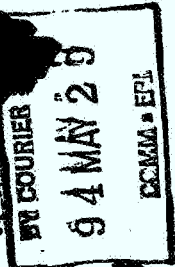

This letter stated that Dr. von BRAUN did not know the writer of the letter and had no knowledge as to the reason the letter was written to him. [REDACTED] in his letter, requested that if the Bureau conducted investigation that his office be notified of the results. He also stated in the letter he thought this was necessary in order to provide for the safety of Dr. von BRAUN in his visits throughout the United States.

There is no violation within the Bureau's jurisdiction. [REDACTED] has been advised of this fact and of the fact the Bureau cannot afford Dr. von BRAUN any protection. No further action being taken in this matter.

Dear Baron Von Braun,

When I got out of prison I was forced to return to my job at Michigan State Employment Service, because my clothes had been confiscated, along with all my other personal possessions, and I was penniless, as I am now.

They shucked me off the job before you got to Lansing, and each time you're due in the area of my flight, they send Government Agents on my trail, to re-commit me via a new snatch, so I'll have to keep running, like a Fox to Hounds.

I have a Tourist permit to Mexico, where I have friends, but no money to get there, although I'm only three hours away by train. This was as far as my money lasted, and they are holding up my bit of

Retirement money, the better  
to corner me in this country.  
Contrary to what you may  
have been told, they have no  
intention of letting me live.  
It's buried within Army and the  
Presidency, while their Psychiatry  
teams attempt to give my mind  
to that French paragon of  
the Moroccan King. Elsewhere,  
they're using other persons in  
the identities of my family, my  
non-existent children, and me,  
for cash, for U.S. military bases,  
and for a phony fight against  
communism.

To get it done, they've turned  
me over to the Jews and Negroes,  
and barred anyone from helping  
me. Indeed, I can't even obtain  
medical attention at the most  
reputable hospitals and medical  
centers, on pain of being "put  
away." I know, because I  
tried it at Barnes Hospital in



St. Louis, where I used to go <sup>(3)</sup>  
as a girl, after our German  
family Doctor returned to the  
Fatherland.

They've got Spain in a trap of  
U.S. bases, threatening France  
Morocco, while threatening  
punitive actions against Mexico,  
and occupying Germany.  
They holler Communism, while  
all my help and protection comes  
from Russia, excepting a team  
of inner Gov't personnel, with  
military and civilian status  
who are loyal to me, and keep  
me informed.

Indeed, Mr. J. Edgar Hoover,  
the real one, left ex-FBI  
agents strategically located to  
cover all the important people  
involved in this giant scheme to  
deprive me of my birthright, my  
inheritance, and my life. I  
know who they are and where  
they are, and they know me.



personally. One is even  
assigned to South Africa. They  
are not answerable to the U.S.  
Government, just to me.

I have knowledge and proof  
of everything, including my  
identity papers. Gov. Patterson  
of Alabama and Gov. Ross  
Barnett of Mississippi will  
verify and assist me, if you  
wish it.

Is there any way you can  
get me across the border, via  
the military you know we can  
trust? Preferably someone like

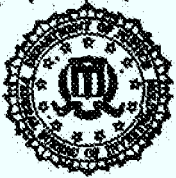

A TESTIMONY OF WERNER VON BRAUN IN A US CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEE

D. MAYER (phon.), a correspondent of the United Press International Agency reports from Washington:

"Dr. ~~WERNER VON BRAUN~~, a rocket specialist, in speaking in the House Committee on Space Problems, stated that he 'would not be surprised' if this year the Russians would place a man in orbit around the earth.

"VON BRAUN, who was born in Germany, stated that Russia is several years ahead in the field of space research. VON BRAUN 'doubts very much' that the United States could overtake it by 1964, even taking into consideration new funds allotted for a big space rocket 'Saturn'."

Referring to American specialists, the correspondent expresses a surmise that "in a flight to Mars, Russia, possibly, will get ahead of America by two years."

The correspondent quotes a statement by VON BRAUN to the effect that even if the Congress would allot "additional millions" of dollars for work in the field of creation of rockets, these sums "would be, very likely, spent to no purpose."

VON BRAUN, writes the correspondent, stated that "the Russians, undoubtedly, will also make advances in cosmic research" during the period when the work on the rocket "Saturn" will be under way, to be completed by 1964. "It is possible, that they even now are creating a rocket exceeding in size everything which they tested so far."

"Even with the existence of such an accelerated program," he said, "it is very doubtful, that we would be ahead by 1964."
