

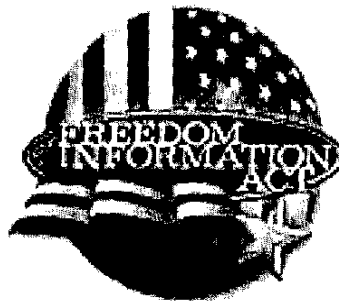

On May 11, 1978, the facts of this case were discussed with Assistant United States Attorney (AUSA) JAMES A. MC GURK. Mr. MC GURK advised that after thoroughly reviewing this matter, that it is his opinion that further investigation is not warranted. He cited the fact that the handwriting exemplars of the prime suspect, [REDACTED] were compared with the writing of the unknown subject by the FBI Laboratory, but no conclusion could be reached [REDACTED] of the threatening letters. Further, Mr. MC GURK also pointed out the fact that the last threatening letter was received in June, 1977, and the possibility exists that the investigation in this matter had brought to the attention of the letters' author the serious nature of such activity.

In view of the above, Mr. MC GURK stated he would decline prosecution for violation of the Federal Extortion Statute.

For information of the Bureau, reairtel sets forth background information and the basis for reopening this case at that time.

Investigation conducted since reopening this case has included interviewing [redacted]

[redacted] The Laboratory compared the handwriting [redacted] with letters received by victims, but was not able to determine whether or not [redacted] authored the letters victims received. Additional investigation to identify Unsub has been unsuccessful, and the victims, who have received no additional letters since 11/78, can not furnish the names of any possible suspects.

On 6/8/79, the facts of this case were discussed with AUSA DENNIS D. FISHER, Northern District of Illinois, Chicago, who advised he did not think further investigation was warranted as this is not the type of case which would be considered for prosecution for violation of the Extortion Statute. He cited the facts that the letters are no longer being received, none of the threats contained in the letters were ever attempted to

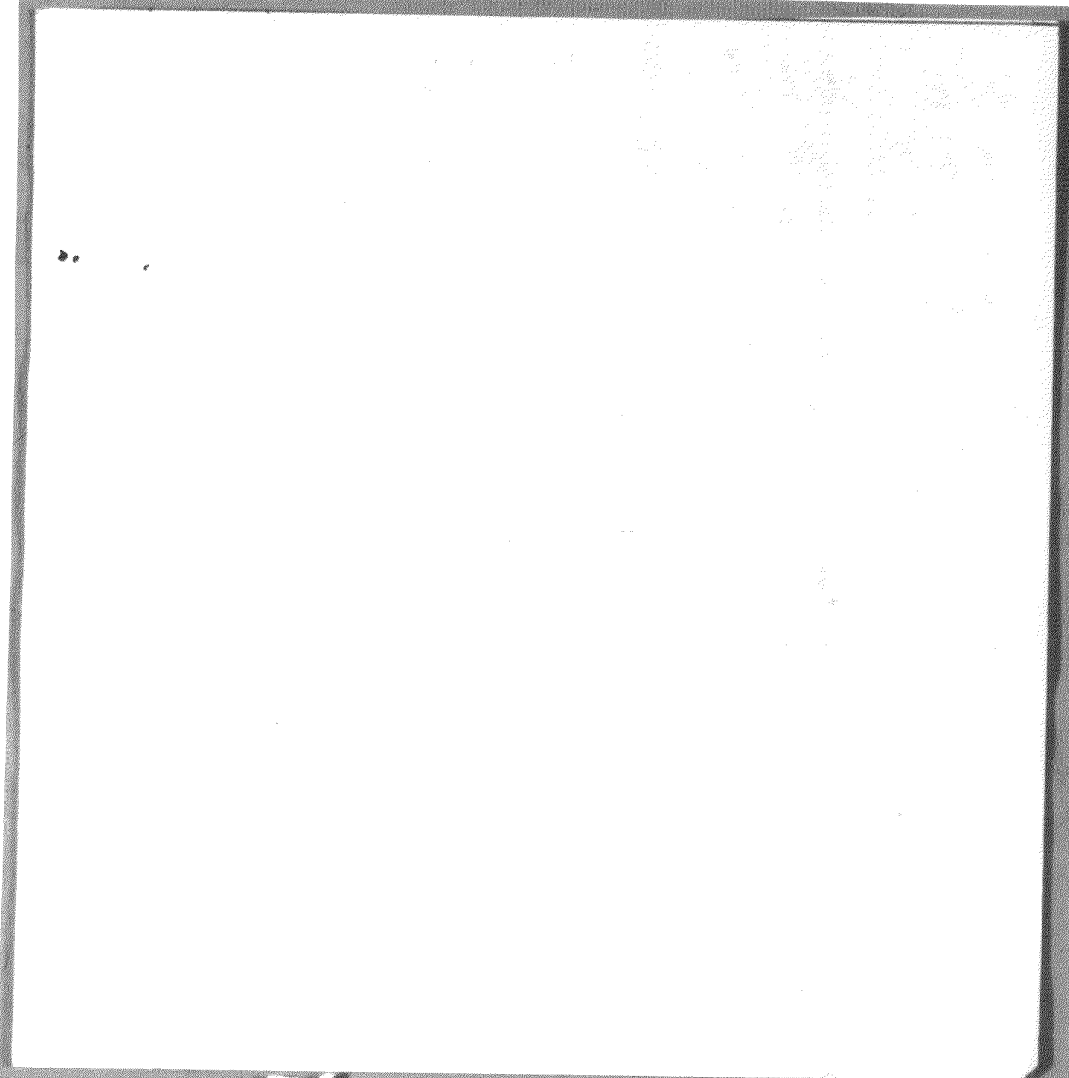

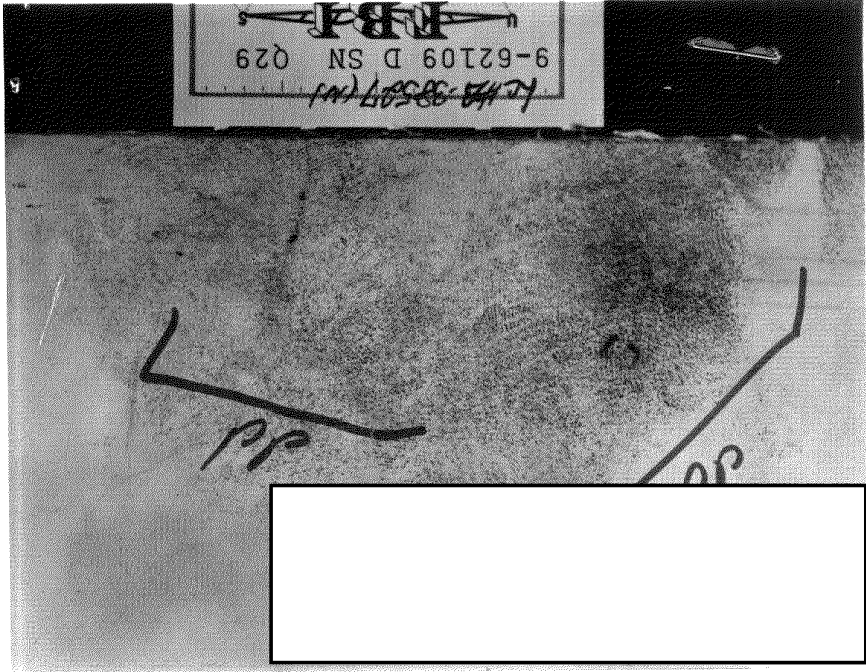
