On December 8, 1987, [REDACTED] United States Supreme Court Police, Washington, D.C., provided a representative of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) with a threatening letter that was received at the Supreme Court. The letter had a return address of [REDACTED]

The letter stated in part to: [REDACTED] "Since the court insist on violating my kids rights to life (survive), you are all now notified that either Brennan [REDACTED] or [REDACTED] is to die." signed TLR.

Investigation was conducted in this matter by the FBI, which included interview of [REDACTED] and other individuals including [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] the matter was presented for prosecution to the office of the U.S. Attorney in Baltimore, Maryland.

On May 18, 1988, Assistant United States Attorney (AUSA) Beth P. Gesner, District of Maryland, advised that her office did in fact intend to prosecute Roberts for an extortionate threat in this matter.

On June 27, 1989, a jury sitting in the U.S. District Court, Baltimore, Maryland, found Roberts guilty of one count of violation of Title 18, U.S. Code, Section 115(a) and (c)(3), Threatening Judge or Judges of the Supreme Court of the United States.

On September 12, 1989, Judge Smalkin, U.S. District Court, District of Maryland, sentenced Roberts to five in custody of the Attorney General.
