CID also agrees that paying this reward will improve the public's perception of the FBI. This will be proposed to the bureau's needs in the future.

An allegation was made that Carreira may have harbored Cunanan. Follow up investigation conducted by the FBI Miami Division determined that this allegation was unfounded. Therefore, FBI Miami concurs with Minneapolis Divisions request.

On was interviewed at his residence, New Jersey (NJ). After being advised as to the identity of the interviewing investigators, and the nature of the interview, furnished the following information:

advised that approximately every ago in May of shortly after graduating from Pennsylvania, he moved to San Diego. It was on his first day in San Diego that he became acquainted with ANDREW CUNANAN. advised that CUNANAN introduced himself as ANDREW DeSLIVA. advised that his friendship with CUNANAN grew to the point where they saw each other practically every day of the three years he stayed in San Diego. Stressed, however, that he did not have an intimate relationship with CUNANAN.

advised that he was astonished when he first learned through the news media of CUNANAN's reported involvement in several murders. Advised that he always thought of CUNANAN as a nice guy who never gave the appearance of being easily agitated or violent. Further advised that he never witnessed CUNANAN use illegal drugs with the exception of valium. However, did suspect that CUNANAN was taking Crystal Methamphetamine. believed this, in part, given that Crystal Methamphetamine was the drug of choice within the gay community. Additionally, CUNANAN always appeared shaky, hyperactive, refrained from alcohol, and was able to stay awake until late in the day, every day.

advised that for the last six months he lived in San Diego, CUNANAN resided only a few streets away. however, could not recall CUNANAN's address.

Throughout all the time knew CUNANAN, he never suspected that CUNANAN was prostituting himself. believed, as did all of CUNANAN's friends and associates, that he had a rich boyfriend paying his way for him. CUNANAN never told anyone his boyfriends name, however believed that he was

someone in his late seventies. He believed this largely due to the way CUNANAN would joke about how old his boyfriend was.

recalled that CUNANAN was generous to a fault, always paying for dinner and drinks. He never saw CUNANAN without a roll of money. The recalled that CUNANAN would often fly to different places. He never, however, disclosed the exact locations he traveled. CUNANAN would simply generalize the places by saying that he was traveling to Europe or New York. CUNANAN once said that he had a friend who owned a condo in New York City, and that his friend allowed him to stay their when in town.

stated that he knew one of the murdered victims, JEFF TRAIL. stated that he knew TRAIL only casually as a bar acquaintance. Additionally, he is certain that CUNANAN also knew TRAIL. did not believe that CUNANAN and TRAIL had an intimate relationship.



Therefore, refunds for tuition or fees for withdrawal, absence, or dismissal will not be made by The Bishop's School except as covered under The Tuition Refund Insurance.

In addition to tuition, some laboratory and art fees, field trips, books and other school supplies will be charged to the student's account and are payable 30 days after mailing the statement. Student Accident Insurance fee of \$24.00 will be charged against those accounts desiring participation.

If an account is forwarded to a collection agency or an attorney for collection, the undersigned agrees to pay all fees and costs incurred by The Bishop's School in collecting the amounts owing.

If local inflation and expenses increase at rates in excess of projected levels, it may be necessary to make a mid-year adjustment to tuition.

It is understood by the undersigned that the above-named student enrollee as well as the undersigned must agree to uphold the standards of the School and comply with the regulations adopted by the School from time to time. It is further understood that failure to do so may be sufficient cause for dismissal of the student at any time.





Andrew is a true intellectual with a ready sense of humor and a concern for others. He relates very well to adults, discourses brilliantly about culture and history and is capable of profound thought. He is independent, occasionally self-indulgent and at times only interested in pursuing areas that truly interest him. A fascinating individual in every way, Andrew can't help but enliven a college campus!

Most of his teachers describe Andrew as absolutely unique in the classroom. He does excellent work on the Advanced Placement level (three 5's to date) with the exception of mathematics which doesn't intrigue him in the least. His study habits and organizational abilities are not as honed as many students, in many ways that is his nature and his strength. As one of English teachers notes: "He reads widely but not always assigned material. He appears to have an international extremely broad background. He writes with style and breadth never misses the point of a question, although he may not have all of the factual information to address it. 





This updates information provided in a SIOC note dated 5/12/97.

On 5/12/97, FBI PH advised CID that although they have received numerous tips in captioned matter, no credible sightings have been reported of Cunanan. Interviews have confirmed that he is an active homosexual and has many acquaintances in the New Jersey/New York area. One close associate of Cunanan's in stated that he would expect Cunanan to contact him if he is in the area. This associate will report all contacts with

Cunanan and FBI PH plans to in case Cunanan should call.

The U.S. Attorney's Office is leaning toward accepting a case against Cunanan as they are of the opinion that conclusive federal jurisdiction apparently exists at the national cemetery in Fort Mott State Park, where victim Reese was murdered.

FBI PH is preparing a request for Cunanan to be placed in a Top Ten Most Wanted status as he has committed at least four murders in a little more than one week. No one has been able to locate any fingerprints of Cunanan as he has apparently never been arrested. A photograph was obtained however, and has been provided to the Pugitive Publicity Unit, OPCA, FBIHQ.

FBI CG advised that they have not found any evidence of a prior relationship between Cunanan and victim Lee Miglin, 72, the wealthy Chicago developer whose body was found Sunday morning (5/11) in his garage, his head bound in masking tape and his body covered with plastic and brown wrapping paper. Miglin had been stabbed several times, his throat slashed, his chest pounded by a blunt instrument. According to the Chicago PD, there was evidence that he had been tortured before he died.

The 1995 sports utility vahicle registered to victim Madson, who was found shot to death with on 5/3/97 near a lake in rural Chisago County northeast of MP, had been illegally parked around

the corner from Miglin's home for several days. Madson's body was discovered four days after murder victim Jeffrey Trail, 28, was found beaten to death and rolled up in a carpet in Madson's loft apartment in Minneapolis. Miglin's Lexus was found abandoned - near the murder scene of victim Reese, and Reese's vehicle is now - missing.

·CG Agents interviewed Cunanan advised the Agents that Cunanan has lots of money as the result of living off of wealthy homosexuals.

Details of those interviews will be available later today. CID discussed this matter with CASKU hast night and instructed FBI CG to provide them with the results of their interviews for use in a potential profile.

FBI CG further advised that at some point in time, Cunanan lived in San Francisco with has reached out to offer whatever assistance she can and a lead has been set for her to be interviewed today.

Additional information will be provided to CID as it becomes available.

# Suspect Is Said to Know Son of a Murder Victim

CHICAGO, May 11 (Reuters) — The suspect in a series of killings in three states was a close friend of the son of one of the victims, The Minneapolis Star Tribune reported today.

The newspaper said the suspect, Andrew Cunanan, 27, was very close with Duke Miglin, a 25-year-old actor and the son of Lee Miglin, a millionaire developer whose body was found last week in the garage of his Chicago town house on May 4.

Mr. Miglin's family has denied any link to Mr. Cunanan, who remained at large today.

Mr. Cunanan spoke frequently to Duke Miglin, friends from San Diego

told the newspaper.

Mr. Cunanan is suspected in the April 30 bludgeoning death of Jeffrey Trail, 28, in Minneapolis, and has been charged with murder in the shooting death of David Madson, 33, on May 3. Mr. Cunanan is believed to have killed William Reese, 45, a caretaker at the Finn's Point National Cemetery in Pennsville, N.J., on Friday and taken his nick-up truck.

On 5/9/97, at approximately 10:54 p.m., Associate SAC Sheila W. Horan, FBI Philadelphia, advised of the following investigation within the Philadelphia Division which has emanated from the Minneapolis and Chicago Divisions:

Associate SAC Haran, advised Andrew Phillip Cunanan was the subject of a state wide manhunt in the Chicago Division as the result of both a Minneapolis UFAP Case and the recent murder of Lee Miglin, a wealthy developer found slain in his residential garage in one of Chicago's wealthiest neighborhoods. Haran said media coverage concerning Miglin's murder has been well publicized throughout the country.

On 5/9/97 at approximately 10:30 p.m., Haran was notified that caretaker William Reese, 45, a federal employee of a national cemetery located within Fort Mort State Park, had been murdered. Fort Mott State Park is located near Pennsville, New Jersey. A Lexis vehicle belonging to Miglin was found at the crime scene and Reese's vehicle, a red Ford pickup truck with New Jersey license plates, was apparently stolen by Cunanan after Reese's murder. Follow-up investigation by the Chicago Division determined Cunanan was in the Philadelphia Metropolitan area when he utilized the cellular telephone in Miglin's Lexis at approximately 3:30 p.m. on 5/9/97. The wife of victim Reese attempted to telephonically contact her husband at Fort Mott State Park at approximately 5:00 p.m., but was unsuccessful and contacted local police who located victim Reese.

FBI, Philadelphia, and New Jersey State Police are working the case jointly due to concurrent jurisdiction. The case may be turned over to the State based on factors or determinations made by the United States Attorney's Office.

On 5/10/97, SSA Philadelphia Division, Fugitive Task Force, advised that on Thursday, May 8, 1997, two hits were made on victim Miglin's cellular telephone in the Philadelphia area, however, required additional hits to pinpoint location. A general radio message was disseminated through the Philadelphia Police Department to contact

the FBI should victim Miglin's vehicle be located. On Friday, May 9, 1997, FBI, Chicago reported a hit on the cellular telephone at 2:30 p.m. at or near Route 295 in Pennsgrove, New Jersey. Local authorities and toll booth operators were notified to be alert for the vehicle. Subject Cunanan apparently exited at the last New Jersey exit and found his way to Fort Mott State Park, where victim Reese was working as the sole cemetery employee. Reese was shot once in the head. SSA advised one Minnesota victim was shot with a .40 caliber weapon and a second victim was beaten to death with a hammer. A half empty box of .40 caliber ammunition was located. The Chicago victim, Lee Miglin, was stabbed to death.

On 5/10/97, SSRA Philadelphia Division, South Jersey RA, advised that an autopsy revealed victim Reese was shot once in the back of the head with a .40 caliber weapon, and that the round exited through the right frontal lobe. Time of death was placed between 3:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. New Jersey State Police handled the collection of forensics evidence. Physical evidence located within Miglin's vehicle will be processed on Monday, 5/12/97, following coordination with FBI, Chicago. SSRA advised telephone calls have been received from individuals claiming to know Cunanan, and one caller from Arizona described Cunanan as a "gay gigolo" who "catered to older men".

The following individuals were notified regarding this incident: Acting UC and SC VCFU, and Acting U/C TT/GRC.

on May 3, 1997, two fishermen discovered the body of an adult male lying in the grass near the shoreline of East Rush Lake. The fishermen contacted the Chisago County Sheriff's Department, who dispatched deputies to the scene. When the deputies arrived, they observed a deceased mule who appeared to be in his late twenties/early thirties. In a tursory visual examination of the body, deputies observed what appeared to be bullet wounds to the decedent's head. Officer: also noted in the grass near the body, tracks where a motor vehicle pulled into the area, drove in a circle, and then drove back out.

The officers then conducted a search of the area, discovering two empty casings for a .40 caliber Remington/Peters ammunition, along with a remote and ry system and keys for a Chrysler product motor vahicle. The decedant wid not have any identification on his person. The lady was then taken to the coroner's office where an autopsy was to be nonducted. The Chisago County Shariff's Department than released information regarding the unidentified male being found near Rush Lake. The information included the height, weight, hair color, and approximate age of the decedent.

Shortly thereafter, Investigator Rivard of the Chisago County Sheriff's Departmen': was contacted by Minneapolis Police Sergeant Tichich, who told Investigator Rivard that the gunshot victim found near Rush Lake fit the description of a person they were looking for regarding a homicide investigation in Minneapolis. Sergeant Tichich told Investigator Rivard the party they were looking for was named David Madson. Sergeant Tichich then shared information regarding the

Minneapolis investigation.

On April 29, 1997, the caretaker for the apartment building located at 280 2nd Avenue North in Minneapolis was contacted by a co-worker of David Madson, the tenant in Apartment 404 of her building. The co-worker told the caretaker that David Madson had not been to work the last two days and that the co-worker was concerned for his well-being. The co-worker then requested the caretaker to check Madson's apartment. The caretaker then enlisted the aid of another resident and went to David Madson's apartment, number 404, and entered using the pass key. Inside the apartment they saw what they thought was a person lying on the floor wrapped in a heavy rug. They also saw blood on the floor and the back of the front door to the apartment. The caretaker end friend then left the apartment and called the police.

The Minnespolis Police Department conducted an investigation, which revealed the victim found in Madson's apartment was one Jeffrey Trail, an acquaintance of Madson's. When the officers determined it wasn't Madson, whose body was in the rug, they received a search warrant for the apartment. Pound in the search of the apartment was a claw hammer with a blood-like substance on it. Also found was a mylon gym-type bag with Andrew Cunanan's name on it. Inside the bag was an empty holster for a handgun and a box of Remington/Peters brand..40 caliber Golden saber bullets, is live rounds in the box, it rounds having been removed. A gun was not located in the apartment.

while the police were conducting their investigation, a friend of Madson's arrived at the apartment building. The friend was identified as Ms. Salvetti. Ms. Salvetti indicated she had come to the apartment due to her concern for Madson as she had heard from another friend that he hadn't been to work for two days. Ms. Salvetti then shared that she had gone to dinner with with Madson and a friend of his, Andrew Cunanan, who was visiting from California, on Friday night, April 25, 1997 at Nye's Restaurant. On Saturday, April 26, 1997, Madson called her to see if she wanted to go dinner with them, however, she had plans. On Sunday morning, April 27, 1997, she spoke to Madson who told her that he and Cunanan had gone to dinner at the Monte Carlo Restaurant. They then went dancing at the Gay 30's. Cunanan then went to etay with another friend, who Ms. Salvetti knew as T.J. or J.T.

Ms. Salvetti also told the officers that Madson and Cunanau were homosexual and had been intimate. Madson told Ms. Salvetti that Cunanan was secretive and elusive and thought he may be into something "shady"

so he put an end to the intimacy of their relationship. Ms. Salvetti told the officers that Madson met Cunanan while visiting friends of his, Karen Lapinski and Evan Wallit, in California. Ms. Salvetti did not speak to Madson after Sunday morning, April 27, 1997.

Minneapolis officers spoke to a neighbor of Madson's, Jessie Schedoan, who told them on Sunday evening, April 27, 1997, he heard some unusual noises coming from Apartment 404. He recalled hearing someone in a very loud voice yell something to the effect of "Get the fuck out." He then heard the wall shaking and thud-like noises. He stated that the yelling and shaking continued for 30 to 45 seconds, then stopped. He went to the hallway after hearing the noises, but didn't see anyone. He then heard the sound of running water coming from Apartment 404.

While processing Madson's apartment, officers observed that his phone was equipped with a caller ID unit, and when the phone rang at a time indicated as 11:05, the call which was not answered came from number 941-5390. The subscriber of that number was J. Trail.

A police officer then called that number and spoke to Jon Hackett. Hackett told the officer that he is homosexual and has an intimate relationship with Jeff Trail. He had called David Hadson's apartment to see if Madson knew of Trail's whereabouts. Hackett told the officers he had reported Jeff Trail missing to the Bloomington Police Department.

Mackett told the officer that he last spoke to Jeff Trail Sunday, April 27, 1997 about 9:00 p.m. Trail told him he was going to meet Andrew at a coffee shop near the Gay 90's and that he would walk to the Gay 90's and meet Jon. Trail told Jon Hackett that Andrew planned on Staying that night at David Madson's. Hackett told the officers that Trail never met him that night, nor did he show up for work Monday as they both work for Ferrell Gas Company.

During the autopsy of Trail, his watch was observed to have stopped at 9:55 on April 37, 1997.

On May 6, 1997, Investigator Rivard spoke to Karen Lapinski and Evan Wallit. They told Rivard that they knew both Cumanan and Madson. Cumanan had told them that he was coming to Minnesota to take care of some business matters with Jeff Trail and to see David Madson. Lapinski told Investigator Rivard that Cumanan and Madson were homosexual and had been intimate, however, Madson was apprehensive about Cumanan.

Also, on May 6, 1997. Investigator Rivard spoke to an individual who stated that on May 2, 1997 he was returning to Pine City from the Twin City area driving north on Interstate 35. As he drove, he observed a red Jeep Cherokee in front of him. He noticed that there was a bumper sticker on the tailgate that wasn't quite straight that said "VAIL" and that the license place number ended with the letters LUG. He observed two males in the vehicle, one with light colored hair and one with dark colored hair. The vehicle would slow down and then speed up. This individual passed the jeep and remembers seeing it in his rear view mirror periodically, however, after passing the Rush City exit, he doesn't recall seeing the jeep again. Madson's vehicle was a 1995 Jeep Cherokee with Minnesota license number 534 LUG. Additionally, it had a "VAIL" bumper sticker on the hatchback consistent with the description given by the reporting party. Further, Madson had blonde hair and Cunanan has dark colored hair.

During the autopsy of Madson, a bullet consistent with that of a .40 caliber Golden Saber was recovered from his chest. Additionally, the coronor indicated the time of death was on or about May 2, 1997.

- 1. I am a BCA Agent with 25 years of law enforcement service and I have received specialised training in the investigation of fugitive offenses. I am currently assigned to investigate fugitive cases through the Minnesota Fugitive Task Force.
- 7. I have reviewed a warrant for the arrest of Andrew Phillip Cunanan issued on May 7, 1997, by Chisago County District Court in Chisago, Minnesota. The warrant charges Cunanan with Murder in the Second Degree (Intentional), in violation of Minnesota Statutes 1996, 5609.19, Subd 1(1), 5609.11, a falony crime in the State of Minnesota. The warrant alleges that on . Cunanan committed murder in the second degree at Chisago County, Minnesota.
- 3. Despite attempts by investigating officers to locate Cunanan, he has not been found in the State of Minnesota since the Varrant was issued.
- 4. Cunanan was seen on Saturday, May 3, 1997, in Minneapolis driving a red 1995 Jeep Cherokee, license 543 MUG.
- 5. On May 7, 1997, this jeep was found parked in Chicago, Illinois.

Wealthy Developer Found Slain in His Garage

CHICAGO May 7-Lee Migin dreamed big dreams. In the late 1980s, he announced plans to con-struct a 125-story office tower ere that would be the world a tall-

Because of financing problems. the project was never developed, but that did not diminish Miglin's business reputation or the ragu-tosiches sure of his story as the son of an immigrant coal miner who became one of this city's most prominent and socially active real estate developers."

All that ended Sunday morning when the bloody body of Miglin 72, his bead bound in masking tape and his body covered with plastic and brown wrapping paper, was found by police in the garage of his elegant brownstone home in Chicago's wealthiest neighborhood, known as the Gold Coast. He had been stabbed several times, his throat had been slashed, his chest pounded by a blunt instrument. Police Superintendent Matt Rodrirocz said there was evidence that e had been tortured before he

In a city where violent street crime is all too common, Miglin's gruesome death has sent a shudder through business and society circles and shocked the exclusive Gold Coast enclave, which hugs the shores of Lake Michigan north of downtown. Today, the case also appeared possibly linked to twocarlier alayings in Minnesota that authorities said involved men who may have been lovers.

The link was a 1995 sports willty vehicle that has been illegally parted for several days around the corner from Miglin's home. Police said the vehicle's Minnesots license plates were registered to David Madson, 33, a Minneapolis interior designer; who was found Chisago County northeast of Minneapolis on Saturday.

Madson's body was discovered four days after another murder victim, Jeffrey Trail, 28, was found beaten to death and rolled up in a

carpet in Madson's loft apartment in a trendy warehouse district near. downtown Minneapolis.

While Chicago police were searching today for Miglin's missing luxury automobile, police in Chizago County, Minn., leaved a warrant for the arrest of Andrew Conznan, 27, in Madaon's slaying. According to news reports here and in Minnespolis, Cunanan and Crail were lovers.

There is considerable speculation that some part of this is part of a lover's triangle, but we don't know that for sure," said Penny Parrish, a spokeswoman for the Minneapolis police department.

How, or even it, the Minnesota slayings were connected to Miglin's violent death was not known, but the presence of Madson's vehicle on a quiet Chicago street only deepened the mystery surrounding the killing of the real estate tycoon. According to Mark Jarasek a spokesman for Miglin's real estate development firm, and John hot to death-near a lake in rural ... Ryan, whose retail marketing firm employed Madson, there is no known link between the two men.

Miglin was 'a very, very private individual," Jarasek said.



CASKU recommended Rapid Start as an information management tool, discussed interview strategies, and offered behavioral considerations. CASKU emphasized to the group that we did not have pertinent FD302s or copies of crime scene/autopsy photographs or investigative reports important to fully develop offender characteristics.
- On 7/16/97, CASKU again participated in a conference call with FBIHQ (Unit SSA BI Minneapolis, Chicago, Philadelphia, and Miami. Miami advised that the red truck found in a parking garage near the crime scene of Versace was the stolen vehicle taken from the homicide scene of victim Reese (New Jersey). 

Details: CASKU first became actively involved in the CUNANAN matter on 5/16/97 when UC Violent Crime Unit (VCU), FBI Headquarters (HQ), requested CASKU's assistance in providing information on "Profiling" serial killers. UC needed this information for inclusion in a statement Assistant Director Esposito was going to provide to the media regarding CUNANAN. The information was provided and it was used although the content was changed somewhat by HQ personnel and its accuracy therefore suffered.

On 5/19/97 SSA HOLD HQ, telephonically contacted CASKU and requested the Unit's participation in a conference call with HQ personnel scheduled for 5/20/97. The Unit participated in that call and discussed interview strategies and offered 252-18-4777-9

On 7/15/97 captioned victim Versace was murdered in front of his home in Miami Beach, Florida. On 7/16/97 CASKU was asked to participate in a teleconference with FBI personnel from (HQ), Miami (MI), Minneapolis (MN), Chicago (CG), and Philadelphia (PH). During this teleconference CASKU suggested: 1) That consideration be given to utilizing Rapid Start in the two existing CUNANAN cases (MN and PH) so there would be an accurate 2) That consideration be given to scheduling a conference to be attended by all the Field Divisions having an interest in the CUNANAN investigation. This would enable CASKU to view the crime scenes from all five cases and therefore be in a better position to predict CUNANAN's future behavior. 3) That consideration be given to determining who, from CUNANAN's closest friends, might be the most appropriate person to make a national plea for CUNANAN's surrender. 4) The development of a comprehensive offender time line.

Subsequent to the 7/15/97 teleconference CASKU personnel were asked to participate in each subsequent, daily teleconference from 7/16/97 through 7/23/97. During those eight days the above four suggestions were adopted by all the teleconference attendees which grew to include Los Angeles (LA), San Francisco (SF), New York (NY), San Diego (SD) and Boston (BS). The above-referenced conference was convening when CUNANAN took his own life in MI on 7/23/97.

During the above conference, though a "Profile" was not an expectation, CASKU personnel were able to offer a number of suggestions which, if followed, would strengthen the evidentiary case against CUNANAN through utilization of forensic evidence to include hair, fiber and body fluid collection and comparison.

The first documented indication that ANDREW P. CUNANAN, driving the LEE MIGLIN Lexus, was in the vicinity of Pennsville, New Jersey was at 2:28 PM EDT on 5/9/97. This documentation was provided by Ameritech Cellular, showing incoming, unanswered calls to the cell phone installed in the center console of the Lexus. There had been reports in the media indicating that the police were tracking the movements of CUNANAN by monitoring the signal being emitted by the cell phone in the Lexus.

Witnesses in the Pennsville, New Jersey area put the vehicle in the vicinity of the Finn's Point National Cemetery by 1:00 PM on 5/9/97. These times are all estimated.

A witness observed what is believed to have been CUNANAN attempting to dismantle the telephone in the center console of the vehicle. When recovered, the hand set wire connecting it to the cradle had been cut, most likely with the pliers from the Lexus tool kit. The antenna had been removed from the rear window mount; the head liner at the rear window had been pulled down and the antenna wire from the antenna mount removed. With all of these attempts to eliminate the signal, the phone would still intone when engaging the ignition, giving the impression that the signal was still actively transmitting.

The body of the victim was found in the basement of the cemetery office building. The door to the basement had been latch locked by CUNANAN before he left the scene.

The vehicle was parked (neatly) next to the spot where the victim's pickup truck would have been parked.

Absolutely no connection between CUNANAN and the victim has been established nor is there one suspected.

It is the opinion of all involved in this homicide investigation that CUNANAN killed WILLIAM R. REESE for his vehicle, a red 1995 Chevrolet pickup truck.

Investigation conducted since that time revealed the probability that CUNANAN proceeded south (I 95) and removed a license tag from a car in Florence, South Carolina. Most likely while parked in a Wall-Mart parking lot near SC 20 and I 95).

The owner of the tag has said the plate had been held on loosely by one bolt.

Evidence found in the pickup truck in Miami Beach, Florida indicated CUNANAN probably stayed in New York, from 5/5/97 through 5/8/97.

It should be noted that the most direct route to Pennsville, New Jersey would be the New Jersey Turnpike.

Evidence obtained to date seems to indicate that CUNANAN traveled directly to New York from Chicago, Ill., via I 80.

While the Veteran's Administration representatives were conducting their inspection of the cemetery office space on 6/20/97, a bible was found on the desk. In the bible was an index card marking certain passages which speak of "Unknown Murderers", Deuteronomy, chapters 19 through 22. The victim was a religious man and studied the bible.




