Bureau files concerning subject reveal a person of the same name forwarded an undated letter to the Bureau which was received 8/13/66. The communication was mailed from Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and concerns itself with the activities such as riots, burnings of American activities such as riots, burnings of American flags and so forth. The letter is somewhat rambling, does not make good sense and was not acknowledged.

#### UNITED STATES SUPREME COURT JUSTICE ABE FORTAS - VICTIM

The following letter was received at the office of the United States Marshal, United States Supreme Court, Washington, D.C.:

"Justice Abe Fortas Supreme Court Phila., Pa.

'Dear Sir:

"In ref, to your rather lengthy article on law appearing in the Phila Inquirer the White Racist Majority isn't buying what you are trying to sell them. You are a Jew, and a member of Minority. Therefore it is logical to assume your knowledge of law is one sided in favor of the Minority, which makes the rule of law oppressive against the White majority. This is quite obvious to every school boy. When the rights of the ballot box and laws passed by State legislators of the South one ruled unConstitutional the entire population of these States has lossed their basic rights in our so called Free Society. Therefore the White Racist Society opposes your appointment as chief justice. We consider you one of the most dangerous men ever to arrive on the American scene. This will be the first Jew, but also the first Communist to aspire to the highest office in the Land. An appointment handed to you by a fellow traveler like President Johnson. The White Racist Society will leave no effort unturned to remove you from the American scene. Being a Jew is very bad to hold such an office, but also a Communist is more than the White Racist Society can take and I predict your removal will be swift. The survival of the White Racist Majority is at stake.

"This hatred for the Jews is not unique here in America, but also every country of the Globe. We consider Jews a Cancer in any free society and should be exterminated. The knowledge of Jews is forminable. Therefore I predict that constant racial out breaks will increase. The White Racial Majority 180,000,000 strong will engage in a Civil War to overthrow this government by force and violence. The extermination of the Minorities is the No I issue facing the White Racist Majority.

"I predict that the Civil War will be organized and launched in the South. Every White Man, Woman, and child will bear arms. It will gain momentum from State to State until it reaches Washington.

"I predict the Federal forces will face massive desertions of Whites and join their white brothers in a White Christian Crusade to eliminate the Jews and Negroes from these shores.

"This is our dedication and a fight to the death. We will never realize the pursuit of happiness in this land. There will be no peace, integration of the races unless the ruling forces of the Minority are destroyed There is no other choice. The law of the jungle will prevail and the survival of the fittest will become the ruling force in our Nation. The death and destruction of our Country is a small price to pay for the future generation of whites, to protect their rights of freedom and pursuit of happiness.

'To sum up it is the forces on the Left versus the forces on the Right. Only War can settle the issues."



On August 6, 1968, Assistant United States Attorney John Galloway, Eastern District of Pennsylvania at Philadelphia, advised an agent of the FBI that he would decline prosecution in this matter because there is no direct threat of bodily harm as required by the Federal Extortion Statute. Further the letter contains no directions to perform any certain act

or refrain from doing so under a threat.

The Director inquired: "How could a CBS Newscaster be on an NBC network?"

My office has been advised that this was an open press conference held by Senator Tydings and that a number of newsmen and cameramen representing the various networks were present. The questioner, who we are informed was Roger Mudd, of CBS, was not shown. Frequently a network will utilize a question and answer from a news conference which they deem newsworthy, even though their own announcer covering the conference did not propound the query which their camera crew filmed. This would explain why NBC did not use the name of the announcer.

# Guilt of Rosenbergs To the Editor:

On two successive Sundays, The Times reviewed a play entitled, "U Saligainst Julius and Ethel Rosafferg" which had a short run in Cleveland. The first review appeared in the Arts and Leisure Section of April 20, inder Julius Novick's by-line. The second was published in the news section of April 27, by Clive Barnes.

This generous allocation of space would evoke no comment from me except for two circumstances.

The play does not purport to be a fictionalized production based upon an historical event. It pretends to be a "documentary" presentation of the "trath."

The play presents the Rosenbergs as innocent of the crime of which they were convicted. Mr. Novick wrote that although he was "ready to believe that the Rosenbergs were innocent," he found the play "tendentious" Mr. Barnes, on whether the Rosenbergs were innocent, wrote, "Perhaps. I still believe so." Both thus become more than drama critics. They have ventured into the writing of history. If so, those of us who know something of the judicial process have a right to inquire what credentials either of these writers bears entitling him to express an opinion in a responsible journal on a subject of this importance

The gravity of the accusation made by both writers has probably escaped their notice, but in fact they have declared that American justice is so treacherous a tool that despite the long and elaborate process of sifting and resifting which occurred in the Rosenberg case, despite the earnest efforts of the long array of judges known for their extraordinary devotion to human liberty, it has produced a wrong and wicked result in this case.

lend fuel to the fires of present day rebelion by violence which is afflicting our cities, our universities and other sensitive areas of our society. It constitutes another charge of victous brutality leveled at a generation at which the present younger set has already learned to look with contempt.

The facts do not support the unwarranted aspersions by these critics on American justice as it was displayed in the Rosenberg case.

The Rosenbergs were convicted by the unanimous verdict of the jury at a trial in which counsel for the defense, on three occasions, before verdict, after verdict and at sentence, expressed to Judge Irving R. Kaufman, who presided, warm appreciation for the manner in which the trial was conducted. He said, "The Court conducted itself as an American Judge"

I should hate to believe Mr. Novick's statement that it is part of the received tradition of liberals that the Rosenbergs were innocent. It would not do credit to their intelligence or judgment. Memory fades as the years roll by, but I am prepared to challenge the assertion that liberals generally held so misguided a view.

The law is our last remaining anchor in this troubled era. If that goes, if faith in the processes of law is eroded, we shall have no shelter against the brutality and the vinlence which have become the instruments of the present day sa-called reform. We shall then each hide in our own separate burrow, in a jungle where no one is free and no one is safe.

Defense of Fortas To the Editor:

Where were the law professors? Where were the civil libertarians? Where were the bar associations?

The absence of a spontaneous defense of the Supreme Court and one of its most brilliant jurists, Abe Fortas, can be attributed to the Kafkaesque miasma in which the issues have been enveloped. There were no clear-cut accusations that Mr. Justice Fortas had not met the standards of either law or morality. Instead, we were titllated with snide innuendoes by Attorney General Mitchell which suggested that the old Nixon of the Joe McCarthy days is not dead but lives on through Mitchell. (How many photostats do you have in your hand, Mr. Mitchell?)

There was no specification of charges. There was only guilt by association.

Mr. Justice Fortas, while sitting on the Supreme Court, accepted payment from a foundation to do work for that foundation. The foundation was controlled by a man who was subsequently indicted for a criminal offense Sometime thereafter Mr Fortas returned the payment to the foundation and advised that he would not perform the services for it.

Why the hue and cry? Under our system a man is presumed innocent until found guilty. This rule even applies to Louis Wolfson who, at the time the payment was made to Mr. Justice Fortas, was not even under indictment Why is there a presumption of evil in Mr. Fortas's association with Wolfson?

On the record to date there is no evidence of any impropriety on Mr. Fortas's part The scandalous attack upon him in my view was motivated by political opportunists capitalizing upon murky currents in the mainstream to overwhelm the critical standards of a bemused

nation already racked by later nal dissension over the war in Vietnam, the uprisings on the campus and the black revolution.

It is tragic that a great figure like Fortas is being offered as a sacrifice





### LET FREEDOM RING

A recording of the message entitled, "Let Freedom' Ring" was obtained on June 17, 1969 by dialing St. Petersburg, Florida telephone number 896-1373.

"Let Freedom Ring. Supreme Court Justice William O. Douglas, like his good friend, Abe Fortas, has some interesting financial connections. In 1966, it developed that Douglas was receiving \$12,000.00 a year from the nonprofit Parvin Foundation which has ties with Las Vegas gambling interests. This would appear to be a highly questionable source of income for a Supreme Court Justice who is well paid by the American people to interpret the law. Alfred Parvin, the donor and for whom the foundation was named that paid Douglas, was named as an alleged coconspirator in a stock manipulation case with Lewis Wolfson. This is the same Wolfson in the famous \$20,000.00 a year payoff to former Justice Abe Fortas. When it leaked out that Douglas has interesting financial ties either directly or indirectly with Wolfson and Fortas, the secretary of the Parvin Foundation quickly announced that he would have an independent analyst demonstrate Douglas' benefactor, the Las Vegas connected Parvin Foundation, was beyond reproach and the so-called independent analyst turned out to be one Carolyn Agger. Carolyn Agger happens to be Mrs. Abe Fortas. Not suprisingly, Mrs. Abe Fortas found nothing wrong with Douglas' other employer, the Parvin Foundation. Douglas was renamed President until recently when for some reason, he decided to resign. Douglas is also mixed up with another shadey outfit called, The Fund for the Republic.

More on this and Douglas' pro-communist activities next week. Meantime, for more specific information on Justice Douglas and the nine-man dictatorship called the Supreme Court, send 35¢ in coin to Supreme Court, Box 1775, Sarasota, Florida, 33578. Let Freedom Ring."
