen automobiles in investigations under the Interstate Transportation of Stolen Motor Vehicle Statute, and the apprehension of over 2,700 persons who were sought at the specific request of state and local authorities for fleeing across state lines in violation of the Fugitive Felon Act.

During fiscal year 1963, convictions were recorded against 96 per cent of the persons brought to trial and 93 per cent resulted from guilty pleas.

As a result of these convictions, the courts imposed sentences, including actual, suspended, and probationary, totaling 37,000 years. In addition, there were seven terms of life imprisonment.

KILNAPING

Kidnaping for ransom became one of the most feared crimes among upper-class families in the thirties. In 1932 there were six such crimes, including the famous Lindbergh case. The following year there were 10, and 1934 saw five kidnapings for ransom.

enacted the Federal Kidnaping Statute and investigative jurisdiction was assigned to the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The following year the FHI solved every kidnaping case referred to it, setting the pattern for an almost perfect record through the years. So effective has been the FHI's investigations of kidnapings that kidnapings for ransom have dwindled to only an occasional event. Throughout the forties there was only one kidnaping for ransom, and only four were recorded in the fifties.

In 1960 two highly publicized kidnapings for ransom occurred—the kidnap-murder of Adolph Coors III in Colorado and the kidnaping of Anthony Alessio in California. Both cases were quickly solved by the FEL.

No kidnaping for ransom occurred then until December 8,

at Harrah's Club Motel in Stateline, California. Ransom totaling \$240,000 was demanded and paid by the young singer's father.

In just over 123 hours after the kidnaping occurred, the FBI had all three persons involved in custody and had recovered virtually all of the ransom. Even more important, it had taken so action whatever to jeopardize the safety of the kidnap victim who was released unharmed. The FBI had scored this tremendous success in spite of some vitriolic and unwarranted criticism leveled against it during the course of the investigation.

The accused kidnapers have been convicted for their crime. Two were sentenced to life in prison, while the third was sentenced to 15 years, 8months. Two have appealed.

The Federal Kidnaping Statute was last amended in 1956 shortly after the famous Weinberger kidnaping and murder in New York which the FBI solved. It provides that the FBI shall enter the investigation of any kidnaping where a person, other than a minor taken by a parent thereof, is held for ransom, reward or otherwise within 24 hours after the abduction on the rebuttable presumption that the victim has been transported interstate. The FBI's efficiency in handling these cases has convinced all but a very few that such crimes are foolhardy.

Since the Federal Kidnaping Statute was passed in 1932 there have been 684 major kidnaping cases investigated by the FBI. All but three have been solved. During the 1963 fiscal year, FBI investigations of kidnapings led to 22 convictions which resulted in two life sentences and other sentences totaling \$10 years.

THE FEI LABORATORY

John Edgar Hoover for a much-needed weapon against the
eriminal hordes has since evolved from one lone technician
equipped with a microscope, ultraviolet equipment and a drawing
board into one of the most modern and progressive crime detection
laboratories in the world staffed by approximately 100 scientific
experts, almost as many technical aides and a corps of clerical
and stenographic assistants, and equipment valued at well over
one million dollars.

Year after year, examinations conducted in the FEI
Laboratory help to identify the guilty and to remove the stigma
of guilt from the falsely accused.

The facilities of the FHI Laboratory are available without charge to all duly constituted state, county and municipal law enforcement agencies of the United States and its territorial possessions. In addition, the Laboratory's scientific experts are available to testify as to their examinations at trials in state and
