The Pittsburgh Division's most recent contact with [REDACTED] was a civil suit filed in the Superior Court of Pennsylvania [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] FBI Headquarters has received items of correspondence pertaining to captioned subject and to civil action Number [REDACTED]. Captioned subject's major theme is that there is a "criminal conspiracy with state officials to willfully and unlawfully cause concealment of the fresh and immediate evidences revealing state officials ongoing committed murders, beating, maimings, and unconstitutional conditions of confinement at the prison." b7C

Given the circumstances surrounding this matter and captioned subject's confinement history, Pittsburgh does not believe that an interview of captioned subject would be worthwhile or productive. Since [REDACTED] is presently serving a life sentence without possibility of parole, it is not necessary to place a "flag" in the prison records regarding any possible date when [REDACTED] could be released. b7C
